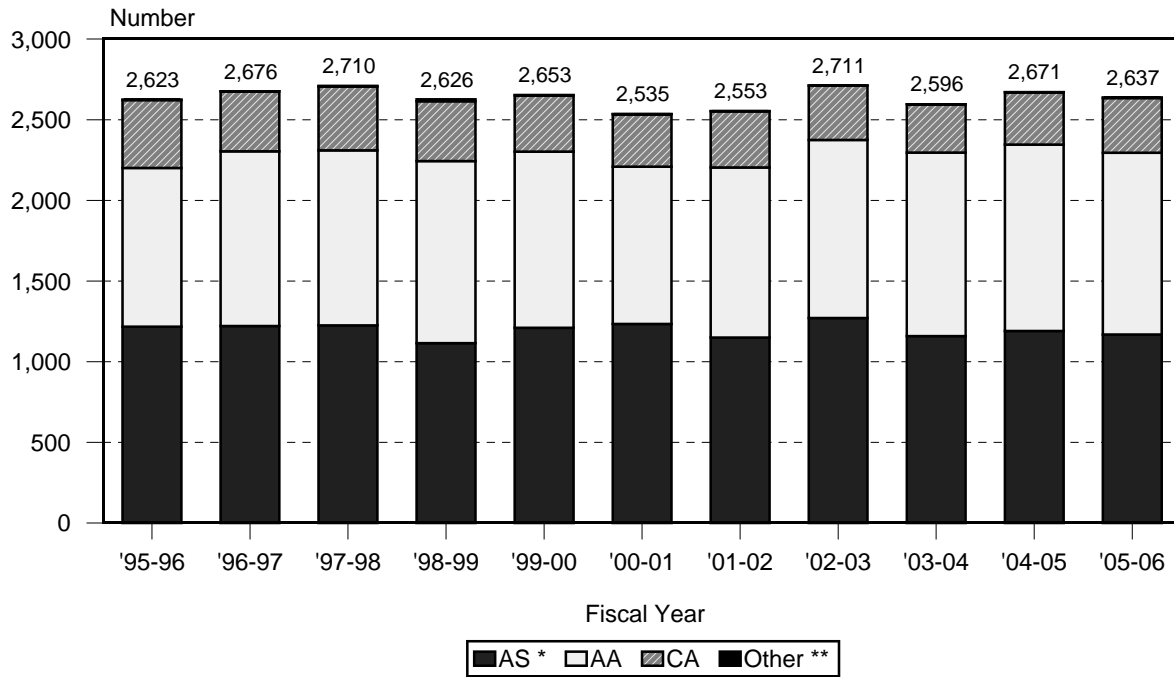

Figure 2 Headcount of Graduates By Number of Degrees Earned

