Applications Processed - All UHCC Campuses

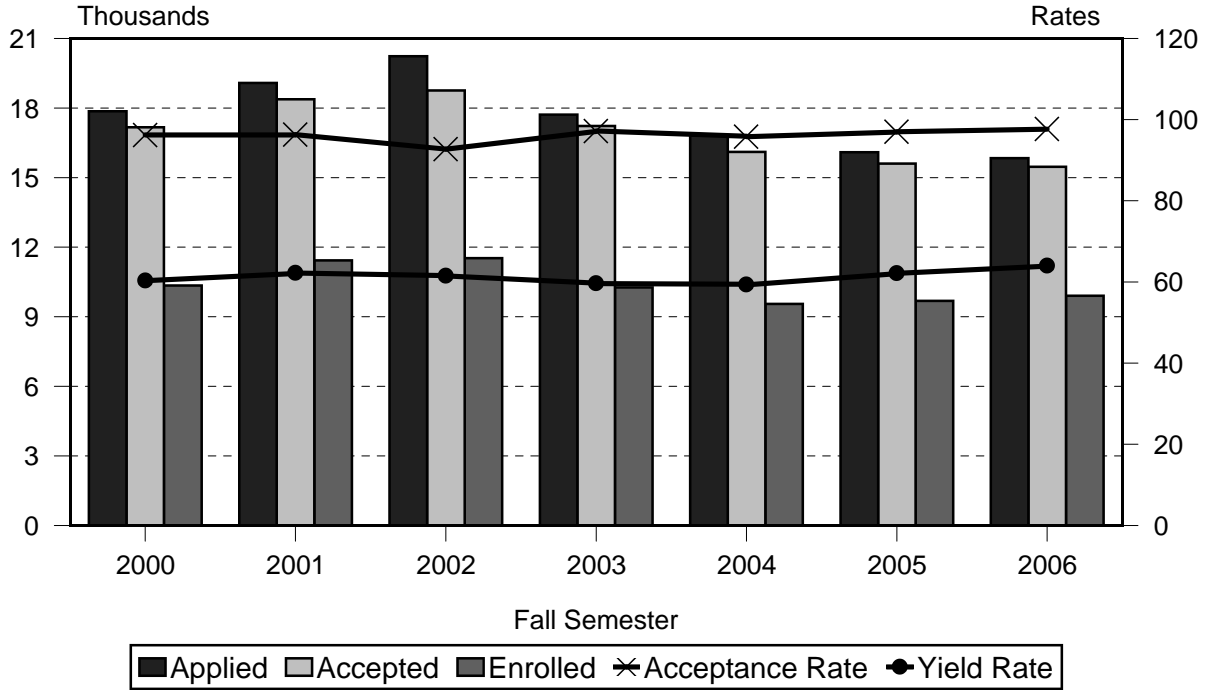
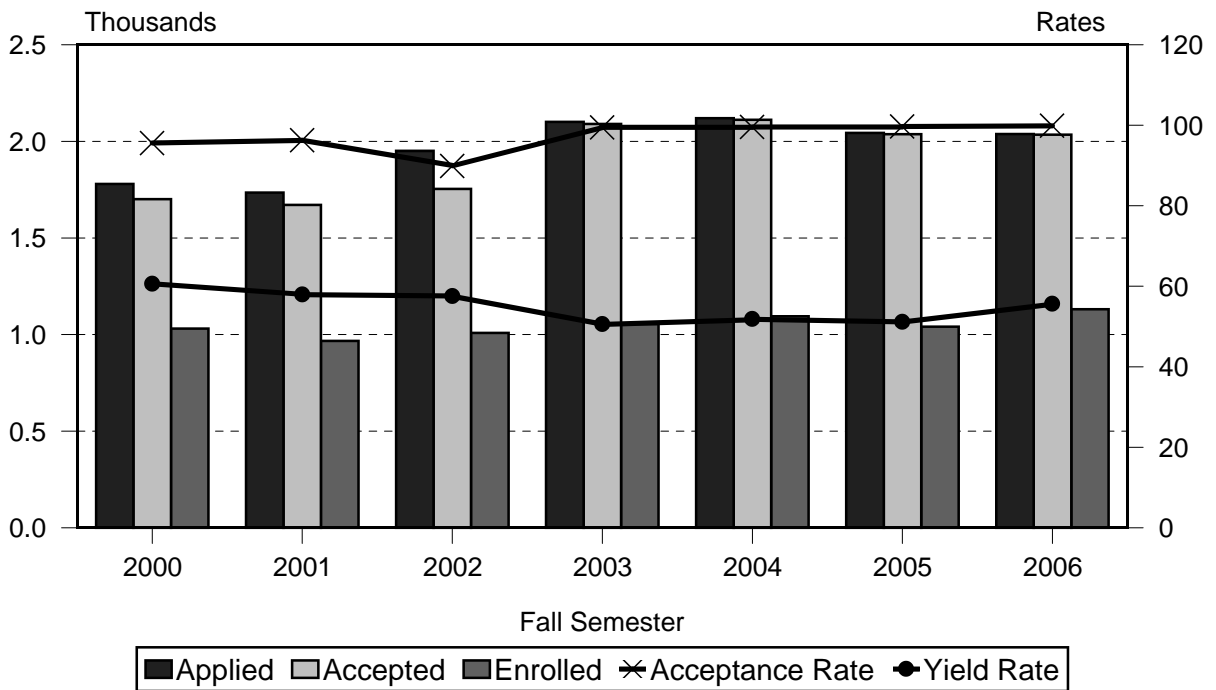

