Total Registrations by Credits Earned / Unearned

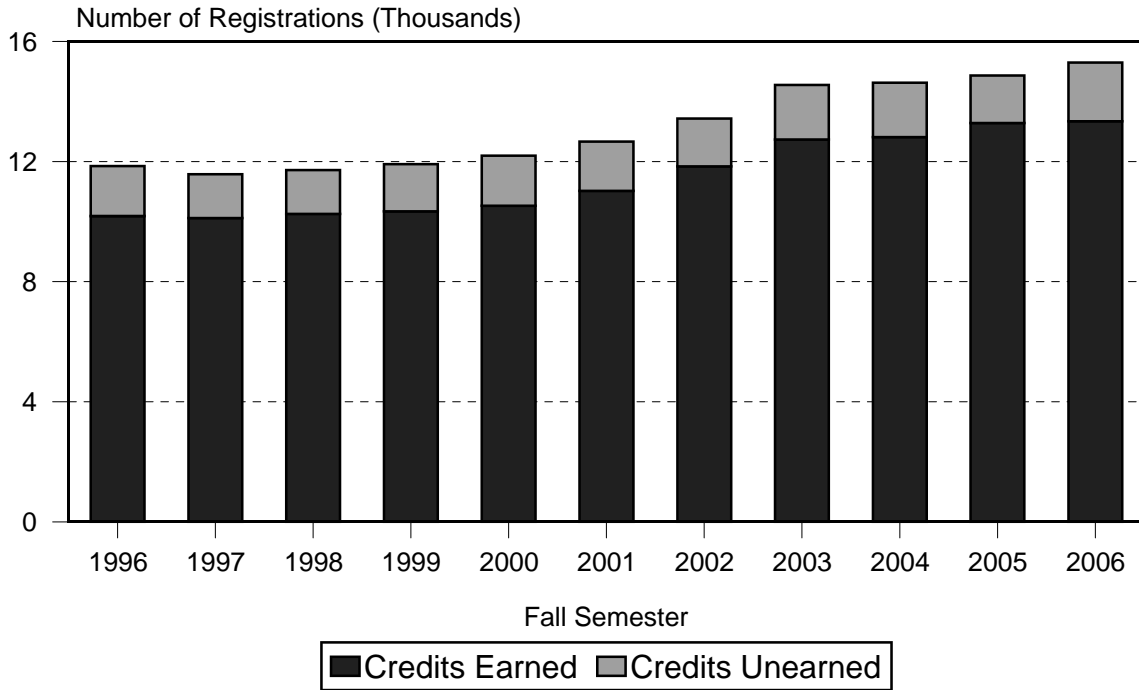
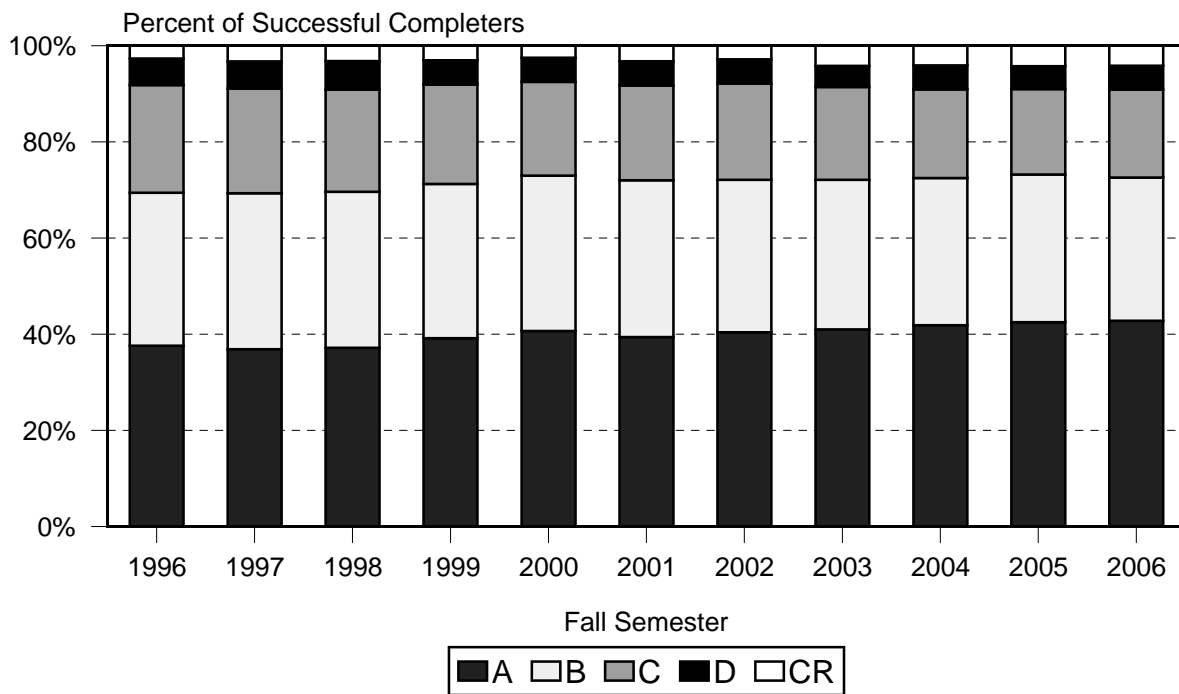

