HIGH SCHOOL BACKGROUND OF FIRST-TIME STUDENTS UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, FALL 2010

Total first-time student enrollment for the University of Hawai'i system measured 9,526 for Fall 2010, a 3.9% increase over Fall 2009 (Table 1 and Figure 1). The total first-time student count in Fall 2010 was the highest on record (going back to 1970).

Enrollment of first-time students from Hawai'i high schools measured 6,992, a slight (0.6%) increase over Fall 2009 (Table 1A). Enrollment of Hawai'i public high school graduates decreased slightly to measure 5,845, while enrollment of Hawai'i private high school graduates increased 4.0% to 1,147. Enrollment of students from the U.S. mainland increased 8.4% to measure 1,245, while 378 students came from foreign countries and U.S. related areas.

The going rate of Hawai'i recent high school graduates (those who completed high school within the previous academic year) into the University of Hawai'i system measured 38.1% in Fall 2010, a decrease of 0.9 percentage points from Fall 2009 (Table 3 & Figure 7). The going rate of public high school graduates decreased from 40.7% to 39.3%, while the going rate of private high school graduates increased from 32.9% to 33.6%.

The number of high school graduates for the State of Hawai'i in June 2010 measured 14,052, a decrease of 3.5% from the previous academic year (Table 4 & Figure 5). Overall the number of high school graduates has declined 4.0% from the peak measured in June 2008. WICHE has forecast a gradual decline through academic year 2018-19 (Figure 14).

The going rate of Hawai'i high school graduates into the UH campuses posted solid gains for the three fall semesters from 2007 to 2009 (Table 4 and Figure 7). Although the going rate softened slightly in Fall 2010, it remains at a fairly high level historically. Of interest is the observation that total first-time students reached a new historical high in Fall 2010, even as the total going rate declined. As shown in Table 1A and Figure 3, the proportion of first-time students with GED credentials has grown in recent years. In addition, the proportion of first-time students who have been out of high school for one or more years has increased (Figure 4). These students are not included in the going rate calculation, which is limited to high school graduates in the current academic year. Although this may be a temporary phenomenon linked to the recessionary economy, we may conclude that, at least for the time being, more returning adults are being served.

In general, the UH Community Colleges enroll the vast majority (75%) of first-time students at the University of Hawai'i (Table 1). Furthermore, the UHCCs serve a much higher proportion of students from Hawai'i public high schools than do the four-year campuses (Figure 2). On the other hand, the UH four-year campuses enroll a higher proportion of students from Hawai'i private and U.S. mainland high schools. Most of the students who have GED credentials or who did not receive a diploma (Other Special) enroll at the UHCCs. Not surprisingly, most of the growth in the UH system going rate in recent years has occurred at the UH Community Colleges (Table 4 and Figure 7).

Total First-Time Students by UH Unit




First-Time Students by Geographic Location of High School




By Public and Private High School





From Hawai‘i High Schools





UH Mānoa and UHCC System




Honolulu CC and Kapi'olani CC




Leeward CC and Windward CC



By Public and Private High School


