Headcount and FTE Enrollment

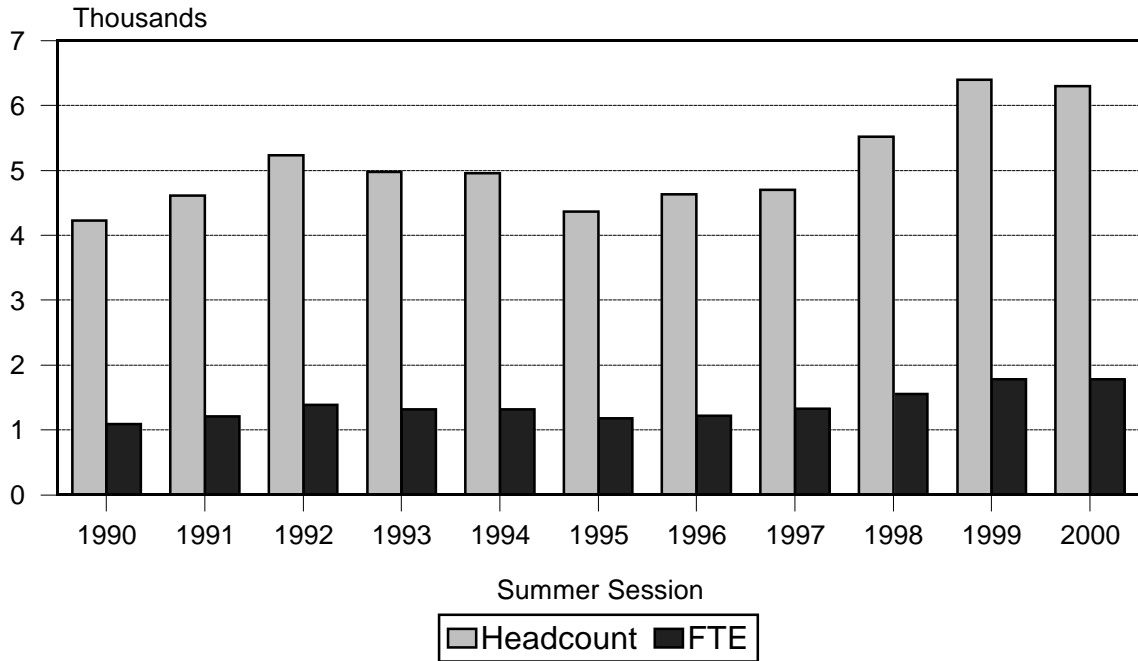
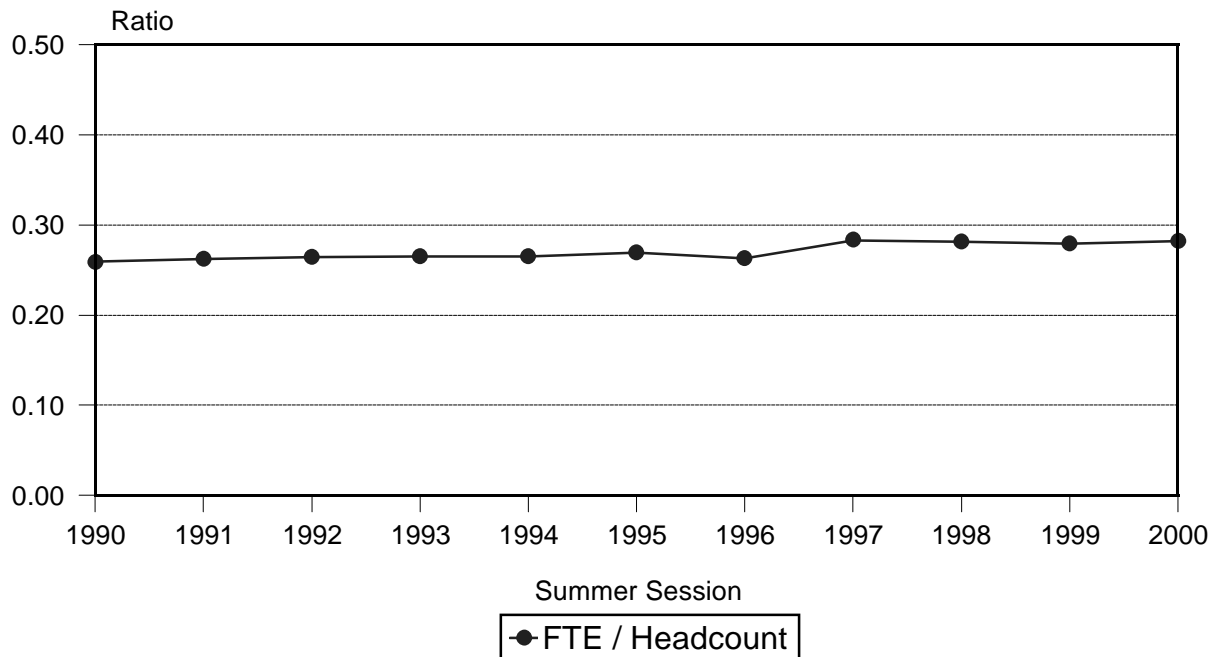
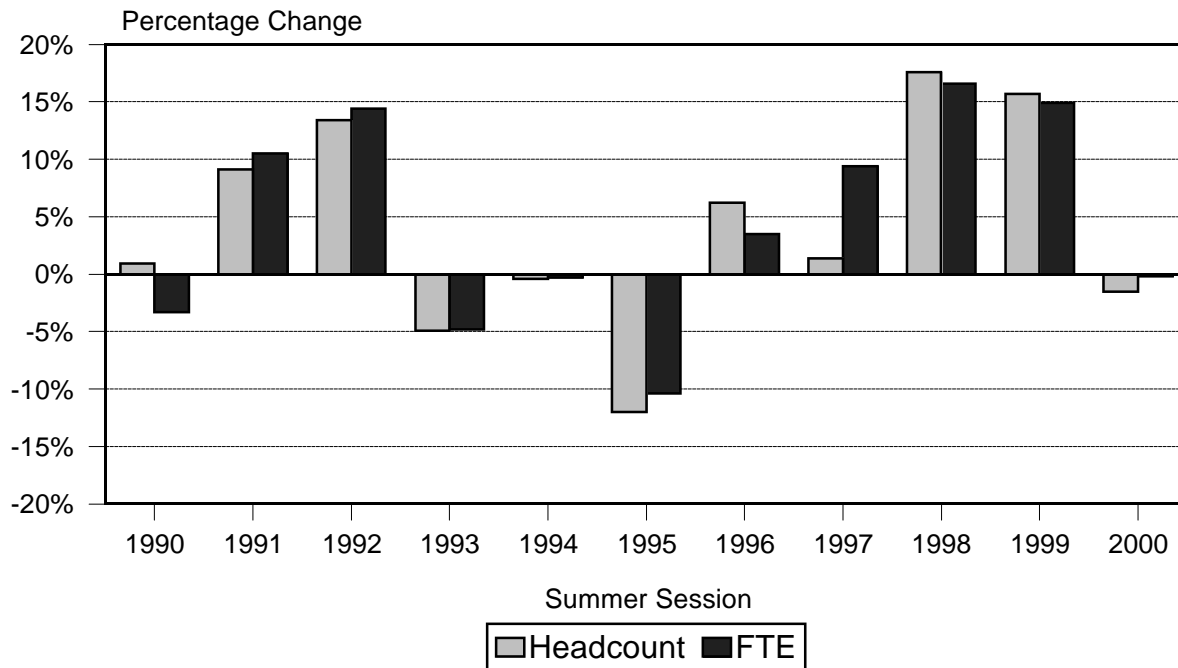

FTE / Headcount Ratio



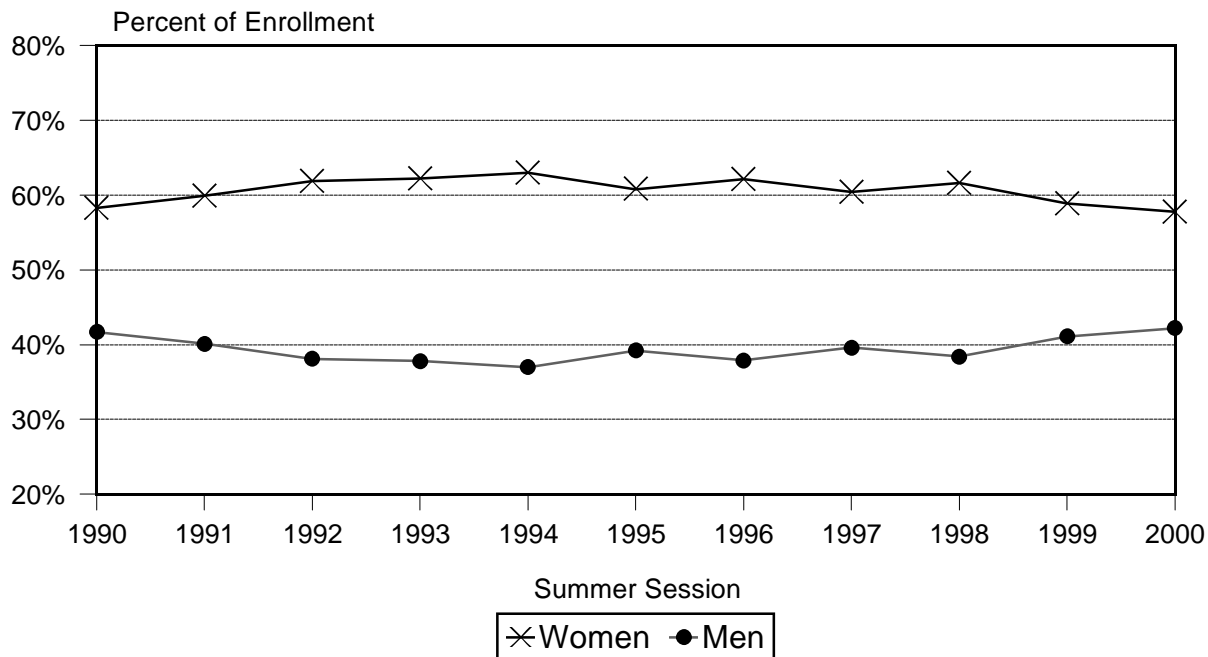

Mean Age

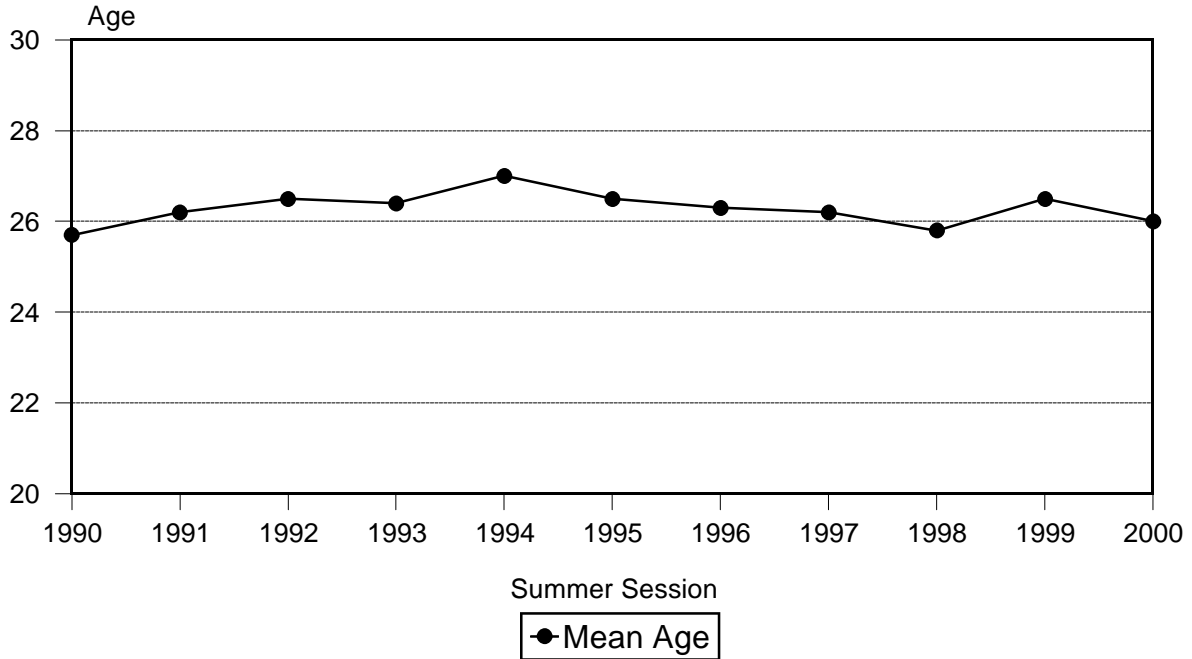
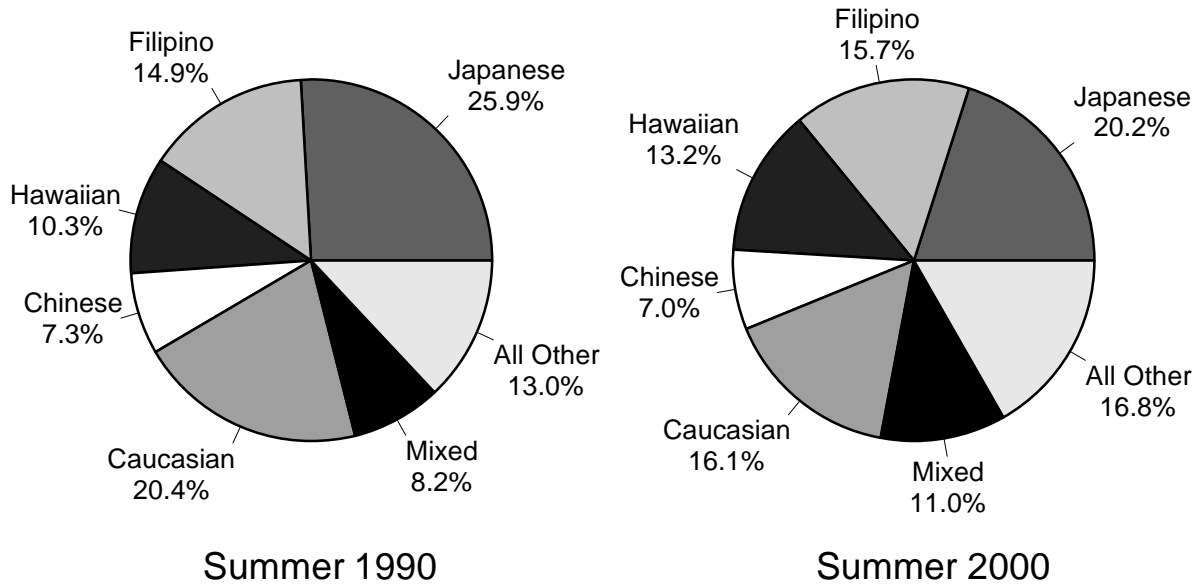
