Headcount and FTE Enrollment

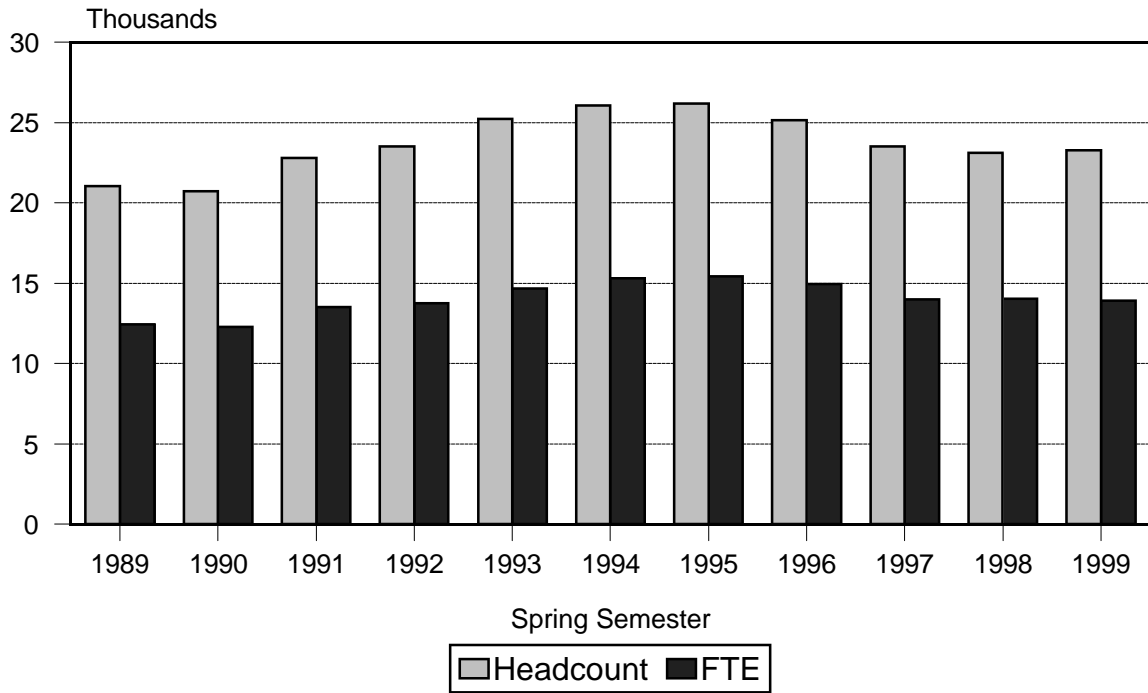
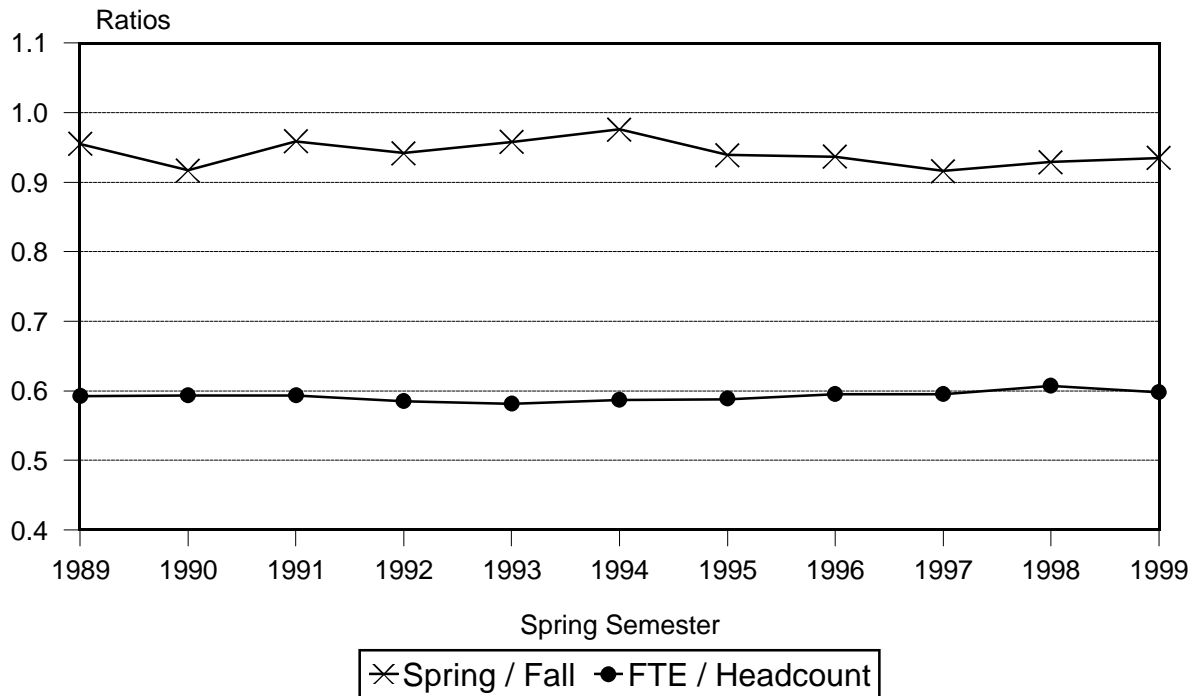

