This course is designed to help elementary teachers understand the basic principles and concepts of economics to teach in grades K-6, support the Hawai'i Content Performance Standards (HCPSII) in their instruction; learn ways to meet the economics criteria of the Standards-Based report card. In addition, teachers will learn ways to integrate economics with other subject areas such as language arts, life skills, and mathematics; and examine instructional materials and teaching strategies to teach economics in the elementary classroom.
