THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT M NOA HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT, FALL 2005

Headcount enrollment at the University of Hawaii at M noa measured 20,644 for Fall 2005, a slight increase over Fall 2004 (Table 2 and Figures 1 & 2). Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment increased 1.2%, to 16,575 (Table 3). Fall semester enrollment has increased for five consecutive fall semesters and has grown 19.6% since Fall 2000.

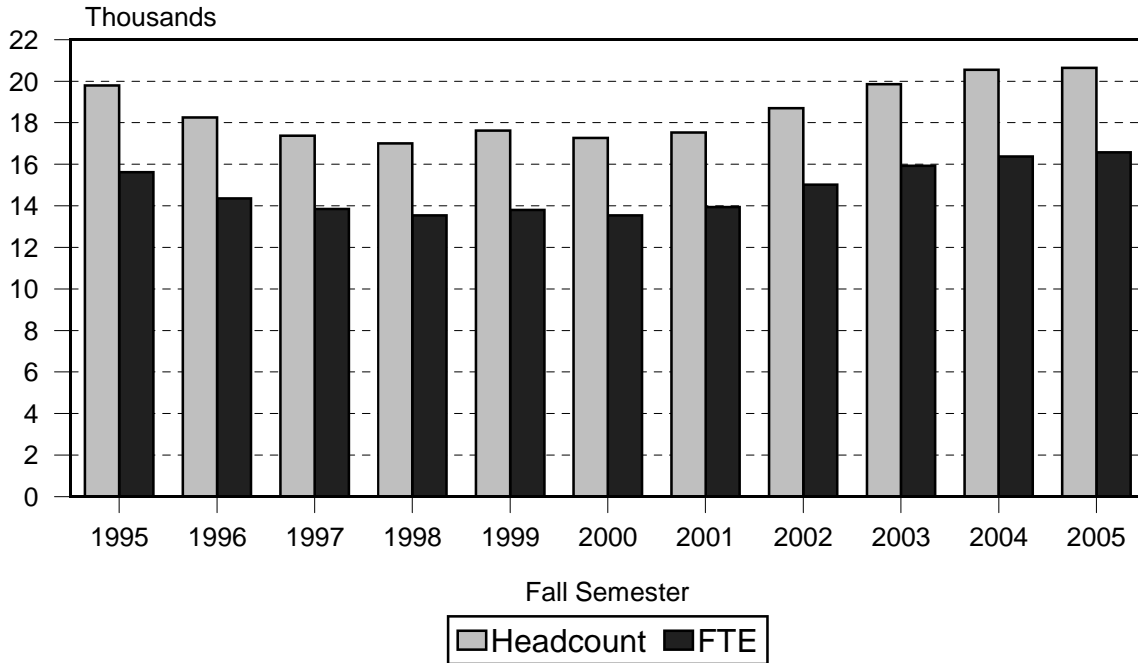
In Fall 2003, the UH four-year campuses migrated to a new student registration system. In Fall 2005, the University of Hawaii's Institutional Research Office completed development of the IRO Base table. Breakouts for certain items in the report tables, such as citizenship and local address have changed. The Hawaiian Ancestry measure is new. Data for certain other items may show discontinuities due to changes in data processing. The reader is advised to exercise caution when examining trends or percentage data over time.

Other Fall 2005 enrollment highlights:

- ! Since Fall 2002, the rate of enrollment growth has slowed (Figure 2). Further enrollment growth may be undesirable, or may be constrained by resource limitations, such as in housing and parking. Policy issues, such as limits on the percentage of non-resident students, may require attention.
- ! Enrollment of non-resident students has increased dramatically in recent years (Table 5 & Figure 6). Since Fall 2000, non-resident students paying out-of-state tuition have increased 78%, while enrollment via the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program has surged by over 200%. Enrollment of non-resident students of all types (including exempted) measured 7,007 in Fall 2005, or 33.9% of total campus enrollment.
- ! Entering undergraduate enrollment measured 4,534 in Fall 2005, a 2.8% decline from Fall 2004 (Table 5 & Figure 7). First-Time freshmen enrollment grew slightly to 2,021, while transfers were down 7.2%. Returning students were slightly higher. Due to data processing irregularities, previous college was not identifiable for undergraduate transfers in Fall 2005.
- ! The Hawaiian Ancestry characteristic is a new item, beginning in Fall 2005. Students were asked on the application to indicate Hawaiian ancestry. The figures given in Table 4 and Table 5 show the aggregate number of students who indicated "Yes" to Hawaiian ancestry or who either indicated "No" to Hawaiian Ancestry or did not answer the question but selected Hawaiian ethnicity. The total for the campus measured 8.8% of enrollment.
- ! In Fall 2005, the percentage of male students increased slightly, to 43.6% of enrollment (Table 5 & Figure 3). The percentage of students enrolled full-time held steady at 72.8% (Figure 4). The mean age of students declined slightly, to 25.3 years, the lowest mean age in over 10 years (Figure 9). The UH M noa student body is ethnically diverse and continues to diversify (Figure 10).