Enrollment by Program

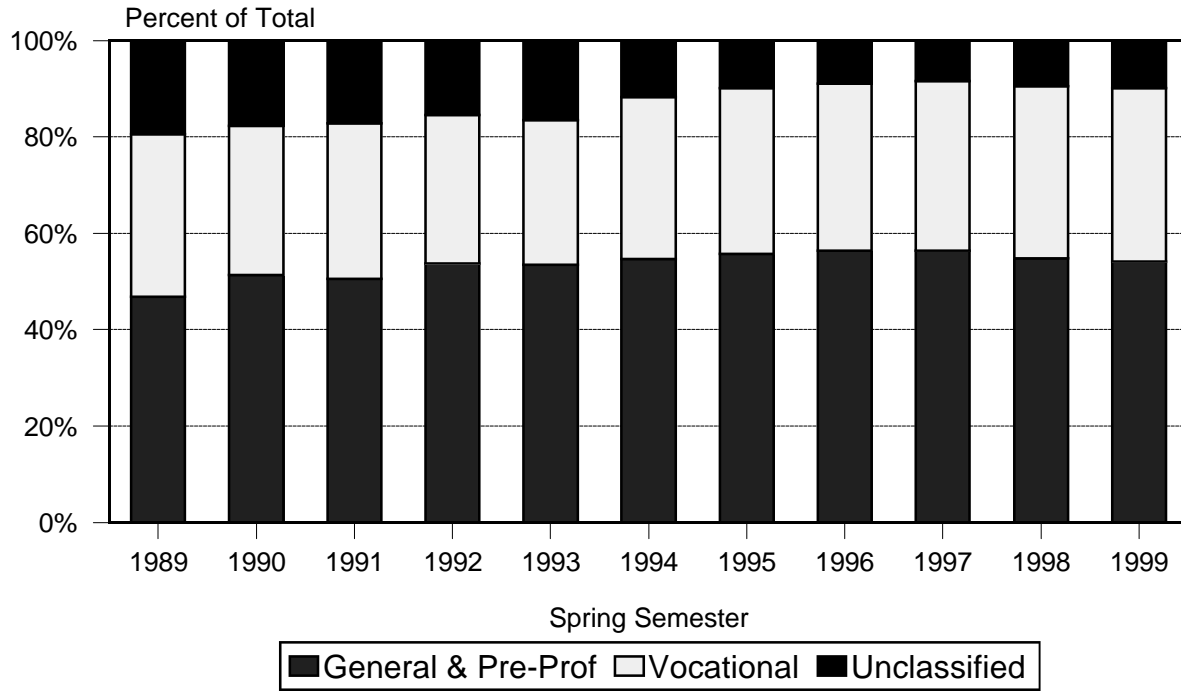
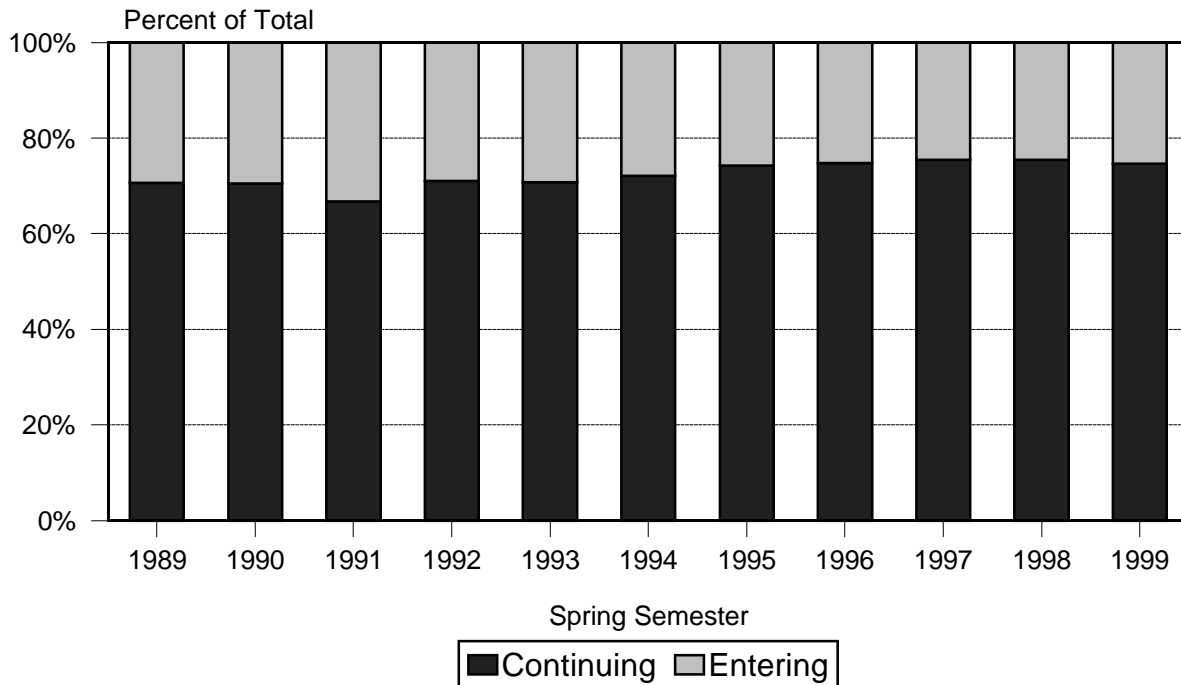

