June 2006 Hawaii Public High School Graduates Enrolled in Remedial and/or Developmental Classes at the University of Hawai'i Community Colleges in Fall 2006

The percentage of graduates enrolled in remedial/developmental English and Math courses can be examined in two ways. The first is by the number of registrations in remedial/developmental English and Math courses, which denotes the volume of classes taken by students. However, because this is a registration count, a student registered in a two remedial English courses is counted twice. Thus the percentages will be inflated by such multiple registrations.

The second method of analysis is by an unduplicated headcount¹ of those in remedial/developmental English or Math courses, regardless of the number of classes they are taking. Since a number of students take more than one English class and more than one Math class, especially at the remedial level, the headcount method is the preferable and more accurate way to measure the percentage of high school graduates enrolled in remedial or developmental classes as it avoids multiple counting.

Registration counts

Table 1 summarizes registration counts (the first analysis method) in remedial/developmental English and Math classes. Overall, 65% of June 2006 Hawaii public high school registrations are in remedial or developmental English classes, and 64% are in remedial or developmental Math classes. As stated above, the numbers and percentages show the volume of classes taken. However, the percentages are inflated by multiple registrations, for instance when a student is registered for a series of remedial classes, thus are not the focus of this analysis.

Headcounts

The focus of this analysis is the number or the headcount of students enrolled in remedial/developmental classes, found in Tables 2 to 10.

Of the 2,589 June 2006 Hawaii public high school graduates enrolled at the University of Hawaiii Community Colleges in Fall 2006:

- 1,295 or 50.0% were enrolled in remedial or developmental English classes: 361 or 13.9% in remedial English classes, and 934 or 36.1% in developmental English classes. Students from Windward county high schools had the lowest percentage enrollments in remedial/development English classes at 32.6%, while students from Kauai County schools had the highest percentage enrollments at 65.5%
- 1,251 or 48.3% were enrolled in remedial/developmental Math classes: 341 or 13.2% in remedial Math classes, and 910 or 35.1% in developmental Math classes. Students from Hawaii county schools had the lowest percentage enrollments remedial/developmental Math classes at 38.9%, while students from Honolulu district schools had the highest percentage remedial/development Math enrollments at 53.3%.

Tables 3 through 10 show percentages of June 2006 public high school graduates enrolled in remedial/developmental English and Math classes by public high school and English/Math class. There are 3 different percentages shown:

¹ The headcounts are unduplicated only within these 4 distinct groups: remedial English, developmental English, remedial Math, developmental Math. Registrations were not unduplicated between remedial and developmental courses or between English and Math courses. Thus the unduplicated headcounts are still duplicated to the extent that there are multiple registrants between and among remedial/developmental and English/Math groups.

- of the total June 2006 public high school graduates, the percentage enrolled in remedial or developmental classes
- 2. of the June 2006 public high school graduates, the percentage enrolled at the UHCCs (also known as the UHCC going rate, shown here for comparison purposes), and
- 3. of the June 2006 public high school graduates enrolled at the UHCCs, the percentage enrolled in remedial or developmental classes.

Tables 3 to 6 are sorted by the third percentage mentioned above, the percentage of high school grads at the UHCCs who are enrolled in remedial/developmental classes. The tables show the schools whose percentage of students enrolled in remedial or developmental classes fall above or below the mean. Tables 7 to 10 order the schools by county.

It should be noted that the 4-year campuses of the University, at Manoa, Hilo and West O'ahu did not offer remedial or developmental English or Math classes.
