COURSE REGISTRATION SUMMARY
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I AT HILO
FALL 2001

In Fall 2001, there were 473 courses taught at the University of Hawai'i at Hilo (UHH), with an enrollment of 12,659 registrations in 677 classes for a total of 35,771 student semester hours (SSH) and course FTE of 2,389 (Tables 1 and 2).

All course registration measures increased over the previous fall semester. Number of classes, semester hours, registrations and SSH increased approximately at the same rate of 4%.

In the College of Arts and Sciences, SSH was 3% percent higher from Fall 2000 (Table 3). In the last five years, the SSH in the College of Arts and Sciences climbed steadily from 29,566 to 33,044, an increase of 12%. However, this may be due in part to the inclusion of continuing education classes that began in Fall 1999. Within the college, Social Sciences courses have shown steady increases in SSH over the past five years. From Fall 1997 to Fall 2001, SSH for Social Sciences courses increased 19%.

SSH in Ka Haka 'Ula O Ke'elikolani was up 17% from last Fall, after a steady decline from Fall 1997 to Fall 2000. The increase may be attributed to an increase in SSH in Hawaiian Studies classes and the addition of three new courses that were taught this semester.

For the College of Agriculture, Forestry and Natural Resource Management, over the past five years, SSH was highest in Fall 1998 with 1,333 and slowly declined to 1,208 in Fall 2001.

The average class size (ACS) at UHH, computed for all classes except individual instruction (-99) and thesis research (700) was 21, the same as in Fall 1997 (Table 4). From Fall 1997 to Fall 2001, ACS at the College of Agriculture dropped from 15 to 14, remained at 22 at the College of Arts and Sciences and went down from 17 to 15 at Ka Haka 'Ula Ke'elikolani.

Number of Classes

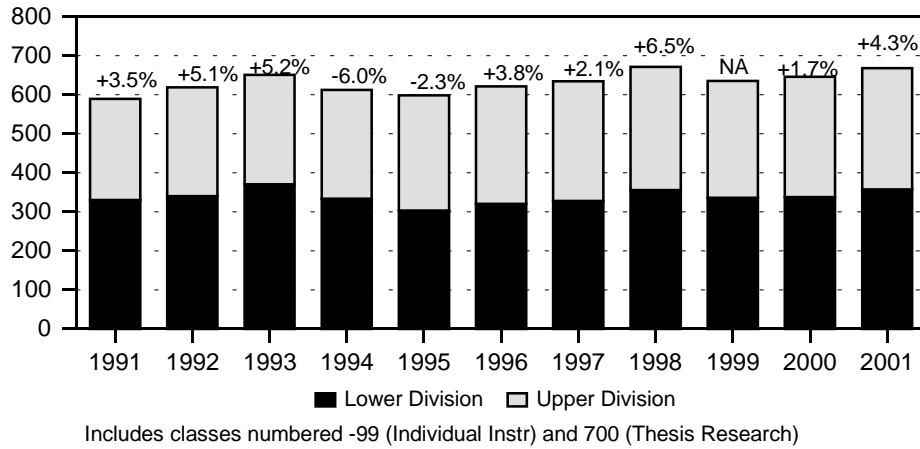

Student Registrations

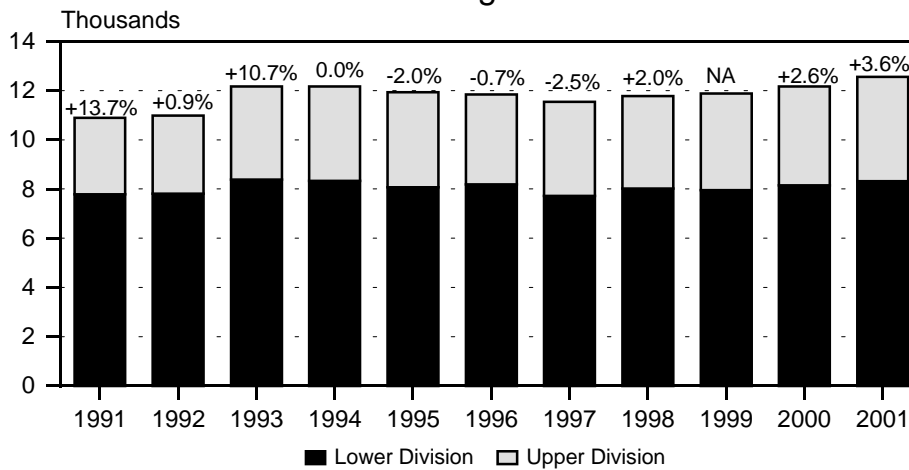
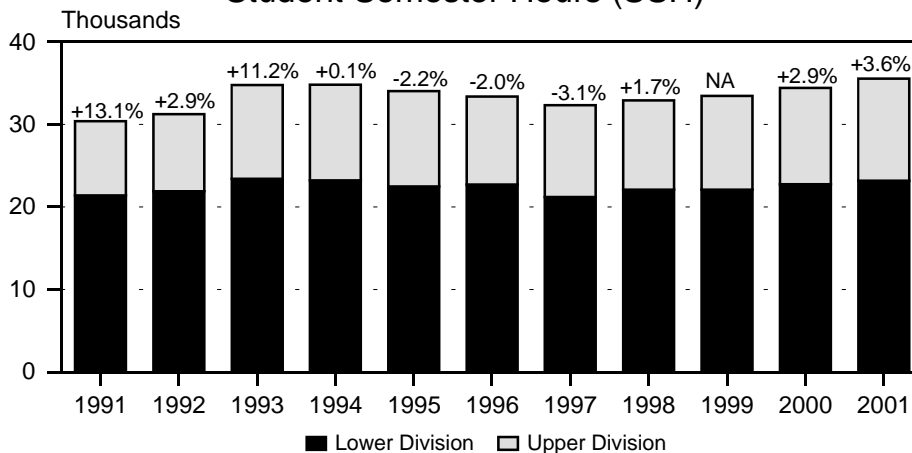