Enrollment by Gender

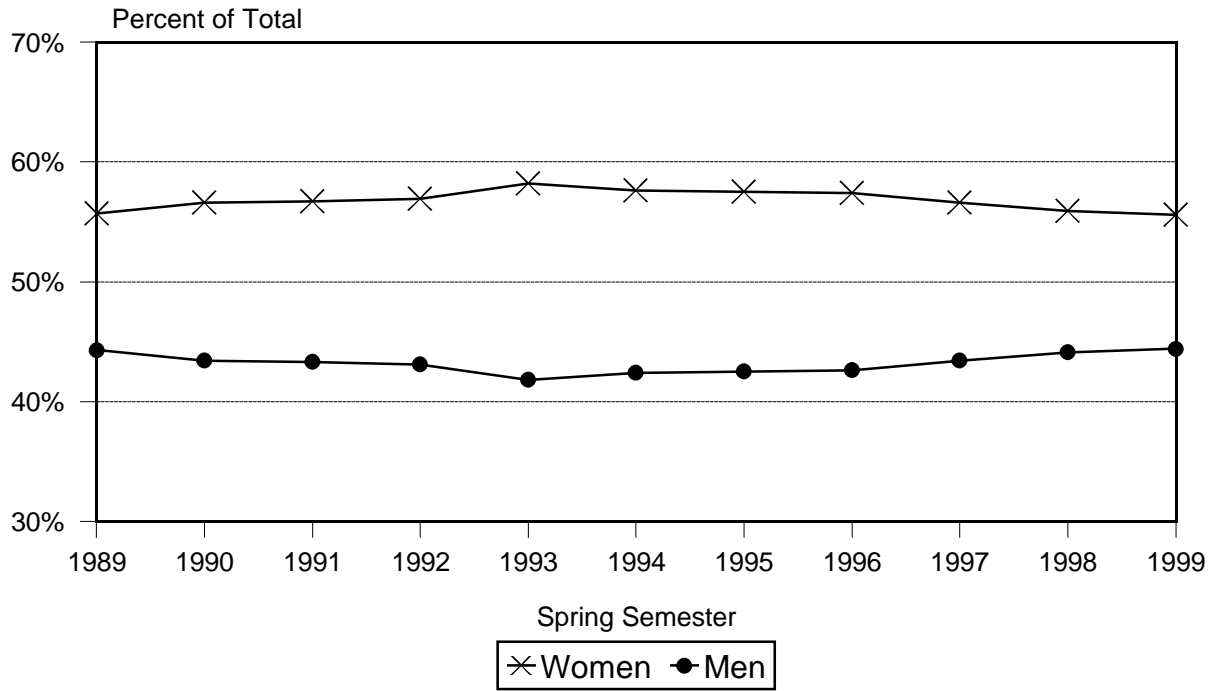
