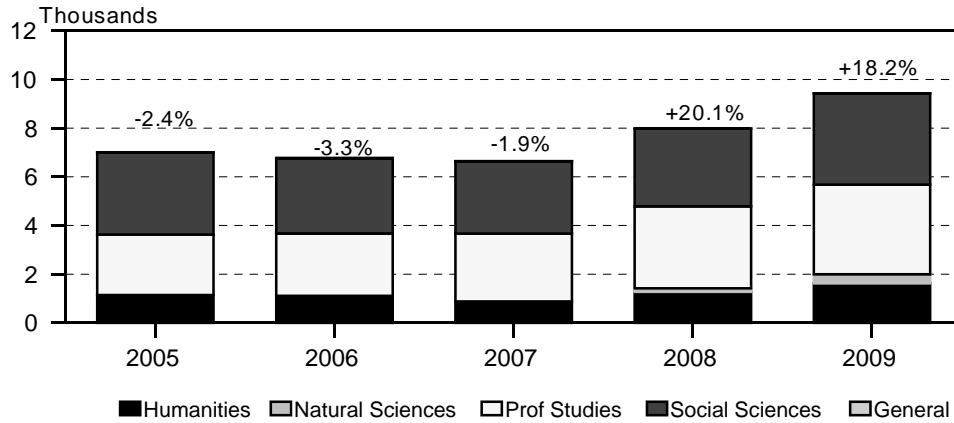

Course FTE

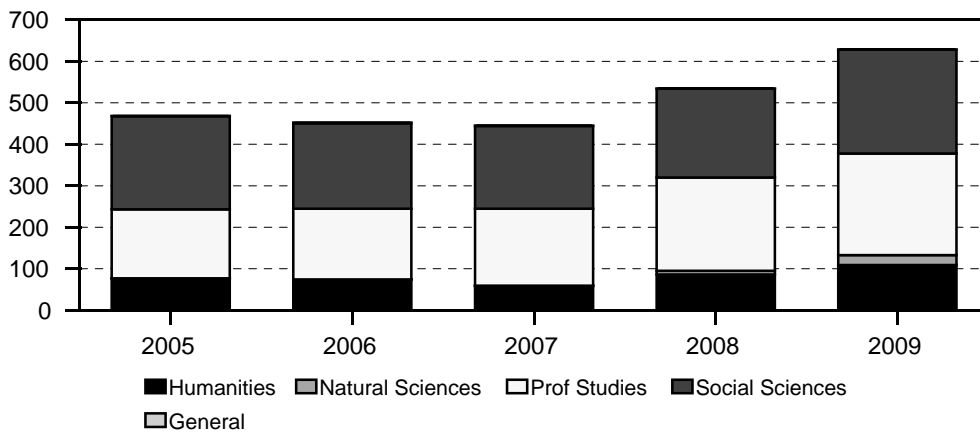
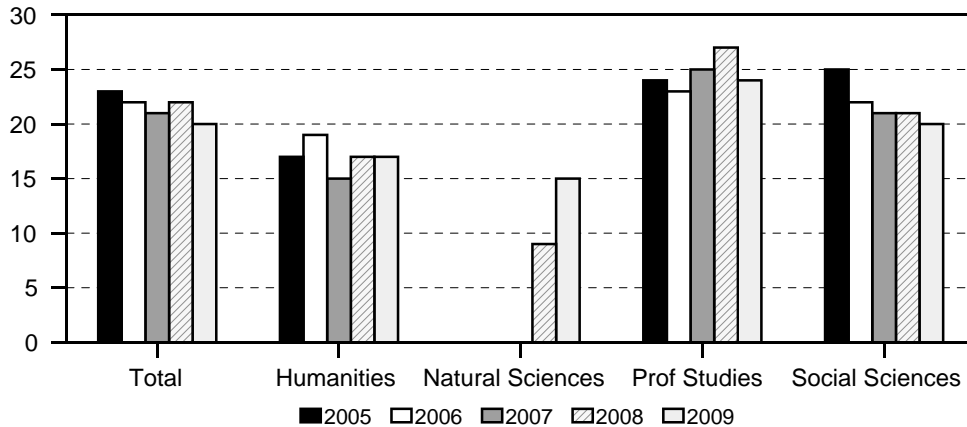