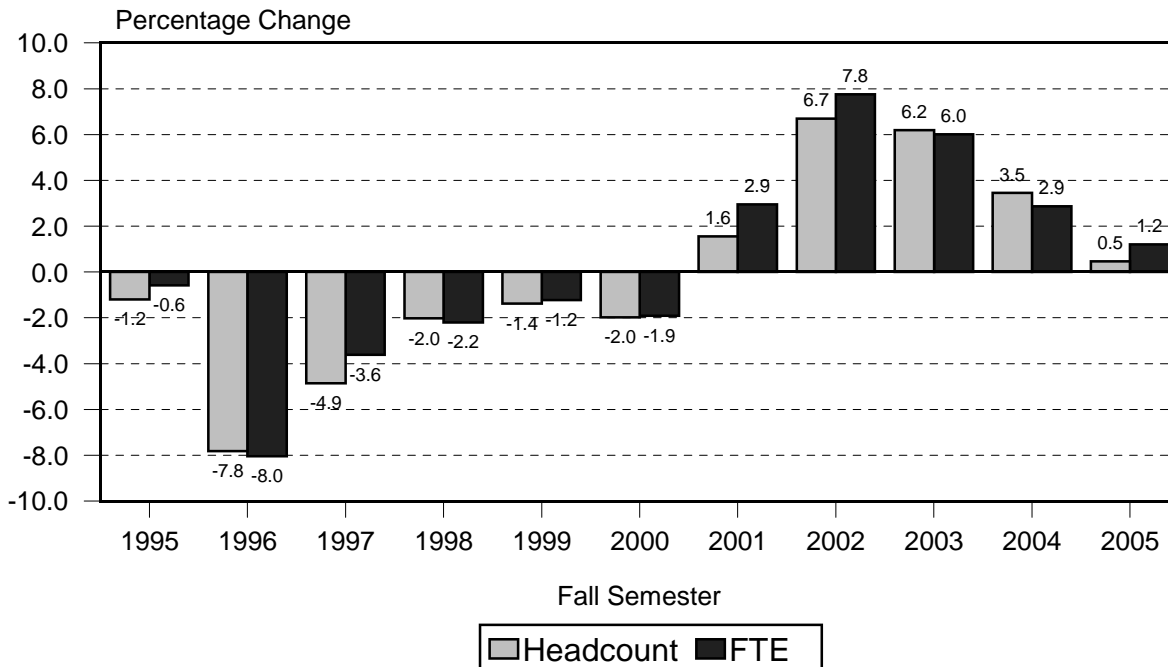

Data include Outreach College, beginning Fall 1999.

