Community Colleges - Total

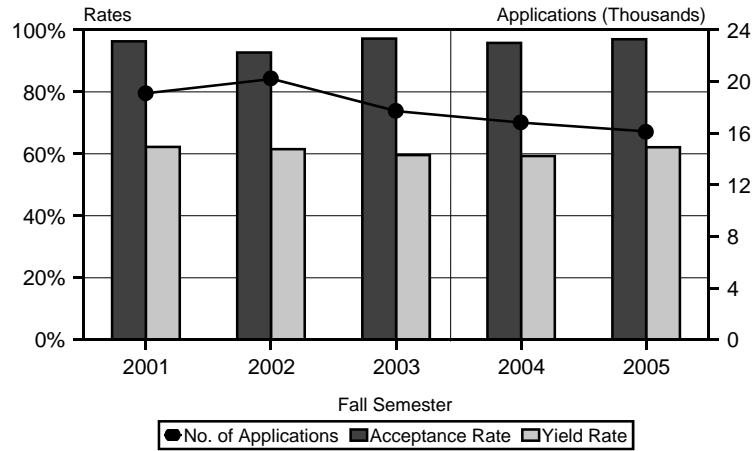

Hawai'i CC

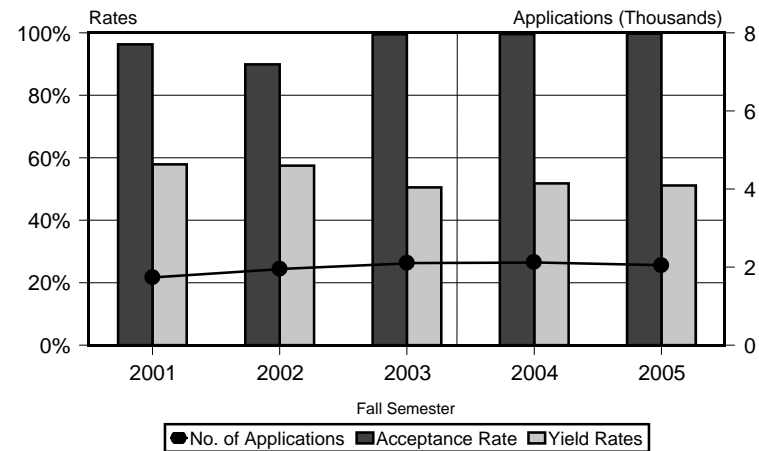

Honolulu CC

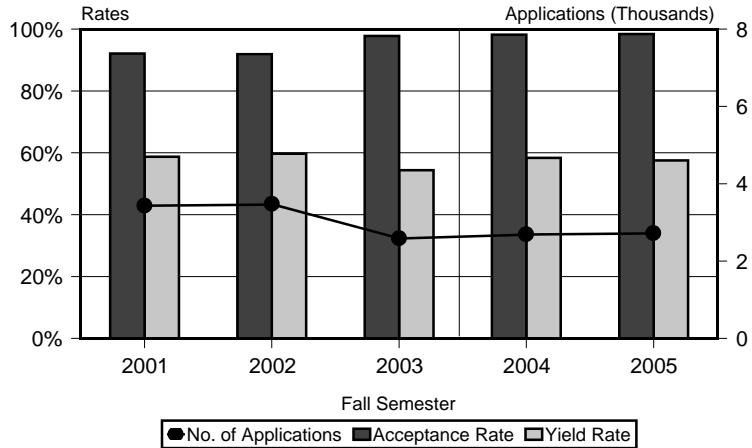
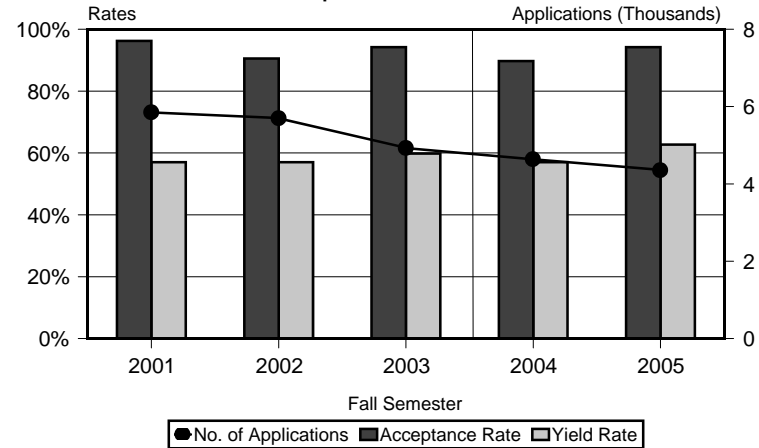

