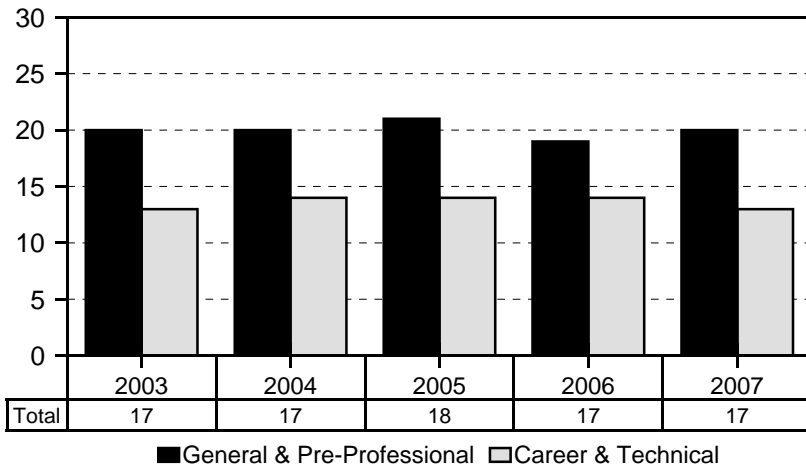
Number of Courses

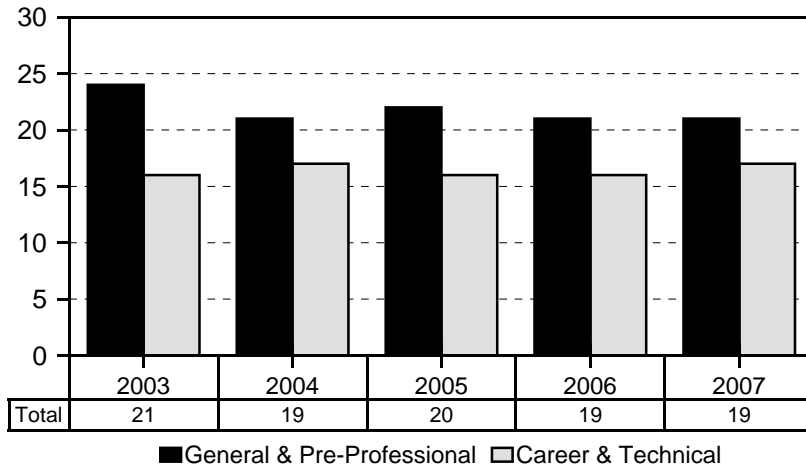
Number of Courses

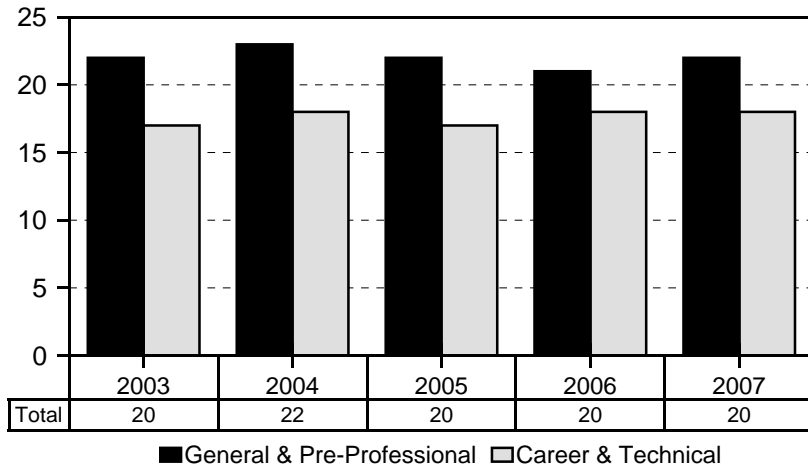
Number of Courses

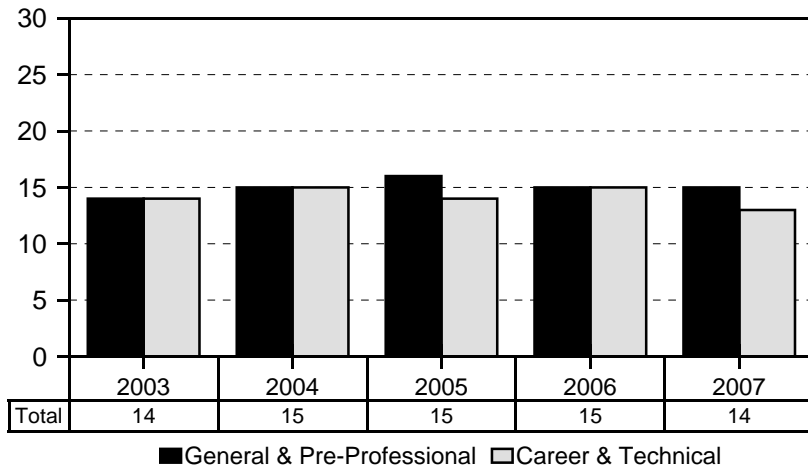