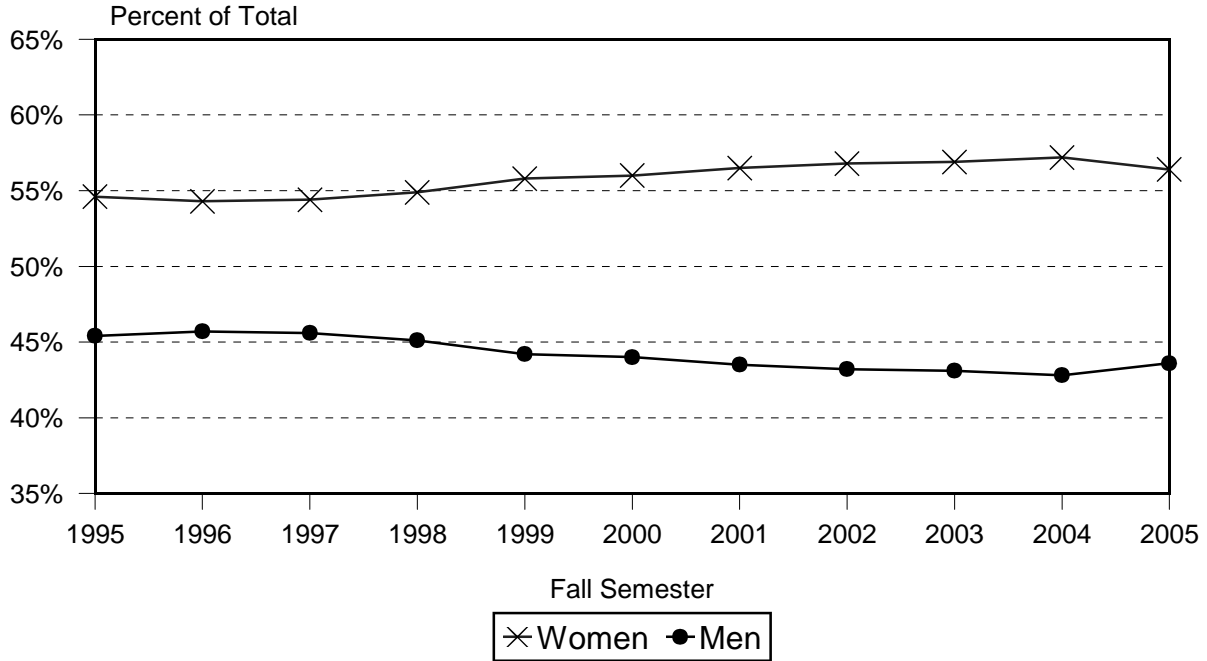

The percentage change calculations for Fall 1999 exclude Outreach College.

