THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MANOA HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT BY MAJOR, FALL 2002

This report summarizes headcount enrollment by major at UH Manoa from Fall 1992 to Fall 2002. Table 1 presents data for each School / College, with breakout by lower, upper and graduate divisions (lower division is the sum of freshmen and sophomores, while upper division is the sum of juniors and seniors). Table 2 shows headcounts by major, with detail by degree objective. Table 3 provides summary counts by degree objective.

Changes to degree programs occur frequently. Details on changes to the programs are itemized in the footnotes to Table 2. Every attempt is made to keep these footnotes comprehensive and up-to-date. Sources for documenting changes include Minutes for the Meetings of the UH Board of Regents, the UH Academic Program Action Reports published by the System Academic Affairs Council and memoranda on program changes issued by the schools / colleges and the UH executive offices.

Changes for Fall 2002 include (but are not limited to) the following:

- ! Graduate Certificate candidates in International Cultural Studies appear for the first time. This interdisciplinary program, offered jointly by College of Social Sciences and the East-West Center, was approved by the UH Board of Regents in June 1999.
- ! An MEd program in Curriculum Studies has been added in the College of Education. This program consolidates the MEd programs in Elementary and Secondary Ed and was approved by the UH Manoa Chancellor in January 2002.
- ! MS and PhD degree offerings in Natural Resource & Environmental Management (CTAHR) have been added. These programs consolidate certain elements of the programs in Agriculture & Resource Economics and Agronomy & Soil Science. The change was effective in Fall 2002.
- ! The BS program in Entomology (CTAHR) has been renamed Plant and Environmental Protection Sciences. The numbers shown in Table 2 for prior years were previously shown under Entomology. The graduate level programs were unaffected.
- ! Degree programs in Tropical Plant and Soil Sciences (CTAHR) have been added. The BS program was granted provisional status by UH Board of Regents in June 2001. The MS and PhD programs consolidate Horticulture and most of the program in Agronomy & Soil Science.
- ! Unclassified students registered through Outreach College can no longer be reported separately, due to changes in the computer processing routines. The counts shown in Table 2 for Regular Unclassified include Outreach College.

Enrollment Highlights for Fall 2002 include the following:

- ! Enrollment for the UH Manoa campus increased by 6.7% in Fall 2002, the largest percentage increase in over 30 years (Table 1 and Figure 1).
- ! Enrollment in BS programs has increased for the last four consecutive fall semesters and stands at the highest level on record (Table 3 and Figure 4). Most of this growth may be attributed to enrollment increases in the Biology and Computer Science programs in Natural Sciences, as well as the addition of the BS program in Global Environmental Science in SOEST (Table 2).
- ! Enrollment in BBA programs declined sharply from Fall 1992 to Fall 1996 (Table 3 and Figure 5). Some of this decline, at least in the early years, was due to the replacement of the BBA program in Travel Industry Management by a BS program in Fall 1991. Enrollment in BBA programs increased 11.9% in Fall 2002.
- ! BEd programs declined sharply from Fall 1996 to Fall 2000, but have increased the last two fall semesters (Table 3 and Figure 5). Analysis of trends in BEd enrollment are inconclusive, but the declines coincided with a period of tuition increases.
- ! Other Bachelor degree programs have also declined in recent years. The BFA program in Art appears to be losing enrollment to the BA program; the overall enrollment level in Art, however, appears to be stable (Table 2). The BArch program is being phased out in favor of the ArchD program, which began in Fall 1999. ArchD undergraduates are counted as BA candidates in Table 3.
- ! Enrollment in Masters programs increased by 6.2% in Fall 2002, while enrollment in PhD programs increased 6.1% (Table 3 and Figure 6). Enrollment in both degree objectives has been fairly stable over the period covered in this report.
- ! First-Professional enrollment has increased steadily since 1997 (Table 2 and Figure 7). The MD program in Medicine has expanded by 26 students (11.6%) over this period, while the JD program in Law has grown by 29 students (12.9%). The ArchD program in Architecture has added another 32 students.
- ! The Professional Diploma in Education program was placed on stop-out from 1994-95 to 1996-97. The program was subsequently replaced by the Professional Diploma in Education and the Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Education. During this transition period enrollments fell sharply (Table 3 & Figure 7). The PB program has attracted most of the enrollment since the program redesign (Table 3).
- ! Unclassified undergraduate enrollment declined from Fall 1992 to Fall 1997, while unclassified graduate enrollment declined from Fall 1992 to Fall 1998 (Table 3 and Figure 8). Unclassified enrollment has recovered since, but remains well below the level of the early 1990s.

