OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM BUDGET

REQUEST FOR THE 2007-2009 FISCAL BIENNIUM

Transmitted herewith in accordance with Section 37-68, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, is the University of Hawai'i's Operating and Capital Improvements Program (CIP) Budget Request for the 2007-2009 Fiscal Biennium, as approved by the University of Hawai'i Board of Regents on September 21, 2006.

Operating Budget

The University's biennium operating budget request is primarily based on achieving the goals and objectives of its strategic plan: *University of Hawaii System Strategic plan: Entering the University's Second Century, 2002-2010*, and addressing the higher education needs of the State as identified in the *Second Decade Project*. Together, these documents were used to formulate the environmental context for the preparation of the biennium budget request. As cited in the *Second Decade Project*, the major components of the planning process were:

- To identify the higher education needs of the State of Hawaii in the next decade;
- To determine those needs that should be met by which of the campuses within the UH system;

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- To determine the means by which those responsibilities should be financed;
- To determine the relative priority of state higher education needs by region of the state; and
- To use this information to inform the 2007-09 Biennium Budget proposal development.

The following initiatives were identified as the higher education needs of the State and adopted as institutional priorities for the development of the 2007-09 biennium budget request:

- 1. Increase the educational capital of the state
 - · Increase college going rate
 - Increase transfer from 2 year to 4 year campuses
 - Increase production of certificates, associate, and bachelor's degrees
- 2. Expand workforce development initiatives
 - Increase outreach to those not in the workforce
 - Expand program capacity in critical shortage areas
- 3. Assist in diversifying the economy
 - · Increase education to encourage entrepreneurship
 - Increase technology transfer
 - Increase responsiveness to training needs
- 4. Address underserved regions and populations of the state, particularly Native Hawaiians
 - Increase educational services to western Oahu (Waianae, North Shore, Ewa) and West Hawaii
 - Increase student participation and success in all regions of the state, particularly East Hawaii

To support the above initiatives, separate categories were created for infrastructure/ support services and technical adjustments.

The University's general fund operating budget request totals an additional \$38,726,634 and 388.00 permanent positions in the first year of the biennium and \$58,116,277 and 590.50 permanent positions in the second year. 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Capital Improvements Program Budget

The University of Hawai'i Board of Regents' Capital Improvements Program (CIP) Budget for Fiscal Biennium 2007-2009 includes 27 projects totaling \$697.963 million. The CIP Budget is focused on meeting the higher education needs of the State of Hawai'i and is categorized in the following nine categories:

- 1. Health, Safety, and Code Requirements;
- 2. Capital Renewal and Deferred Maintenance;
- 3. Projects Addressing Critically Underserved Regions and Populations:
- 4. Infrastructure Projects;
- 5. Major CIP Planning;
- 6. Project Addressing Critical Systemwide Infrastructure:
- 7. Projects Addressing Workforce Development:
- 8. Projects Increasing the Educational Capital of the State; and
- 9. Funding Authorization

The University of Hawai'i's first priority, <u>Health, Safety, and Code Requirements</u>, includes imminent life safety and code mandates. Projects included in this project include: fire safety improvements; air conditioning modifications to eradicate mold and to meet animal research ventilation requirements; grease trap upgrades, traffic safety improvements, cesspool closures and sewage line/septic tank connections; and critical electrical upgrades. Our second priority, <u>Capital Renewal and Deferred Maintenance</u>, is necessary to combat our backlog of deferred maintenance, which is currently estimated at \$165 million.

Priorities three through five address <u>Critically Underserved Regions and Populations</u>. Priority three, University of Hawai'i-West O'ahu Campus Development, includes a total of \$135 million, of which \$100 million is expected to be raised from private sources as part of the University's Public/Private development of lands in Kapolei. The University is requesting State funding in the form of general obligation bonds for the remaining \$35 million. Priority four, Leeward Community College's Waianae Education Center, will acquire the existing education center which the University is currently leasing. The project also includes renovations to the facility to expand educational services to the Waianae region. Priority five includes planning funds to develop facility requirements for Native Hawaiian Success Centers at University campuses.

Priority six is a Systemwide project for <u>Infrastructure Improvements</u>, and includes projects related to energy conservation, shore line protection at Coconut Island, electrical generators, roadway improvements, and telecommunications infrastructure. Priority seven includes funding for <u>Major CIP Planning</u> to update campus long range physical development plans and planning documents for major new projects.

Priority eight, Information Technology Center, addresses a <u>Critical Systemwide</u> <u>Infrastructure</u> requirement by developing a new information technology facility. The

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project, to be located on the Mānoa campus, is particularly critical to address the vulnerability of the University's entire information and communications infrastructure.

Priorities nine through eleven address <u>Workforce Development</u> needs. Priority nine, Temporary Facilities for Nursing Programs, will enable the immediate development of program space to address workforce shortfalls in the area of nursing. The project will enable the expansion of nursing programs on O'ahu, Maui, Kaua'i, and the Big Island. Priority ten, Leeward Community College's Social Sciences/Teacher Education Facility, will provide a new facility to house the Teacher Education and Training program as well as consolidate the Social Sciences division. Priority 11, Honolulu Community College's Advanced Technology Training Center, will provide critically needed space for science and technology related programs and training.

Priorities twelve through twenty-three are projects that <u>Increase the Educational Capital of the State</u>. The majority of these projects have prior appropriations and are crucial to University programs. We would like to highlight priority 17, the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa's College of Education Building, which is necessary to replace the building which was destroyed by the June 13, 2006 fire.

Priorities twenty-four through twenty-seven are projects that require funding authorization.

A summary of the CIP budget request by major unit and means of finance is attached (attachments 5 and 6).

Pursuant to Finance Memorandum 06-07, please find attached Tables P, Q, and R, and Forms S and PAB for all projects included in the University of Hawai'i Board of Regents' CIP Budget for Fiscal Biennium 2007-2009. Tables P, Q, and R have been updated in the State of Hawai'i's eCIP program. Also attached is a report detailing the schedules of projects included in our request.