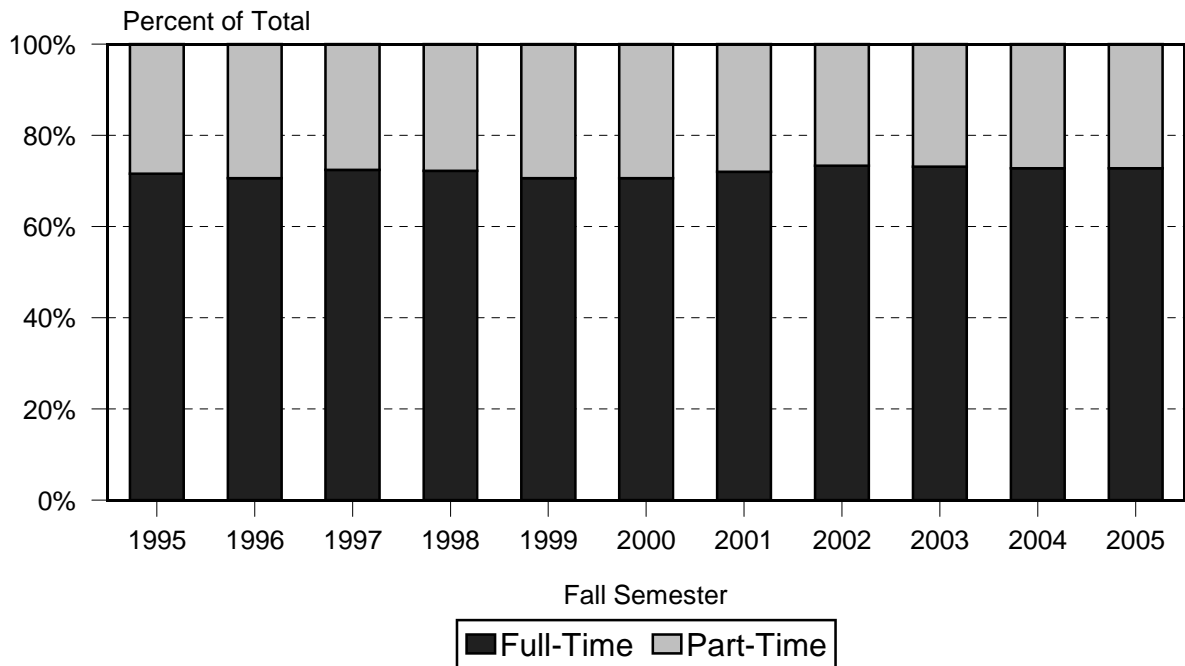

Undergraduate Enrollment by Registration Status

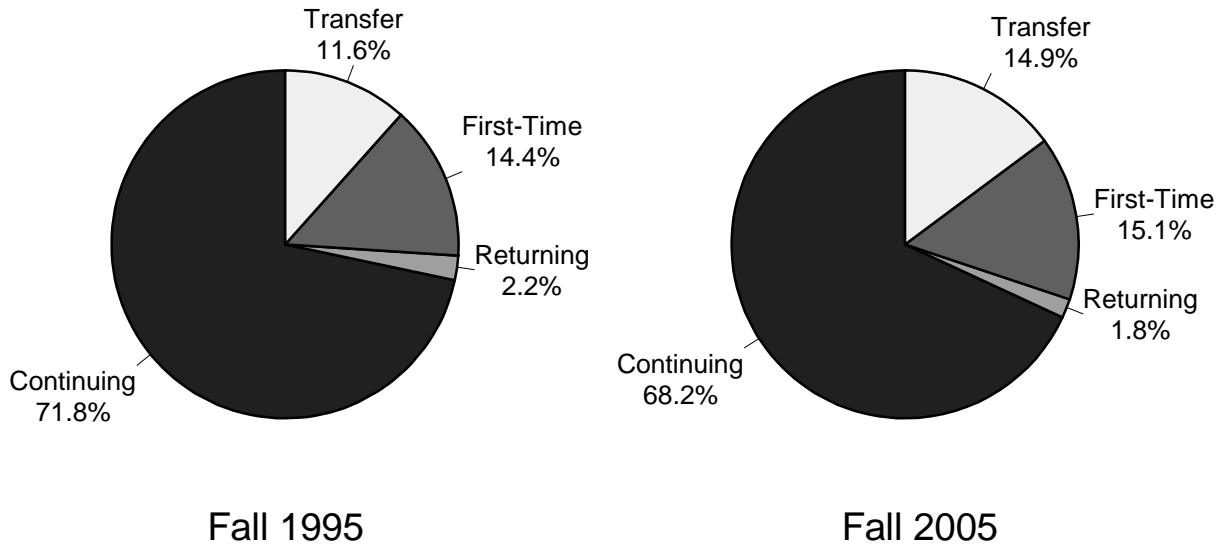
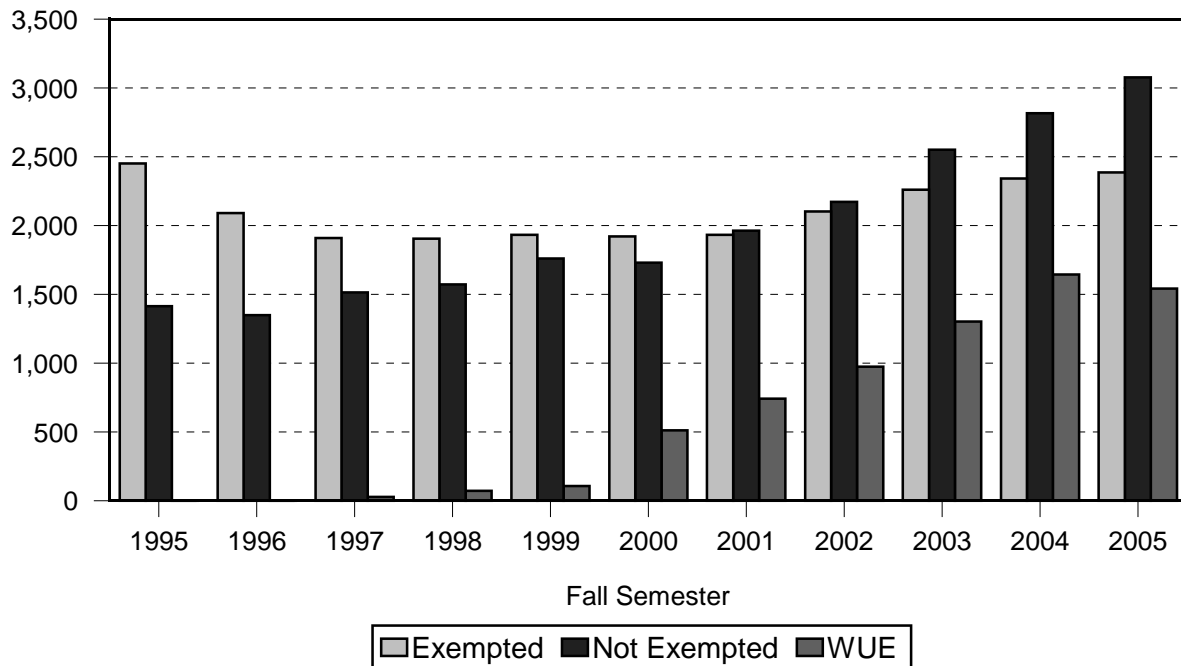