Number of Courses

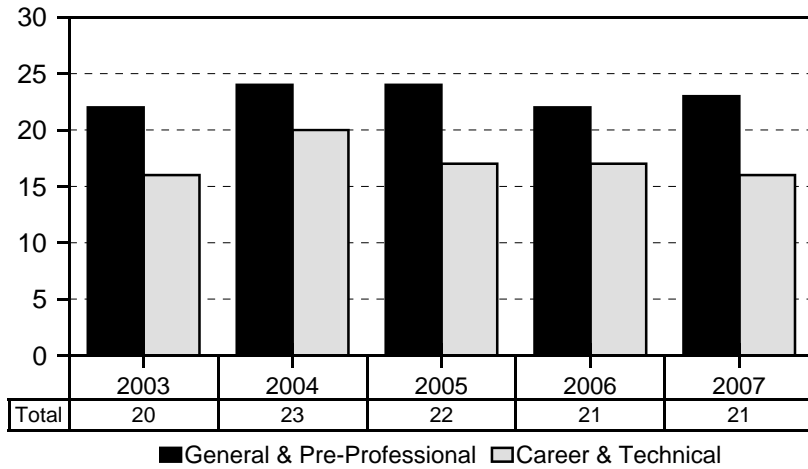
Number of Courses

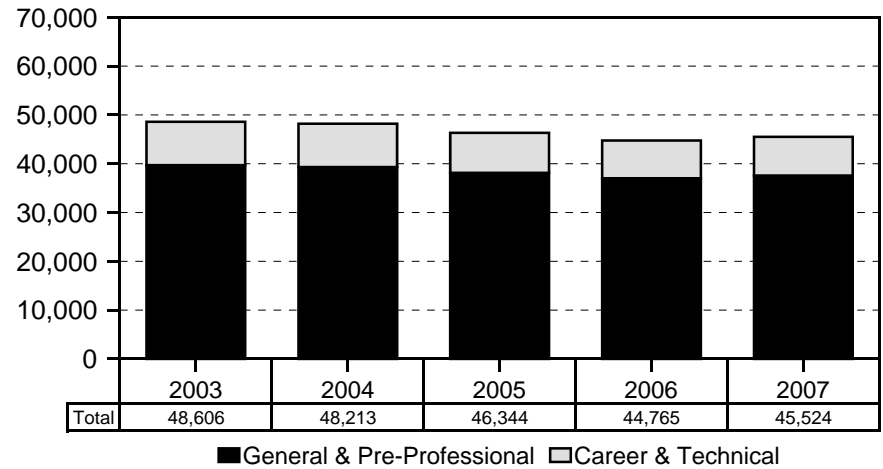

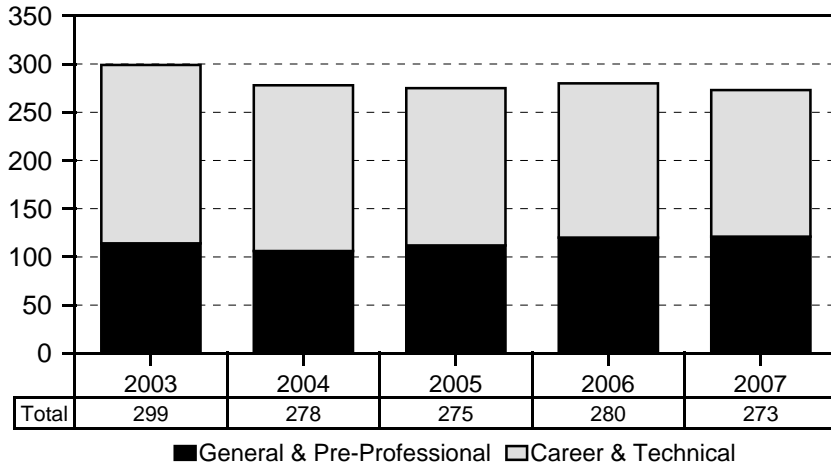

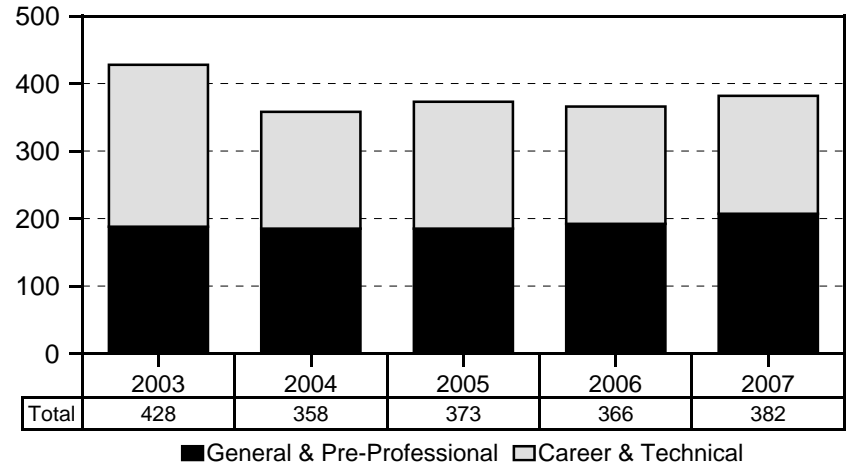