Kaua'i CC

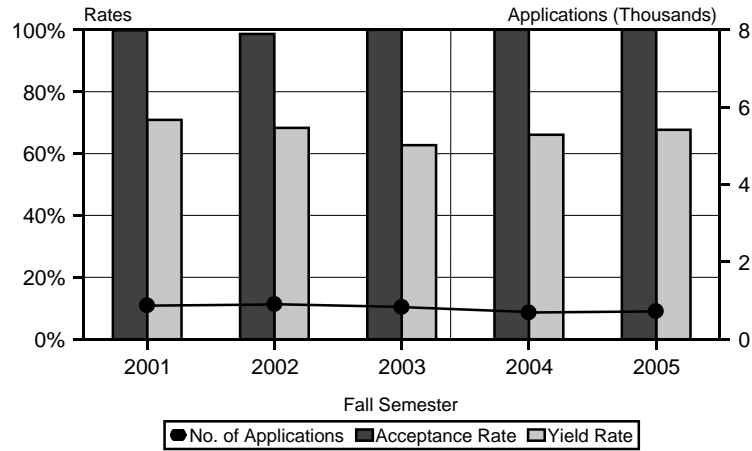

Leeward CC

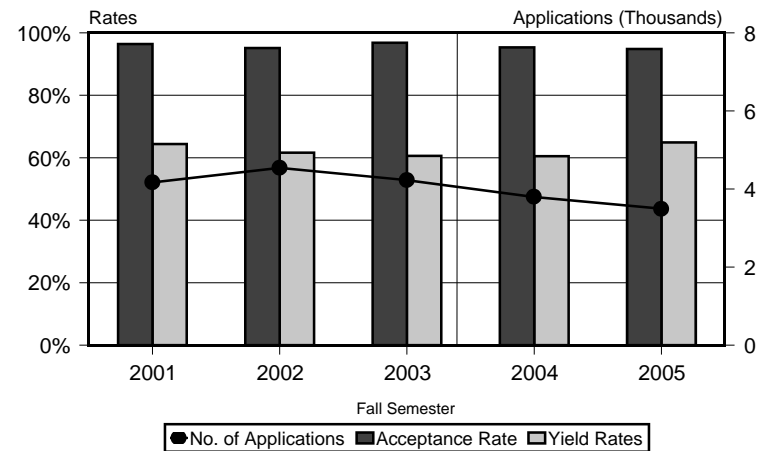

Maui CC

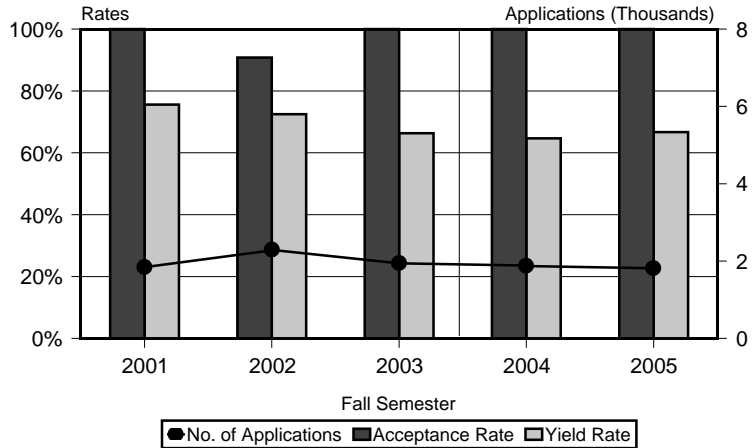
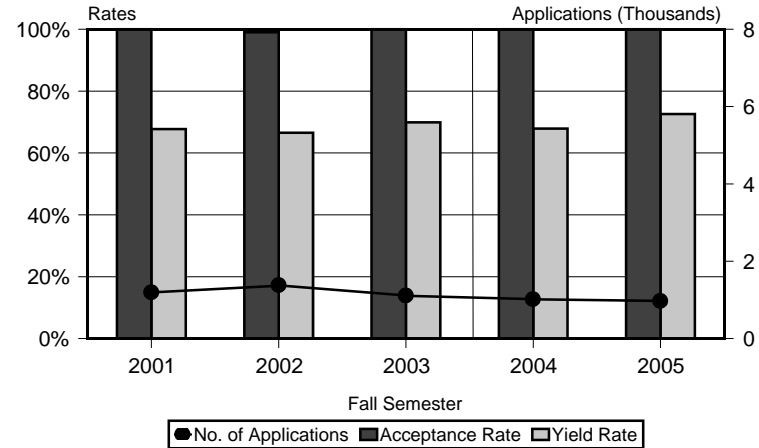


