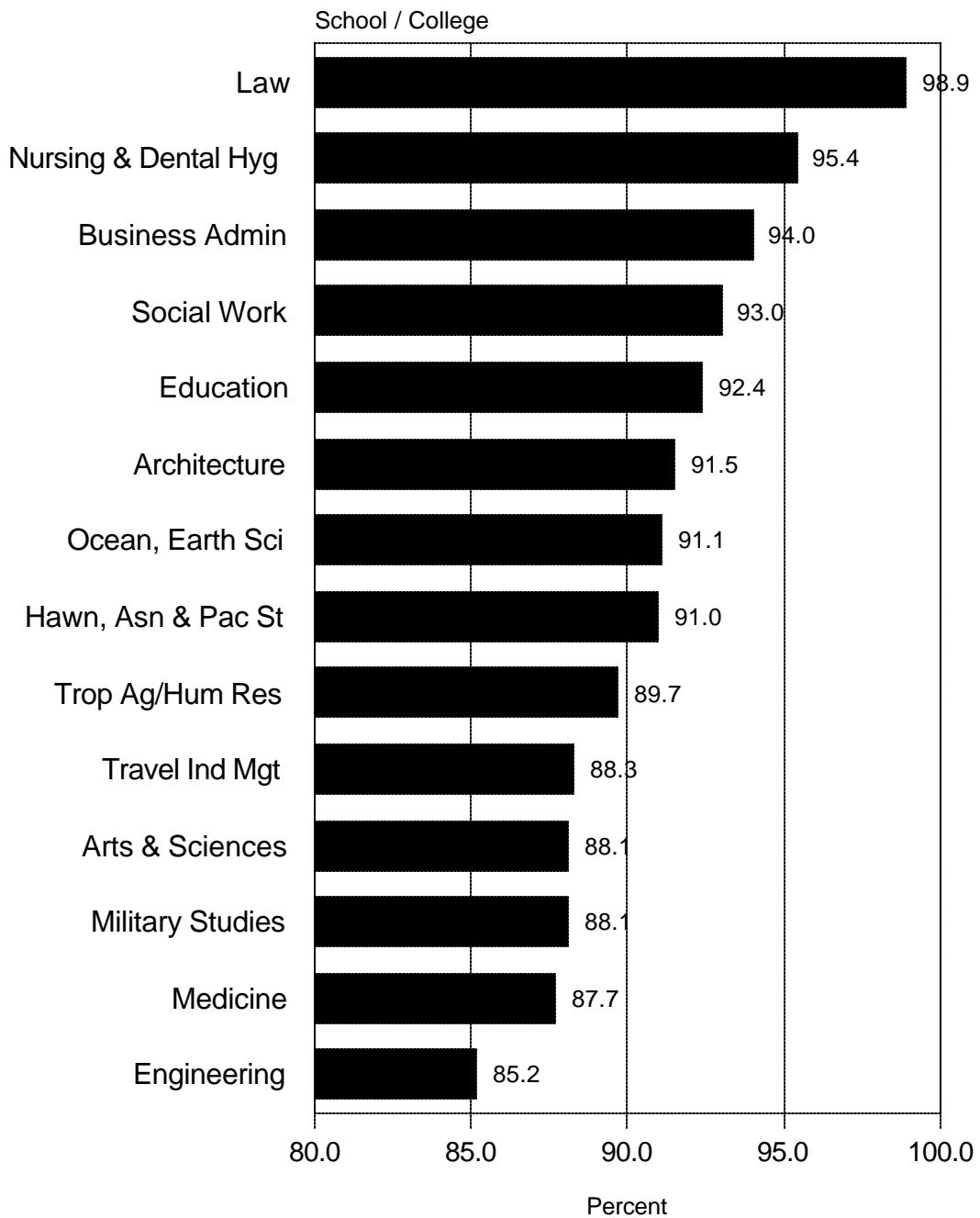

Credits Earned Ratio by Course Offering