Figure 3 Applications Processed - Honolulu CC

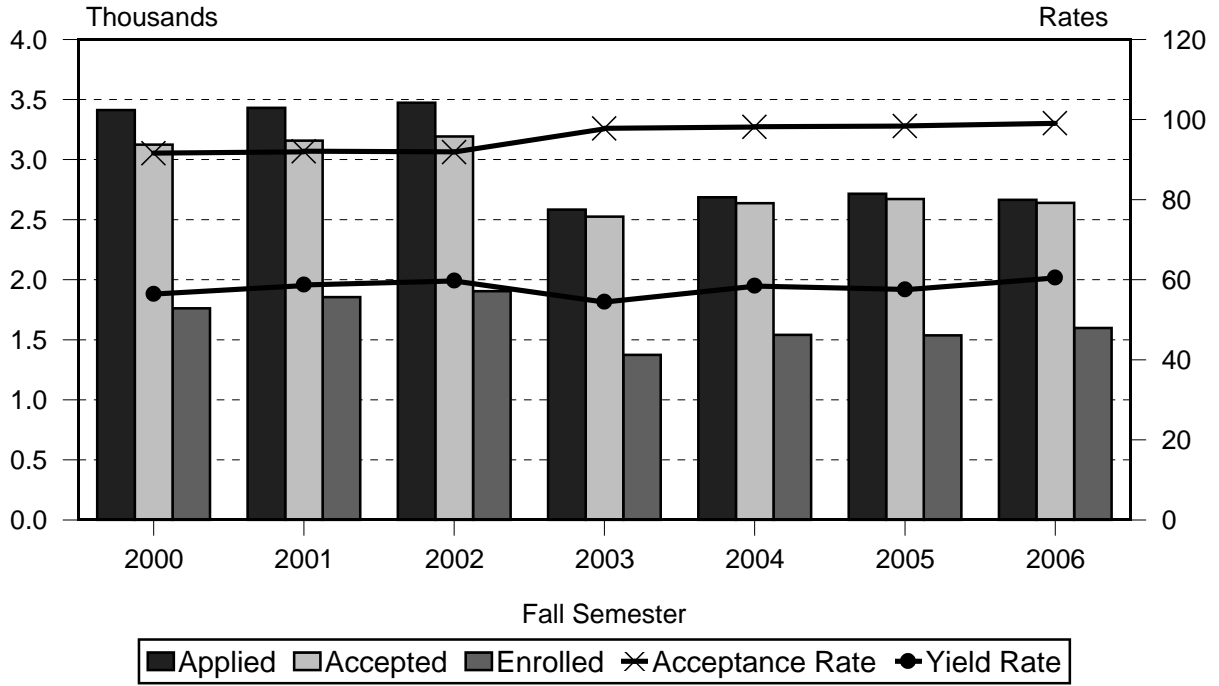
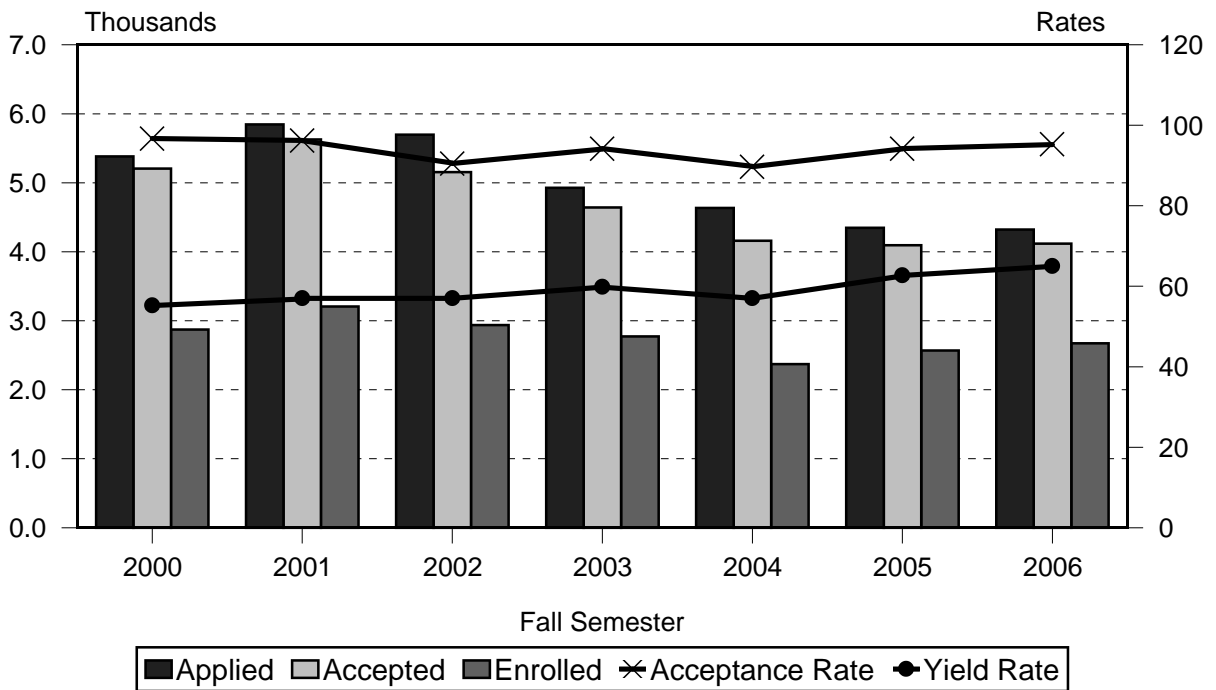


