Headcount and FTE Enrollment

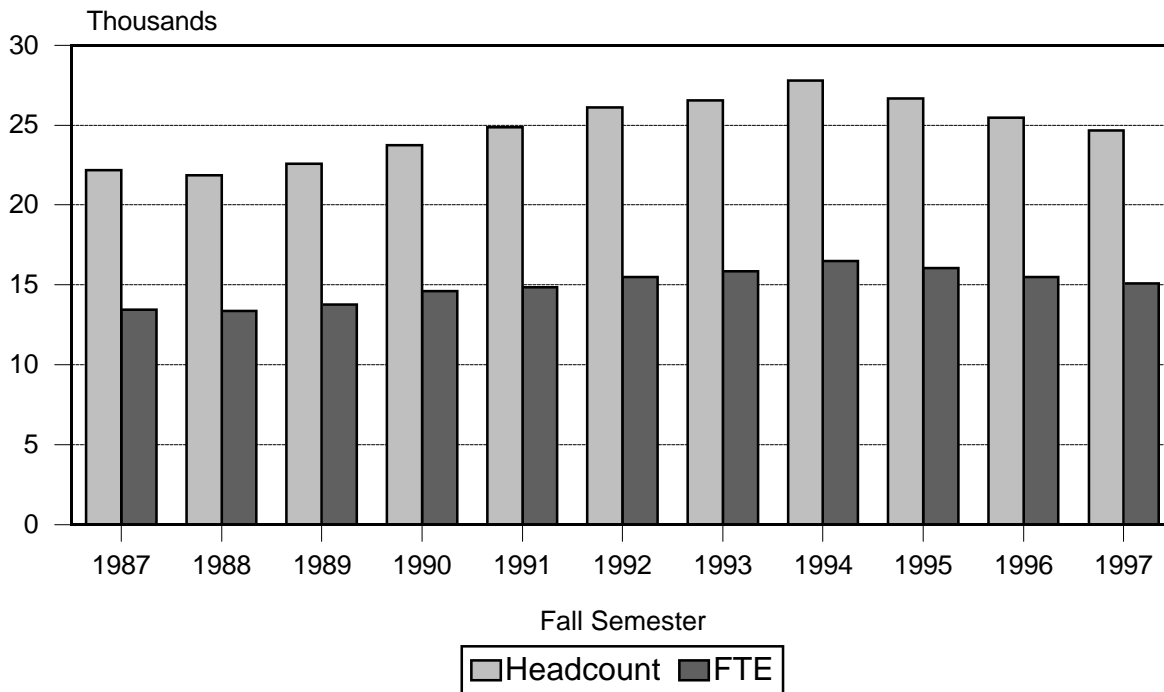
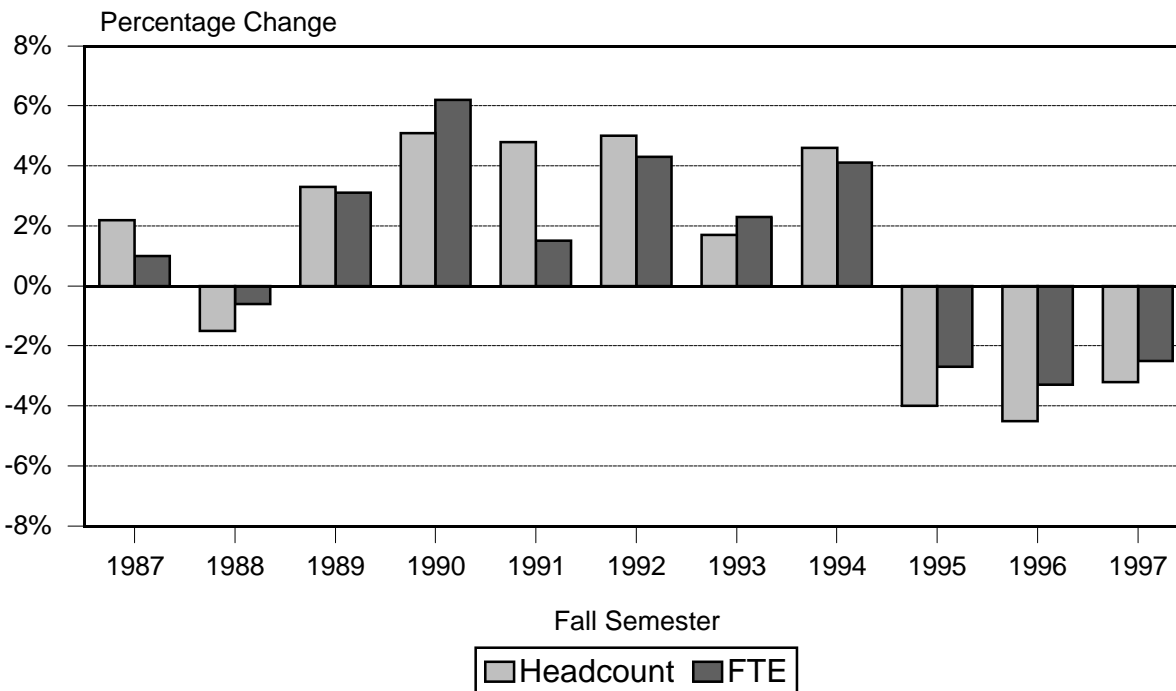

