CONTINUING EDUCATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICE ENROLLMENT UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I, FALL 1997

This report presents information on enrollment in courses offered by the Colleges of Continuing Education and Community Service at UH Mānoa and UH Hilo, and by the Offices of Community Service at the UH Community Colleges. Information is presented for each campus, with breakdown by credit and non-credit course activity. Further breakdown by undergraduate / graduate level is provided for UH Mānoa, and by program type for UH Hilo and the UH Community Colleges. Historical data are presented for the fall semesters from Fall 1987 to Fall 1997 for all campuses.

REPORTING METHODOLOGY

Enrollment reporting for continuing education courses differs markedly from that for regular credit programs. First, while the data reported include some credit activity, the vast majority of the courses offered are non-credit. Second, courses vary in duration, from as short as a single day to as long as several months. Third, courses are offered for on an ongoing basis, with students enrolling throughout the reporting period. The academic semesters (Fall, Spring and Summer) used for reporting regular credit programs do not correspond well to the actual periods of study for continuing education courses. Therefore, the reporting periods used for continuing education courses are somewhat arbitrary, with cut-off dates established to facilitate timeliness of reporting. Fourth, the data presented here are routinely collected every semester from the individual campuses via a survey instrument. Responsibility for the accuracy of the data, as well as for making determinations as to what kinds of data to report, rest largely with the individual campuses. Fifth, for non-credit courses there are generally no strict admission criteria - anyone with an interest may enroll in a course. Sixth, hours earned in a course or sequence of courses generally do not lead to a college degree. Seventh, students who enroll in more than one course at a particular campus within the same reporting period are counted for each course entered. Therefore, with a few exceptions (such as the credit courses offered at UH Mānoa and Honolulu CC), the data provide duplicated registration counts rather than unduplicated headcounts.

NOTES ABOUT THE DATA

In addition to these differences, certain other characteristics of the data merit comment. The most important of these characteristics are highlighted, as follows:

For Fall 1987, certain data were listed in the footnotes to Table 1 in the UH system enrollment report. This practice was subsequently discontinued. Footnoted data for this year have been included in the counts appearing in this report in Table 3. Therefore, the counts reported here for Fall 1987 may differ substantially from those given in MAPS reports published previously.

- In compiling Table 3, recounts and other adjustments were made where prior omissions or miscalculations were found. The counts shown may therefore differ from those published previously.
- Unduplicated headcounts have been reported for CCECS credit and non-credit programs at UH Mānoa only since Fall 1993. Prior to that date, duplicated counts were used. Unduplicated headcounts for credit courses at Honolulu CC have been reported only since Fall 1994. Unduplicated counts at UH Hilo are not yet available. Unduplicated counts will be lower than duplicated counts, but are preferred and are used whenever possible.
- Community Service counts have been reported for UH Mānoa beginning Fall
 1996. Enrollment totals for UH Mānoa for prior years may be understated.
- Reporting of student credit hour data since Fall 1994 has made calculation of FTE possible for those campuses reporting credit data (Table 2). Prior to Fall 1994 student credit hour data were available for UH Mānoa only.
- Credit data included in the tallies submitted by UH Hilo have been identified beginning Fall 1993. Non-credit tallies for semesters prior to Fall 1993 may include unidentified credit data.
- Due to difficulties in course scheduling and the timeliness of reporting, the counts shown here for Kapi'olani CC were reported for the Spring 1997 semester. Reports for Kapi'olani CC routinely lag one semester behind.

Continuing Education and Community Service Enrollment



Continuing Ed Enrollment, By Percent Non-Credit / Credit



Continuing Ed Enrollment, By Campus, Fall 1997