Headcount Enrollment by Ed Level

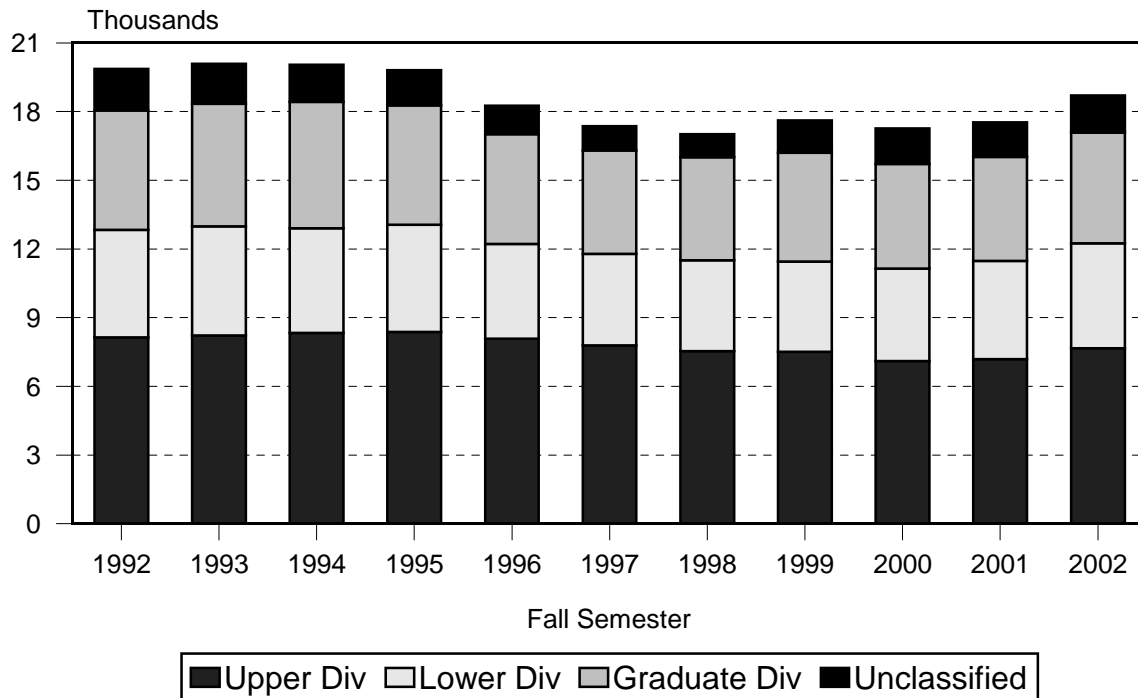
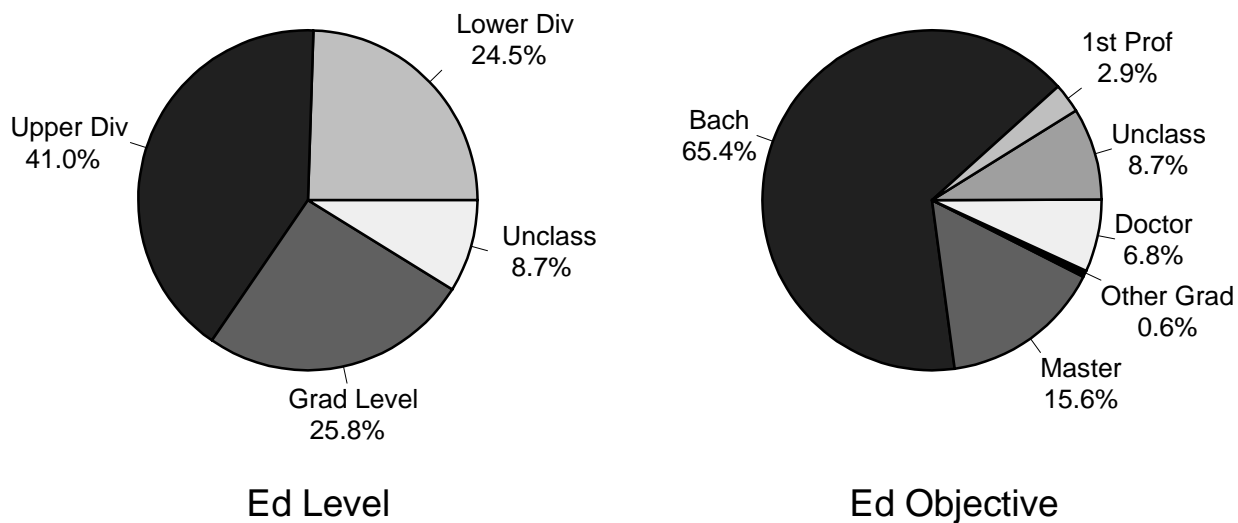

