THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I AT MANOA HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT, FALL 2001

Headcount enrollment at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa measured 17,532 for Fall 2001, an increase of 1.6% over the previous fall semester (Table 2 and Figures 1 & 2). Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment was up 2.9%, to 13,936 (Table 3). This growth ends a six-year period of enrollment decline, and is the first increase in both headcount and FTE enrollment since Fall 1993.

Enrollment in the College of Arts and Sciences increased 2.3% in Fall 2001, with the largest gain in Other Arts & Sciences, at 7.5% (Table 4). Travel Industry Management posted the largest percentage gain of any college, at 16.4%, while enrollment in Medicine rose 13.9% (excluding the addition of Public Health, Medicine was up 6.0%). Ocean and Earth Sciences (SOEST) was up 7.4%, while Nursing increased 4.3%. Social Work declined 7.6%, while Hawaiian and Pacific Studies (SHAPS) was down 5.3%. Most other colleges and schools posted modest gains. Unclassified enrollment was down 4.3%.

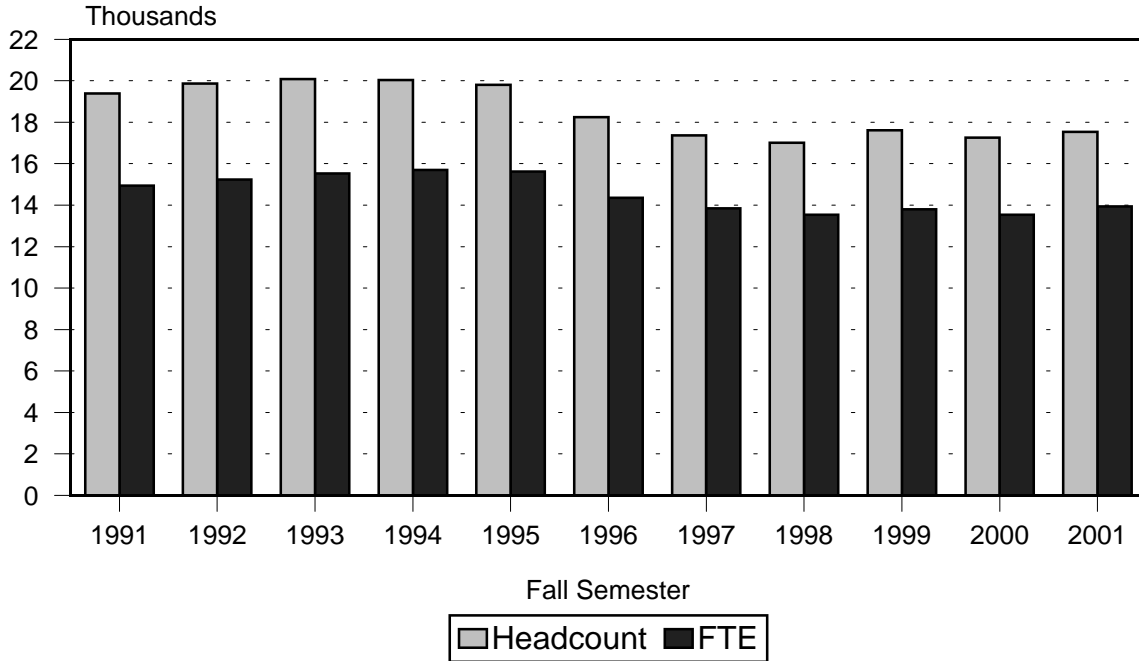
Freshmen enrollment measured 2,142 in Fall 2001, the highest level since Fall 1995, while First-Professional enrollment reached 500, the highest level since Fall 1982. Freshmen, Sophomore and Junior enrollment each grew by over 6%, while overall Classified Undergraduate enrollment was up 3.0% (Table 4). Senior enrollment declined slightly, while Unclassified Undergraduate enrollment was down 5.8%. First-Professional enrollment increased 3.1% in Fall 2001, while Doctoral enrollment grew 1.0%. While Master enrollment declined very slightly, Post-Baccalaureate and Graduate Special / Certificate enrollment continued their long-term decline, each off by 30% or more from a year ago. Unclassified Graduate enrollment was down 3.4% from Fall 2000.