Enrollment by Program Area

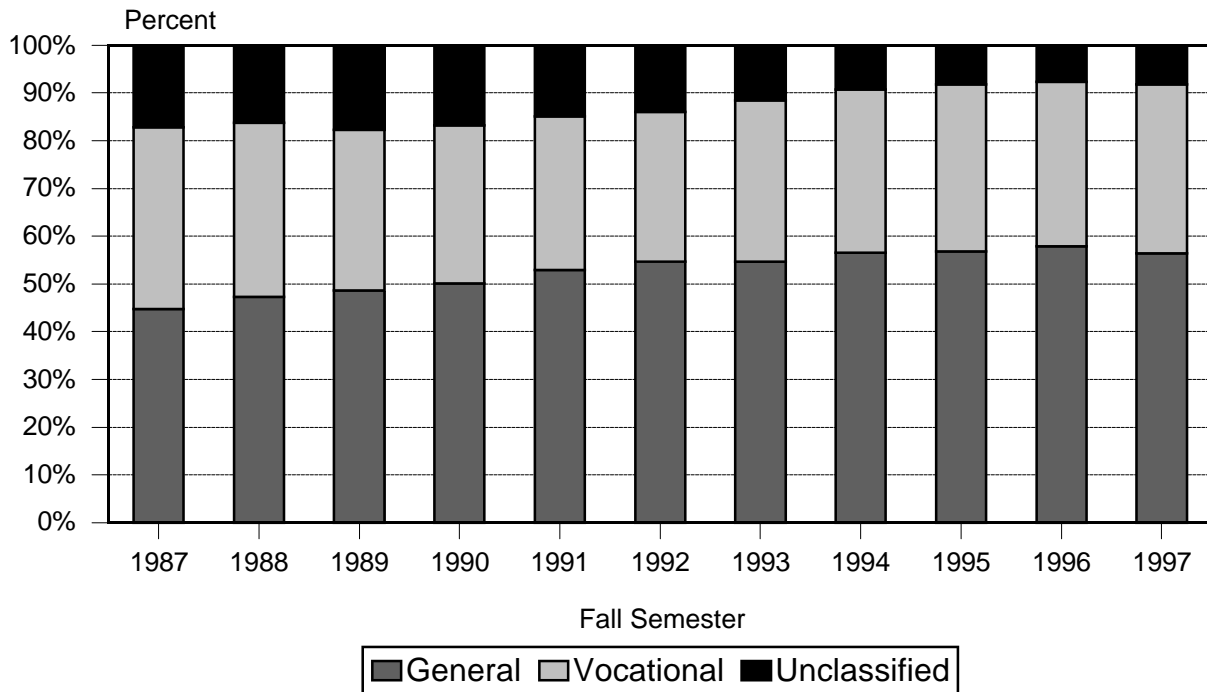
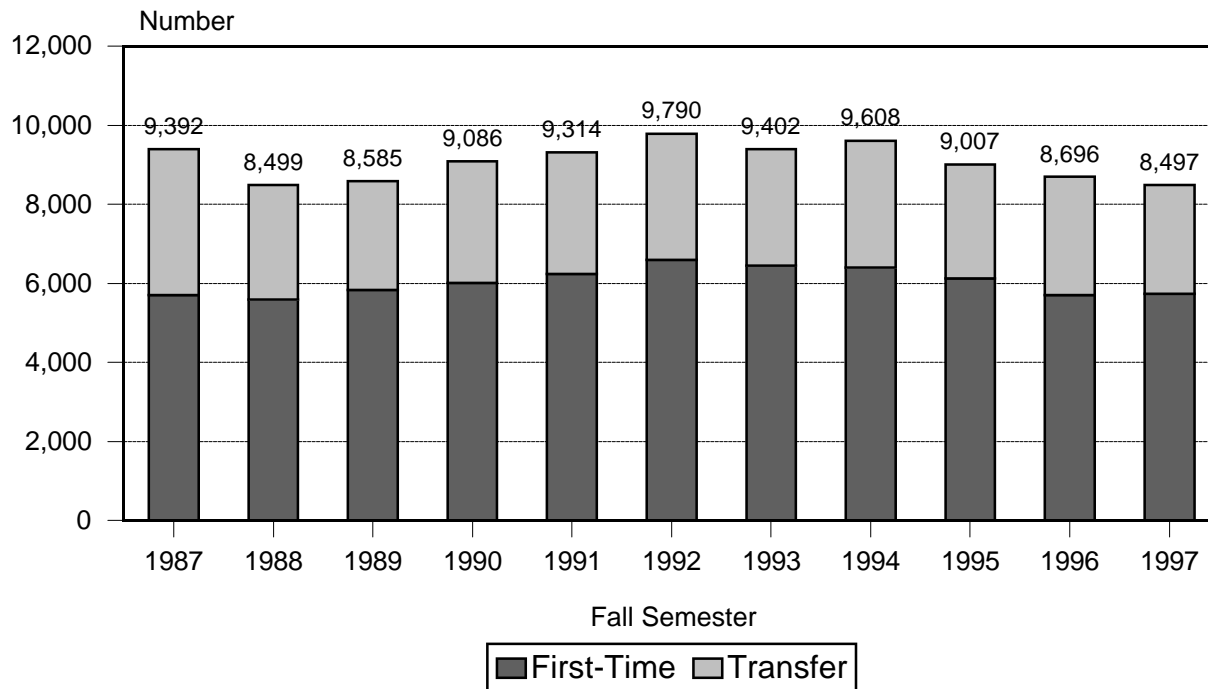