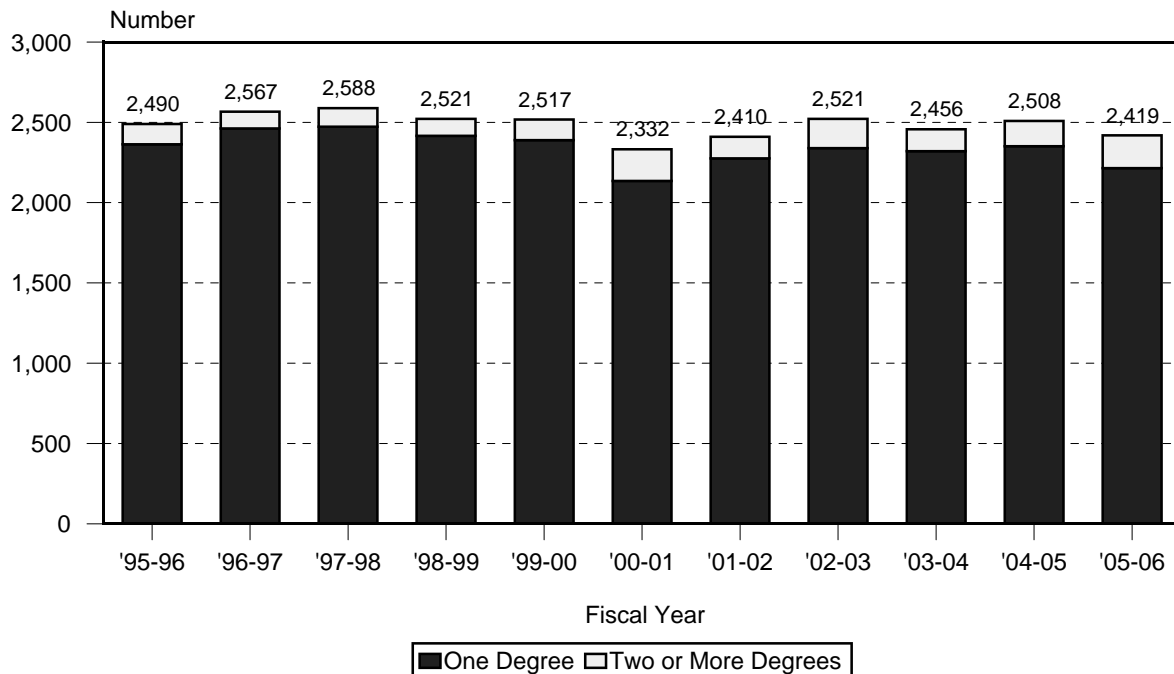
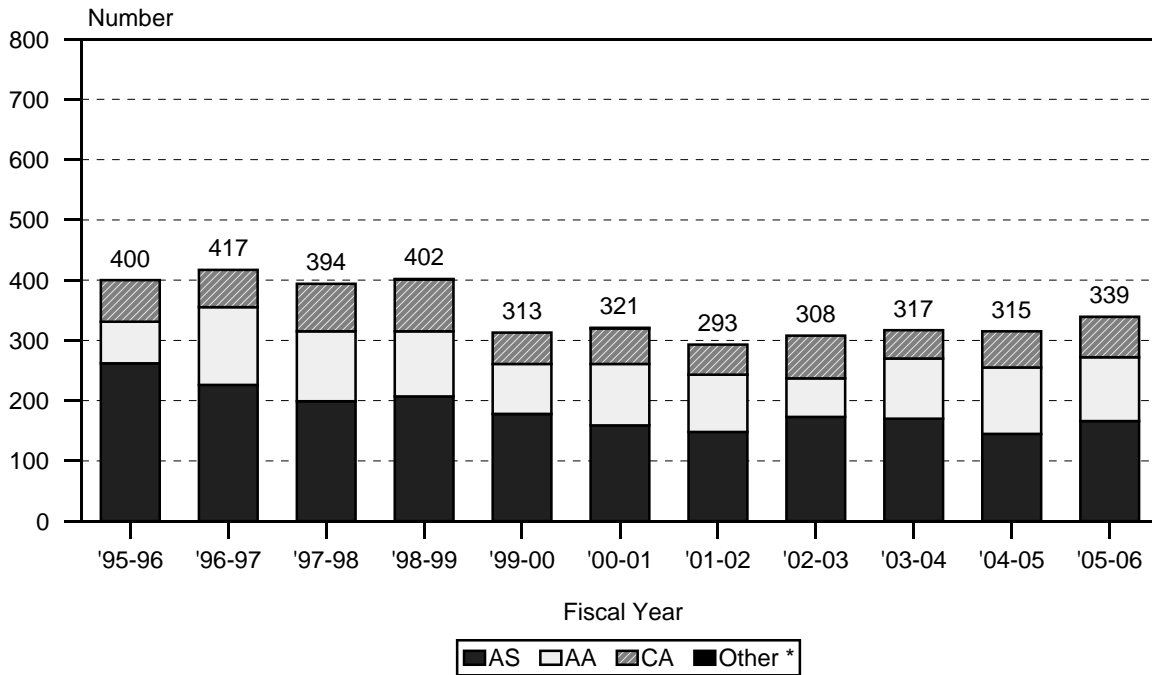
