Headcount and FTE Enrollment

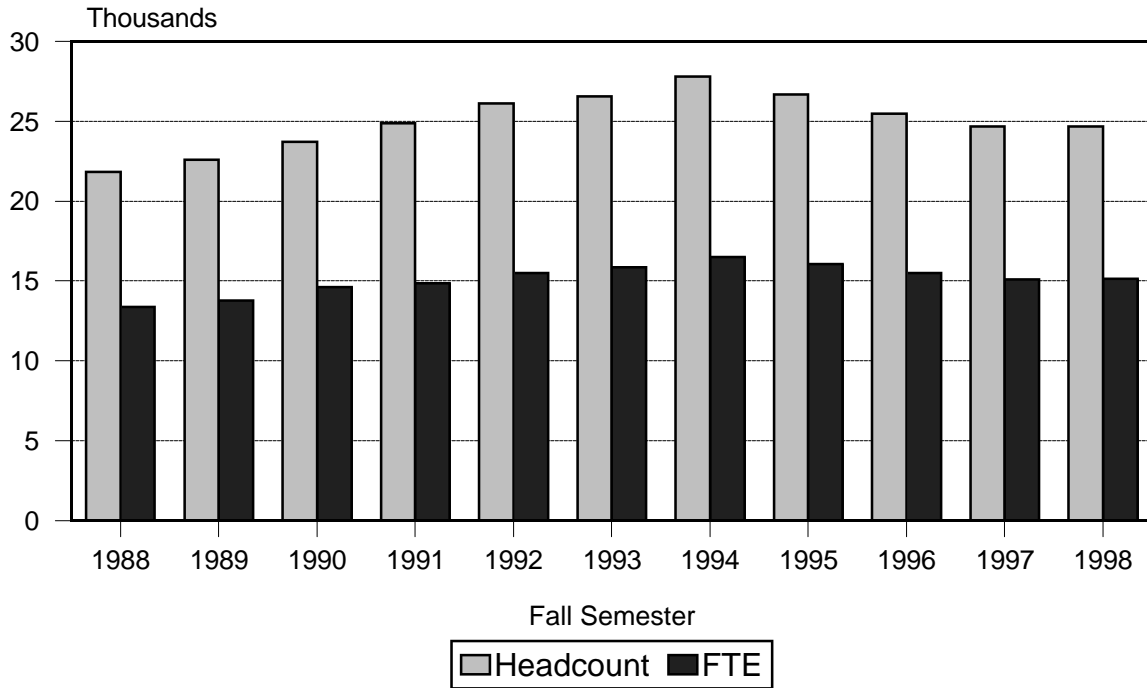
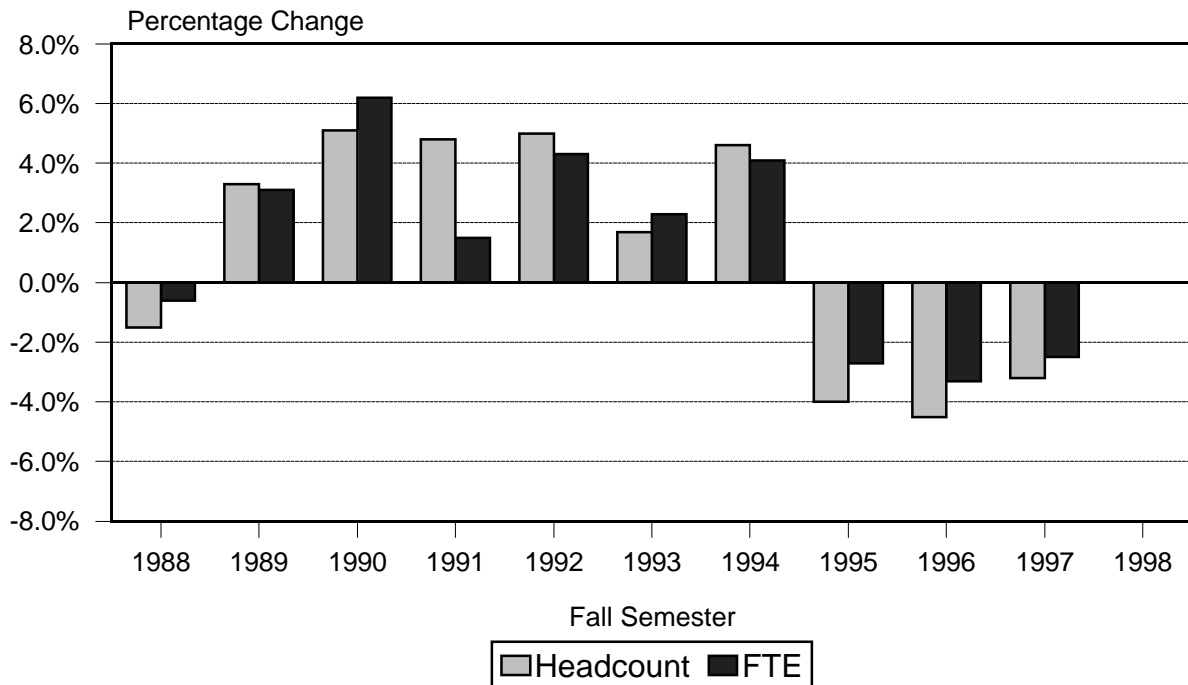