Entering Undergraduate Students

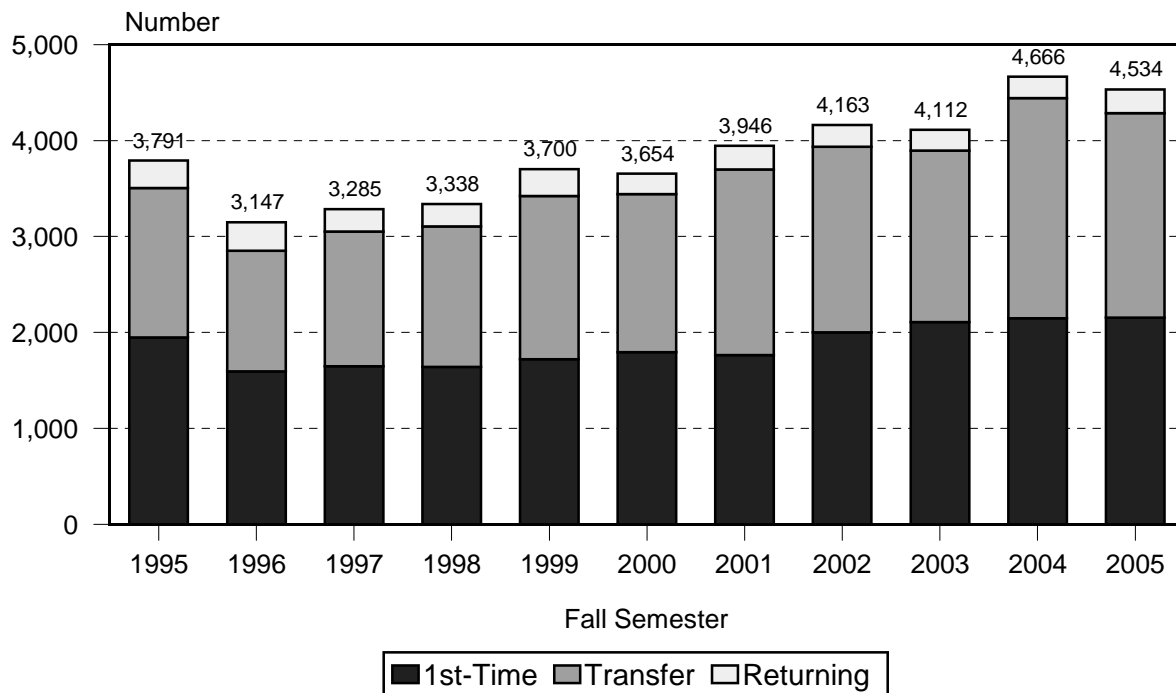
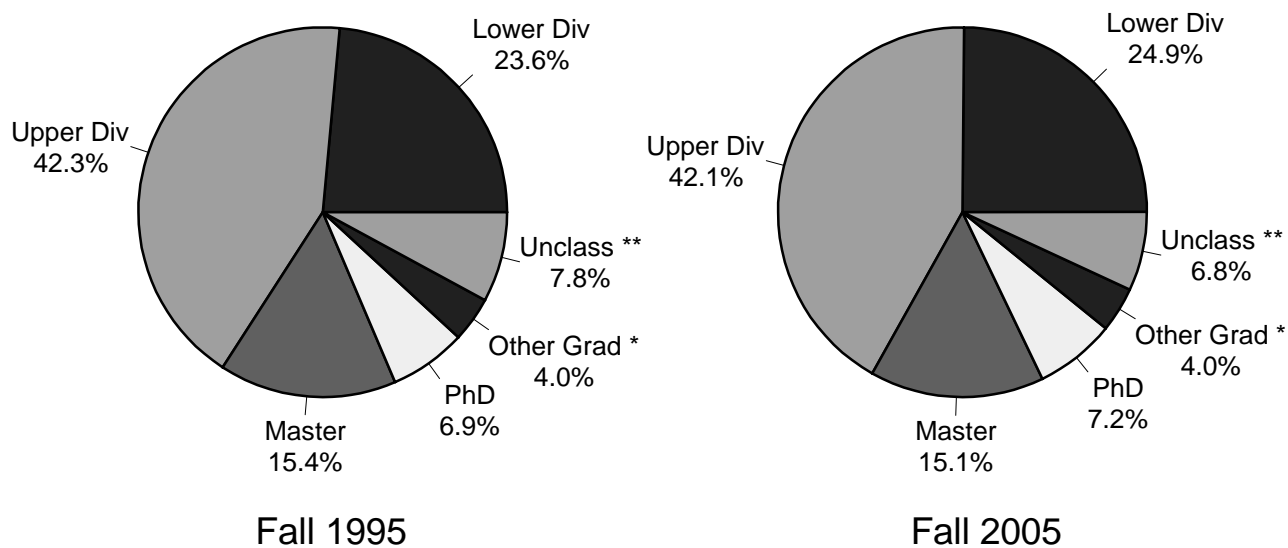

