# **ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I FALL 2004 TO FALL 2010**

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## **INTRODUCTION**

This report provides a summary of the enrollment projections for the campuses of the University of Hawai'i system: the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, the University of Hawai'i at Hilo, the University of Hawai'i-West O'ahu, and the University of Hawai'i Community Colleges: Hawai'i, Honolulu, Kapi'olani, Kaua'i, Leeward, Maui, and Windward. Details of the enrollment projections by campus may be found in the separate reports by UH unit, published annually by the University of Hawai'i Institutional Research Office as a part of the Management and Planning Support (MAPS) series.

The projections are statistical extrapolations of current trends in enrollment by campus. They do not set enrollment targets and, in general, do not take into consideration planned or potential changes in University or campus policies or procedures. They should be considered as an extension into the future of current enrollment trends, and may be used as a foundation for further work in planning and budgeting.

The enrollment projections are based upon unduplicated headcounts of students enrolled in credit courses. Included are classified students in programs leading to a degree as well as unclassified students. Special students (concurrent registrants, early admits and auditors) have been included for all campuses and for all years, both historical and projected. Historical data are included in the tables and charts to facilitate comparison and analysis. They were extracted from the student enrollment, academic crossover and course registration data files.

## **PROJECTION METHODOLOGY**

The projections for classified undergraduates are broken down by registration status: first-time, transfer, returning and continuing. Graduate and unclassified student enrollments are projected separately. The projection methodology makes use of continuation rates as well as various other ratios, trends and constants. The specific methods used and assumptions made in forecasting enrollments vary from campus to campus. Details are found in the separate enrollment projection reports published by UH unit (UH Mānoa, UH Hilo, UH-West O'ahu and the UH Community Colleges).

The Fall 2004 projection report offers three forecast series - high, middle and low. The values in the separate series were produced by varying the input values used in the models from among the range of available values. Otherwise, the same general methodology has been employed for all three series. In general, the input values are averages (either simple averages or rates) calculated using data measured over the last one to five years. In some cases, linear trends are used. The low series uses calculated values on the low end of the range of available values, the high series uses calculated values on the high end, and the middle series uses calculated values in between the two extremes.

The high, middle and low projection series, with breakout by registration status, are shown in Table 1. **The data in all subsequent tables are based upon the middle series presented in Table 1.** Historical and projected enrollments for each campus and for the UH system are summarized in Table 2. Historical and projected enrollments by registration status are presented in Table 3. Annual percentage changes in enrollment by campus are shown in Table 4. Table 5 provides enrollment indexes, useful for comparing across campuses, calculated using Fall 2003 as the base year (Fall 2003 = 100). (An enrollment index is illustrated for the UH system in Figure 2 and for each UH unit in Figures 5 to 8.) Tables 6 and 7 show projected student semester hours (SSH) offered and full-time equivalent (FTE) course enrollments, respectively. Projected enrollments by attendance status (full-time / part-time) are given in Table 8.

## ANALYSIS AND DISCUSSION

- C Enrollment of credit students for the University of Hawai'i measured 50,317 in Fall 2003, an increase of 4.5% over the previous fall semester and the third consecutive increase in fall semester enrollment (Tables 2 & 4 and Figure 1). Enrollment increased at six of the ten campuses in the UH system. UH Hilo had the largest increase in percentage terms at 8.6%, followed by Hawai'i CC at 7.5%, Kapi'olani CC and Windward CC at 6.4%, UH Mānoa at 6.2% and Leeward CC at 4.8%. Enrollment at Maui CC was stable, while enrollment at Kaua'i CC declined slightly. Enrollment declined 2.9% at UH-West O'ahu and 5.4% at Honolulu CC.
- C ***The middle series enrollment forecast for the UH system projects a 2.3% increase for Fall 2004, to 51,483 students, with annual growth averaging 1.3% through Fall 2009, when enrollment will peak at around 54,300 students.***
- C The high series enrollment projection provides for a 4.8% increase in enrollment in Fall 2004, to 52,748 students, while the low series provides for a 1.4% decline in enrollment, to 49,626 (Table 1 & Figure 3). The robust growth of the last three years gives the overall enrollment forecast upward momentum. The high series has enrollment increasing through Fall 2010 at an average annual rate of 2.2%; the low series provides for little or no overall growth.
- C Enrollment of Hawai'i public high school seniors is expected to grow moderately through Academic Year 2007-08, according to information from the Hawai'i Department of Education. Similarly, growth in Hawai'i private high school graduates is expected to peak in Academic Year 2007-08, according to the most recent projections from WICHE. If the going rates of these students into the UH campuses remain unchanged, moderate increases in first-time students from Hawai'i's high schools may be anticipated through Fall 2008. Active recruiting by the four year campuses has contributed to large increases in first-time freshmen from the U.S. mainland over the last several years. However, further growth may be limited by resource constraints, especially housing. The overall outlook for **first-time students** is for moderate growth through Fall 2008.