Other trends of note include:

- Western undergraduate exchange students (Tuition Status) posted strong growth, reaching 743 in Fall 2001, a 45.1% one-year increase. In Fall 1997, WUE student enrollment measured just 30 students (Table 4).
- Foreign enrollment appears to be rebounding, measuring 7.0% of total enrollment for Fall 2001 by Permanent Home Address and 9.1% by Visa Status. These are the highest levels in these measures since the early 1990s.
- Entering undergraduate student enrollment increased by 8.0% in Fall 2001, to 3,946, the highest level since Fall 1995 (Figure 3). Most notably, the number of transfer students increased by over 17% from a year ago. First-Time freshmen were up 2.7%, while returning students increased 16.5%.
- Transfer enrollment growth occurred primarily among students from Non-UH campuses, which increased by over 20% from a year ago. Recent growth in transfer students has been concentrated among those from the U.S mainland (Figure 4).
- The ethnic makeup of the student body continues to diversify. Pacific Islanders grew by 24.6% in Fall 2001, while Hispanic students were up 19%. Both groups have now reached all-time highs.

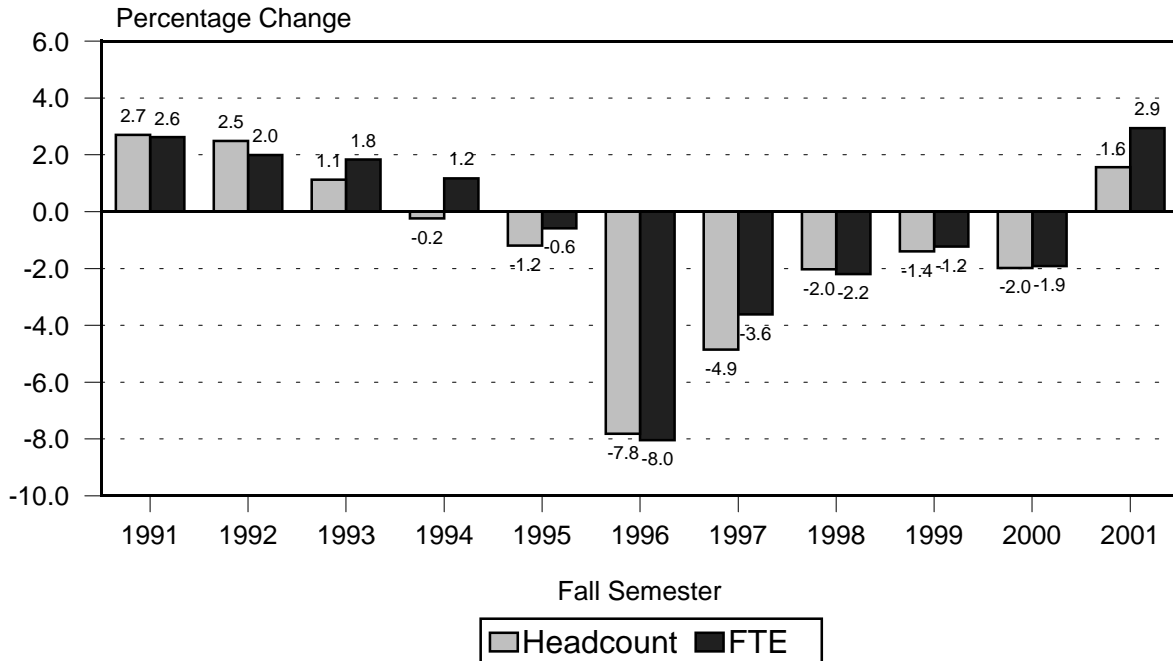

Number of Entering Undergraduate Students

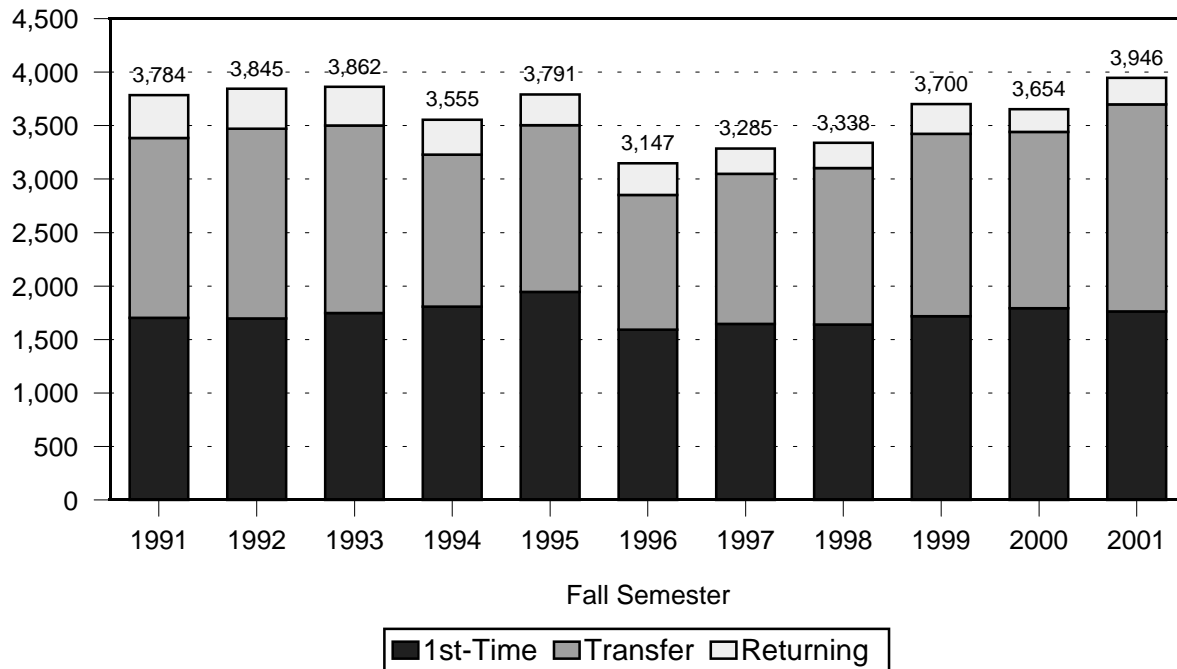
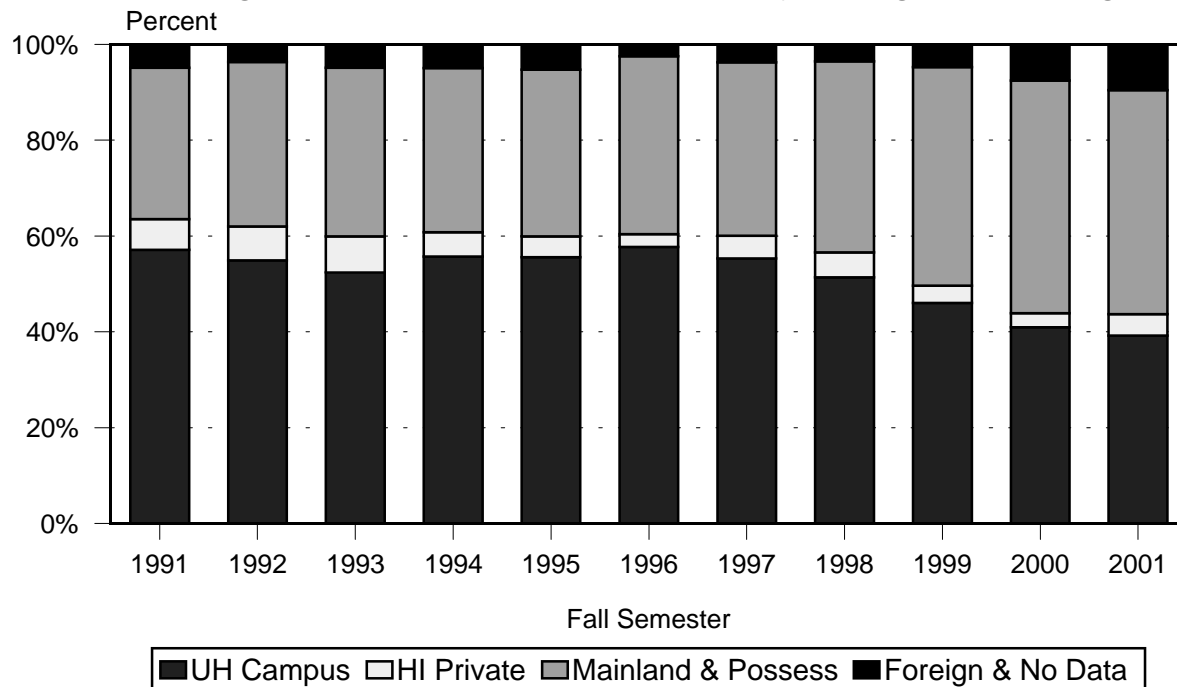
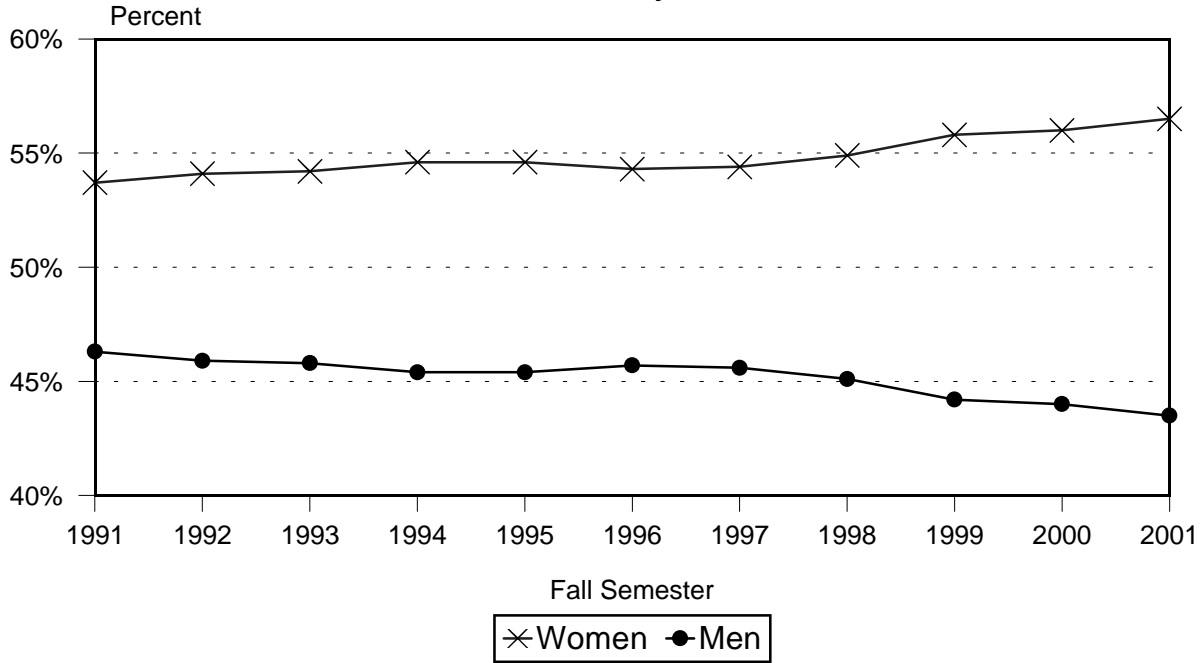

