Based on premise that ancient Hawaiian warriors were renowned not only for their warfighting skills, bravery and courage, but also for their fairness and exceptional ability to rule through respect for the good of the entire community.

Detachment History:

Military instruction began at University of Hawaii during WWI and continued during the interwar years. In 1941, the university's ROTC program was called to active duty and earned a battle streamer defending Oahu after the Japanese attack. Although the Air Force became a separate service in 1947, it was not until 1952 that the Air Force established a separate officer training program at the University of Hawaii with the activation of Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 175. Over the years, the unit has commissioned more than 1,000 officers into the world's greatest Air Force. Distinguished alumni include Major General Darryll Wong, commander of the Hawaii Air National Guard and Don Ho, the legendary entertainer.