Percentage Change in Headcount and FTE

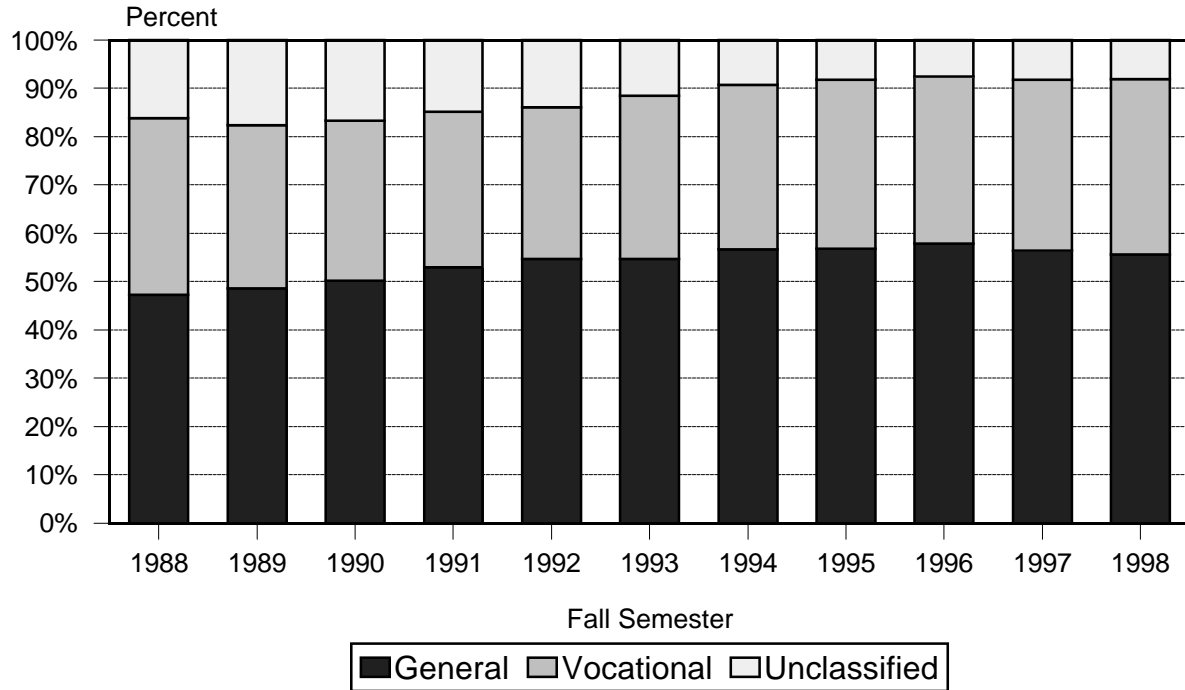

