Headcount and FTE Enrollment

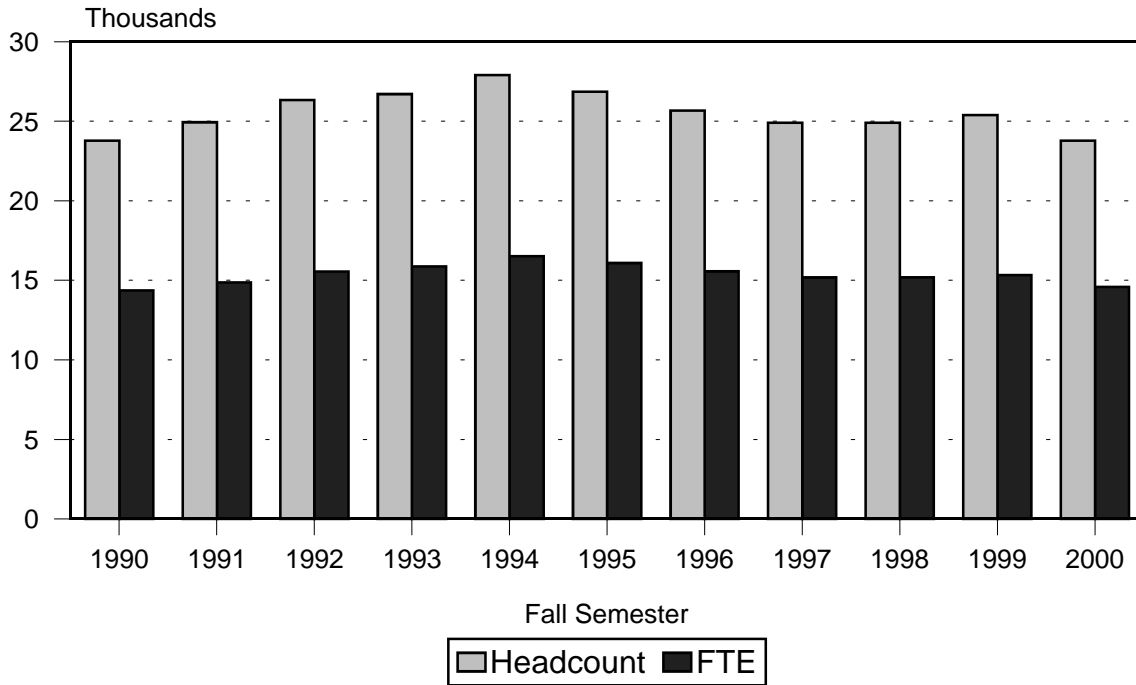
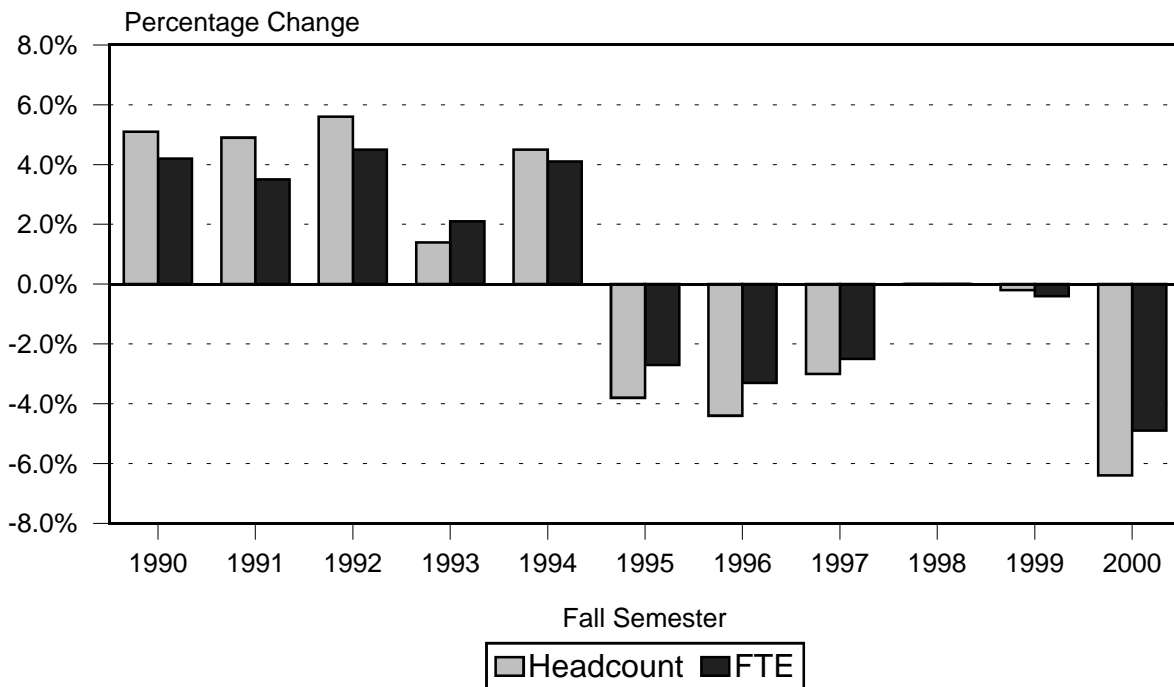

