4/ New residency code for Hawai'i National Guard reservists, effective Spring 2007; students pay resident tuition.

5/ New residency code for DOE Teachers, effective Fall 2006; students pay resident tuition.

6/ New field, effective Fall 2006. Non-citizens line item is the new source for the non-resident alien count, as reported to IPEDS (replaces visa status). The citizenship type field in IRO_Base is more reliable than the visa type field when identifying U.S. citizens and non-U.S. citizens.