Enrollment by Education Level

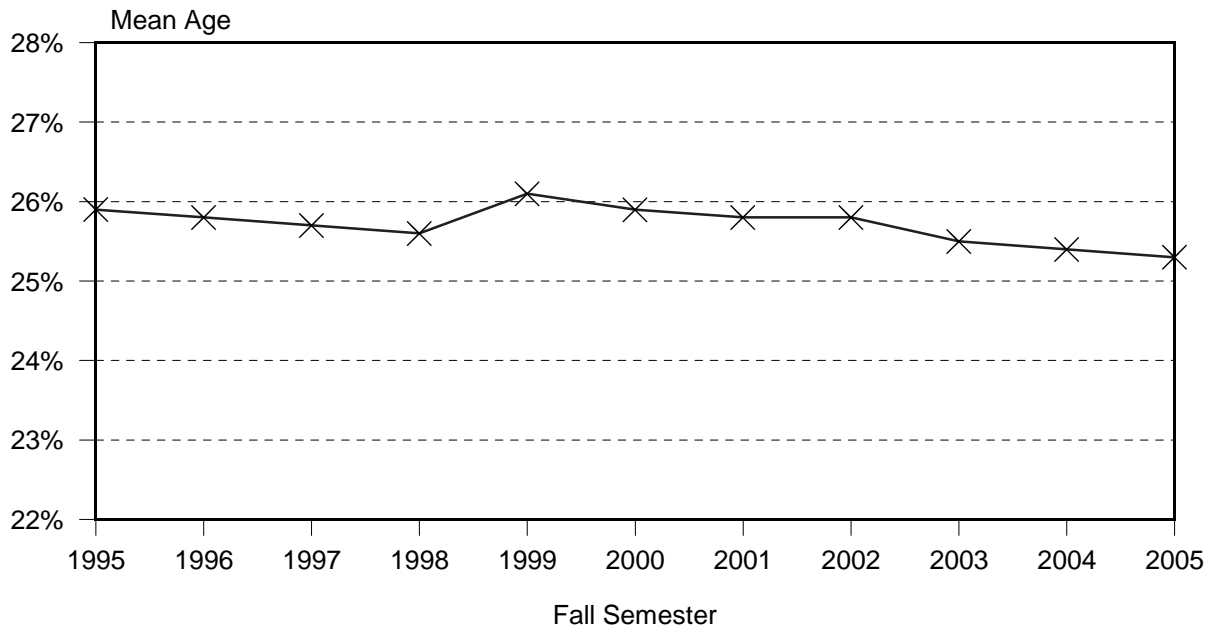