Enrollment of Entering Students

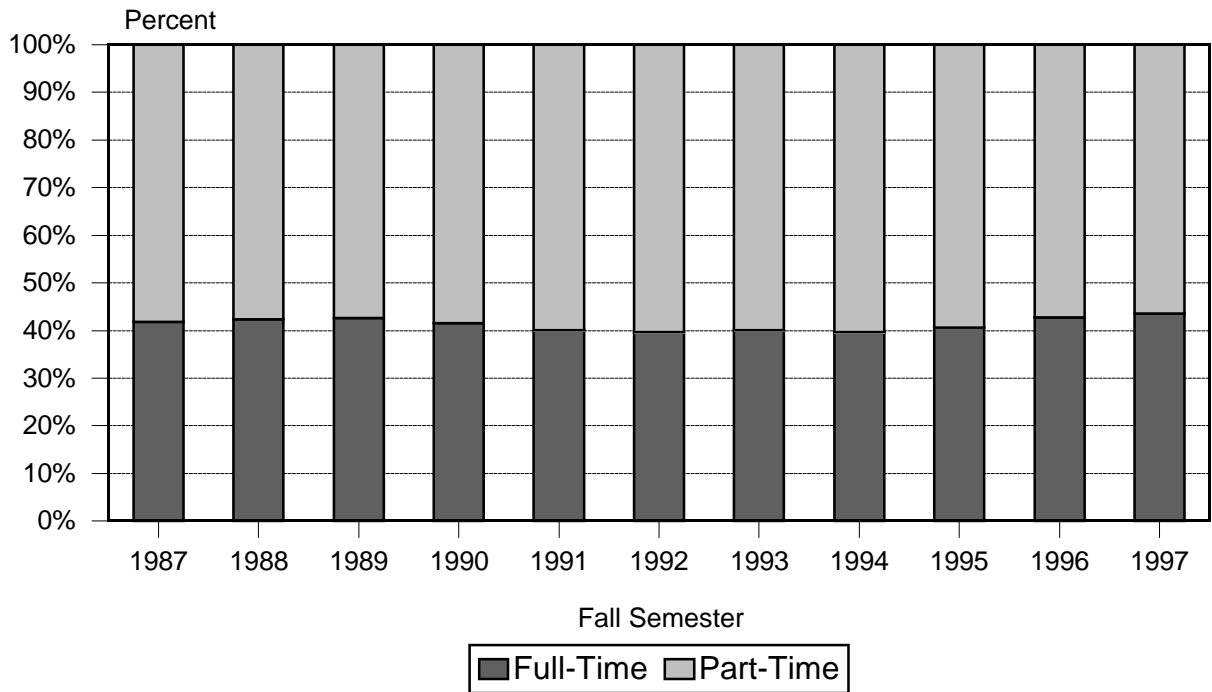

Mean Age