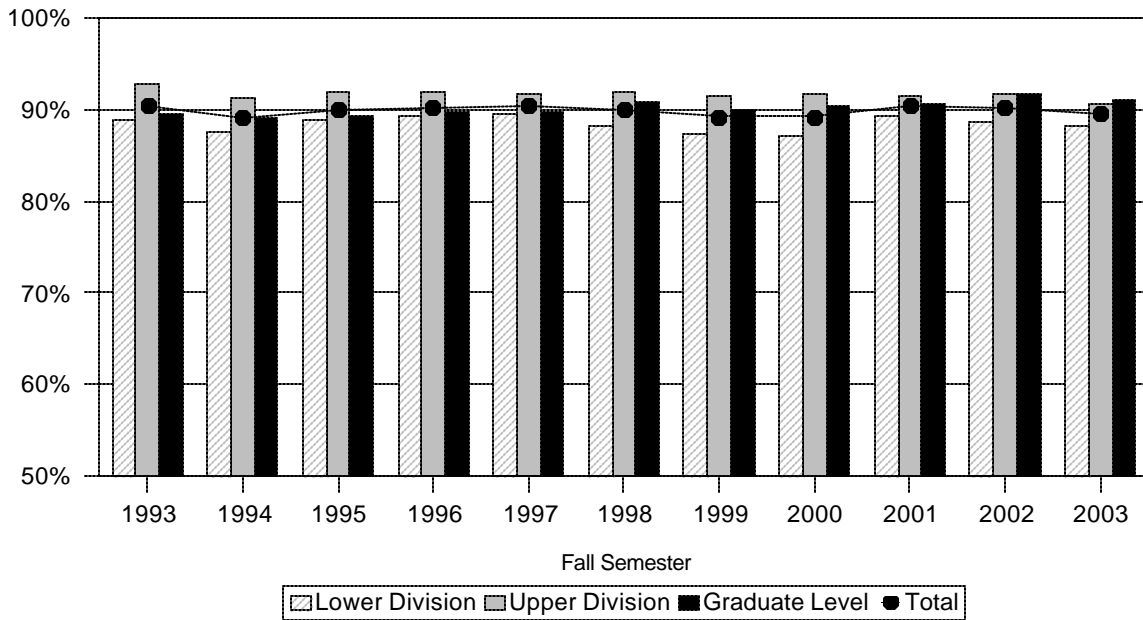
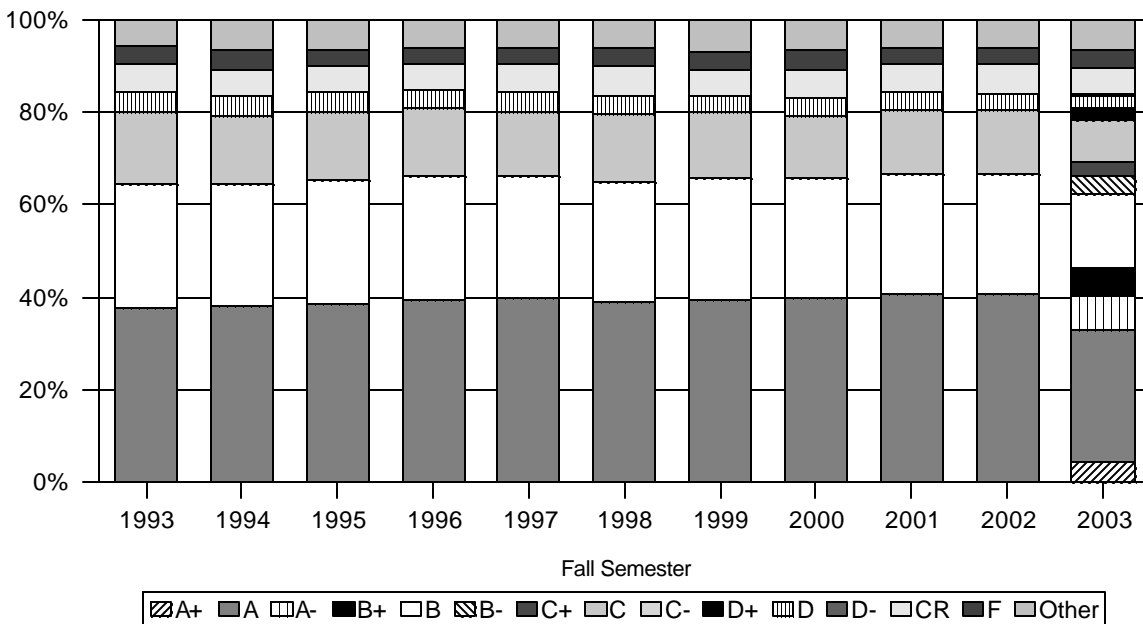