- **Classified undergraduate transfer** enrollment declined 10.4% in Fall 2003, but much of this decline may be attributed to changes in the definition of a transfer student that attended the implementation of the UH common application form. Consequently, these students may now be coded continuing or unclassified. Otherwise, transfer enrollment had been increasing rapidly (Table 3). Transfers are forecast to increase at an annual rate 1.9% through Fall 2010.
  
- C **Classified undergraduate returning** enrollment has been separated from continuing enrollment and forecast separately in the Fall 2004 projections reports for the first time. Returning enrollment has been forecast using constants for most campuses. The forecast follows the overall enrollment curve for the UH system – average annual growth of about 1.1%.
  
- C **Classified undergraduate continuing** enrollment increased 1.5% in Fall 2003., the second semester of solid growth. Growth in first-time, transfer and returning enrollment should translate into significant increases in continuing students through the forecast period, given the same level of student retention.
  
- C **Classified graduate** enrollment increased 7% in Fall 2003, the second consecutive semester of strong growth. The addition of new programs, as well as the demographics of the baby boom echo, should lead to annual increases of 1% to 3% over the next several years. Classified graduate enrollment is forecast to increase 2.3% per year through Fall 2007, and slightly thereafter.
  
- C Enrollment for the UH system grew slowly but steadily from the founding of the UH Mānoa campus in 1907 through 1960, when total UH system enrollment measured 7,771 (Figure 4). Through the 1960s and into the early 1970s, enrollment boomed, increasing more than 470% from 1960 to 1975. Enrollment then leveled off and, despite a surge in the early 1980s, held steady at around 44,000 students from Fall 1975 to Fall 1989. From 1989 to 1994, enrollment grew by 18%, reaching a historical peak of 51,667 in Fall 1994. Enrollment then declined for several years, before stabilizing at around 45,000 students in Fall 1998. The enrollment growth posted from Fall 2001 to Fall 2003 has been large in historical terms and fairly consistent across the UH campuses.

## **SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION**

The University of Hawai'i system is in the midst of a period of rapid enrollment growth. Much of this increase may be attributed to the active recruitment of first-time and transfer undergraduates from the U.S. mainland. Planned increases in first-professional programs at UH Mānoa, the addition of new graduate level programs at UH Mānoa and UH Hilo and demographic trends have helped boost graduate level enrollments as well. Further increases may be anticipated in the near term, though resource constraints will eventually cause the growth rates to level out. The enrollment forecast (middle series) projects annual growth of about 1.5% for the UH system through Fall 2008, with enrollment stabilizing at around 54,000 students. The alternate series provide for continued robust growth on the high side and little or no growth on the low side.

