Degrees Earned, By Type - Total

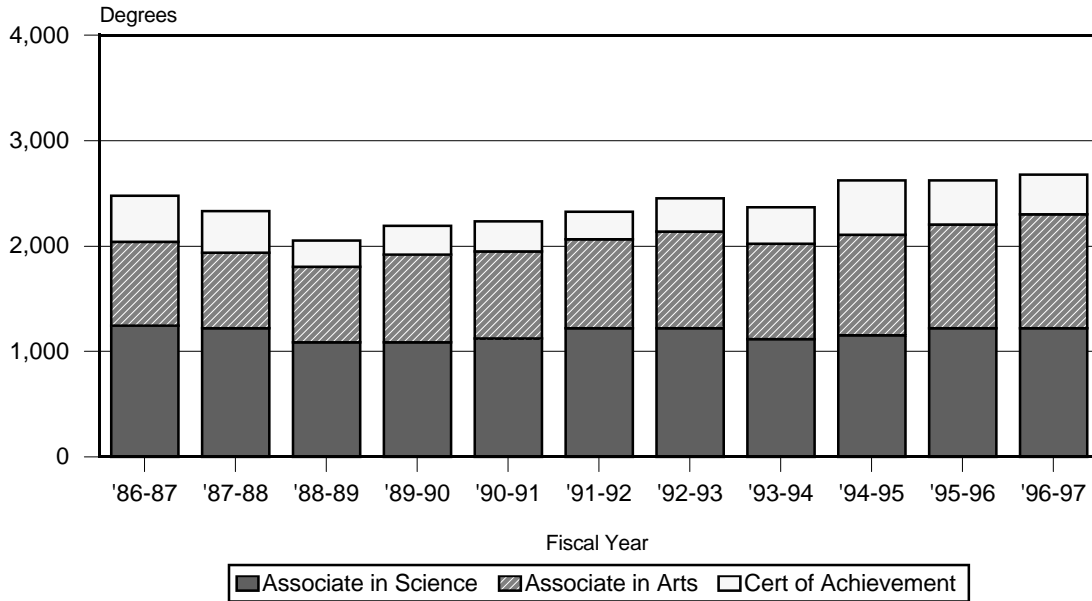
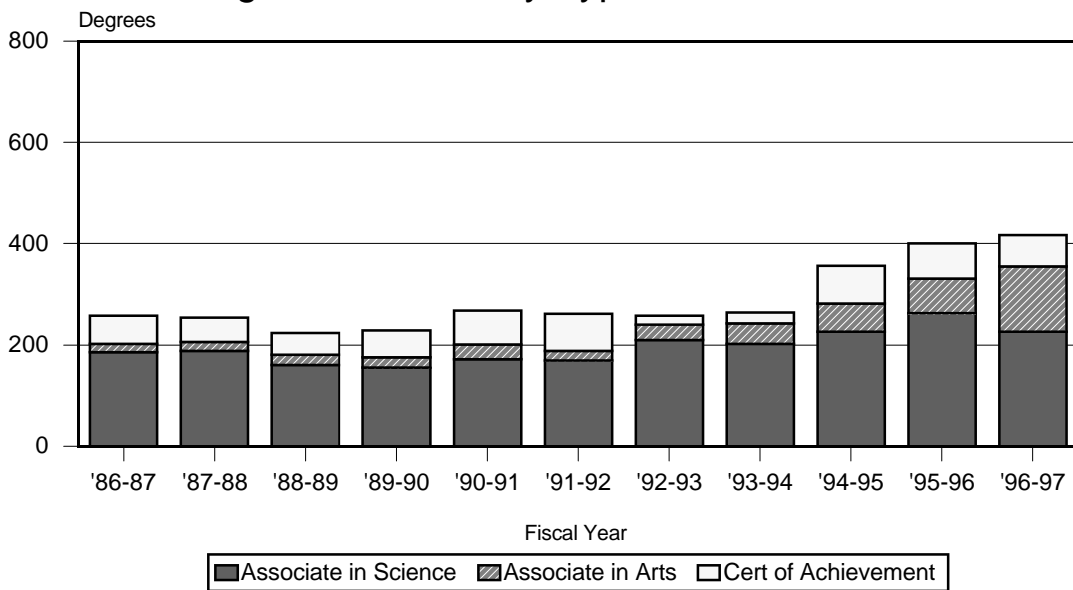