Fall 2002

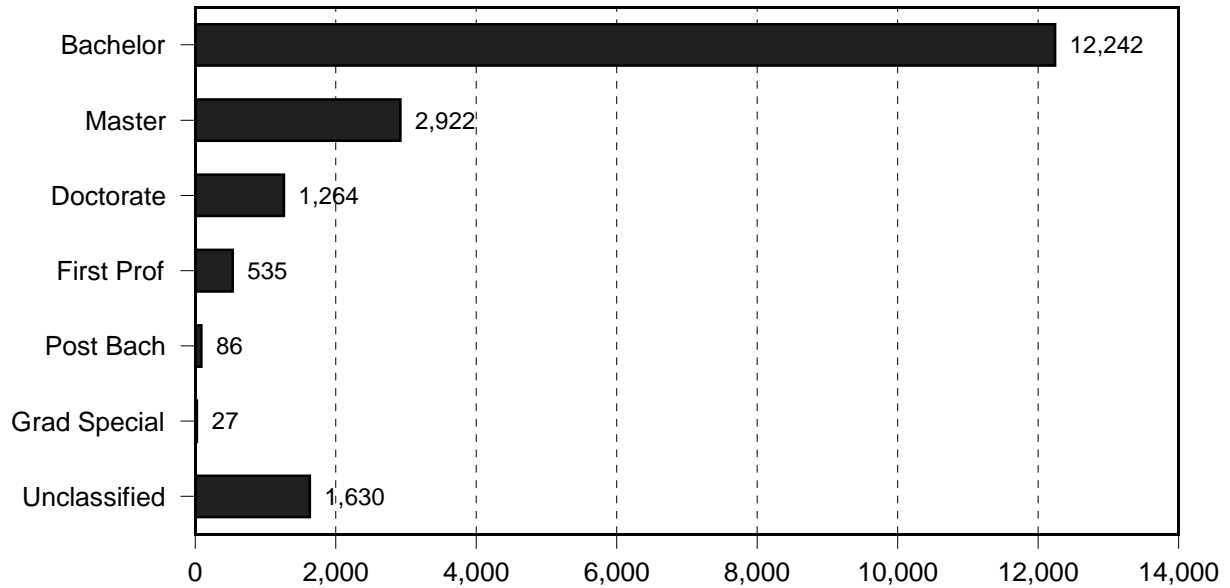
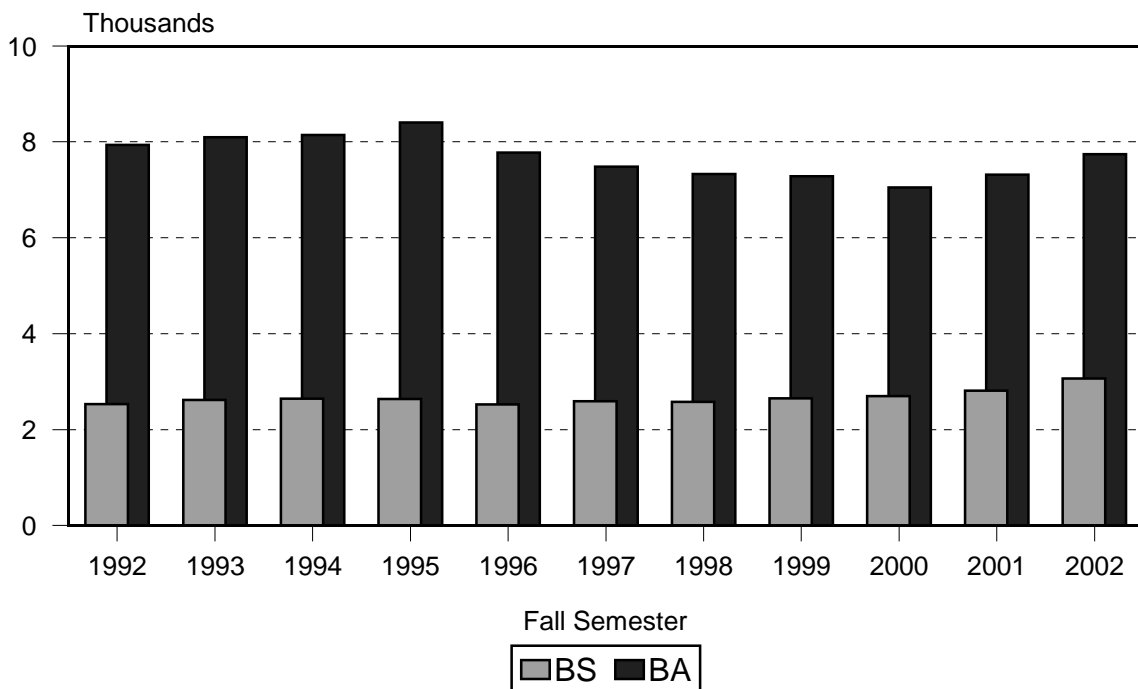

