

**DISTRIBUTION OF GRADES, CREDITS EARNED RATIOS,
COURSE COMPLETION RATIOS
AND CURRENT GRADE POINT RATIOS**

UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI`I, COMMUNITY COLLEGES

**Office of the Chancellor for Community Colleges
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This report summarizes Fall 1996 data on student achievement as perceived from two dimensions: by the current grade point ratios earned by students, by program, and by the distribution of grades in the courses offered by the colleges. Source documents, computer reports 2528 and 2529, which are generated after grades have been submitted at the end of the semester, are on file in the registrar's office at each campus.

The data include the grades given to and earned by all students registered for credit classes; i.e., regular students, special students (early admits and concurrent registrants), students in credit courses offered by continuing education, as well as students who registered for the first time in the second eight-week session.

Tables 1 and 2: Distribution of Grades and Average Grades Assigned

- Slightly more than half (50.5 percent) of the grades were "A's" and "B's" (27.1 and 23.4 percents, respectively).
- "W" and "N" grades were 9.4 and 7.2 percents respectively, of the grades this fall.
- Six of the seven campuses gave "F" grades. Slightly more than seven percent of the grades given this fall were "F's". The proportion ranged from 4.2 to 10.9 percent.
- Average grade assigned, by campus, ranged from 2.6 at Hawai'i and Kapi'olani to 3.2 at Maui. Differences in average grade were due in part to differences in the grading systems utilized by the campuses.
- The average grade for all campuses was 2.7.

Table 3: Credits Earned Ratios

- The credits earned ratio was 73.6 percent.
- The credits earned ratio was higher for vocational courses (80.3 percent) than for general education courses (70.6 percent).
- Credits earned ratios ranged from 66.6 percent (natural sciences courses) to 89.1 percent (health services courses).
- Credits earned ratios by campus ranged from 69.7 percent at Leeward to 80.3 percent at Hawai'i.

Table 4: Course Completion Ratios

- The course completion ratio was 90.6 percent.
- The course completion ratio was higher for vocational courses (94 percent) than for general education courses (89.1 percent).
- Course completion ratios ranged from 85.9 percent (natural sciences courses) to 98.5 percent (food service courses).
- Course completion ratios by campus ranged from 88.2 percent at Leeward to 94.9 percent at Maui.

Table 5: Current GPRs by Major and Educational Objective

- The current mean GPR of community college students was 2.70.
- The current average GPR earned by vocational education majors (2.78) was higher than that earned by liberal arts majors (2.63). The average GPRs of vocational education majors ranged from 2.62 for food service majors to 3.01 for health services majors.
- This semester industrial education students earned the highest GPR (3.42).
- The data by educational objective show that unclassified students earned the highest GPR (2.95), followed by certificate of completion students (2.91) and certificate of achievement students (2.88).