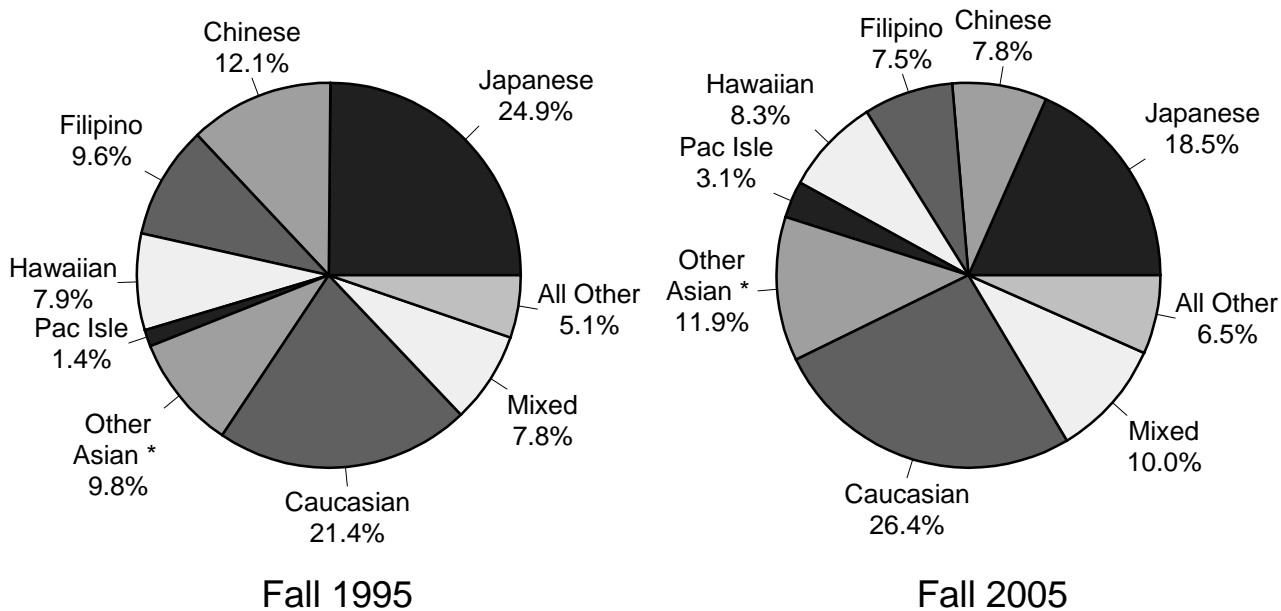