Maui Community College, Spring Semesters

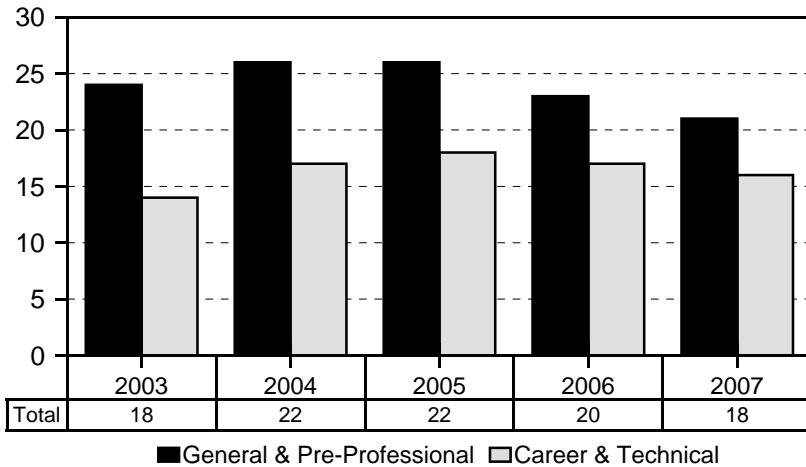
Number of Courses

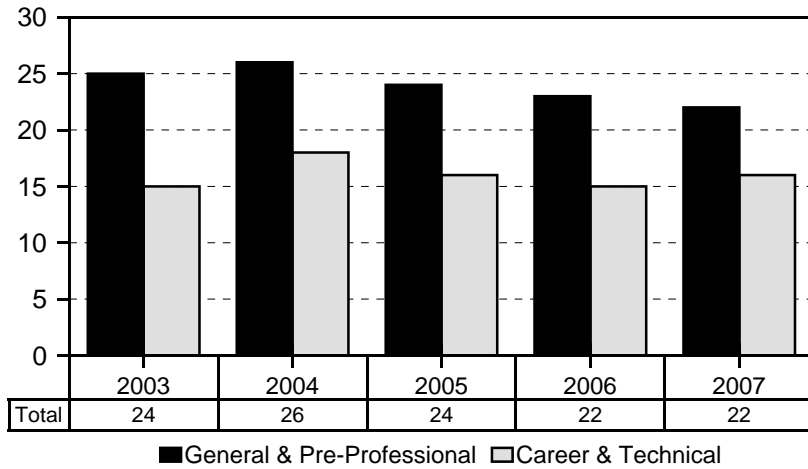
Number of Courses

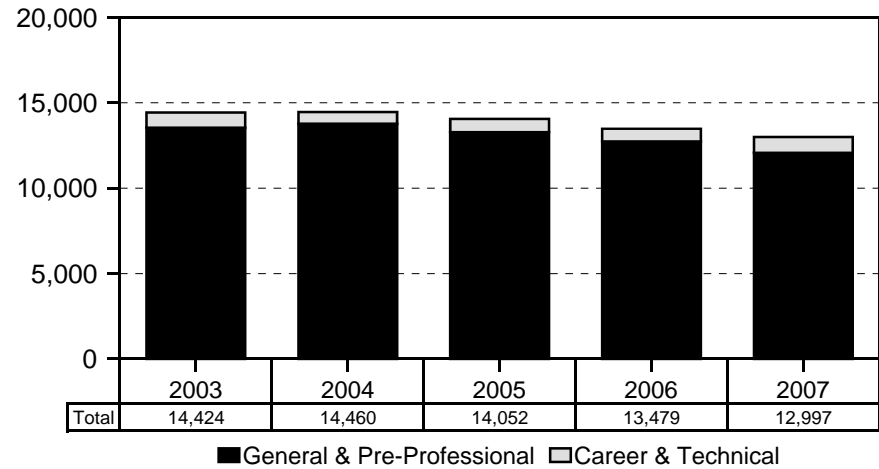