Degrees Earned, By Type - Honolulu CC

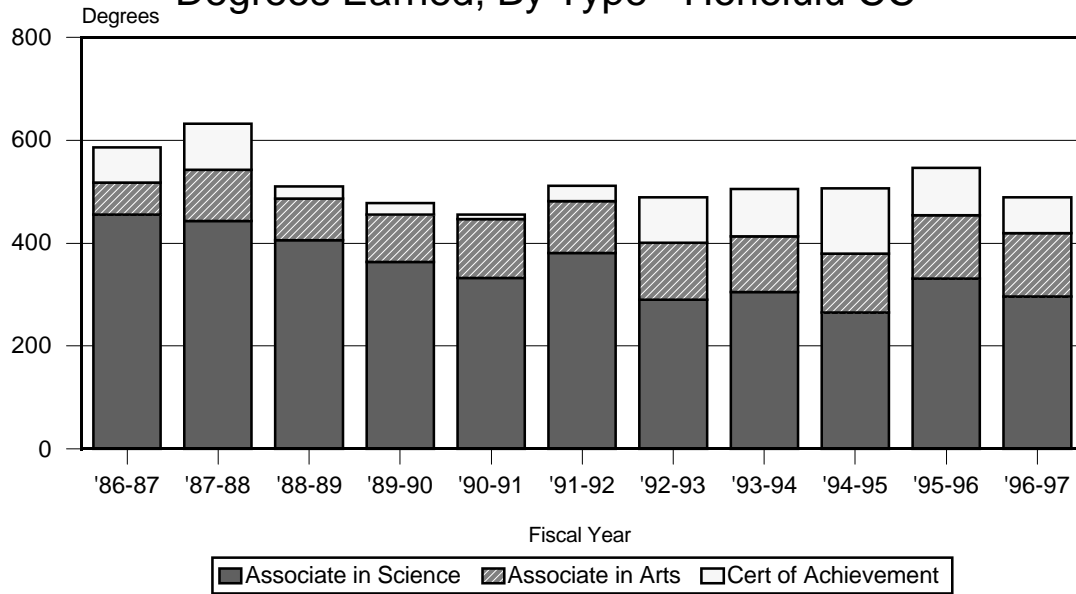
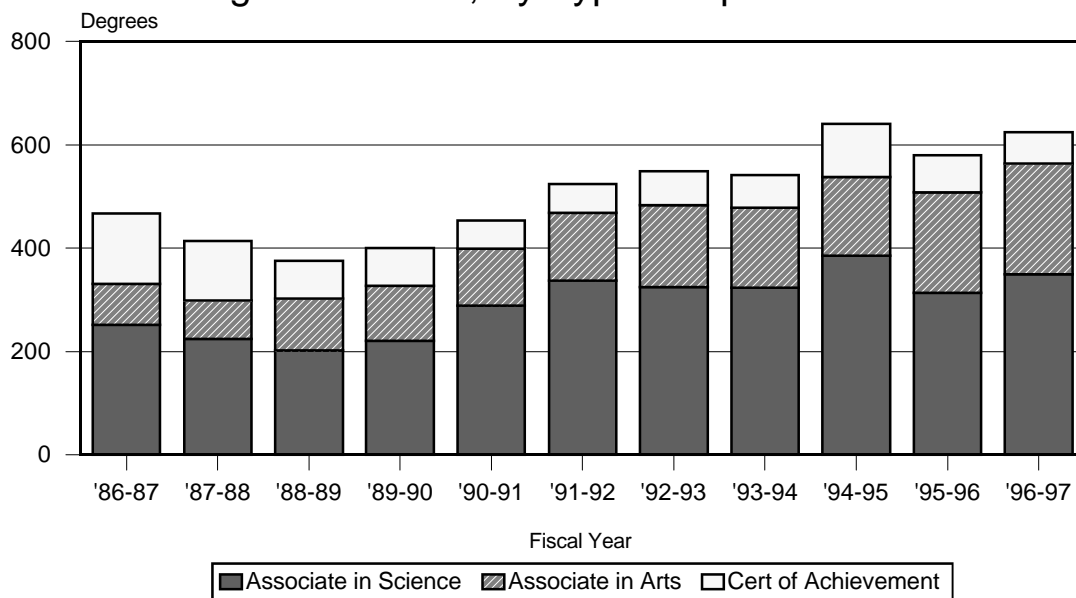