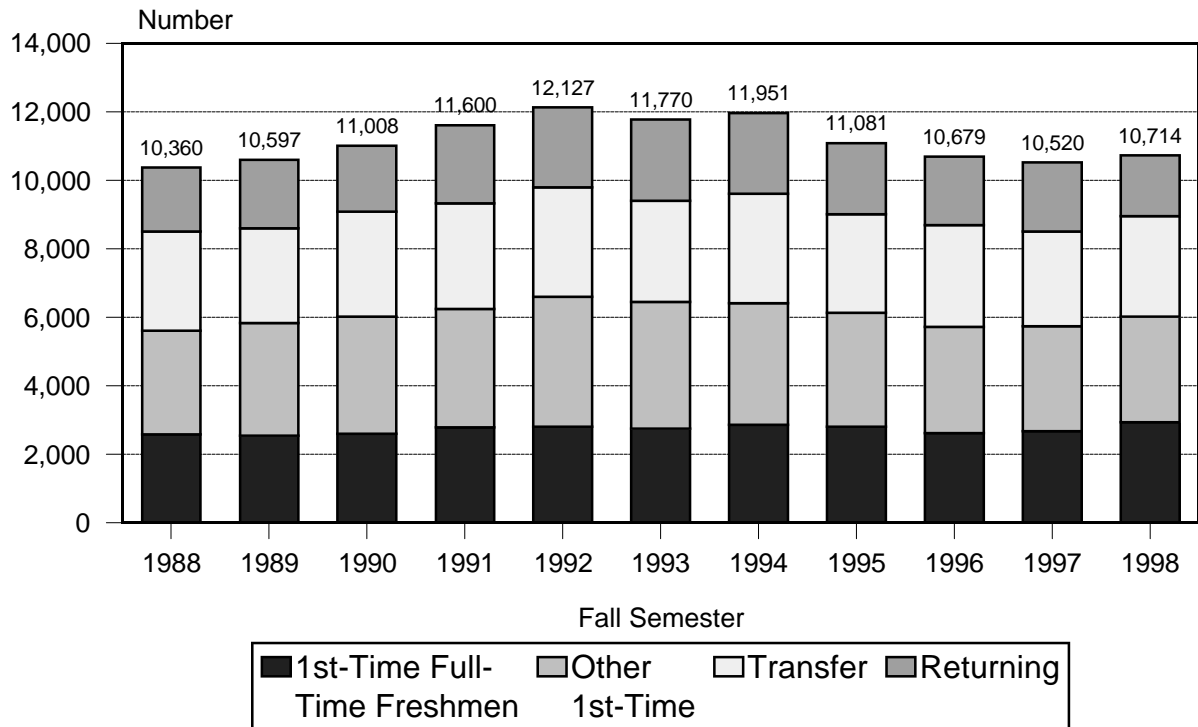

Enrollment by Gender