Distribution of Grades - Lower Division

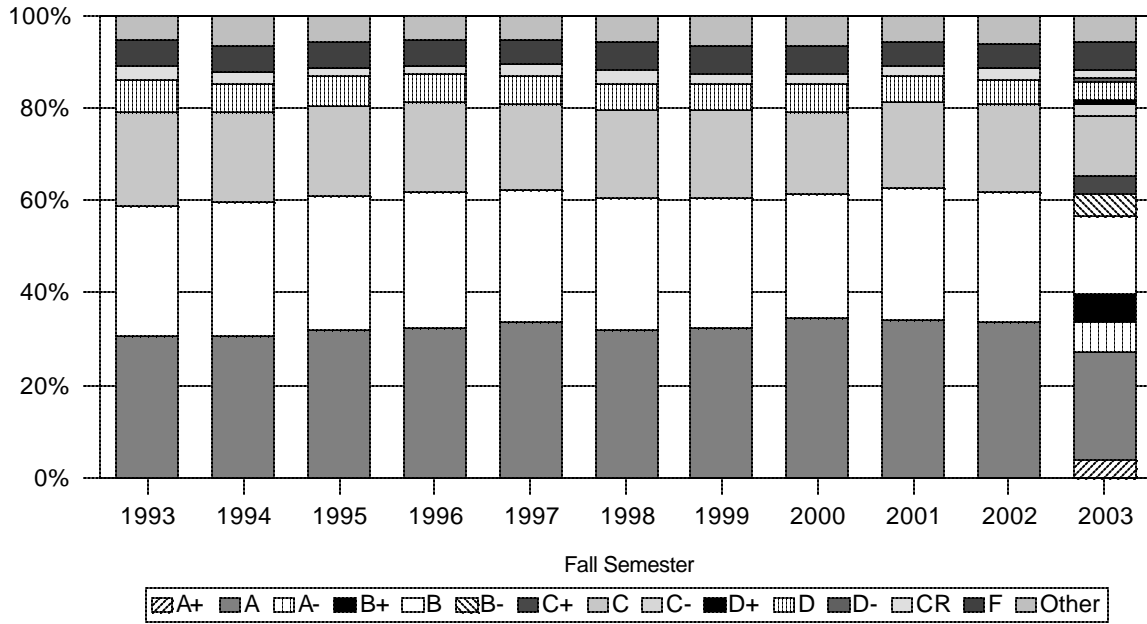