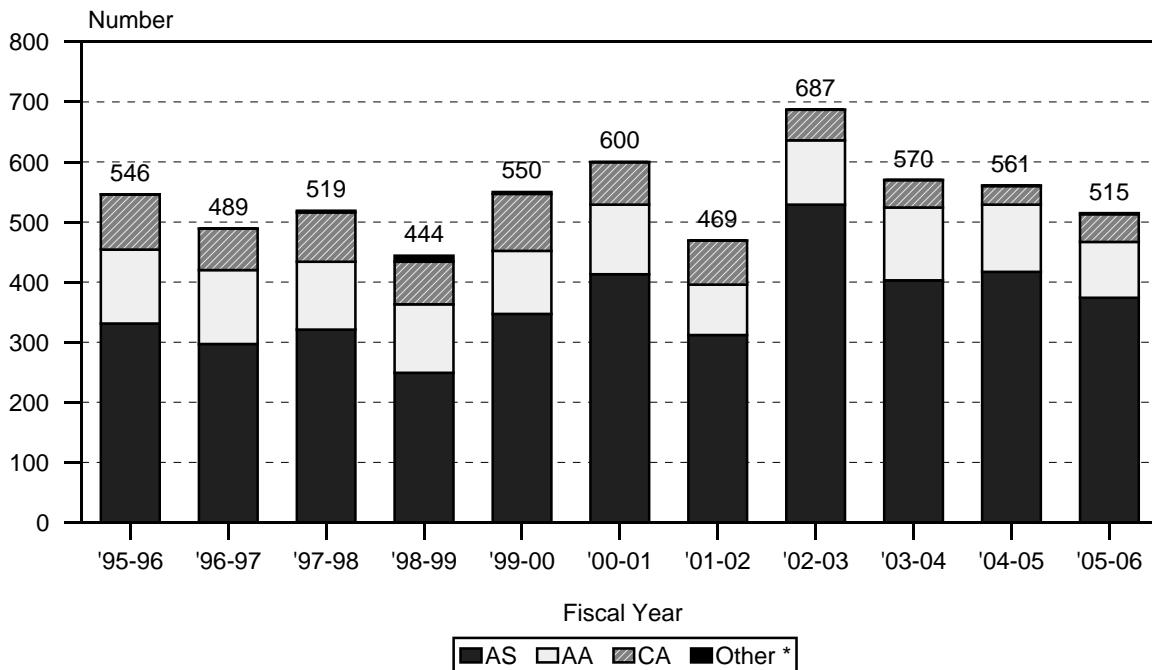

Degrees Earned By Type - Kapi'olani CC

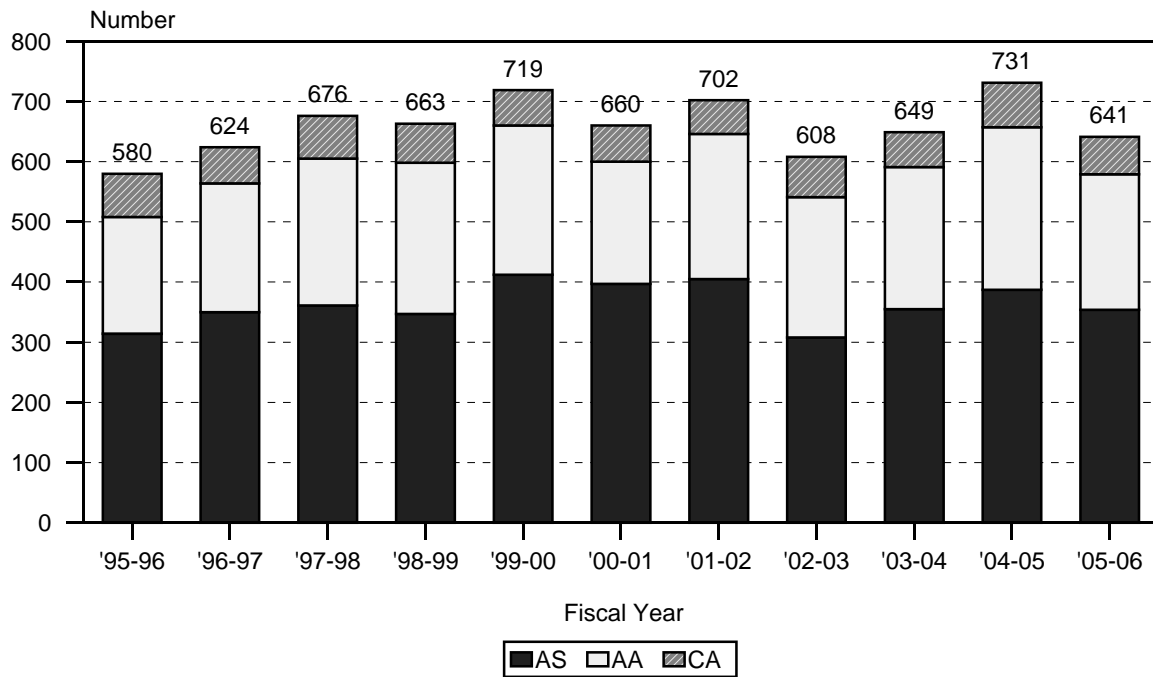