Degrees Earned, By Type - Kaua'i CC

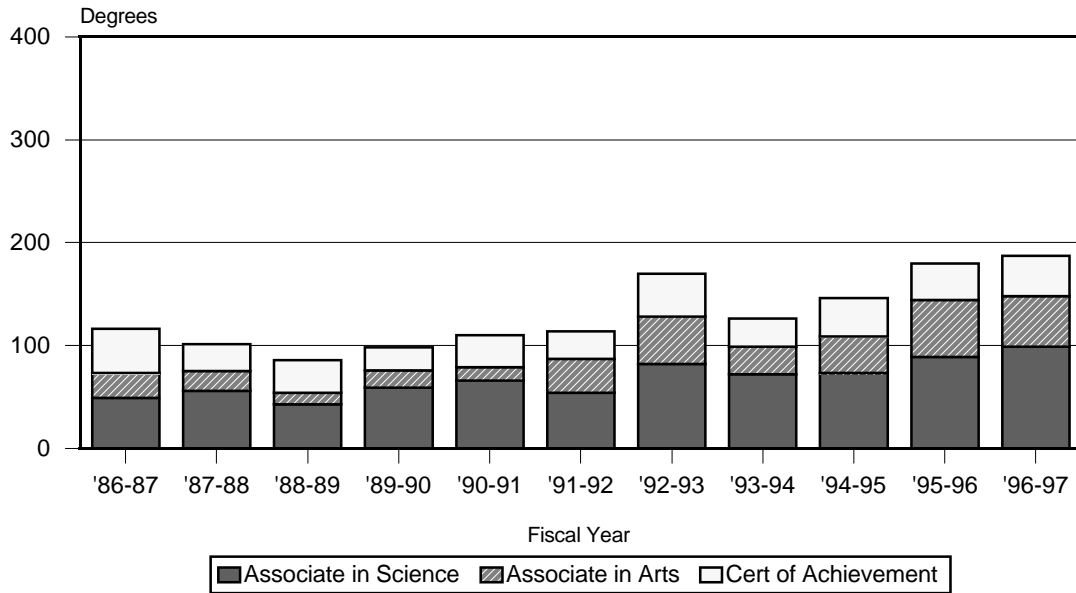
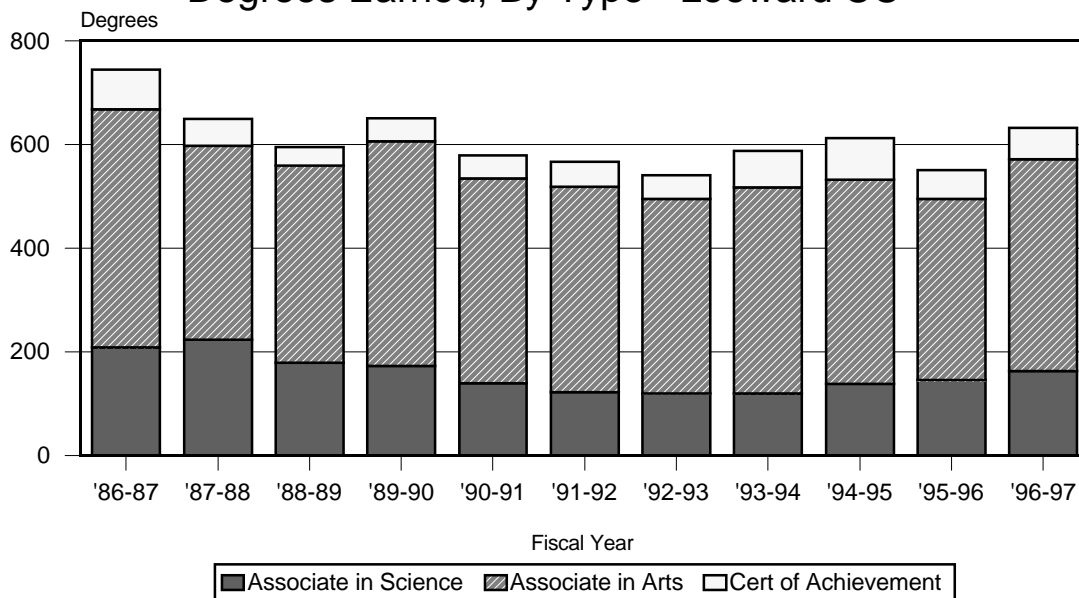