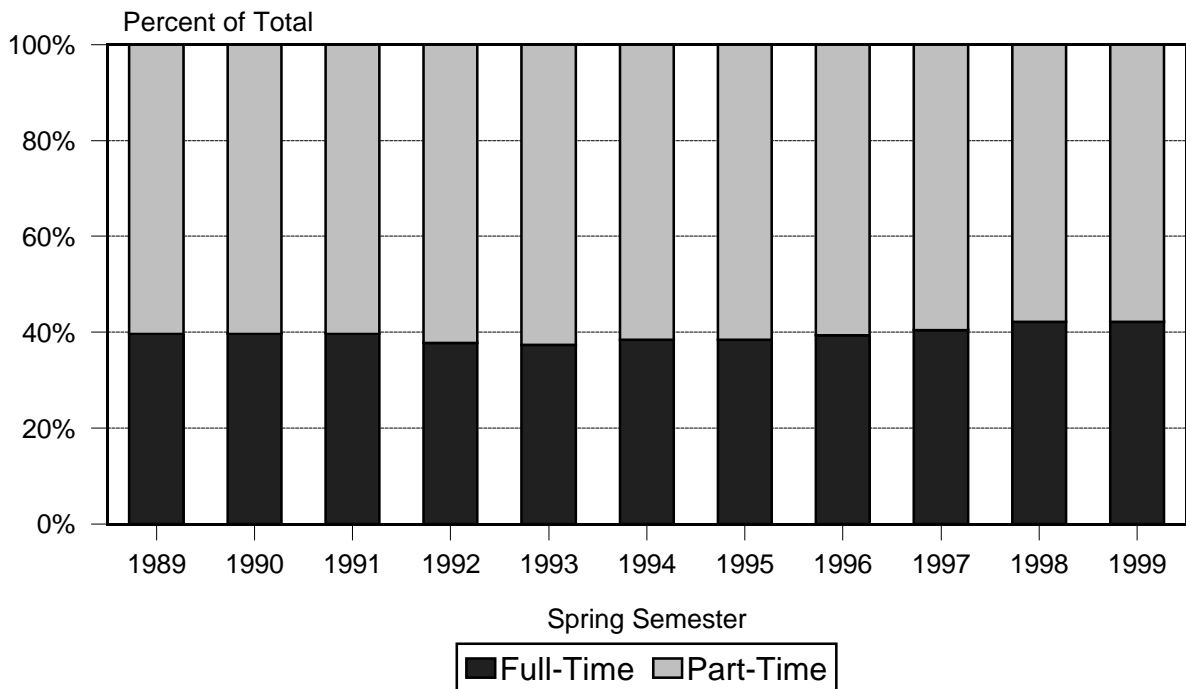