Historical & Projected Headcount Enrollment

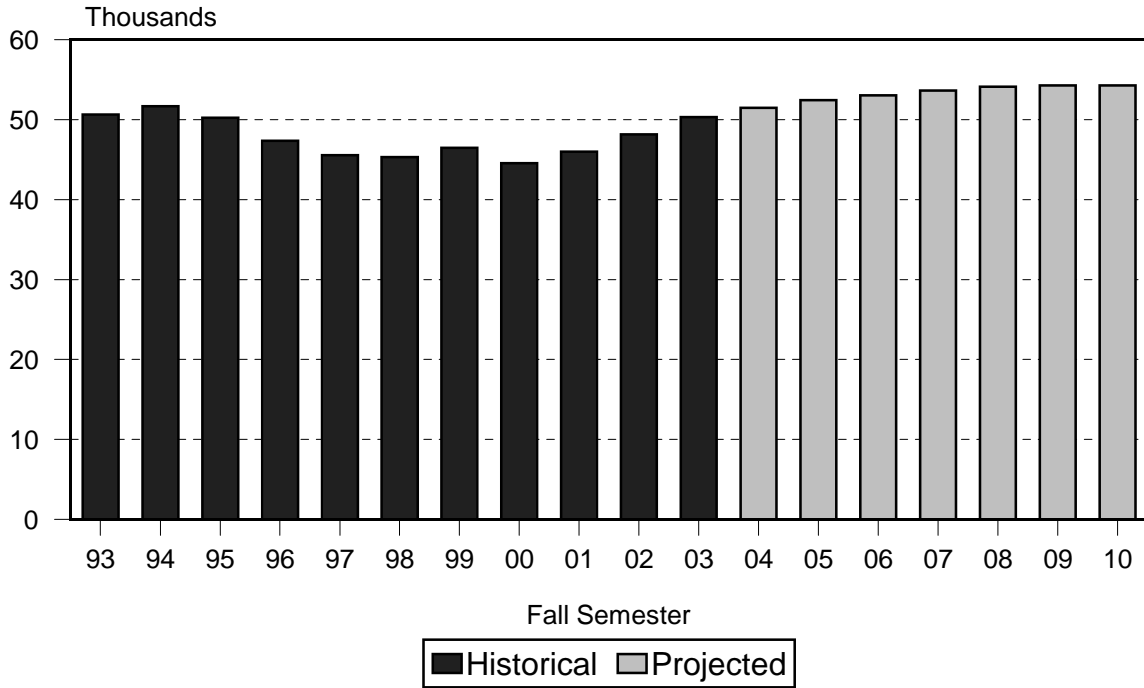
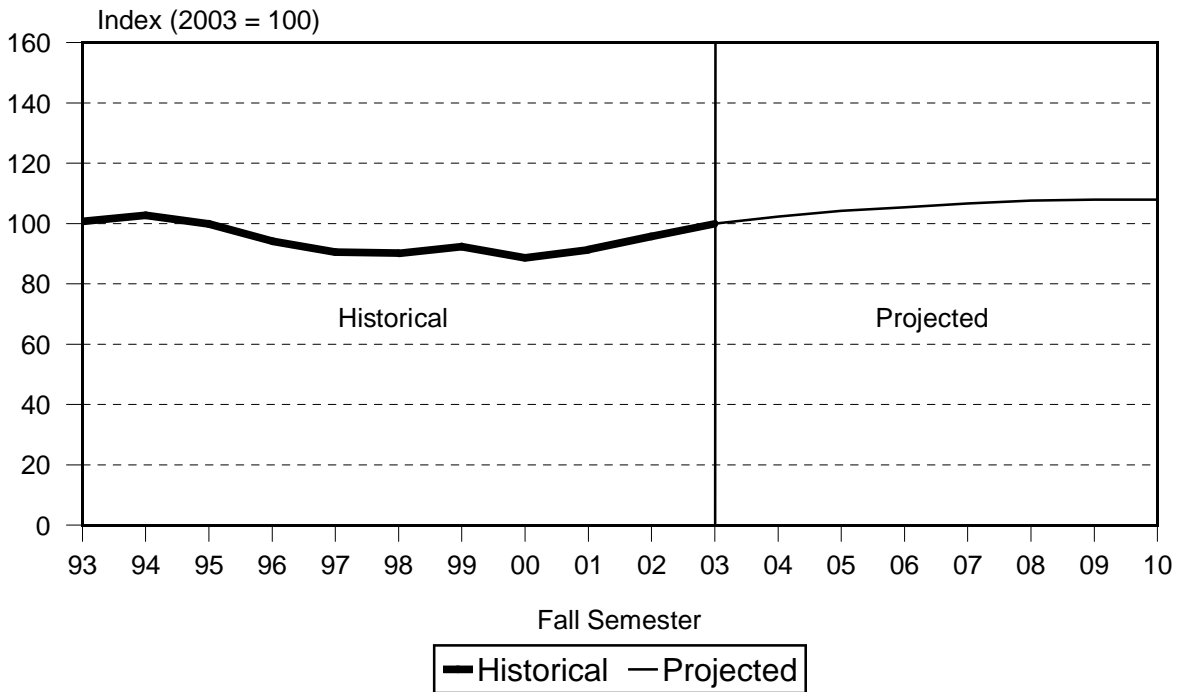

High, Middle and Low Projection Series - UH System

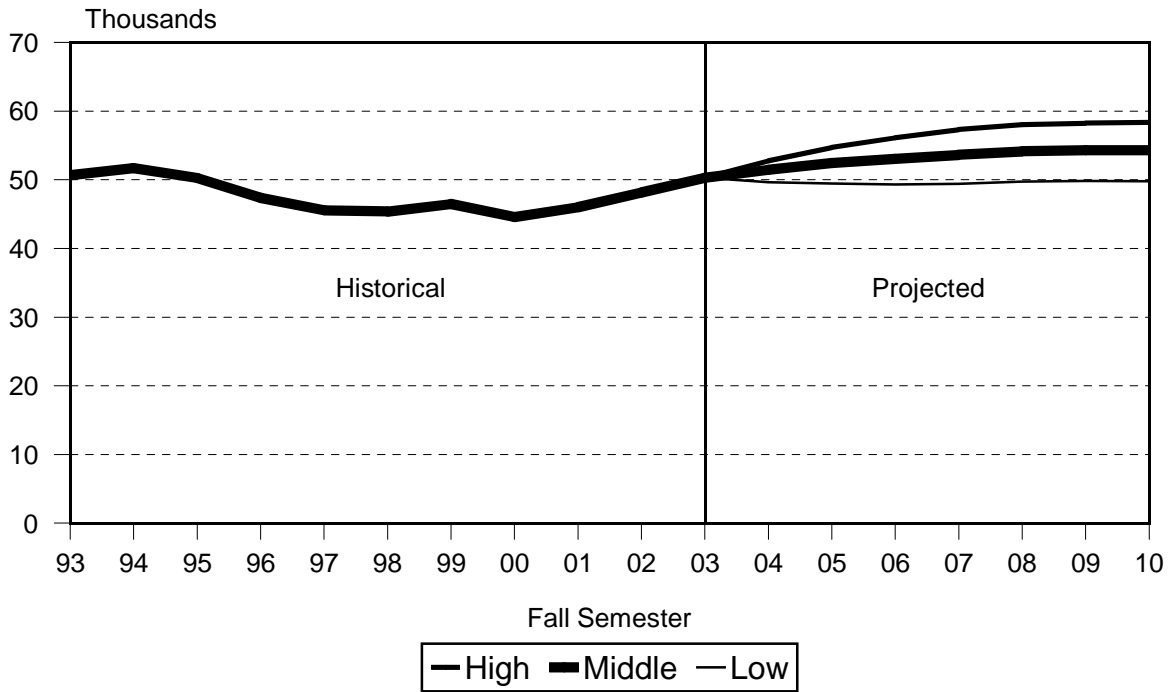
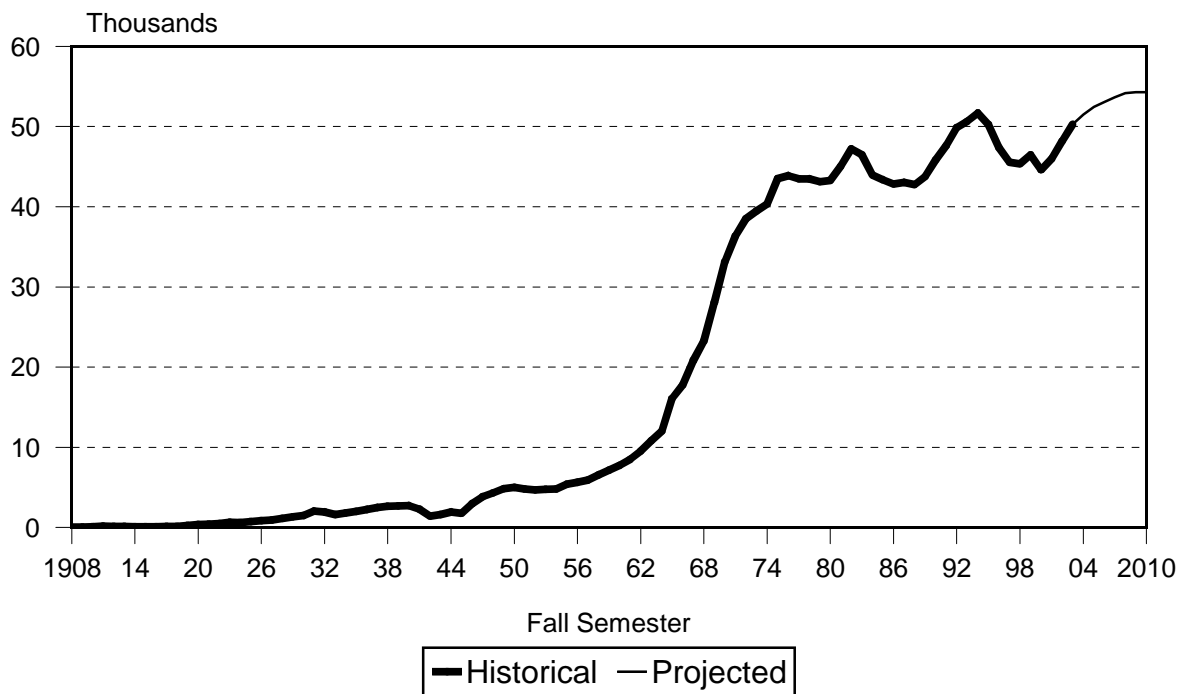

Enrollment Index - UH Manoa

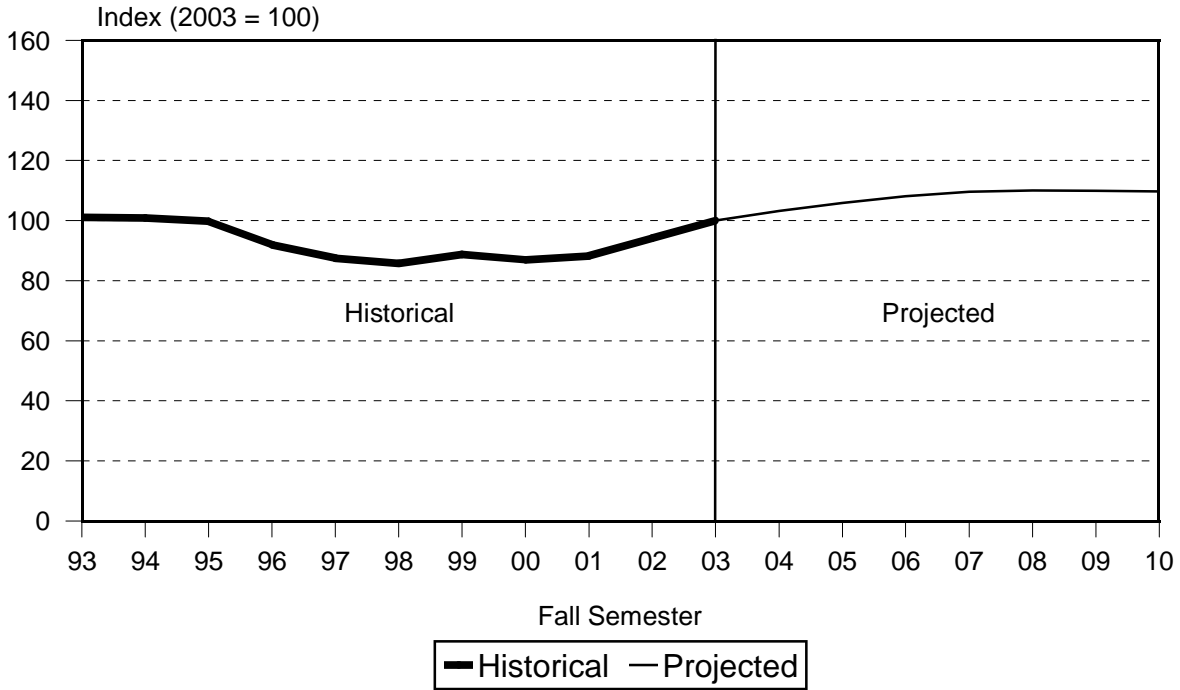
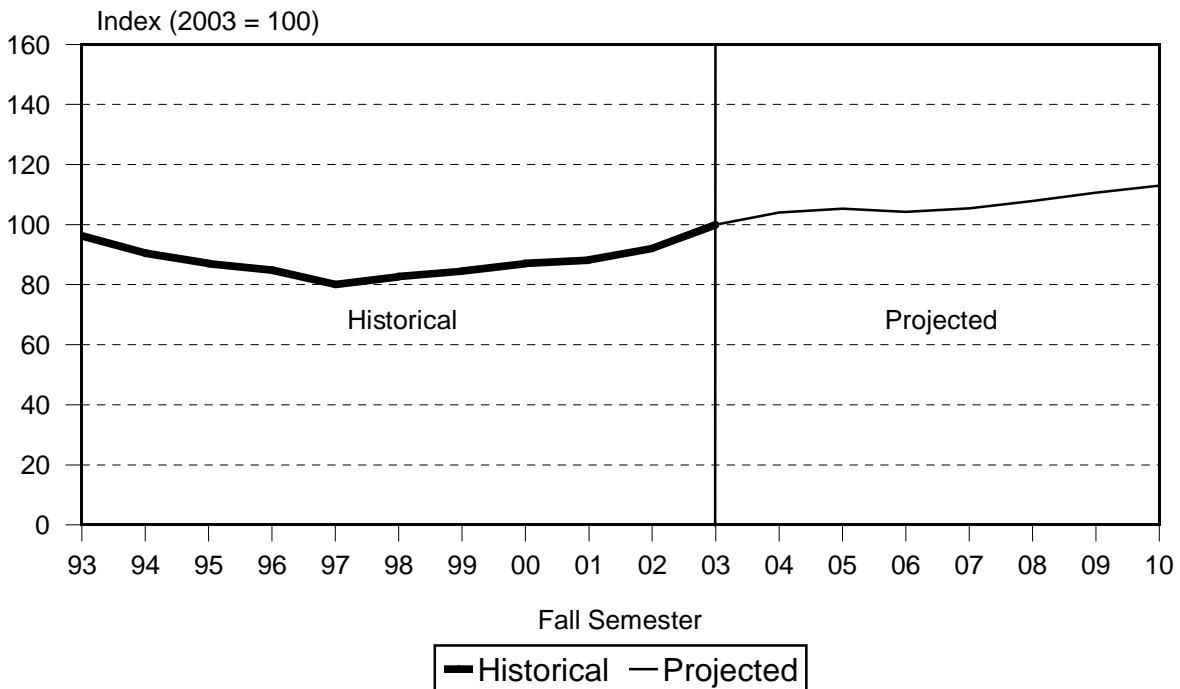