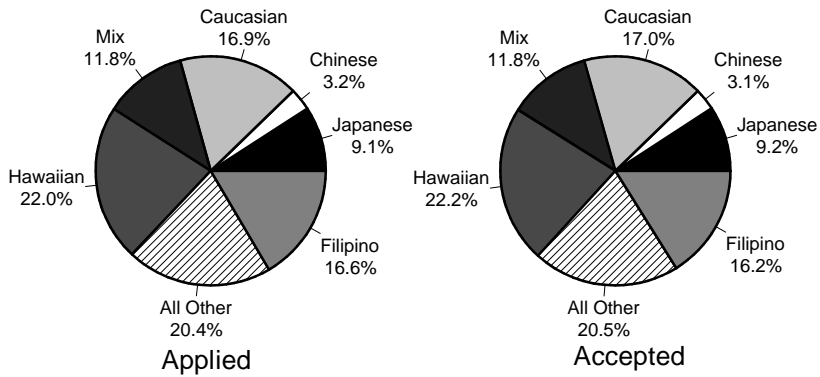

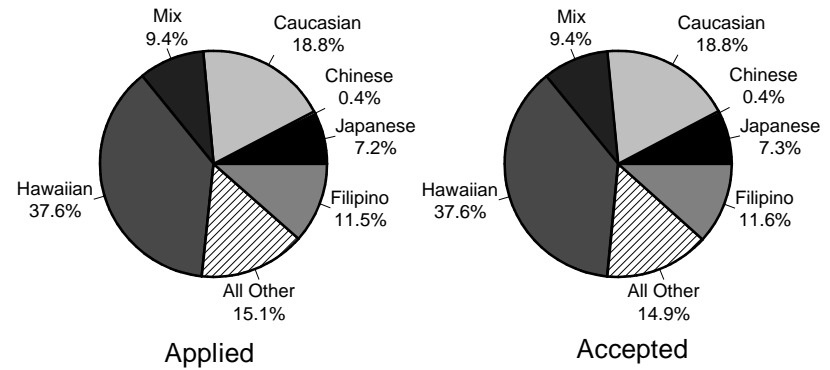

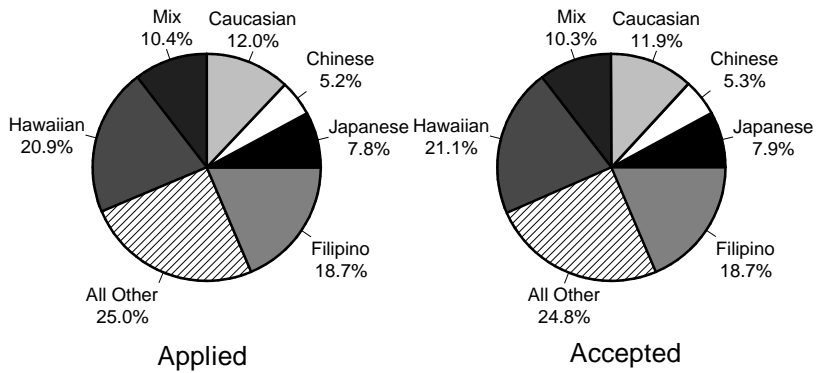

Community Colleges - Total**



