COURSE REGISTRATION SUMMARY
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I
FALL 2001

The total number of student semester hours (SSH) for the University of Hawai'i (UH) increased by 3% from the previous year (Table 2). At the course level, lower division SSH increased by 3% while upper division and graduate level SSH increased by 2%.

Increases in total SSH were also noted at most of the campuses. The University of Hawai'i at Manoa and at Hilo had increases of 4%, while the West O'ahu campus had a 1% decrease. The UH Community Colleges as a whole had an increase of 2%. At Kapi'olani, Kauai, Leeward and Windward, increases in SSH ranged from 2% to 8%. Hawai'i and Maui had decreases of 4% and 3%, respectively. Honolulu had a slight decrease in SSH of less than 1%.

The total number of classes taught at the UH increased 1% from Fall 2000 (Table 3). Number of classes increased 2% at the lower division, decreased 2% at the upper division and increased 1% at the graduate level. From Fall 1999, the increases in number of classes may be largely due in part to the inclusion of continuing education classes at the Manoa and Hilo campuses and also off-campus credit classes at Honolulu Community College.

The average class size at the UH was relatively stable from Fall 1997 to Fall 2001 (Table 3). Compared to last Fall, average class size increased from 20 to 21 in Fall 2001. The average class sizes at the lower and upper divisions and graduate level remained the same.

Number of Classes

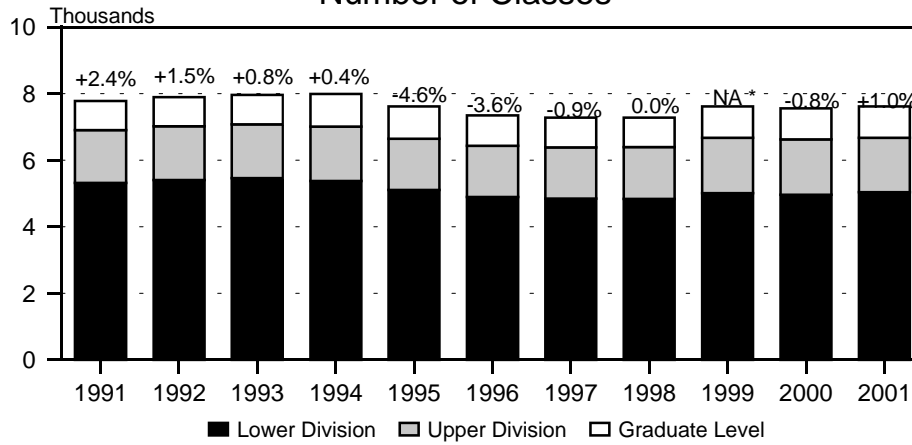

Student Registrations

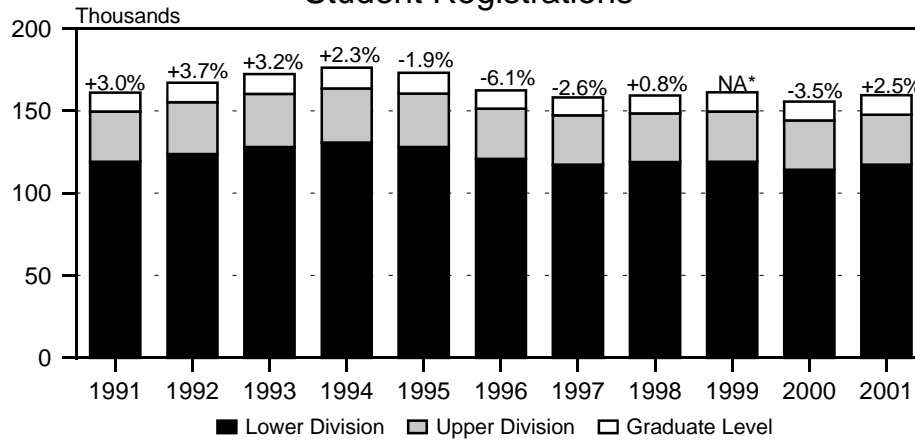
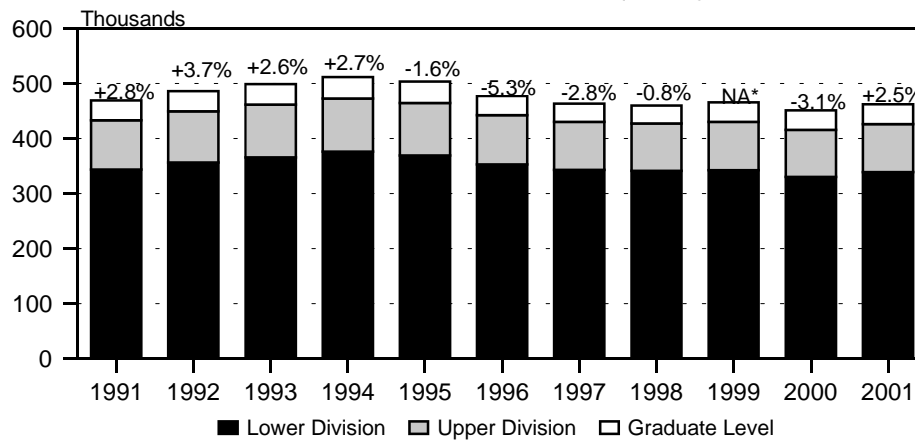

