**SUBJECT:** AiM Advisory Committee Deliverables

This memorandum is to notify you, co-chairs of the University of Hawai'i Business Process Council (BPC), that the AiM Advisory Committee (AAC) has finalized its deliverables for consideration by the BPC.

The AAC was established by the BPC at its meeting on July 24, 2013, with the charge to review and identify key needs and deliverables on space information needs across the University of Hawai'i System. The AAC formally met five times, with its last meeting on June 20, 2014, when its deliverables were approved. The AAC's recommendations are posted at the BPC website and include:
