**GRADUATION AND RETENTION RATES
PEER AND BENCHMARK GROUP COMPARISONS
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I, COMMUNITY COLLEGES
FALL 1998 TO FALL 1999 COHORTS, AS OF 2002**

This report summarizes graduation and retention rates at the University of Hawai'i community college campuses and compares graduation rates with those of its peer and benchmark institutions. Peer and benchmark graduation rates are collected from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) peer analysis system.

Three rates are looked at in this report:

- **Retention/Continuation Rate:** The percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who returned to the campus in a subsequent fall semester.
- **Graduation Rate:** The cumulative percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who graduated within a designated period of time, measured as of the summer term. The designated period of time is 150% of the normal time to completion. In other words, 150% of the amount of time necessary for a student to complete all requirements for a degree or certificate according to the institution's catalog. For example, students in a 2-year program would graduate within 150% time if they graduate within 3 years.
- **Success Rate:** The percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who have either graduated or are still enrolled. The success rate is calculated by adding the graduation and continuation rates together.

Rates in this report are the result of tracking first-time freshmen at specific community college campuses and not across the campuses. For example, a first-time freshman entering Honolulu Community College is tracked at that campus only.

Continuation, graduation, and success rates are provided for the each of the University of Hawai'i community colleges. However, since federal reporting requirements do not require the collection of retention/continuation rates, only graduation rates are available for peer and benchmark institutions.

Appendices 1 through 1G show which schools are included in each benchmark or peer group, as well as the 150% graduation rates for the Fall 1999 cohort.

Due to differing methodologies and databases, data reported here differ from previously reported data from the NCHEMS/University of Hawai'i Longitudinal Database Project.

Graduation Rates

The community colleges have an average 150% graduation rate of 14%. Hawai'i Community College has the highest graduation rate (20%) of the 7 campuses, followed by Maui (18%), Honolulu (15%), Kaua'i (14%), Leeward (12%), Kapi'olani (10%), and Windward (9%).

The average 150% graduation rate is 6 percentage points less than that of its benchmark average of 20%. Graduation rates at each campus are also lower than those of its peer averages:

- Hawai'i's rate is 3 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 23%.
- Honolulu's rate is 8 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 23%.
- Kapi'olani's rate is 7 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 17%.
- Kaua'i's rate is 11 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 25%.
- Leeward's rate is 13 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 25%.
- Maui's rate is 6 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 24%.
- Windward's rate is 16 percentage points lower than that of its peer average of 25%.

Graduation rates of women are higher than those of men at all campuses except Hawai'i. The average UHCC 150% graduation rate is 15% for women and 12% for men.

Nonresident aliens, Hispanics, and Caucasians have the highest average UHCC graduation rates, 21%, 16%, and 15% respectively.

Continuation Rates

The community colleges have an average continuation rate of 23%. Kapi'olani Community College has the highest continuation rate (30%) of the 7 campuses, followed by Leeward (26%), Kaua'i and Honolulu (22%), Windward (19%), Maui (18%), and Hawai'i (14%).

Continuation rates of women are higher than those of men at Hawai'i, Kaua'i, and Windward. Men have higher continuation rates at Honolulu and Leeward. Continuation rates of men and women are equal at Kapi'olani and Maui. The average UHCC continuation rate is the same for men and women (23%).

Asians and mixed-ethnicity students have the highest average UHCC continuation rates, 25% and 23% respectively.

Success Rates

Success rates are the sum of graduation and continuation rates, and reflect the percentage of students who have not dropped out at an individual campus. The average UHCC 150% success rate is 37%. Kapi'olani Community College has the highest success rate (40%), followed by Leeward (38%), Honolulu (37%), Maui (36%), Kaua'i (35%), Hawai'i (33%), and Windward (28%).

Success rates of women are higher than those of men at all campuses, except Honolulu. The average UHCC success rate is 38% for women and 35% for men. Asians have the highest average UHCC success rate (39%).

Summary

- The UHCC average 150% graduation rate is 14%.
- An average of 37% of UHCC students either graduate within 150% of the normal time to completion or remain at the individual campus past the 150% completion period.
- Women have higher graduation and success rates at most of the campuses. Continuation rates by gender vary at each campus.
- Nonresident aliens, Hispanics, and Caucasians have the highest average UHCC graduation rates.
- Asians have the highest average UHCC continuation and success rates.

Figure 1 150% Success Rates by Campus

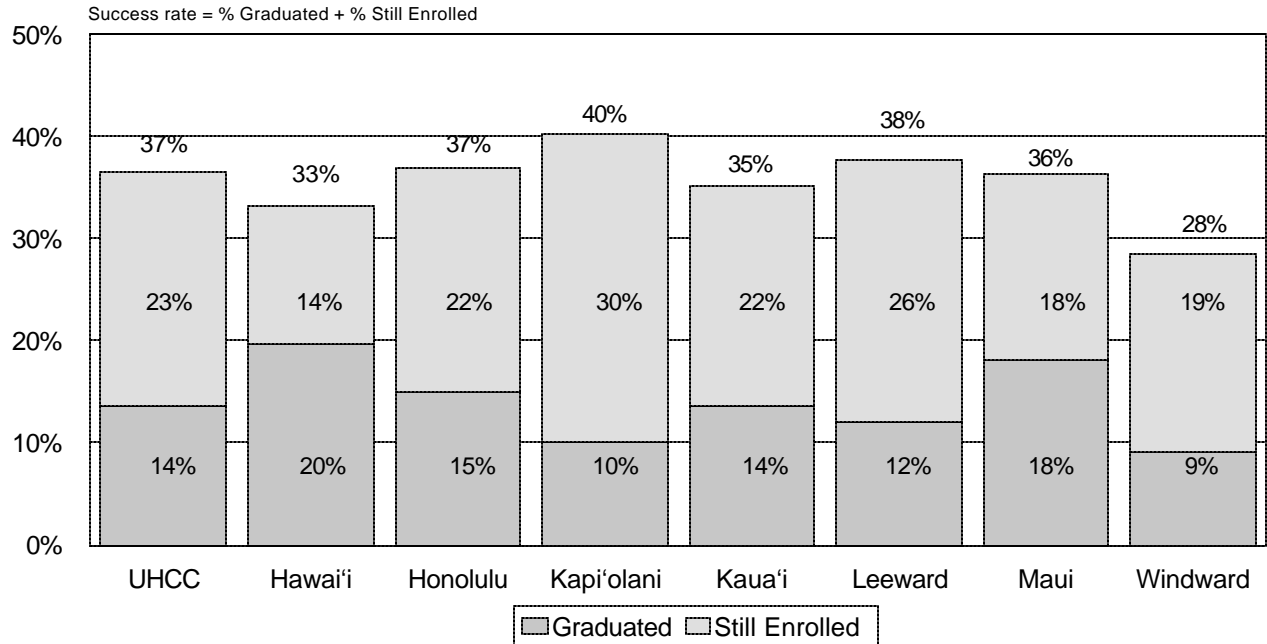
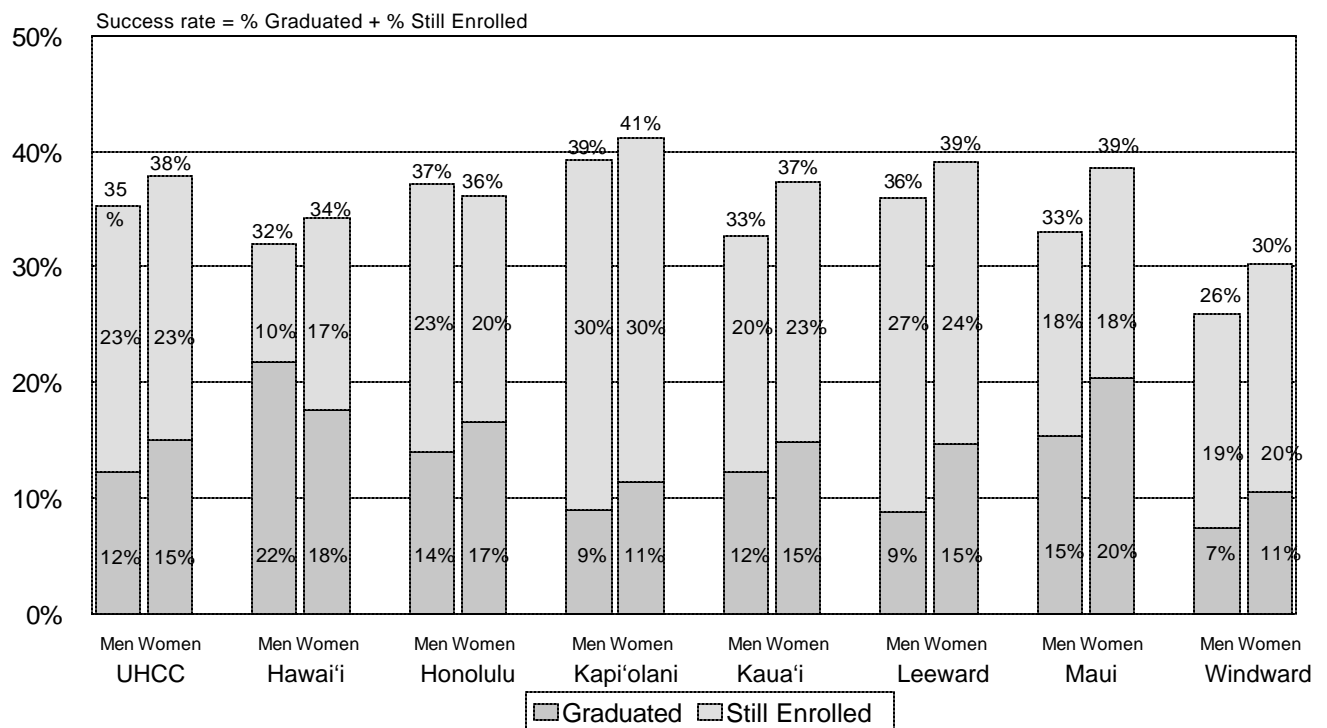


Figure 2 150% Success Rates by Gender

150% Success Rates by Ethnicity - UHCC

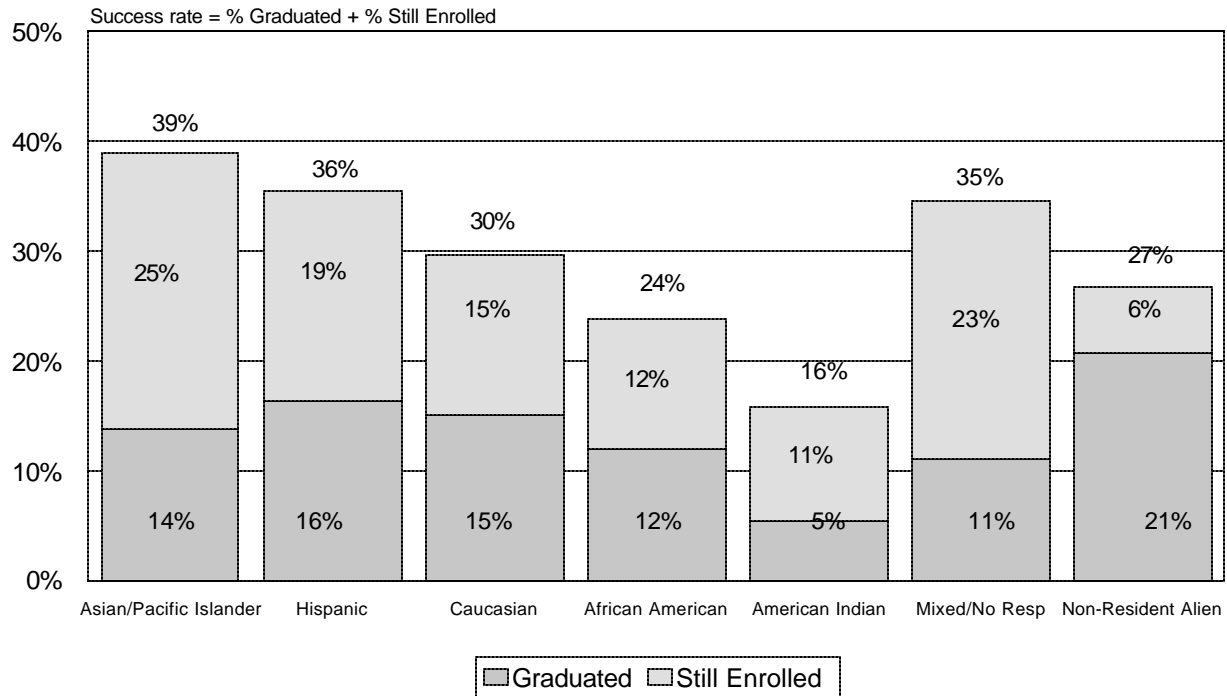
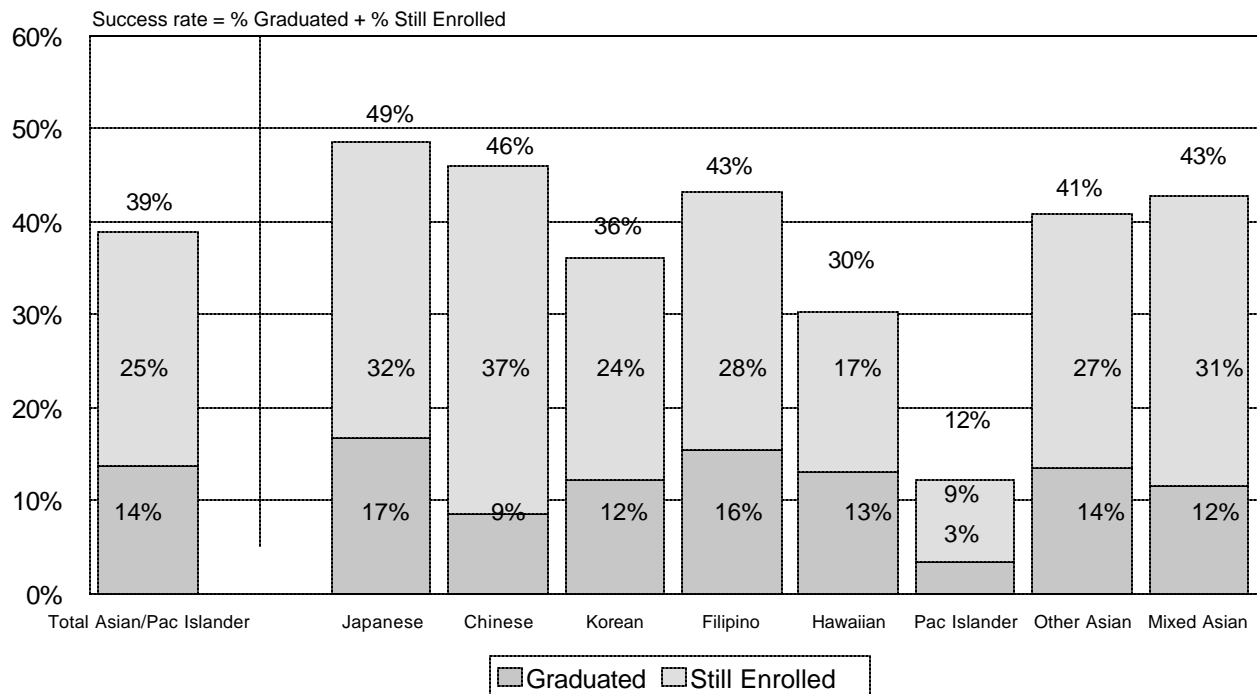

150% Graduation Rates

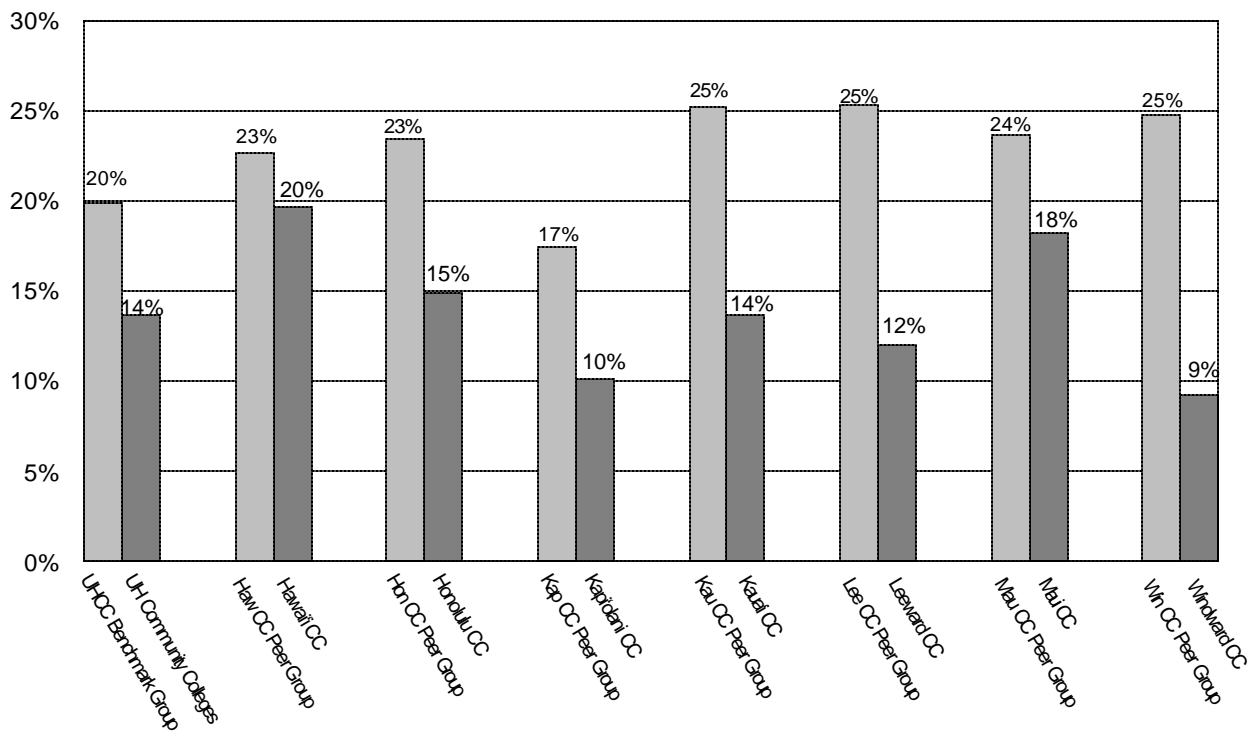