Course FTE

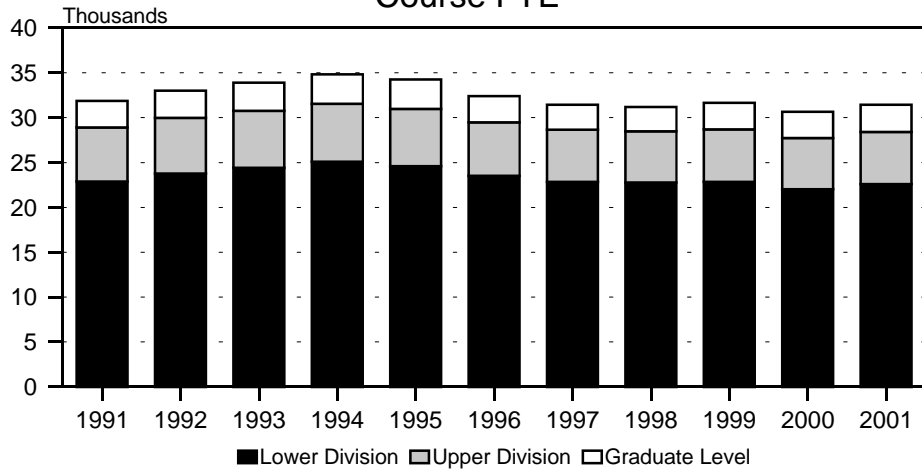

Average Class Size

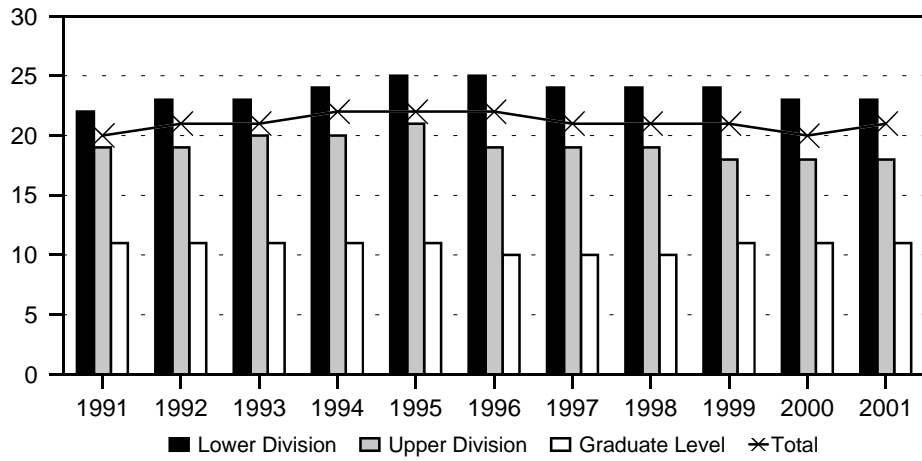

Average Class Size, by Unit

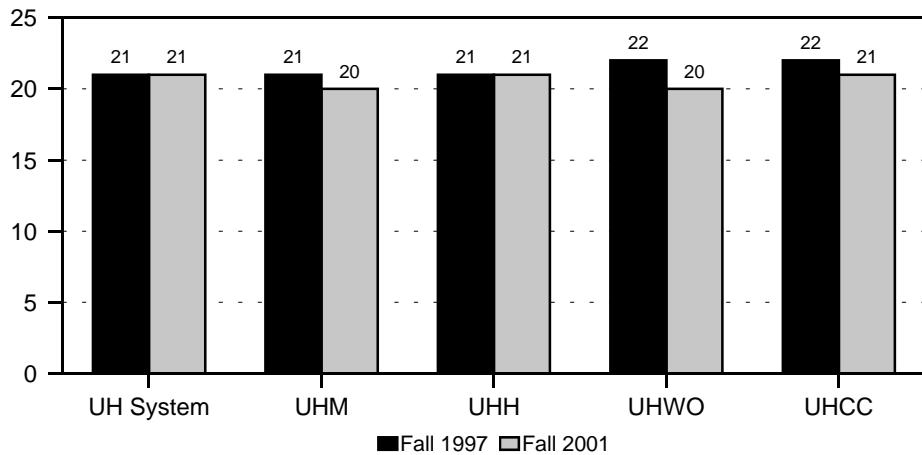