Credits Earned and Course Completion Ratios

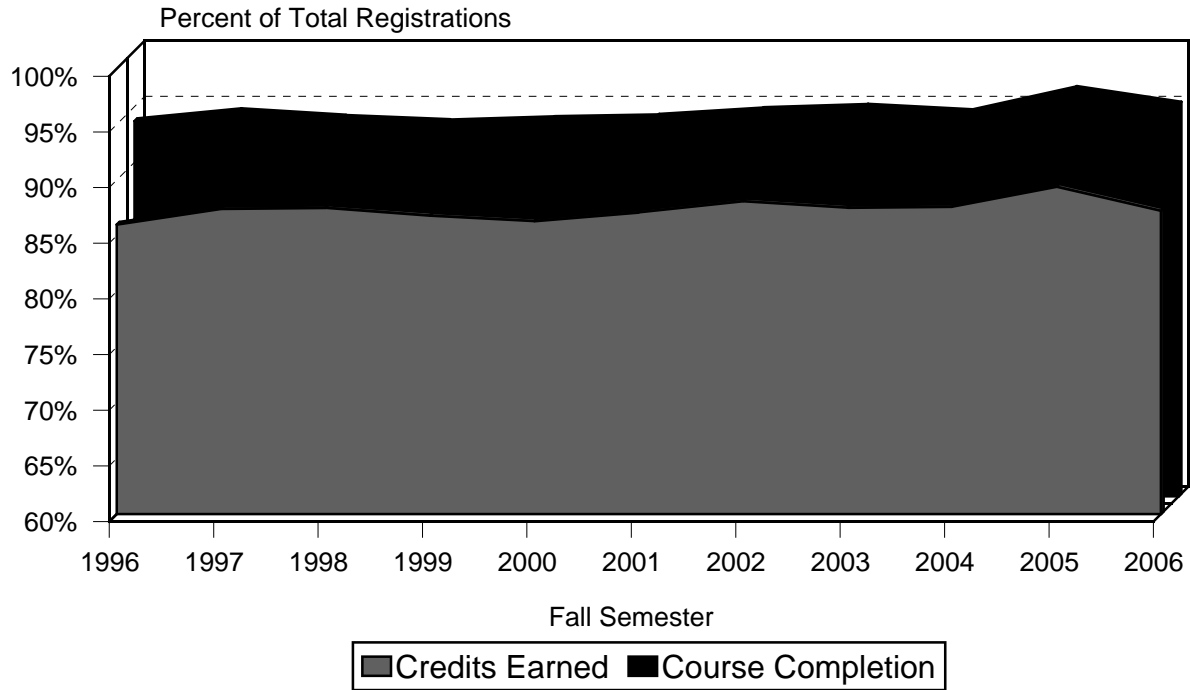

Current Grade Point Average

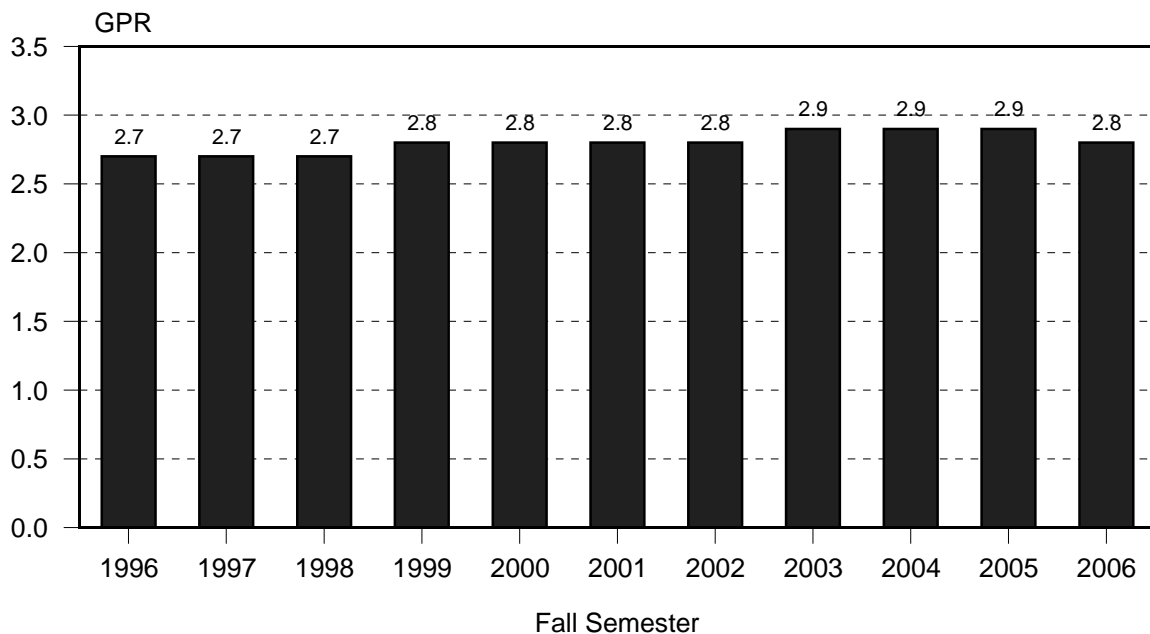