Figure 4 Applications Processed - Kapi'olani CC

Figure 5 Applications Processed - Kaua'i CC

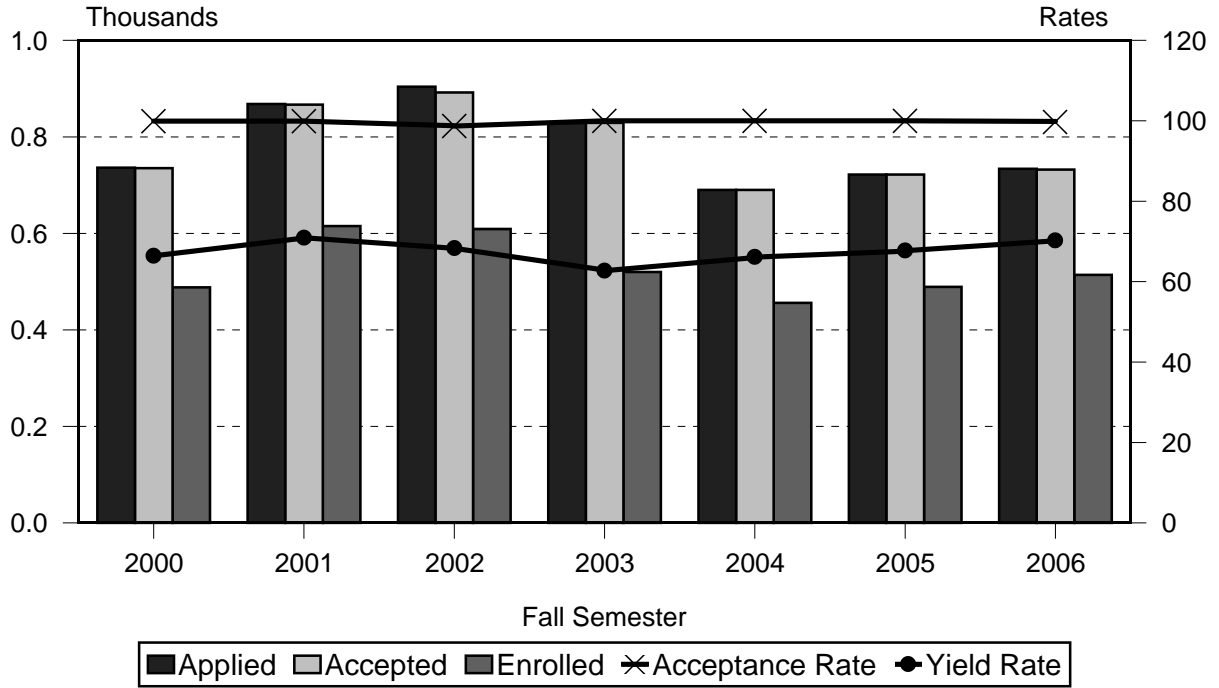
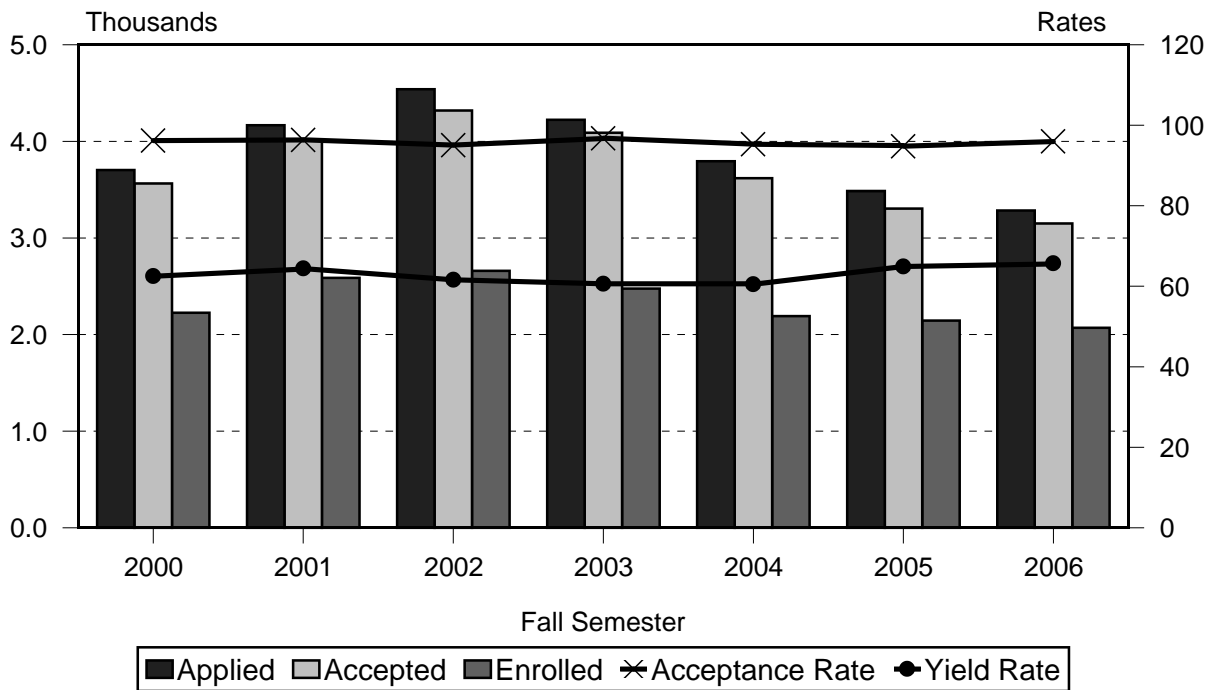