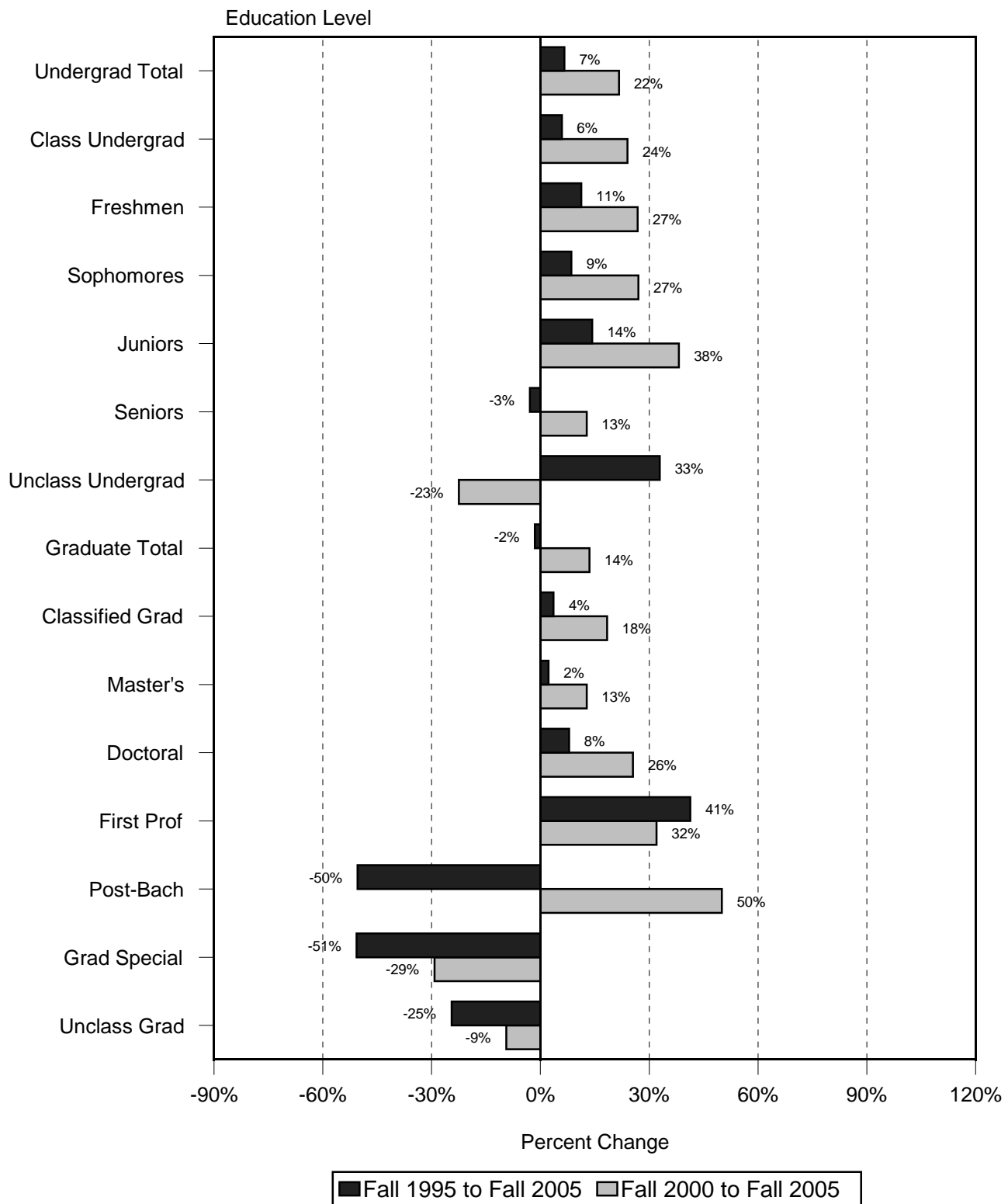

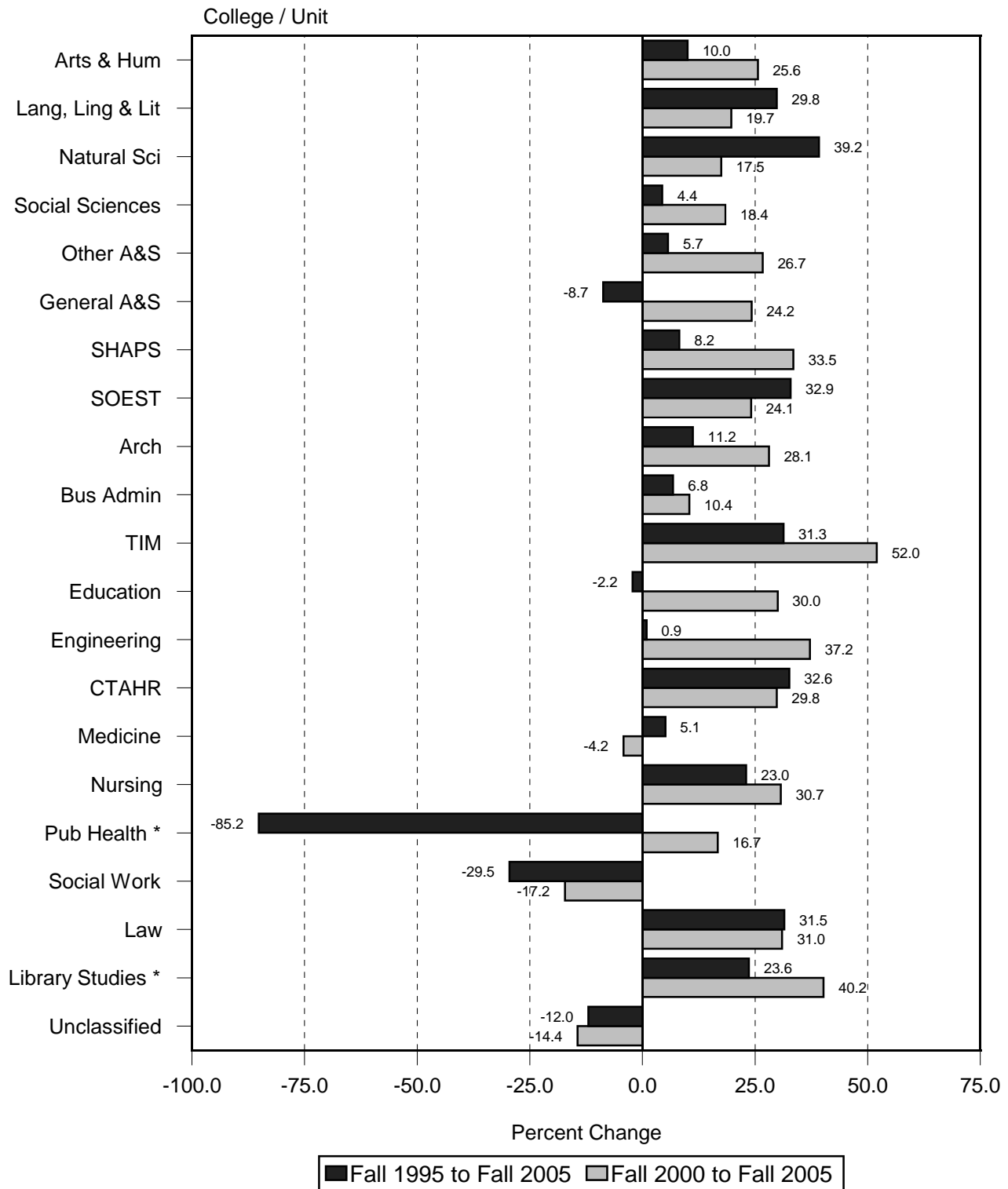
