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## THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I AT MĀNOA HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT, FALL 2008

Headcount enrollment at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa measured 20,169 for Fall 2008, a 0.6 percent increase over Fall 2007 (Table 2 and Figures 1 & 2). Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment increased 0.31%, to 16,085 (Table 3).

Other Arts & Sciences had the largest enrollment increase of any college / school, at 18.7% in Fall 2008 (Table 5), followed by the School of Social Work (16.2%), Architecture (11.3%), Business Administration (10.9%), and Law (9.1%).

The creation of the Hawai'iinuiakea School of Hawaiian Knowledge in 2007 resulted in a reorganization that affected enrollments in the Colleges of Arts & Sciences (College of Social Sciences) and the School of Pacific & Asian Studies (formerly called the School of Hawaiian, Asian, and Pacific Studies).

In Fall 2003, the UH four-year campuses migrated to a new student registration system. During that process, aggregations for certain items in the report tables, such as citizenship have changed. Data for certain other items may show discontinuities due to changes in data processing. The reader is advised to exercise caution when examining trends or percentage data over time particularly in the charts and graphs.


With the migration to a new student registration system in Fall 2003, ethnic reporting has been expanded to include additional Asian and Pacific Islander categories (Tables 4, 5 & 7). However, only new students are included in these new categories; students already enrolled are shown under the ethnic category previously selected.

Other Fall 2008 enrollment highlights:

- Manoa's student enrollment has increased slightly after experiencing two years of modest declines (Figure 2).
- Entering undergraduate enrollment measured 4,137 in Fall 2008 (Table 5 & Figure 7). First-Time freshmen enrollment increased 1.3% from the previous year to 1,866, while the number of transfers decreased 5%.
- The Hawaiian Ancestry characteristic is a new item, beginning in Fall 2005. Students were asked on the application to indicate Hawaiian ancestry. The figures given in Table 4 and Table 5 show the aggregate number of students who indicated "Yes" to Hawaiian ancestry or who selected Hawaiian ethnicity. The total for the campus measured 12.2% of total enrollment, 13.2% of undergraduate enrollment.
- The percentage of male students increased slightly since Fall 2004, to 44.6% of enrollment (Table 5 & Figure 3). The percentage of students enrolled full-time is steady at 71% (Figure 4). The mean age of students also held steady at 25 years. The UH Mānoa student body is ethnically diverse and continues to diversify (Figure 10).







Enrollment by Gender





Enrollment by Attendance Status



Undergraduate Enrollment by Registration Status





Enrollment of Non-Residents by Tuition Status





**Enrollment by Education Level**





Enrollment by Ethnicity



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
**Figure 11**