Figure 6 Applications Processed - Leeward CC

Applications Processed - Maui CC

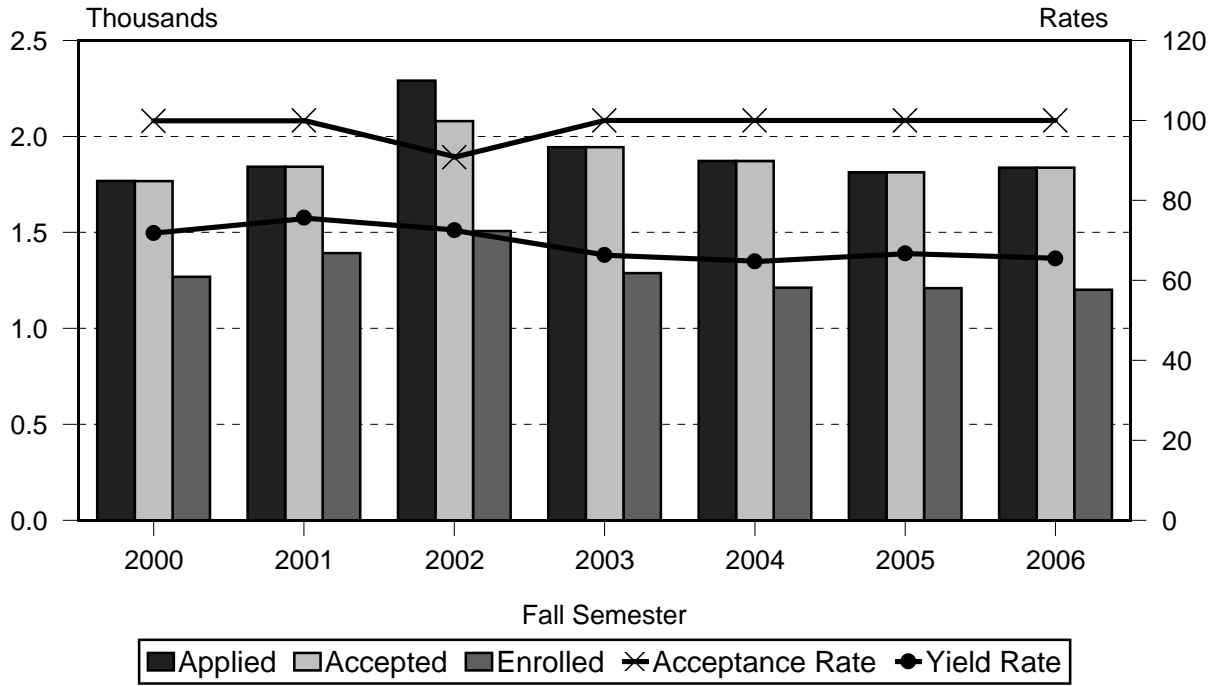
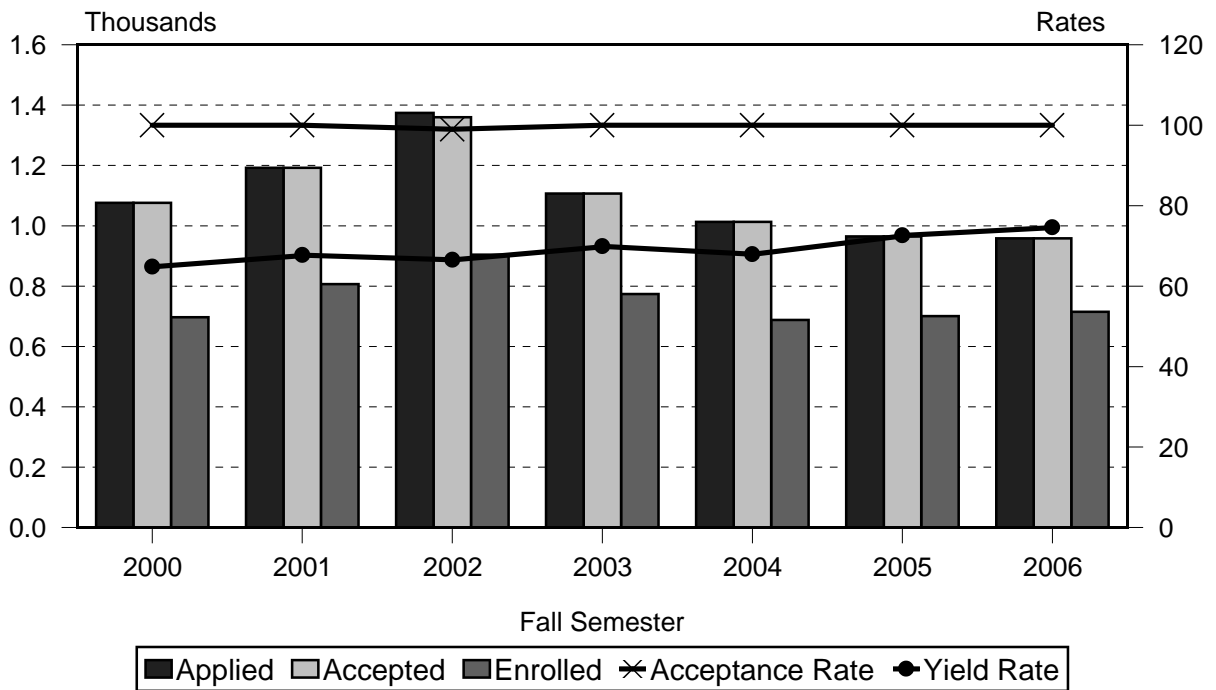