Undergraduate Transfer Students by Geographic Origin



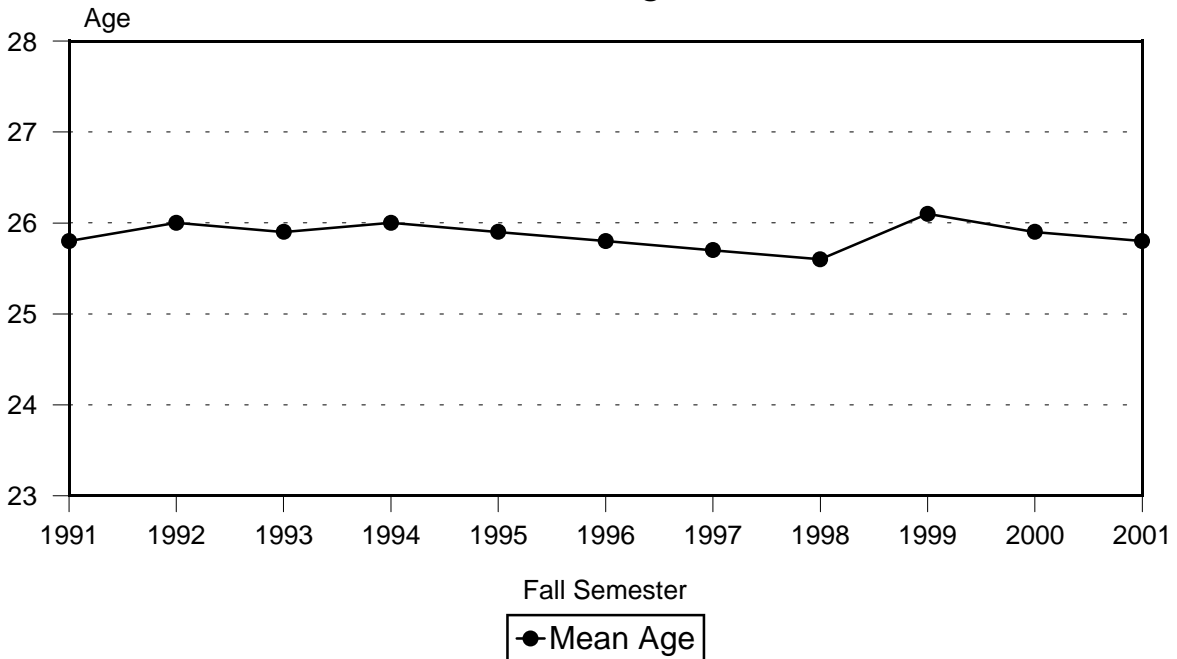

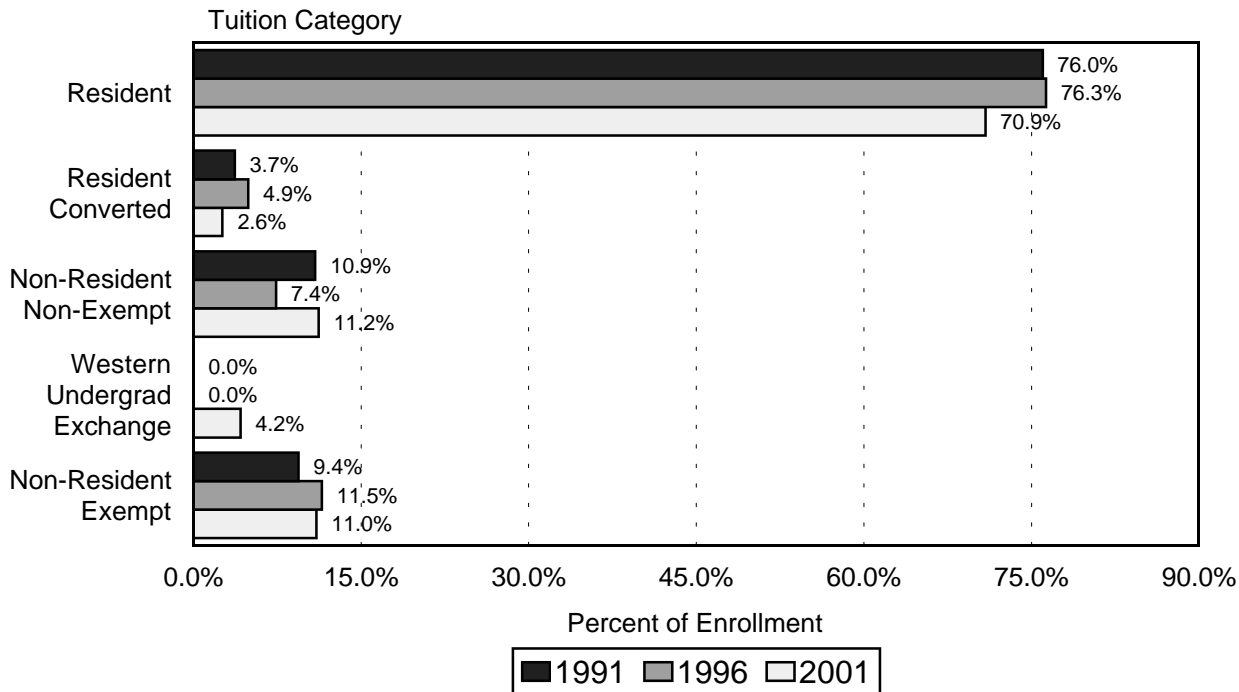