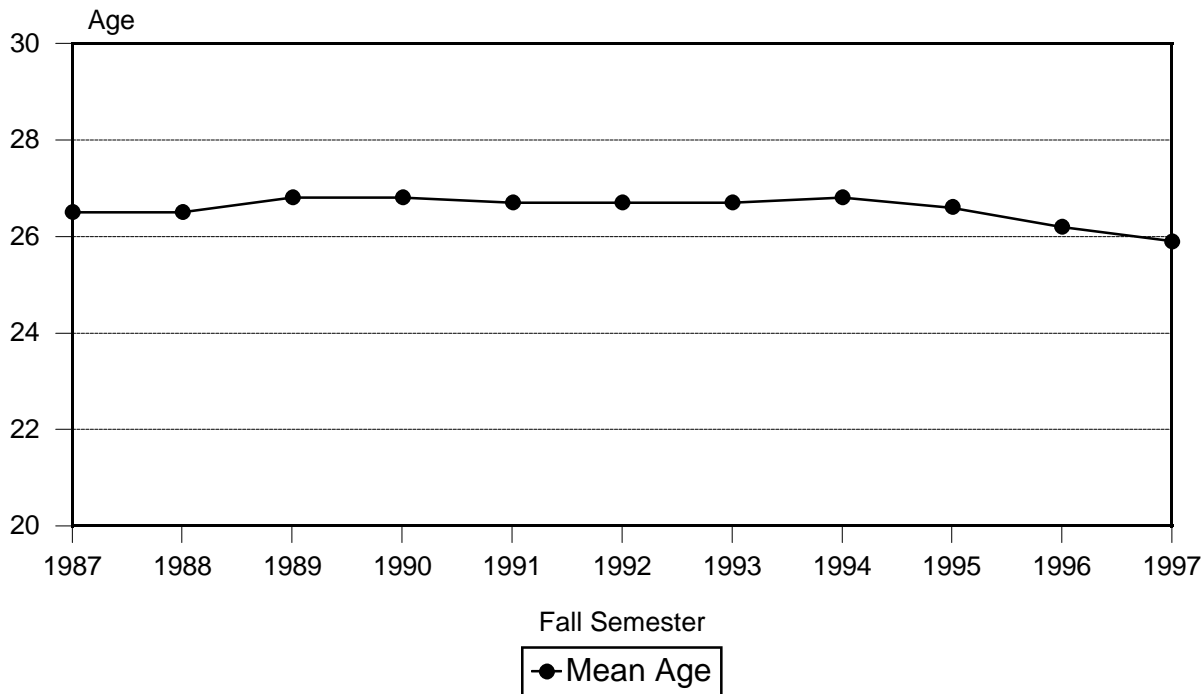

Enrollment by Ethnicity

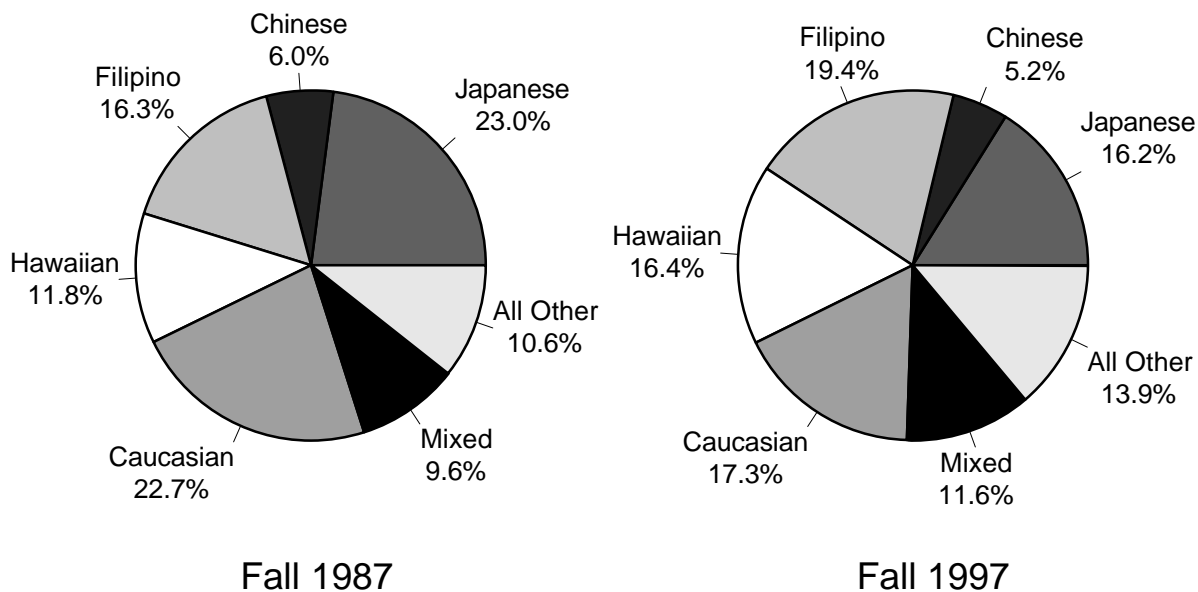