Degrees Earned By Type - Kaua'i CC

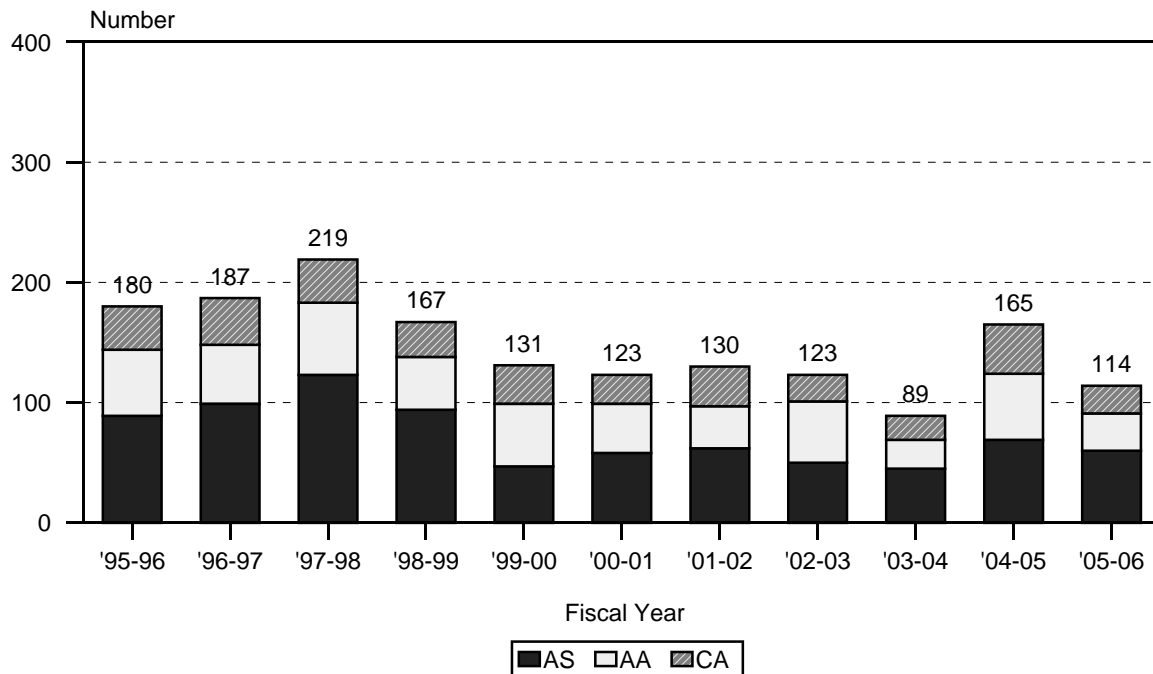