Enrollment by Program Area

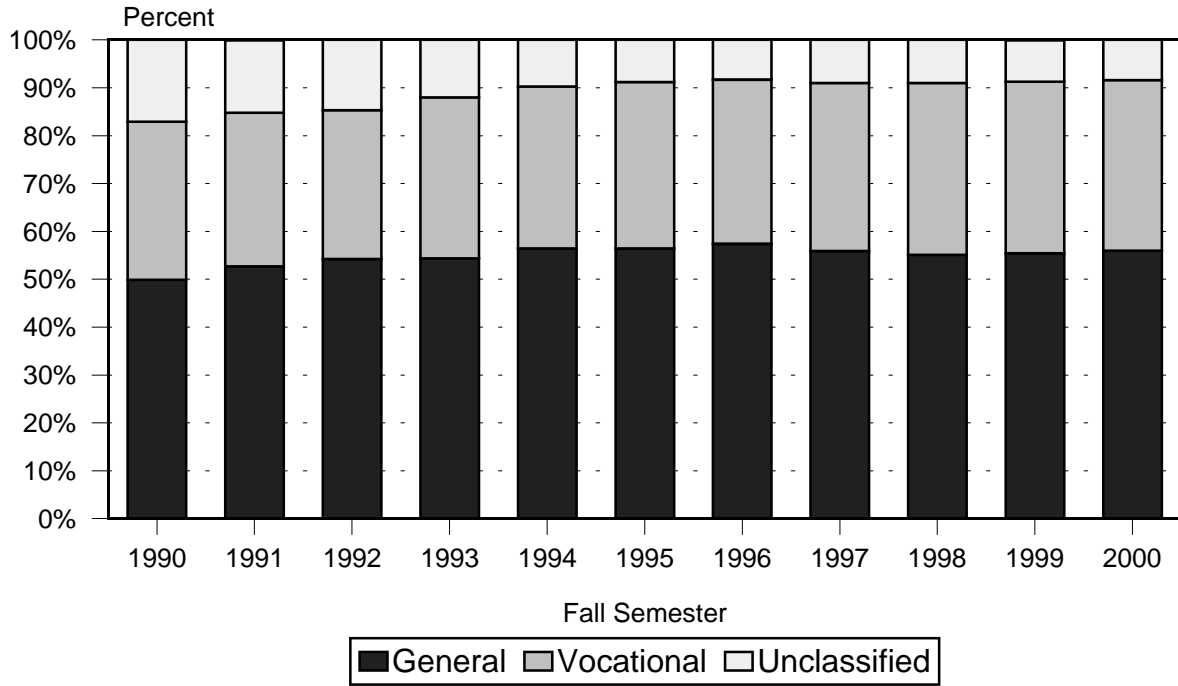