Enrollment Index - UH-West O'ahu

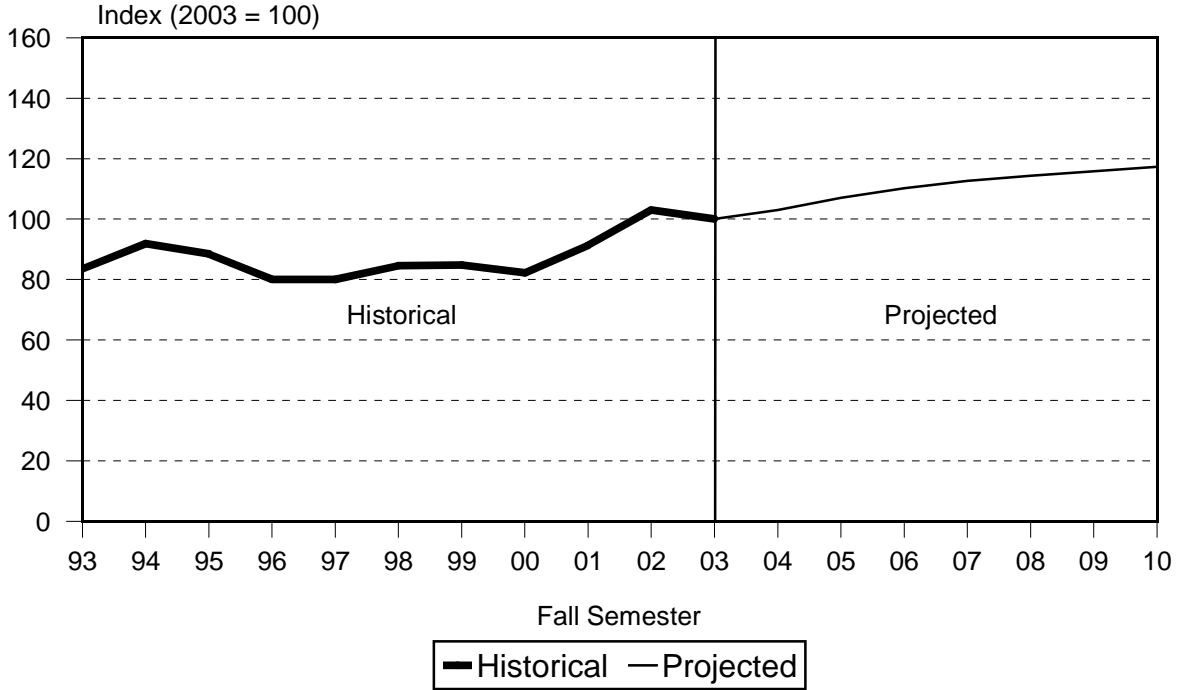