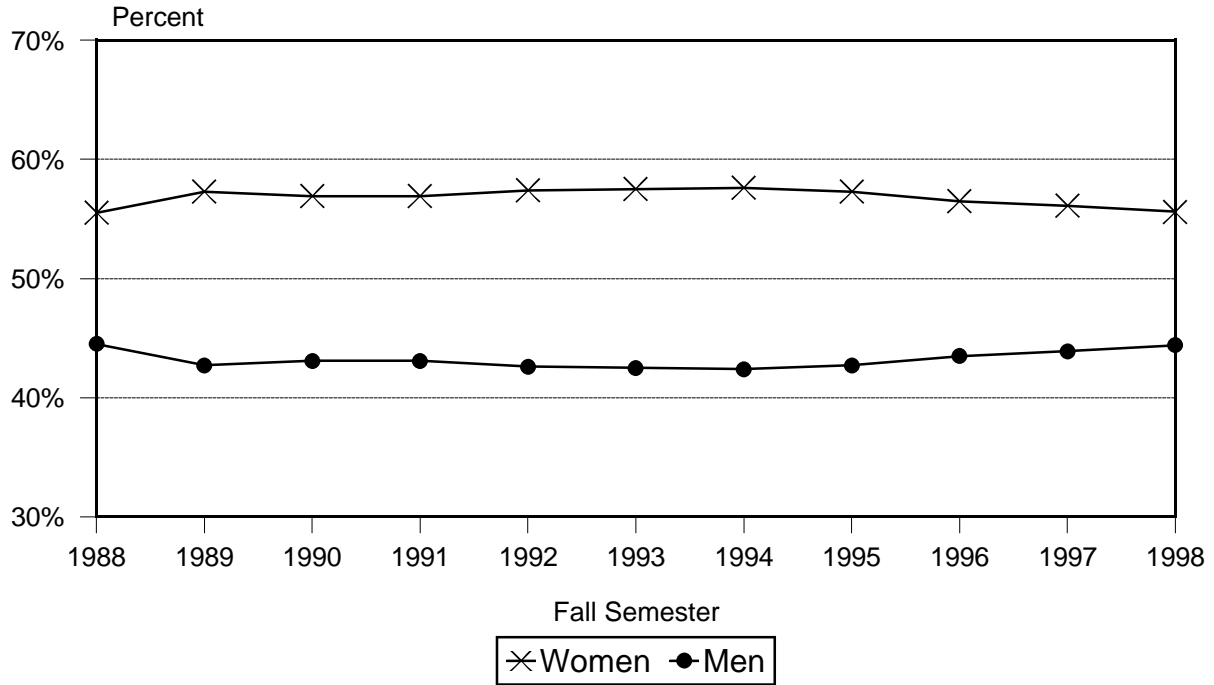
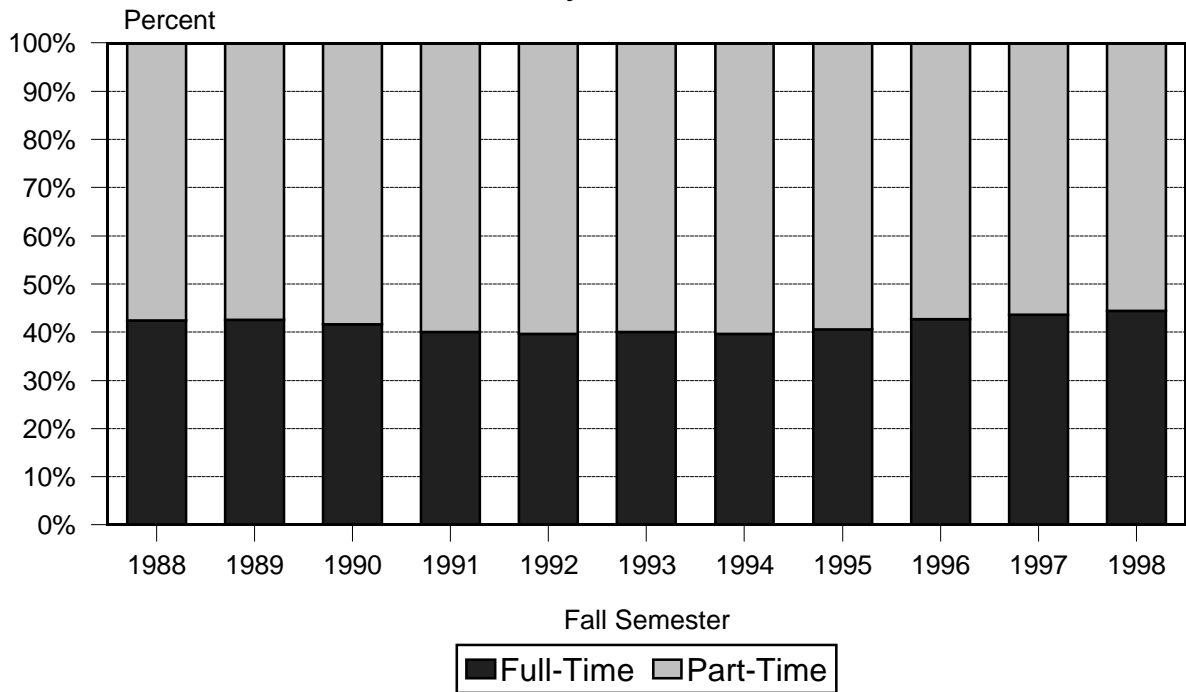