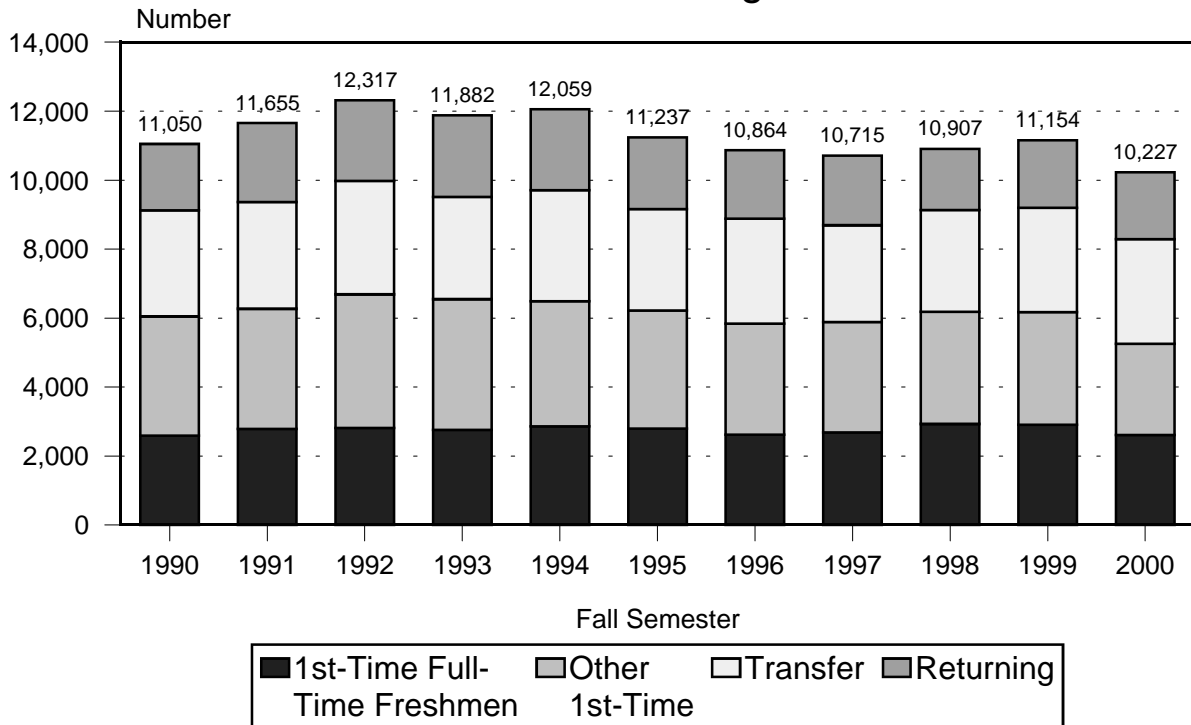