Degrees Earned By Type - Leeward CC

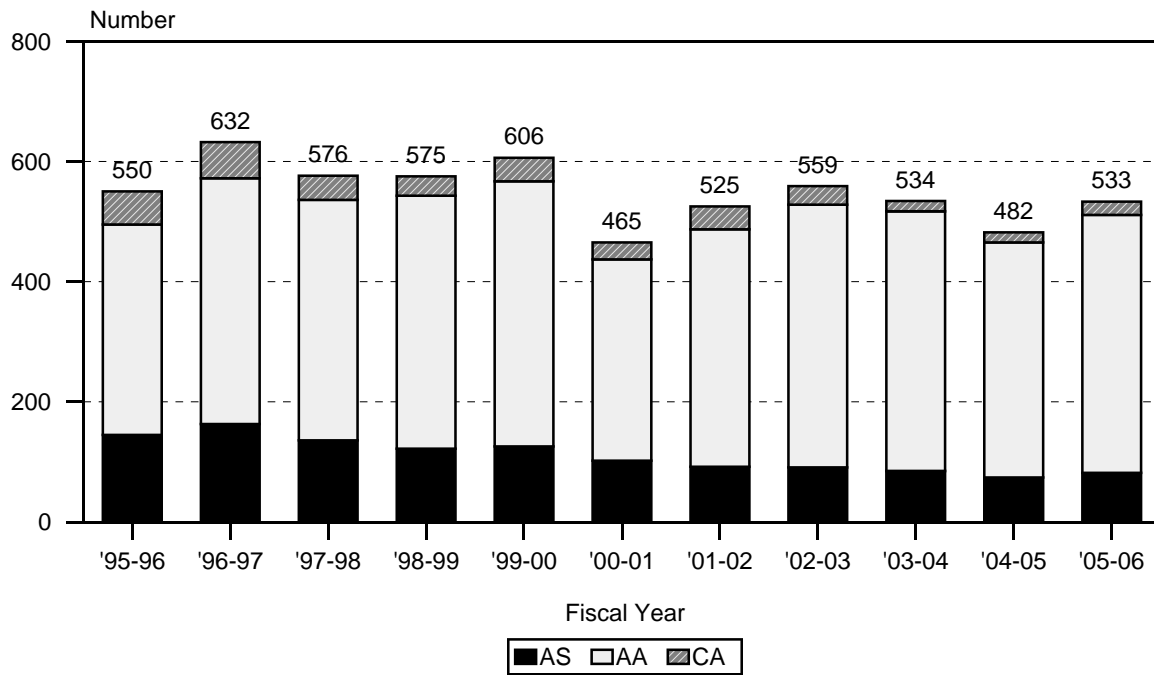
