Application Deadline: By 3:00 p.m., Friday, March 14, 2008

Submission of this application will entitle the applicant to consideration for a Graduate Tuition Waiver or a Pacific-Asian Tuition Waiver in the Art and Art History Department for Fall semester 2008.

All applications are evaluated following the guidelines issued by the Graduate Division.

All awards are merit awards, based on high quality artistic endeavors and distinguished academic achievement. Cumulative GPA must be 3.5 or better for a Pacific-Asian Tuition Waiver and 3.0 for a Tuition Waiver. **Applicant must be a classified graduate student registered for a minimum of eight credits of degree related classes by May 16 for the Fall 2008 semester.**

In addition, Pacific-Asian Tuition Waivers require that a student be a resident of an eligible country in the Pacific Asian region OR pursuing a course of study with a Pacific Asian focus. MFA majors may apply for a Pacific Asian Tuition Waiver but the application will require a statement of how their study is connected to the Pacific Asian region. Eligible countries include China (including Hong Kong and Macao), Fiji, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Myanmar, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Vietnam, and small island nations in the Pacific. Hawai'i is excluded.

Announcement of awards will be made by May 23. Although all awards are for one semester only, renewal is possible for the spring semester if the grade point average is maintained.