Enrollment by Gender

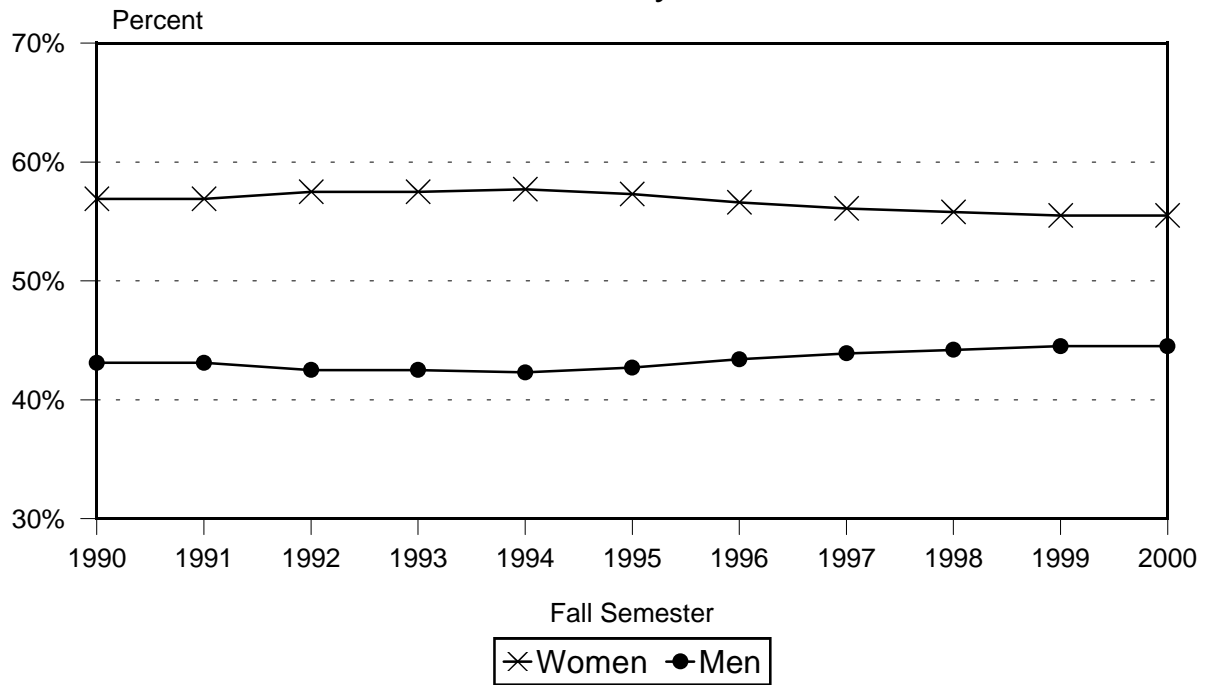
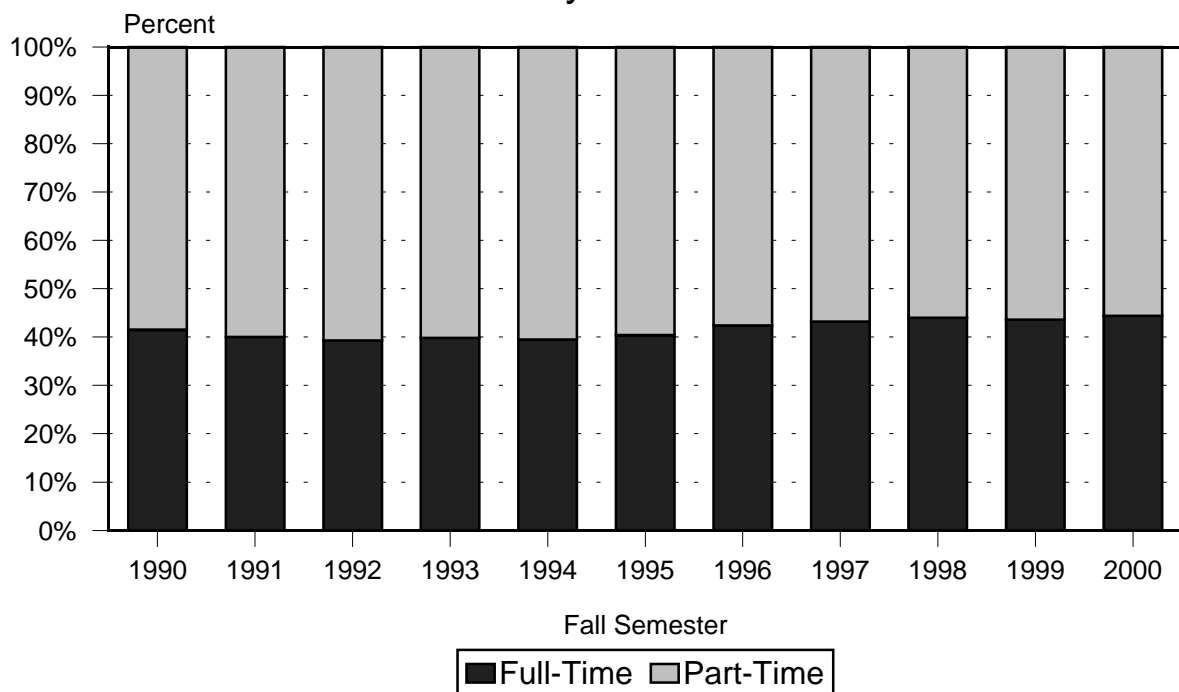