Degrees Earned, By Type - Maui CC

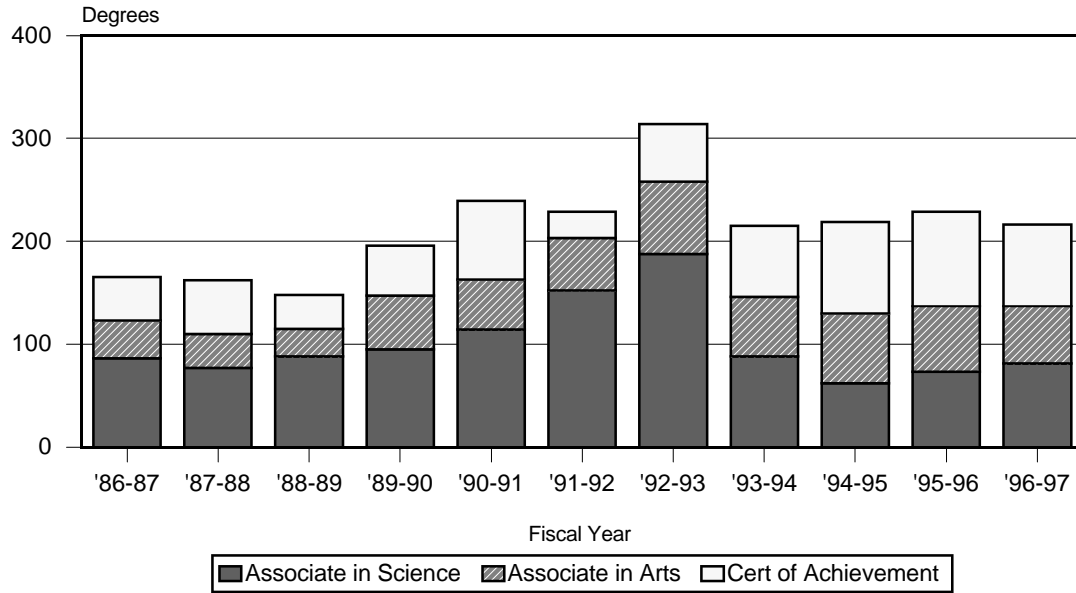
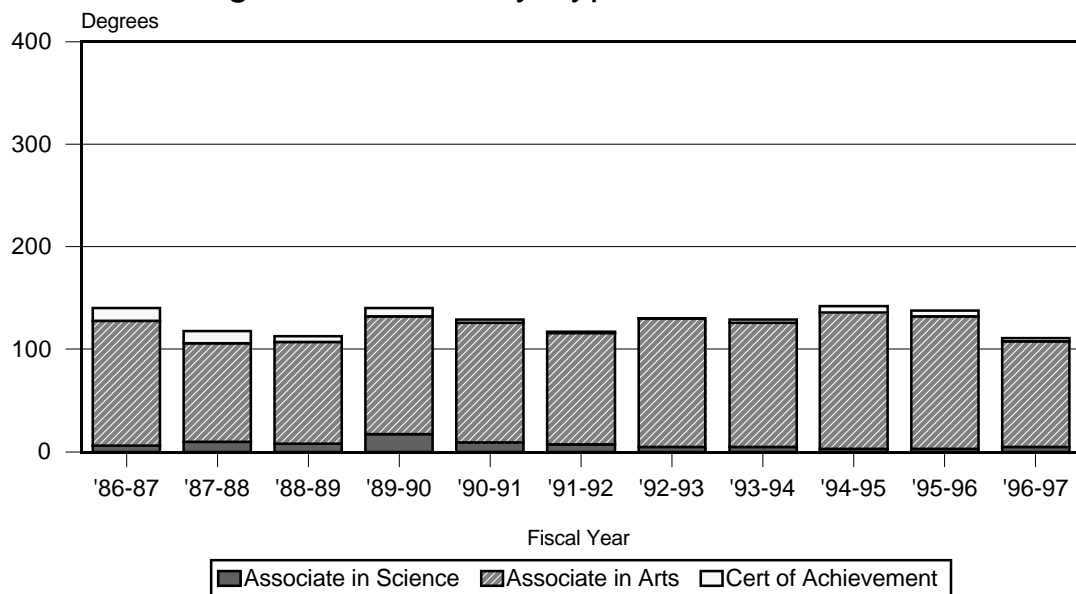