Mean Age

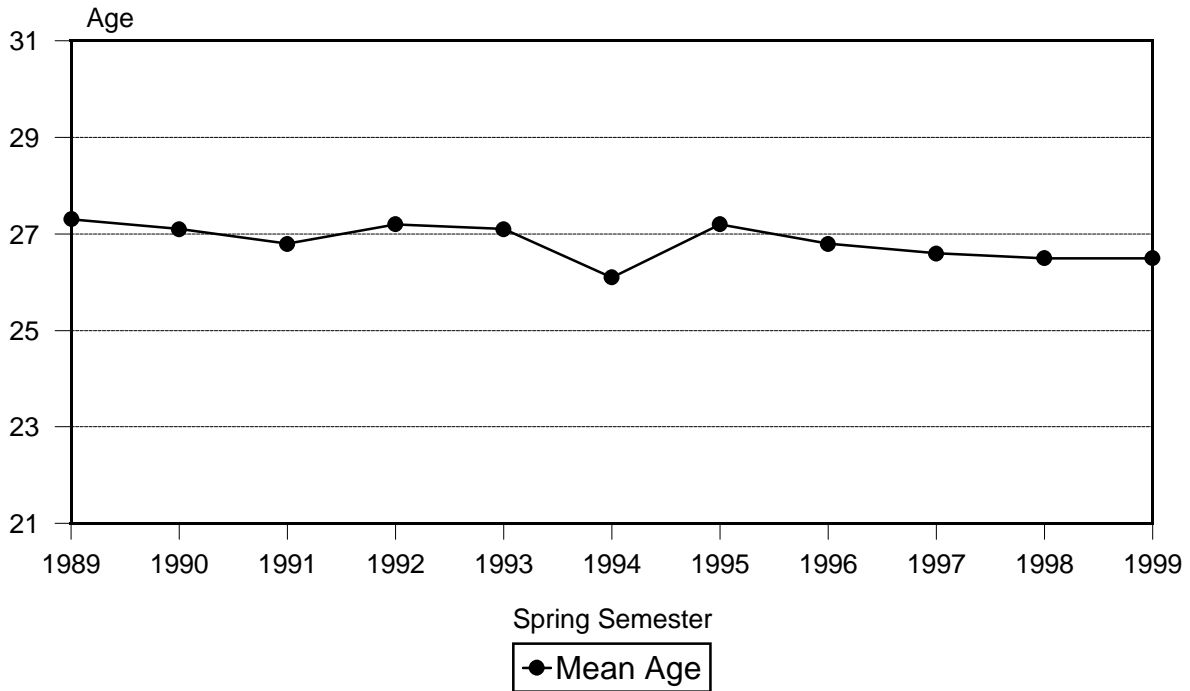

Enrollment by Ethnicity

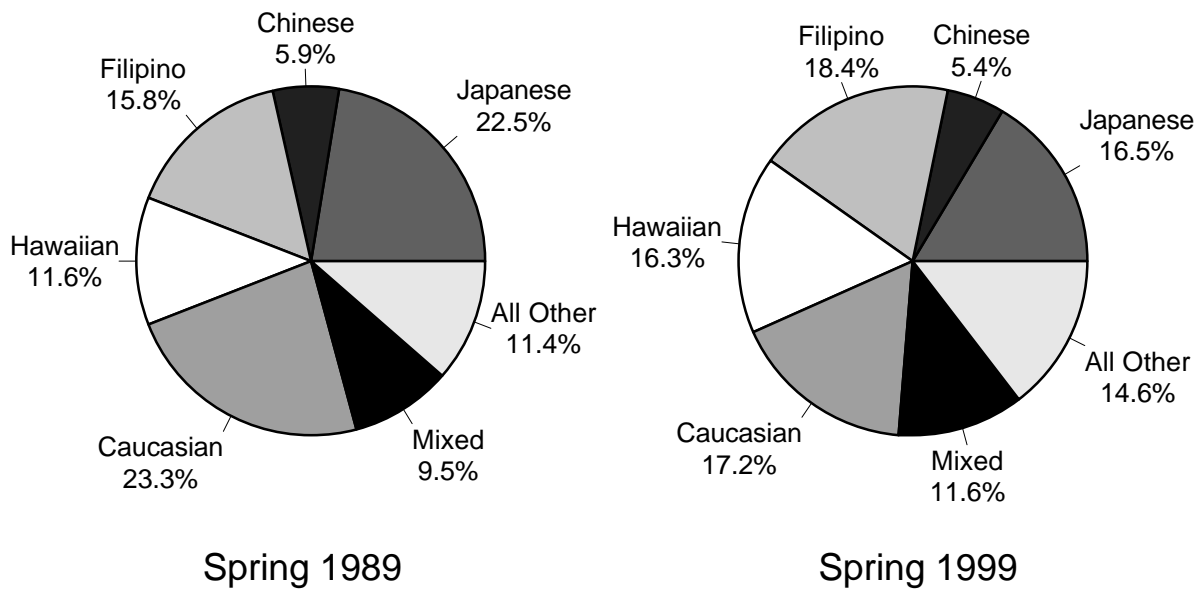