Figure 6

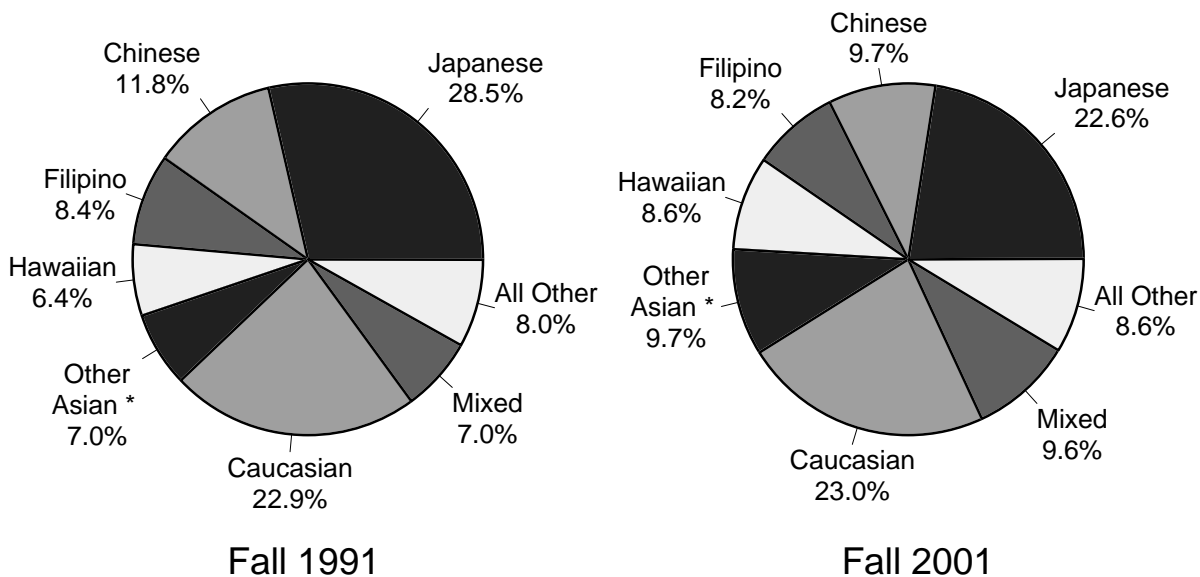

Note: Western Undergraduate Exchange tuition category added in Fall 1997.