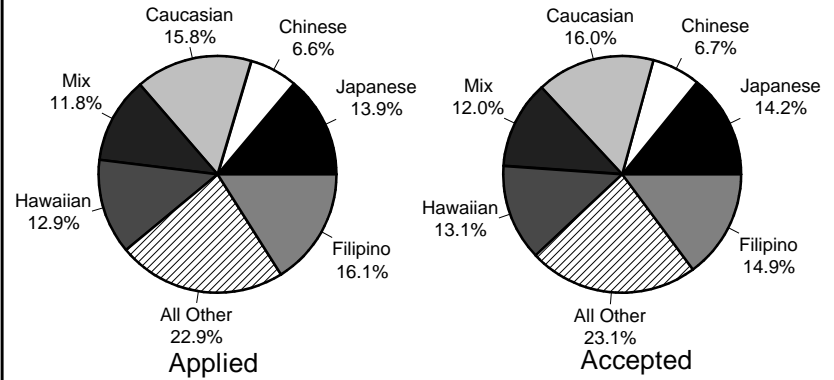

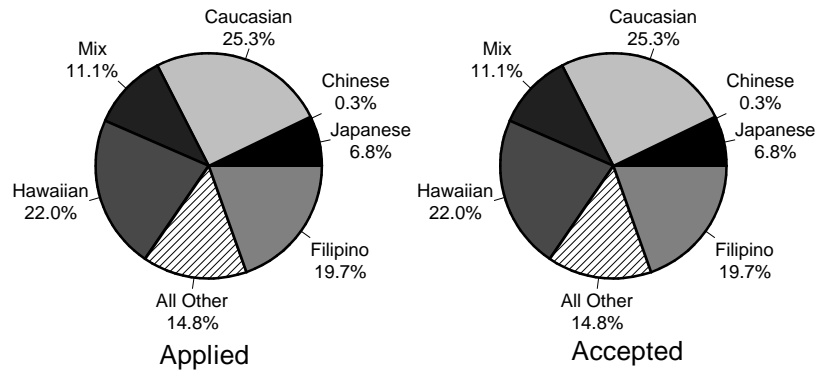

Kapi'olani CC**

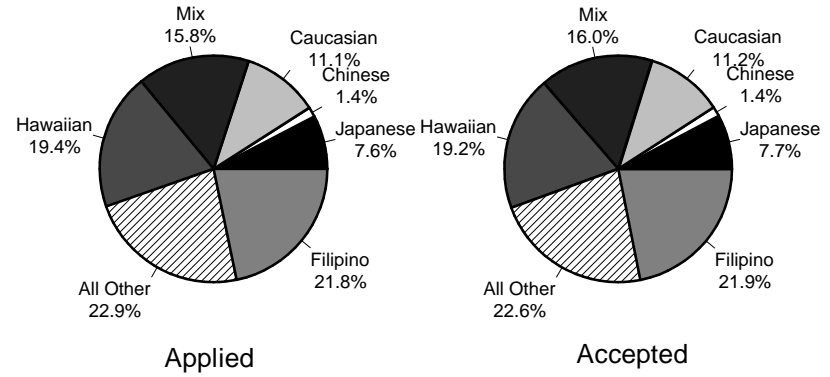