Figure 9 Total UCC Applications by Gender, Fall 2006

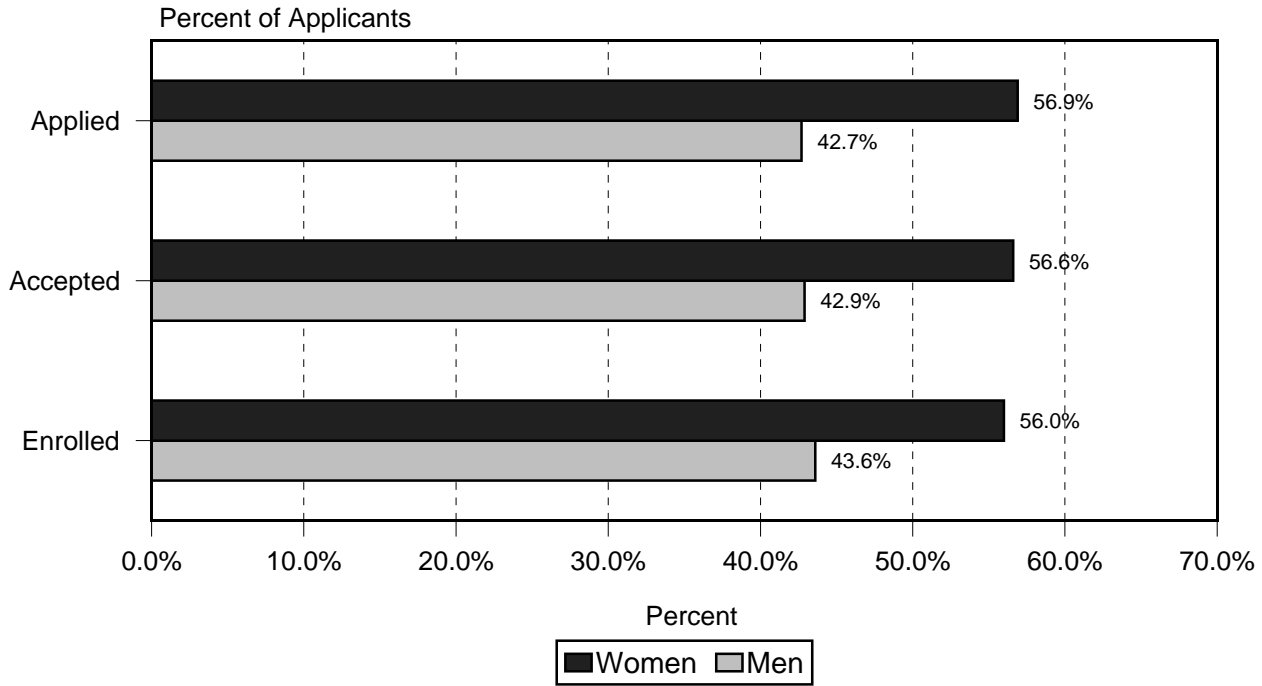


Figure 10 Total UHCC Applications by Ethnicity, Fall 2006

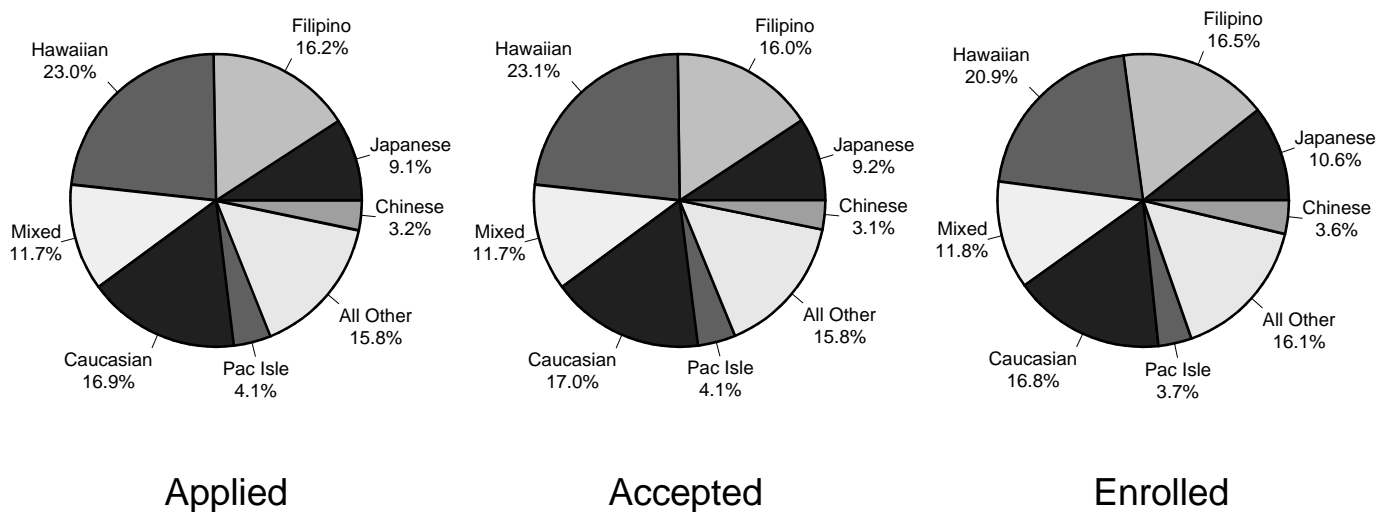