Enrollment Index - UH Community Colleges

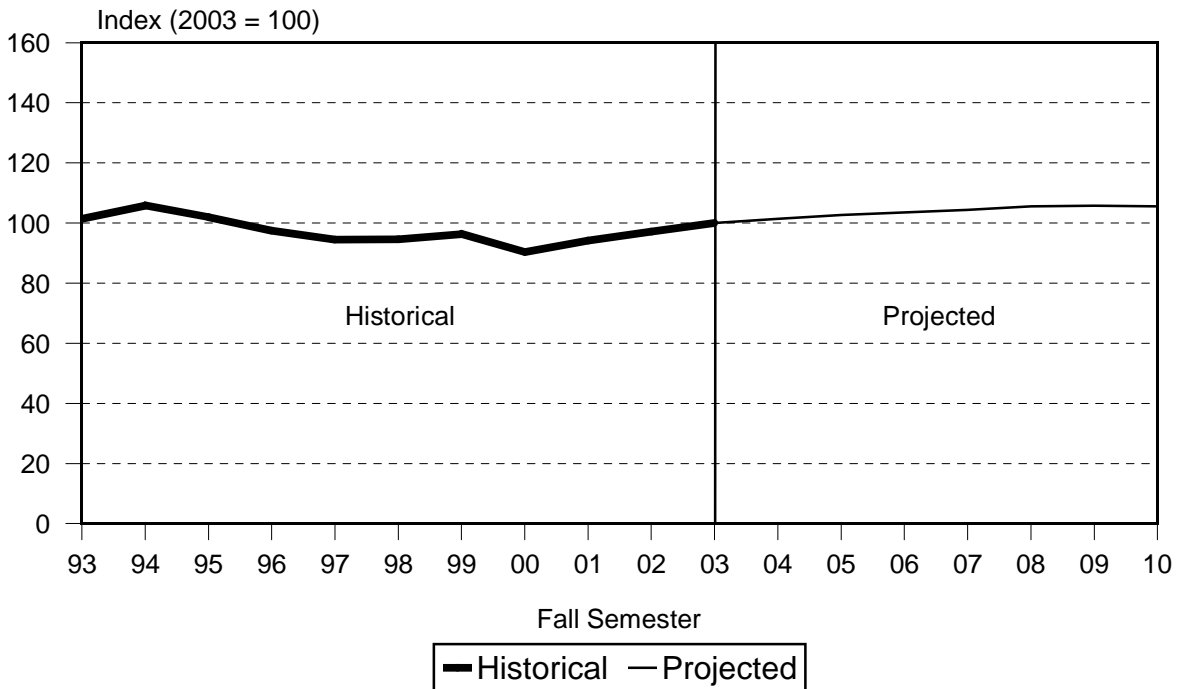