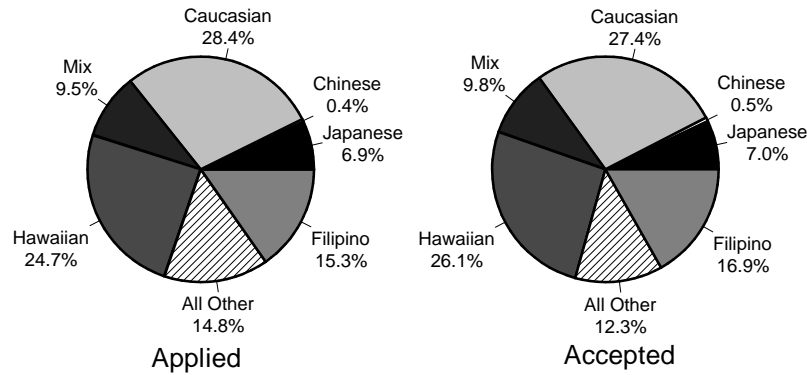

Kaua'i CC**



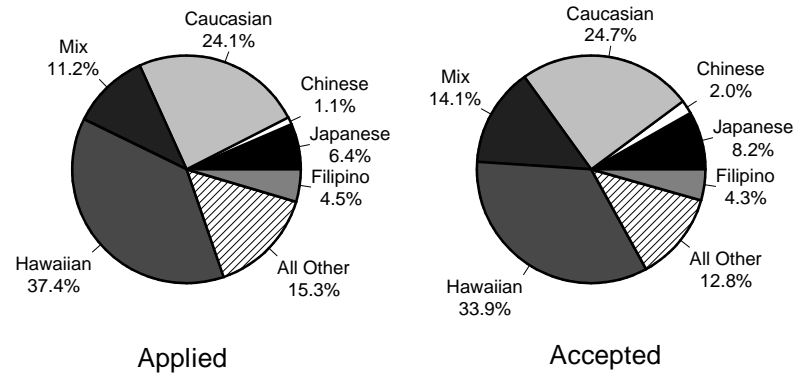

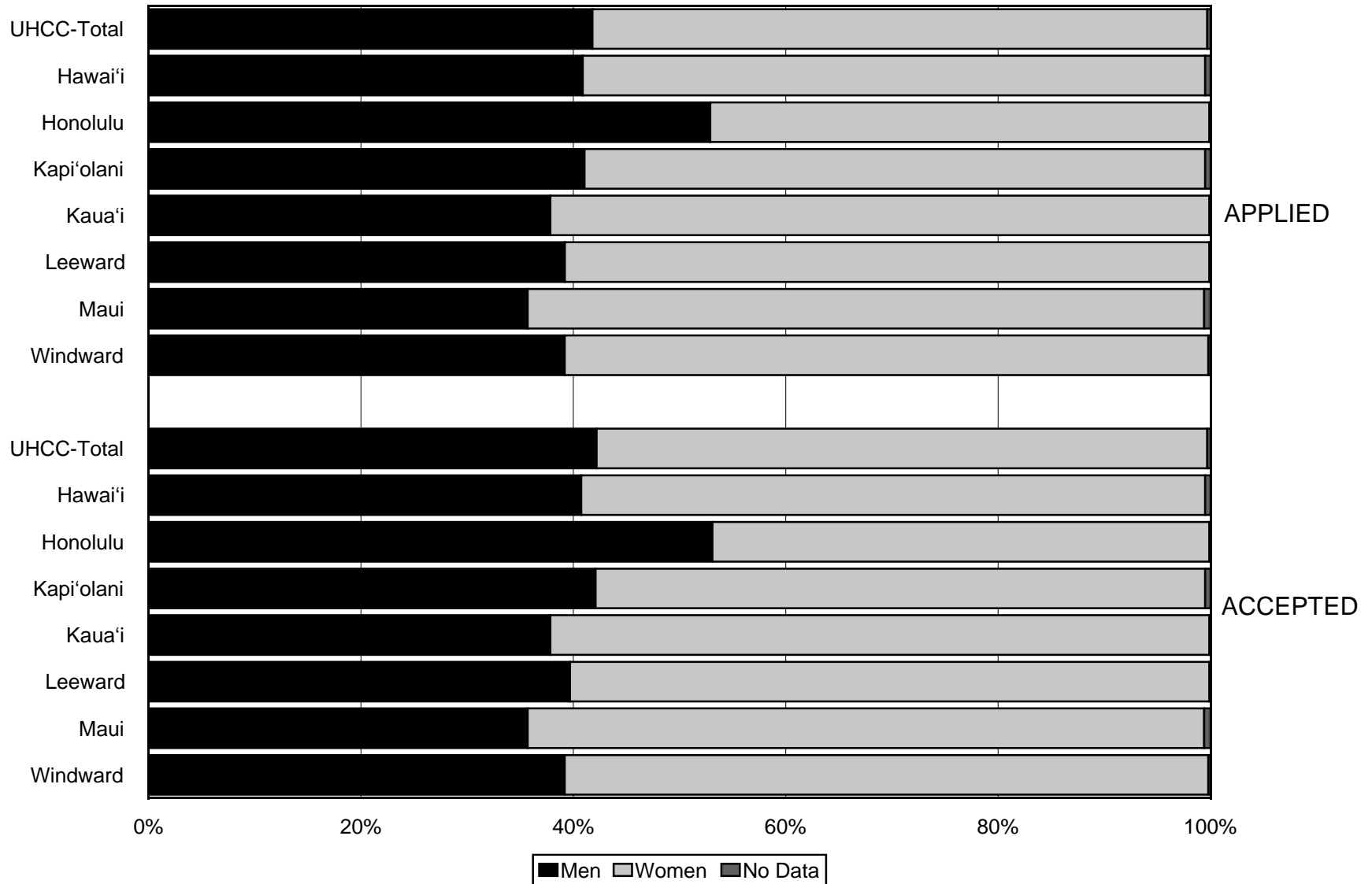