Enrollment by Tuition Status

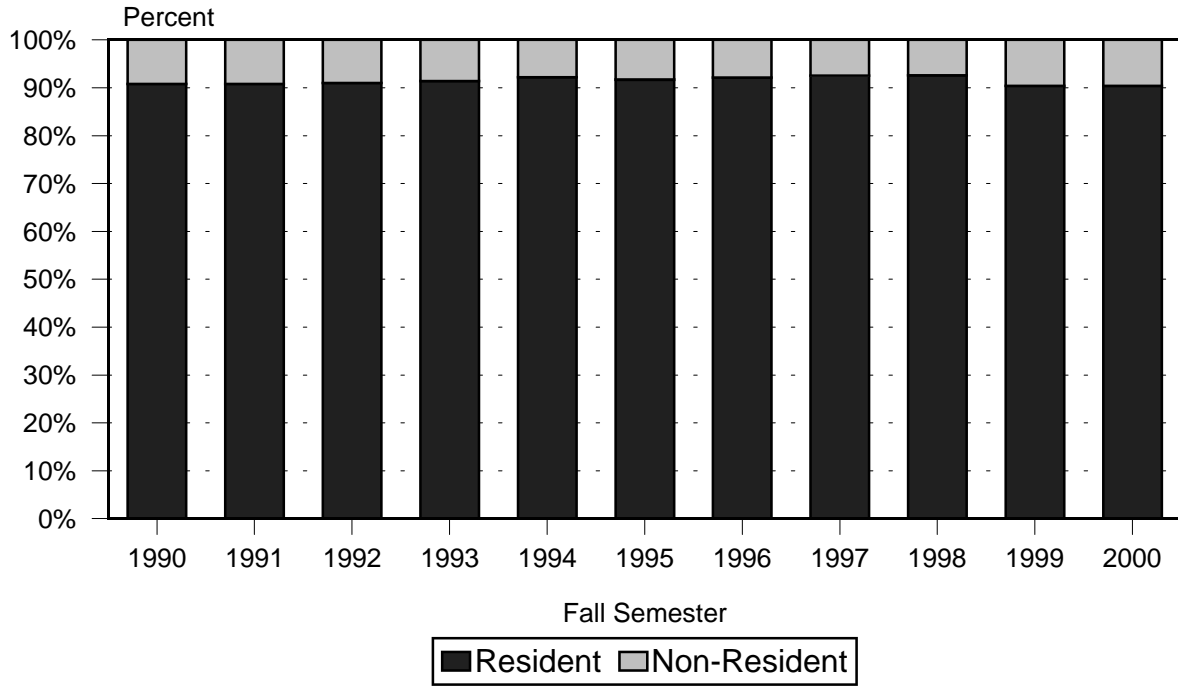
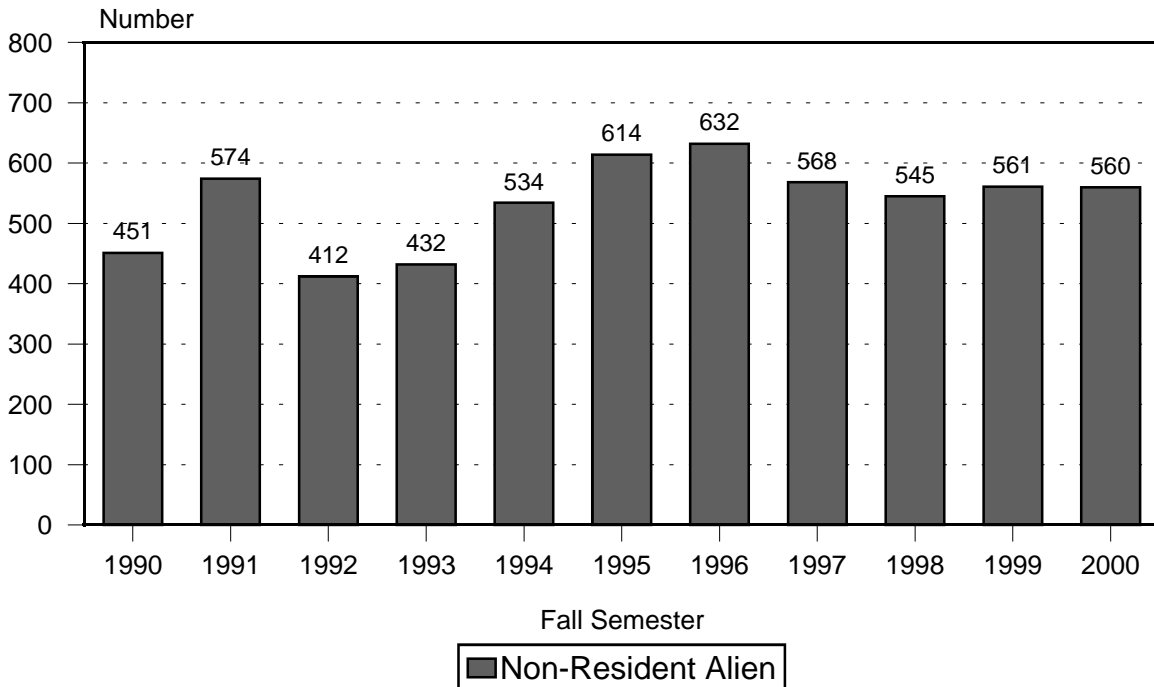