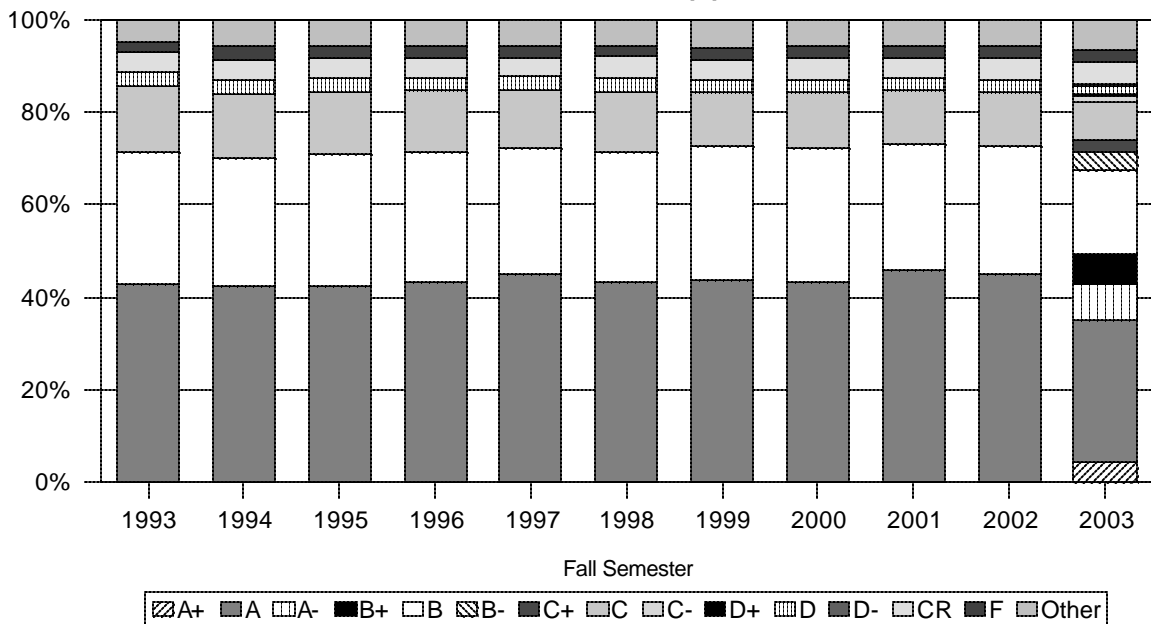
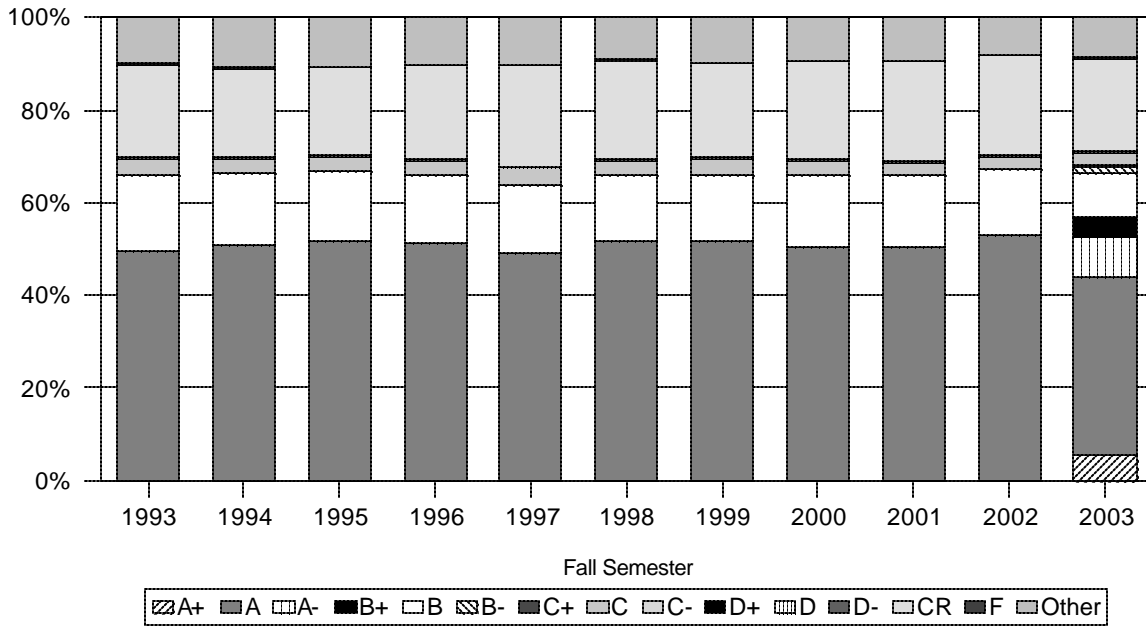