Degrees Earned, By Gender, FY 1996-97

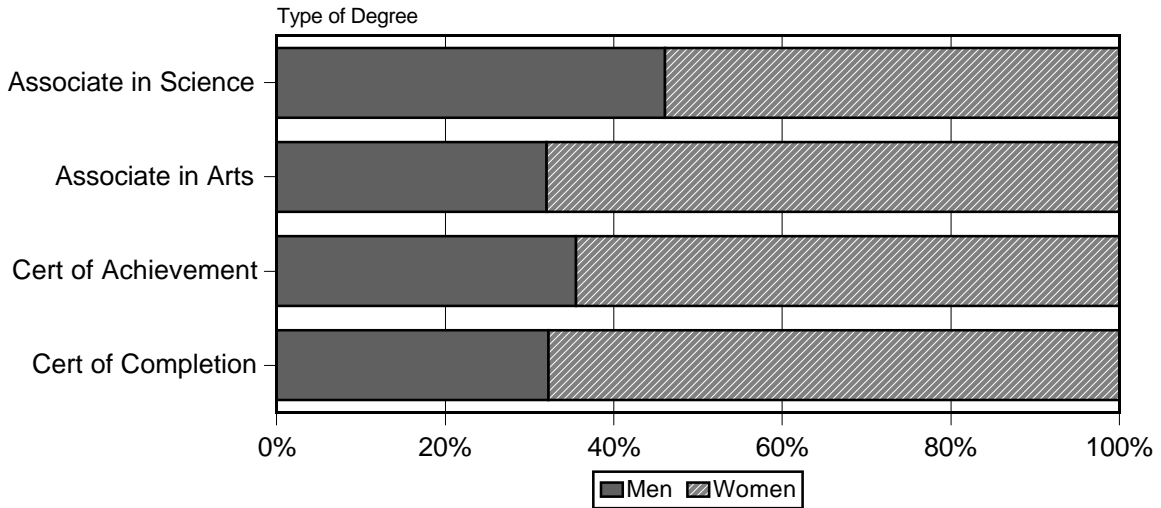
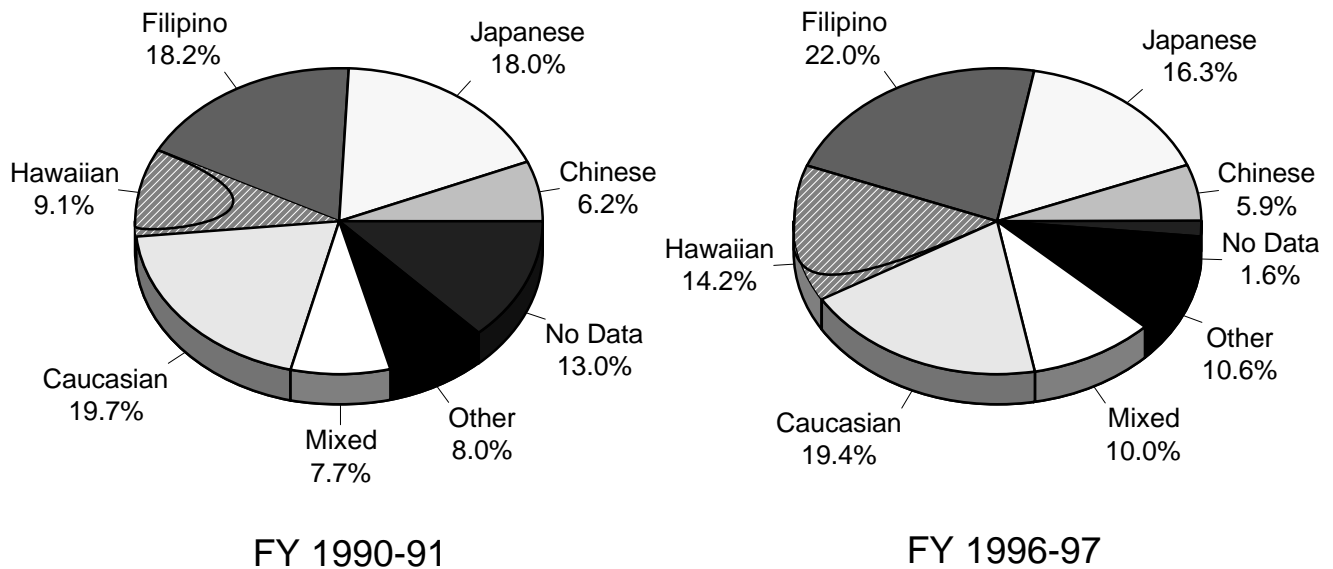