Course FTE

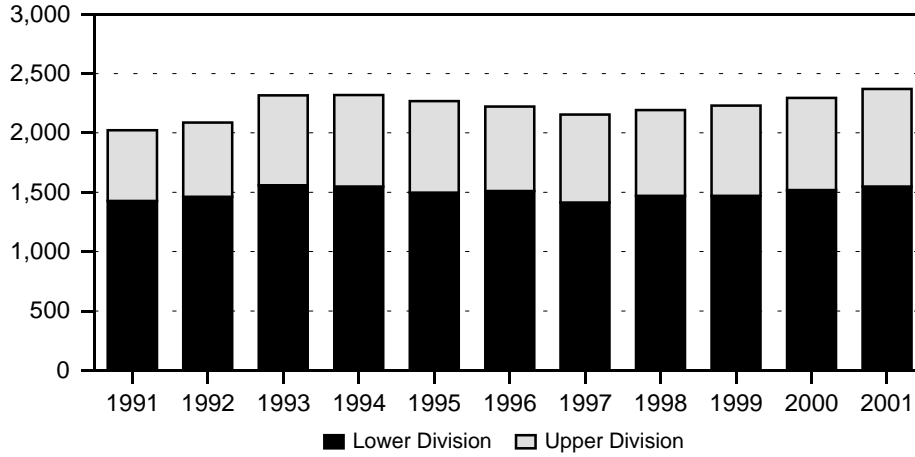

Average Class Size

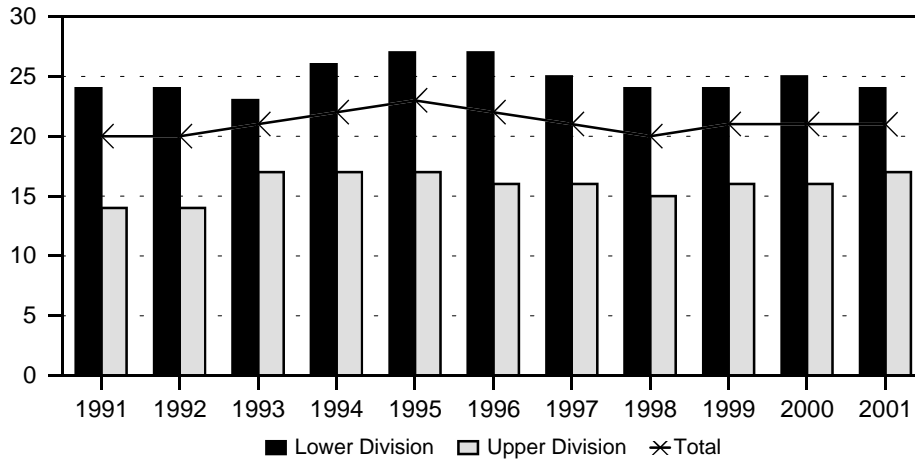
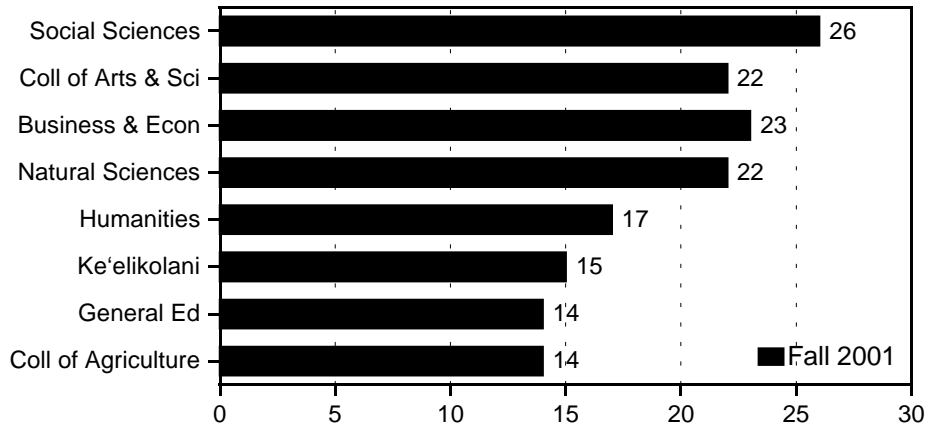