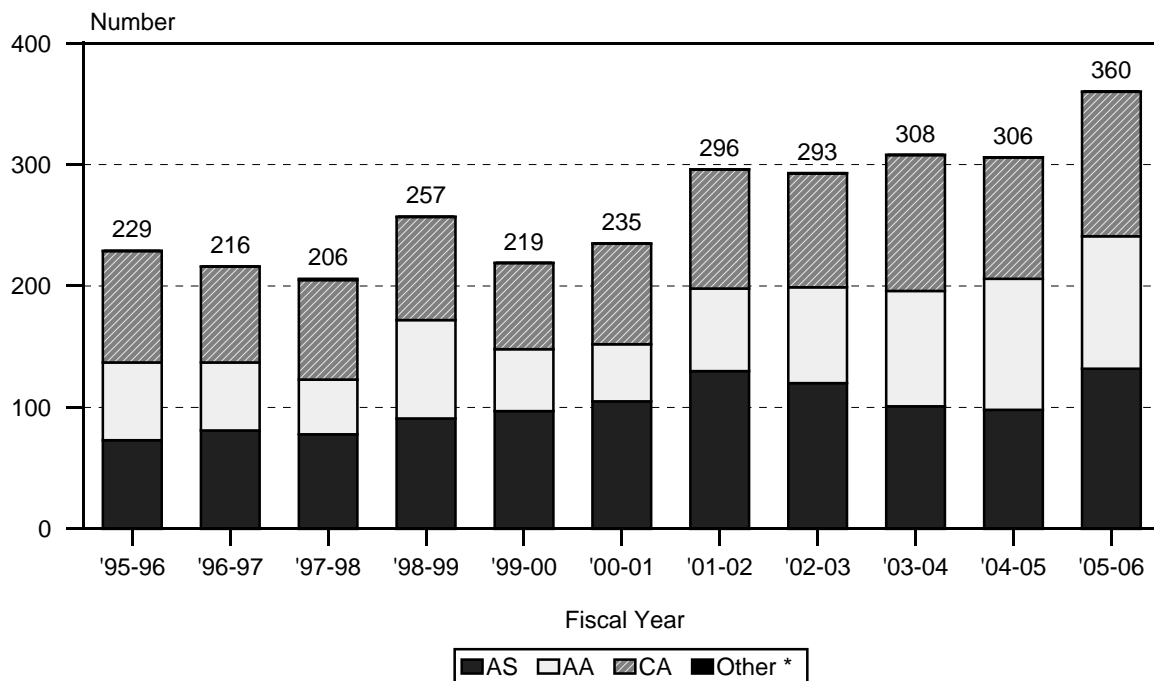

Degrees Earned By Type - Windward CC

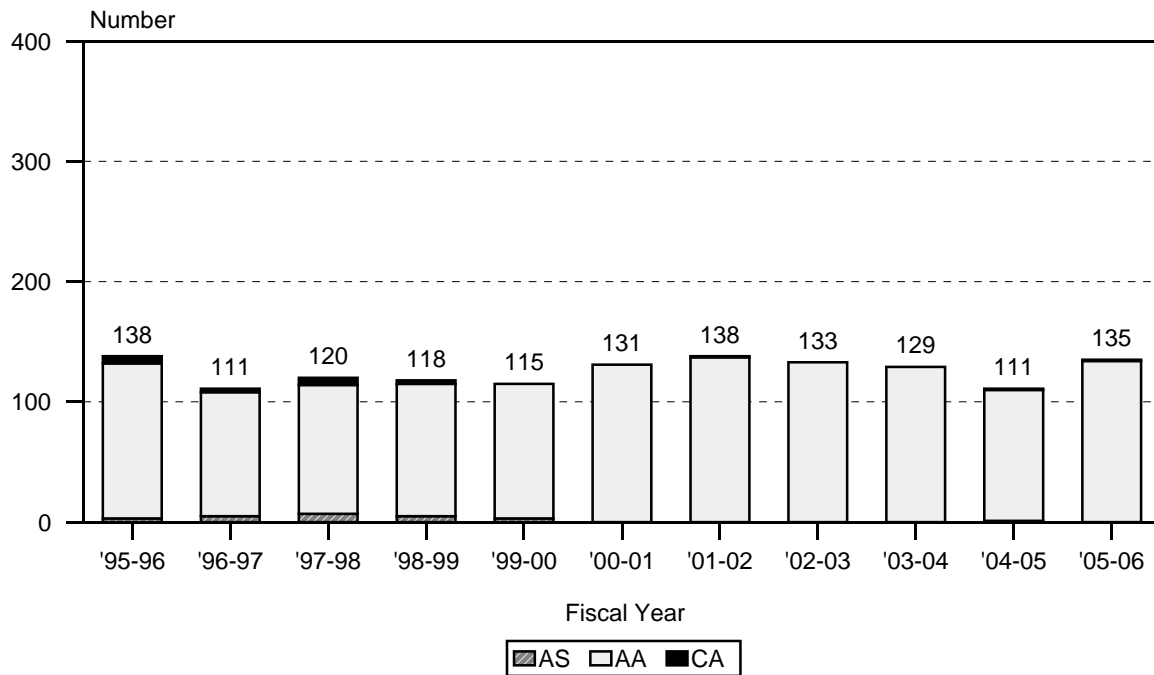

