If you want to apply for a PD credit, you will be expected to develop a Learning Results Portfolio. This application or implementation phase of the Enriching the Curriculum Through Economics course will require work on your part demonstrating the how the course content has impacted your classroom teaching.

The purpose of the Learning Result Portfolio is to provide you with an opportunity to demonstrate *what* you learned from Enriching the Curriculum Through Economics course about teaching developmentally appropriate economics lessons and *how* you implemented what you learned in your own classroom. It also supports you to reflect on your own learning and how that learning is carried over into the classroom. Serious reflection on what worked and what didn't and why, should be seen as way to advance learning for yourself and for your students.

3. Provide artifacts to document student understanding of the lessons.
4. Submit your work by January 30, 2006.
