Increase knowledge and awareness at all levels of society about long term care, aging, and supportive services.

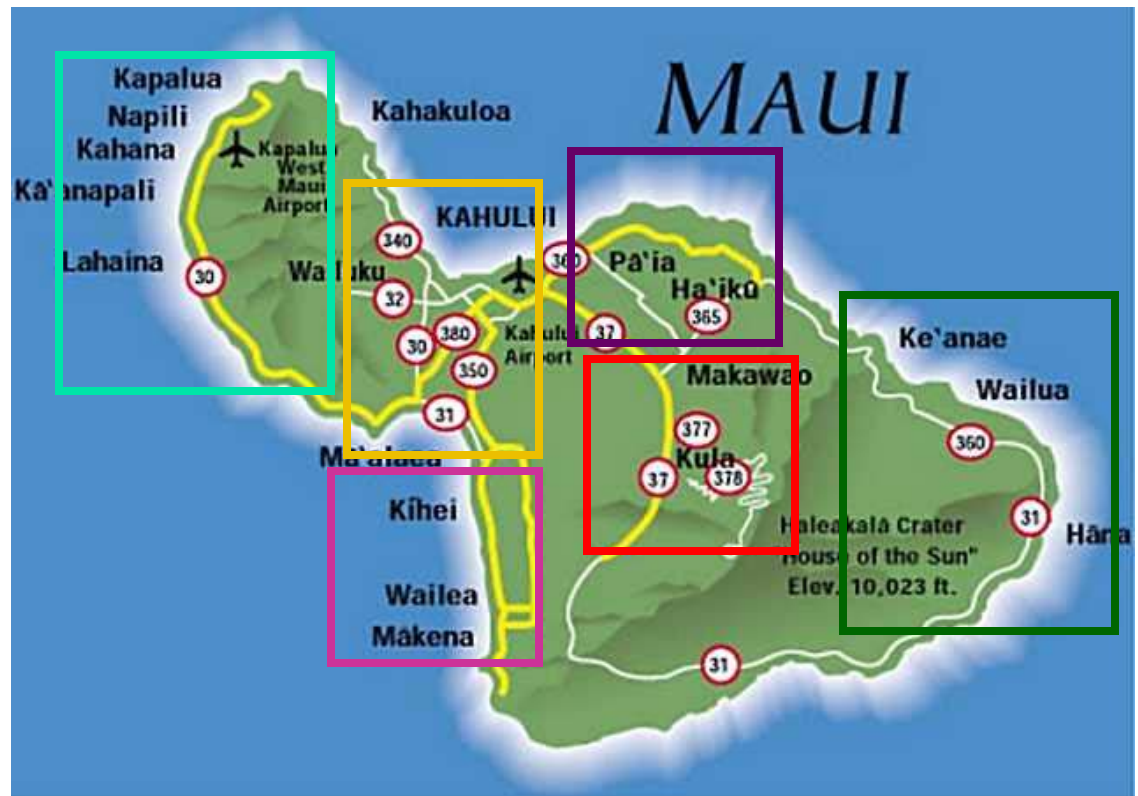
Provide education and training to long term care caregivers.

Develop, implement, and sustain an organized long-term care infrastructure that matches the community's needs and preferences.

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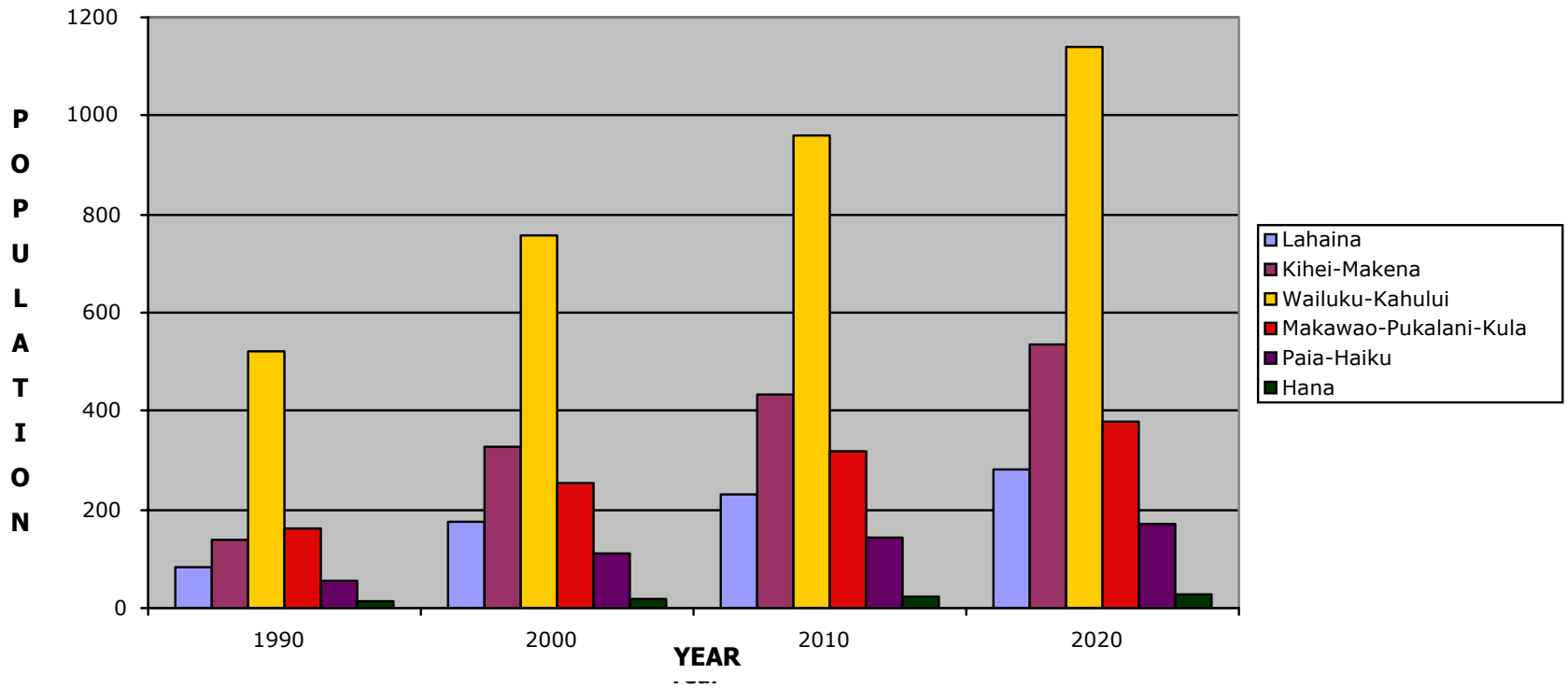

What is *Aging with Aloha*?

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What is Long Term Care?

- The range of home and facility based care and assistance received by Kupuna and people with disabilities so that they can live as independently as possible.
- Long term care is provided formally and informally. Formally includes certified nurses and nursing assistants. Informally includes caregivers and volunteers in a home setting.