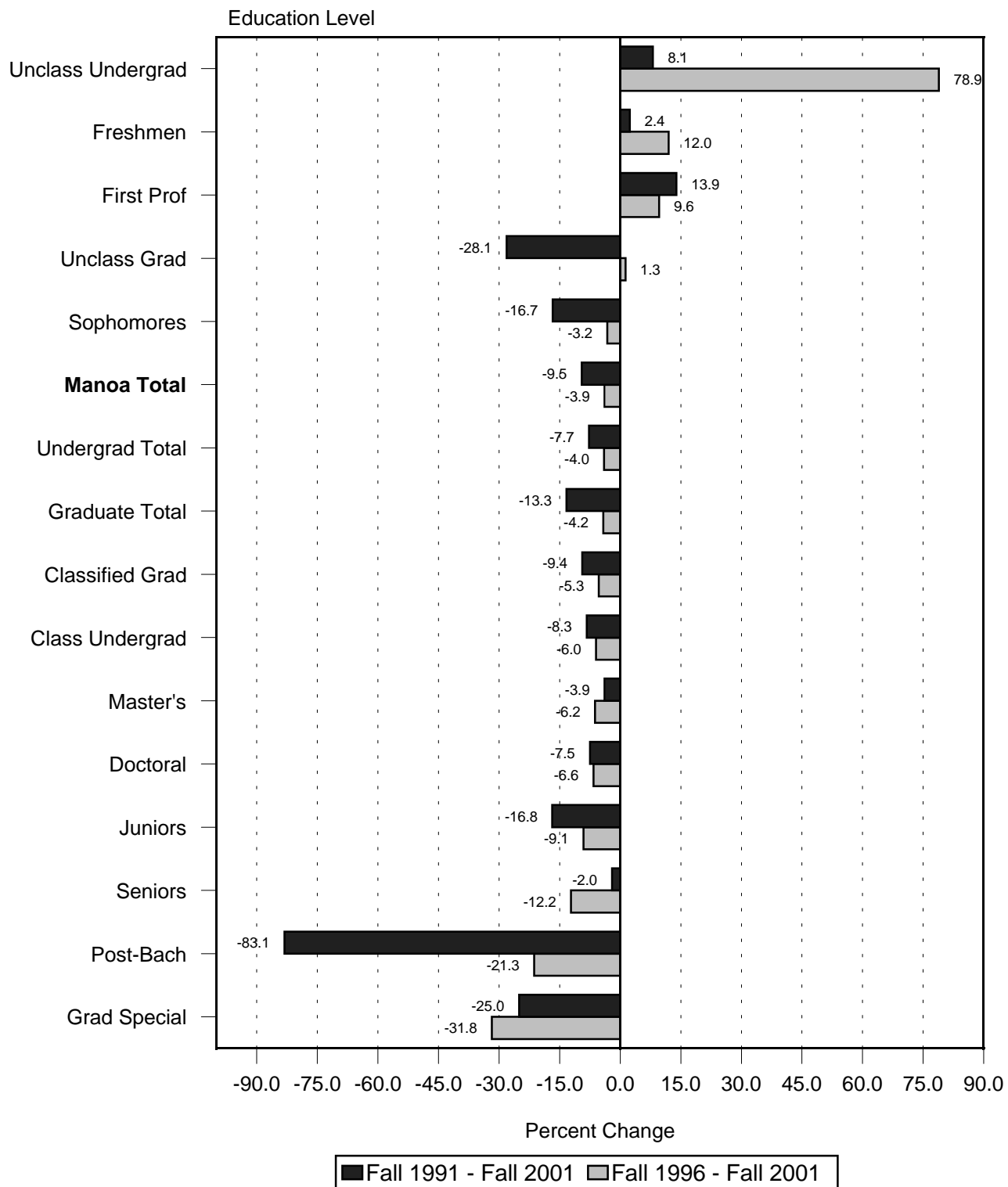