Mean Age

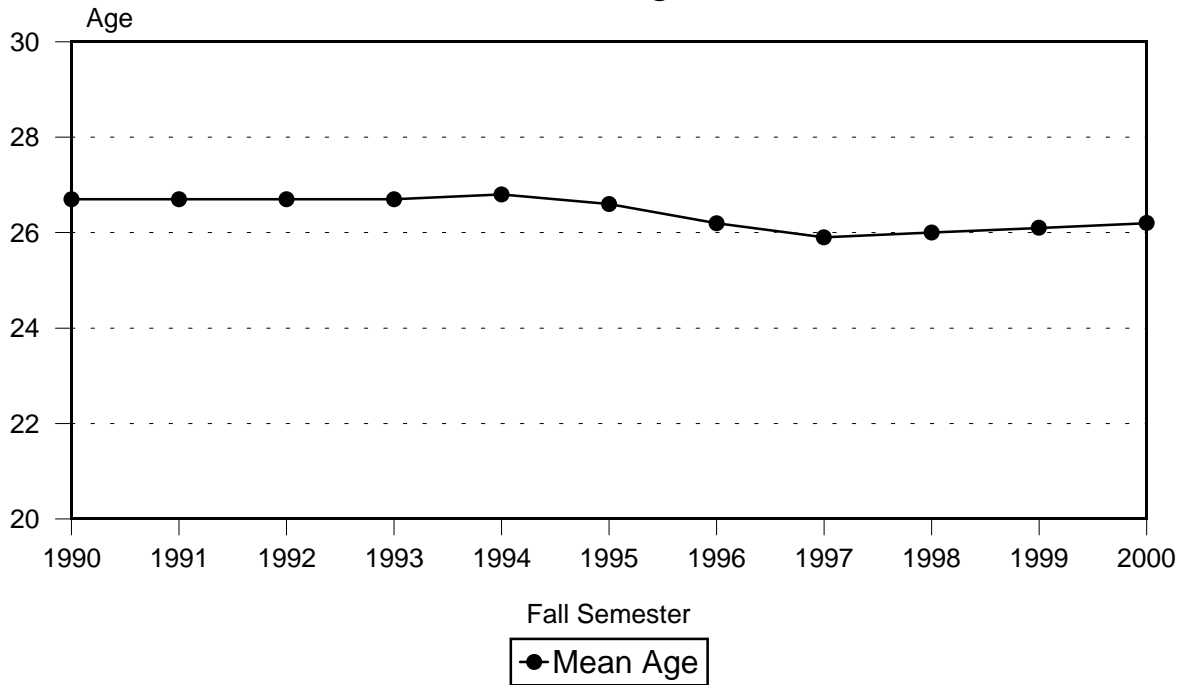

Enrollment by Ethnicity

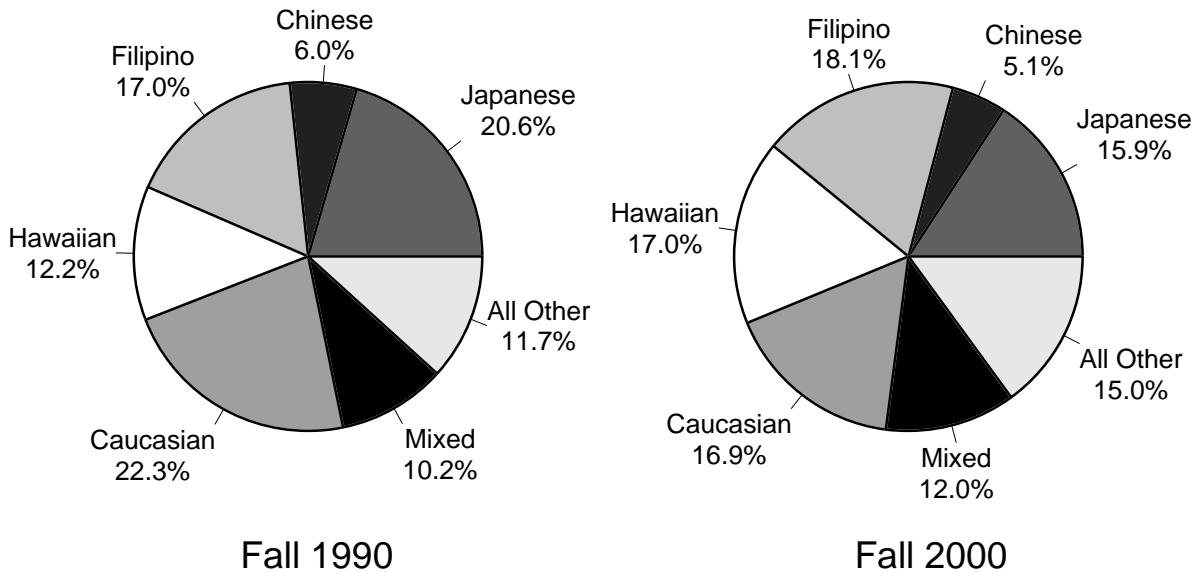
