

Objective

Eligibility

Any student in grades 6-12 can submit one original poster.

Specifications

Theme: **Engineering** (Mechanical, Electrical, Robotic, Civil, Construction, Chemical, Computer, Solar, Industrial)

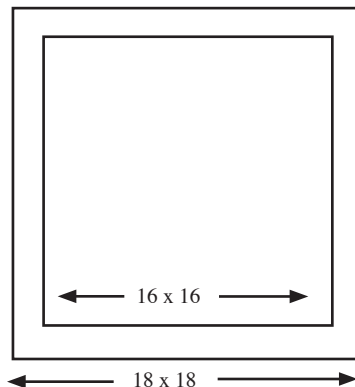
Square design 16" x 16".

Black & white only, no color.

No title, just the design.

Mounted on white poster board: 18" x 18" (1-inch border).

Use spray mount for cleaner look and **erase all pencil marks.**

Judging Criteria

Visual quality, artistic skill and originality. The poster should be easily viewed across a room, as well as look nice when reduced to about 7" x 7" so it can be used as the science fair program cover. Any scientific symbols, formulas, illustrations and icons should be accurate.

Prizes

Grand Prize \$300. 2nd Place \$200. Honorable Mentions in 3 grade divisions (6-7, 8-9, 10-12) are \$75 each. Teachers of all prize winners will receive gift certificates for art supplies.

Awards Ceremony

Receive prizes at the Neal Blaisdell Center Exhibition Hall in the Pikake Room on Wednesday, April 2, 2008 at 4:30 PM.

Poster Pick-up

Posters can be picked up outside Pikake Hall on the day of the Awards Ceremony (April 2) between 5 PM and 8 PM. If you cannot make these times, call beforehand to arrange for pick-up at another time, or your poster will be discarded.