Mean Age

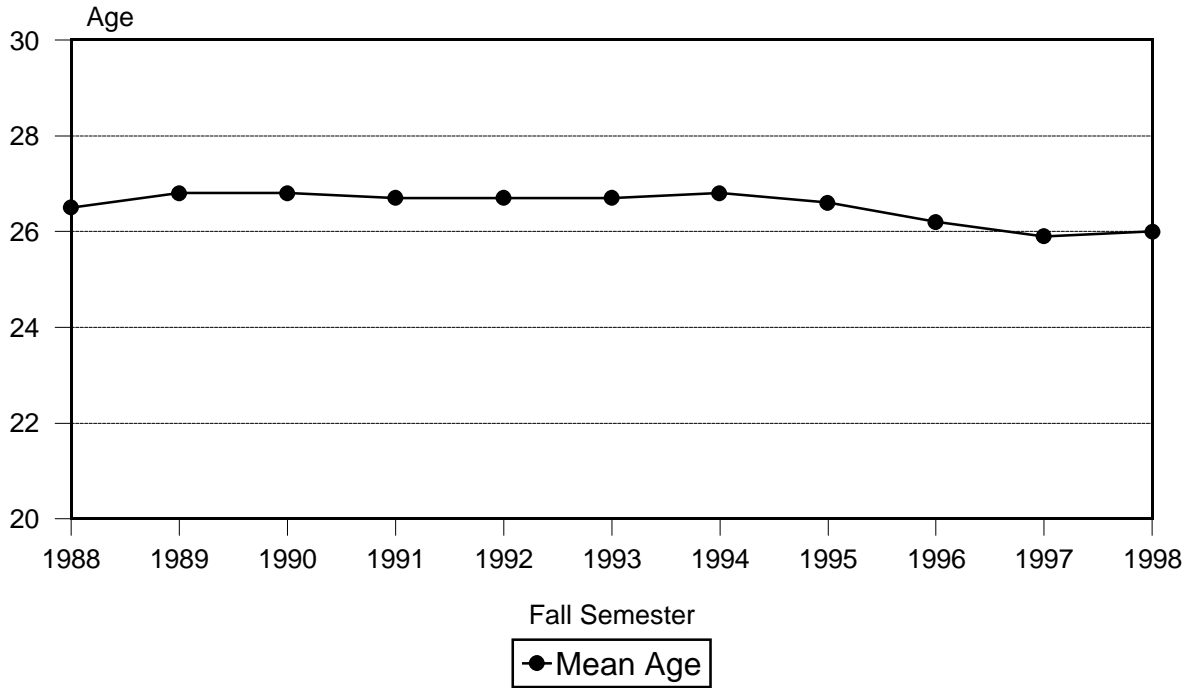

Enrollment by Ethnicity

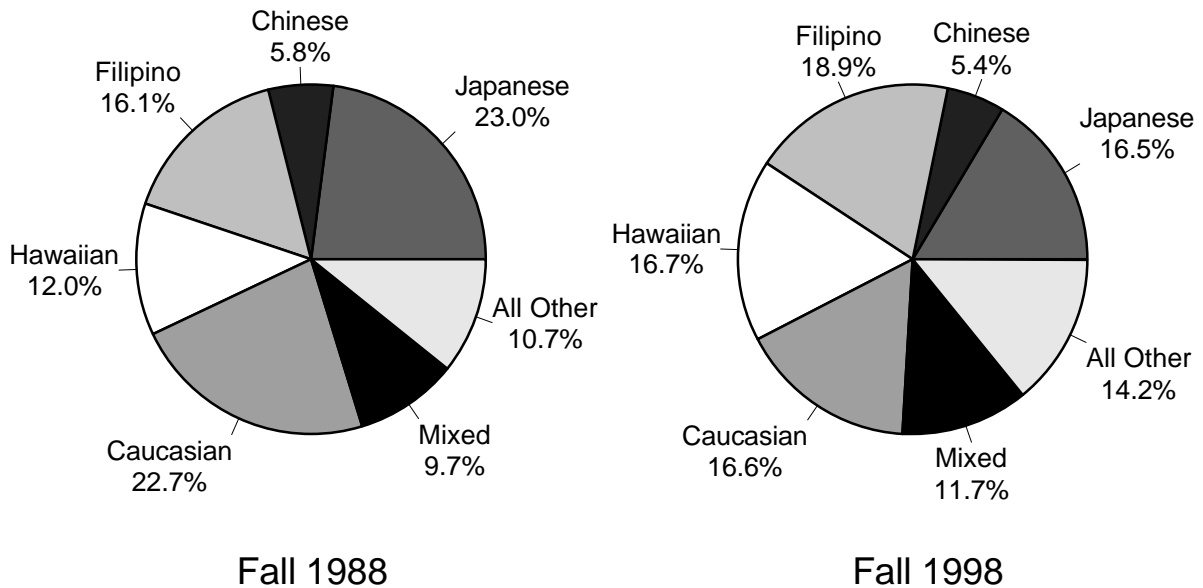