Certificates of Completion Earned

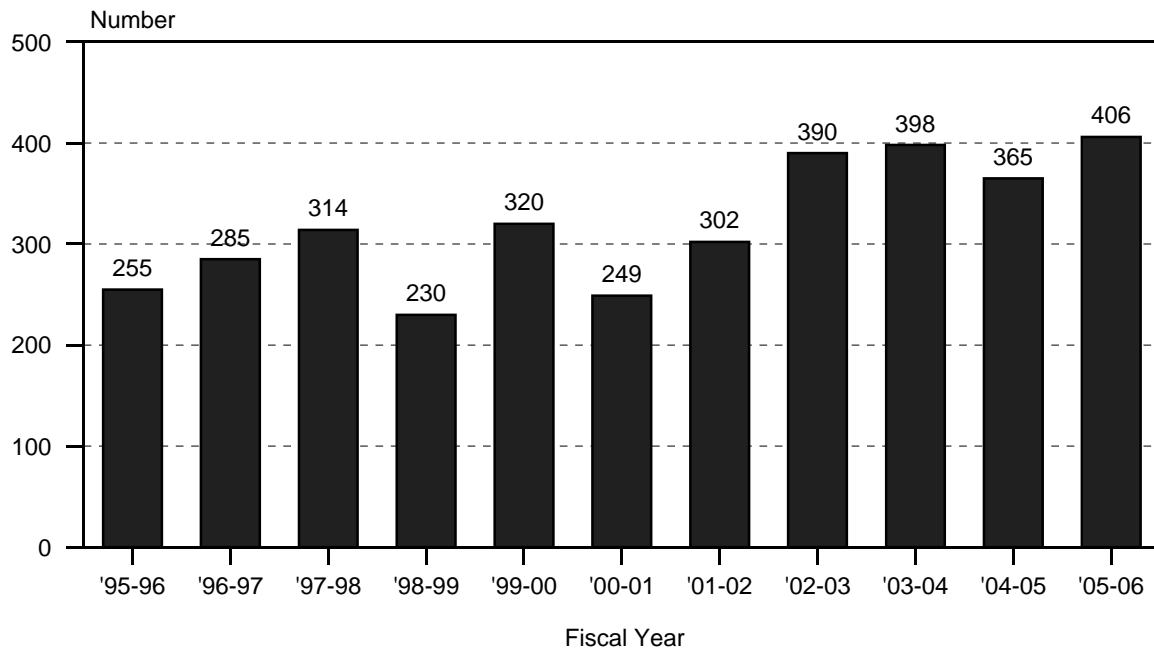