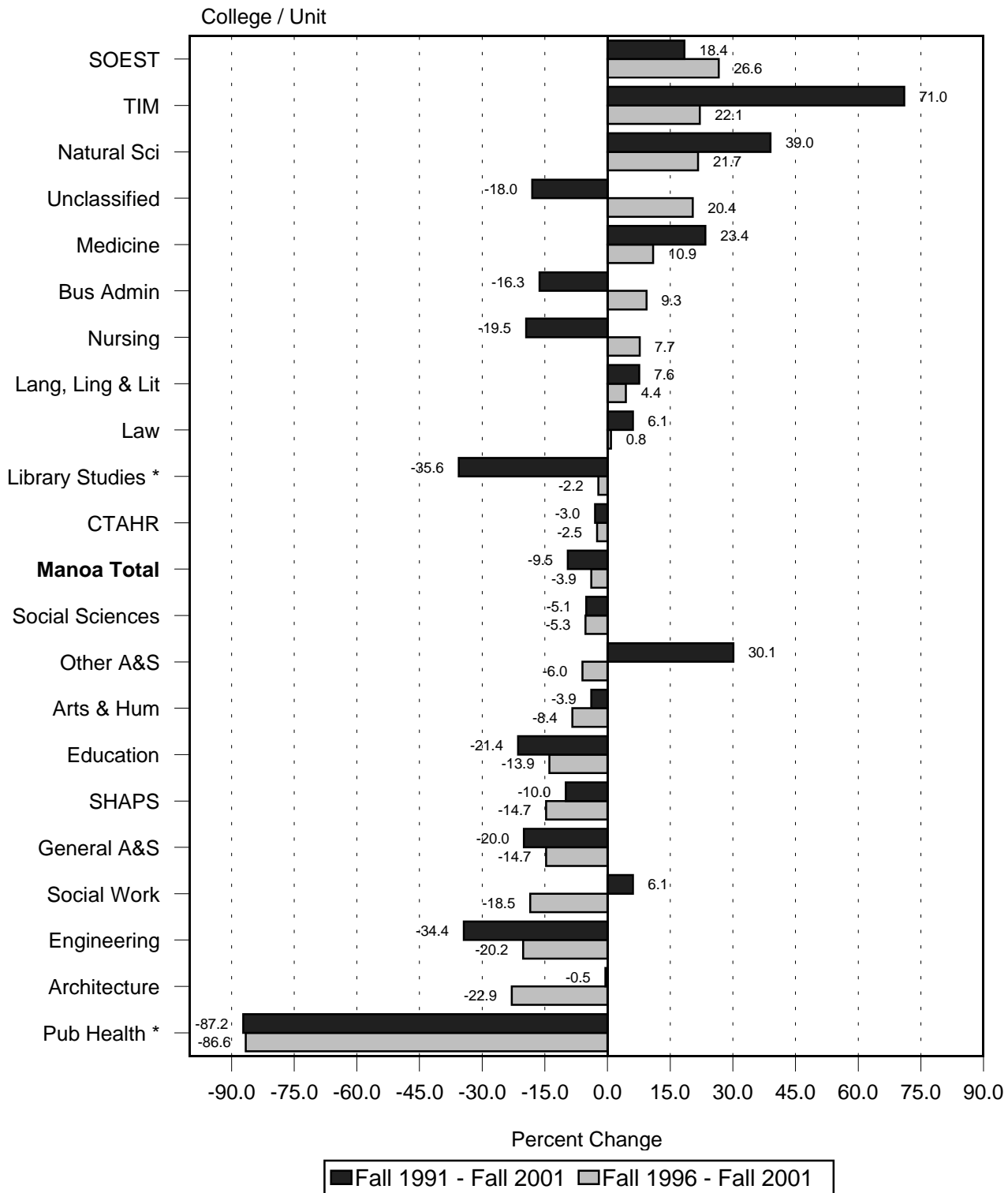