Degrees Earned By Gender

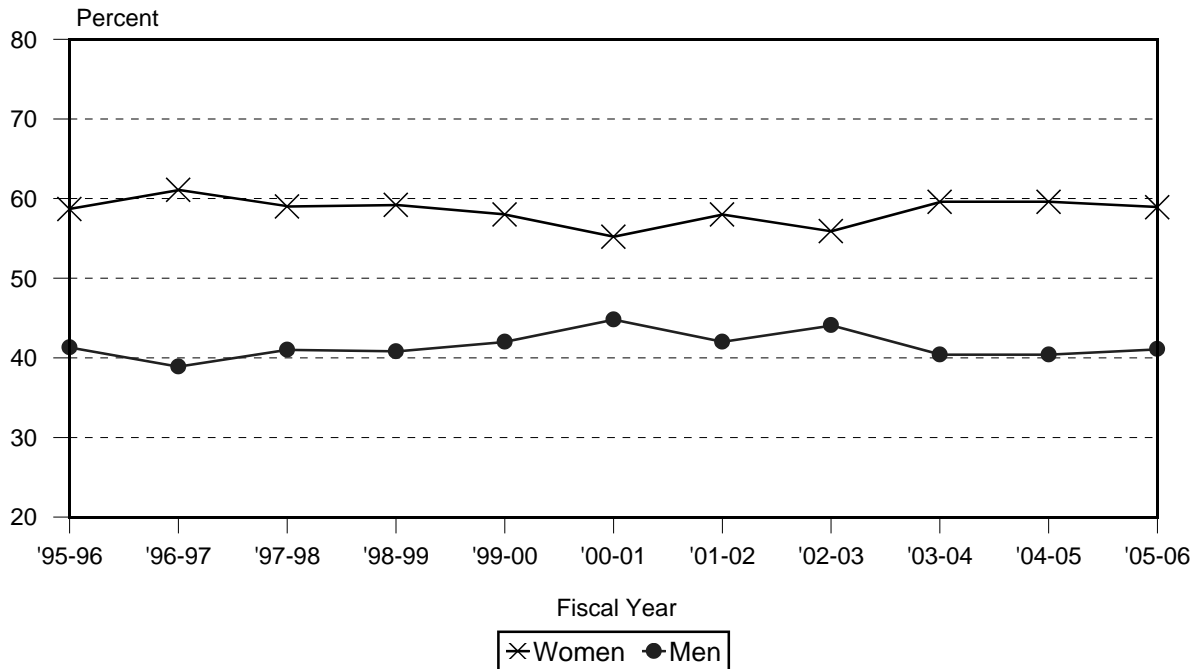
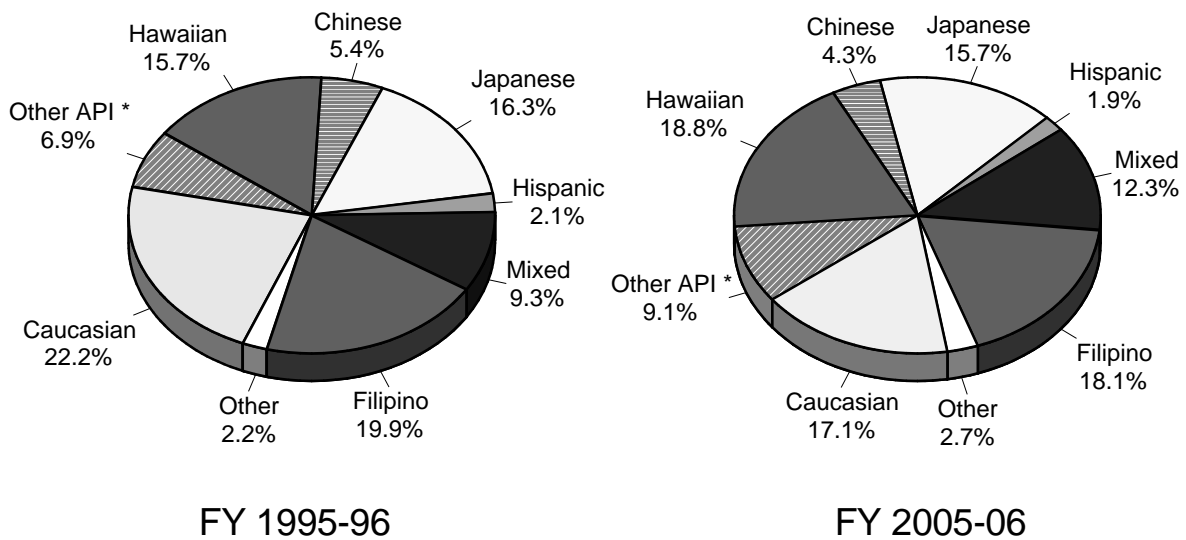