Headcount Enrollment by Degree Objective

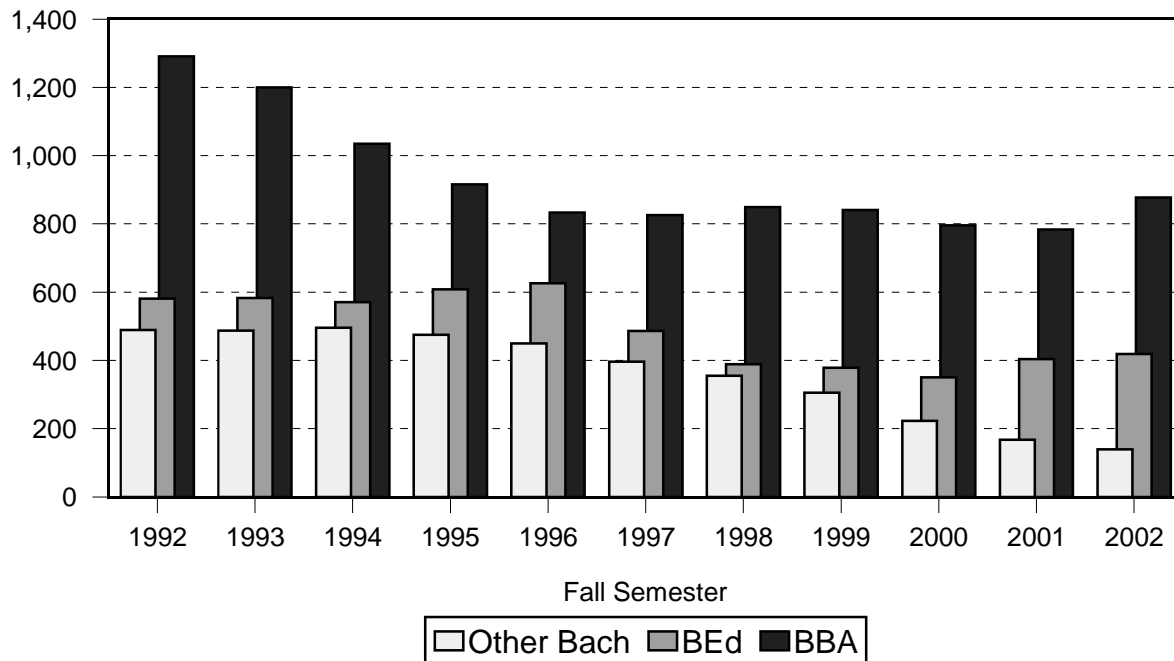
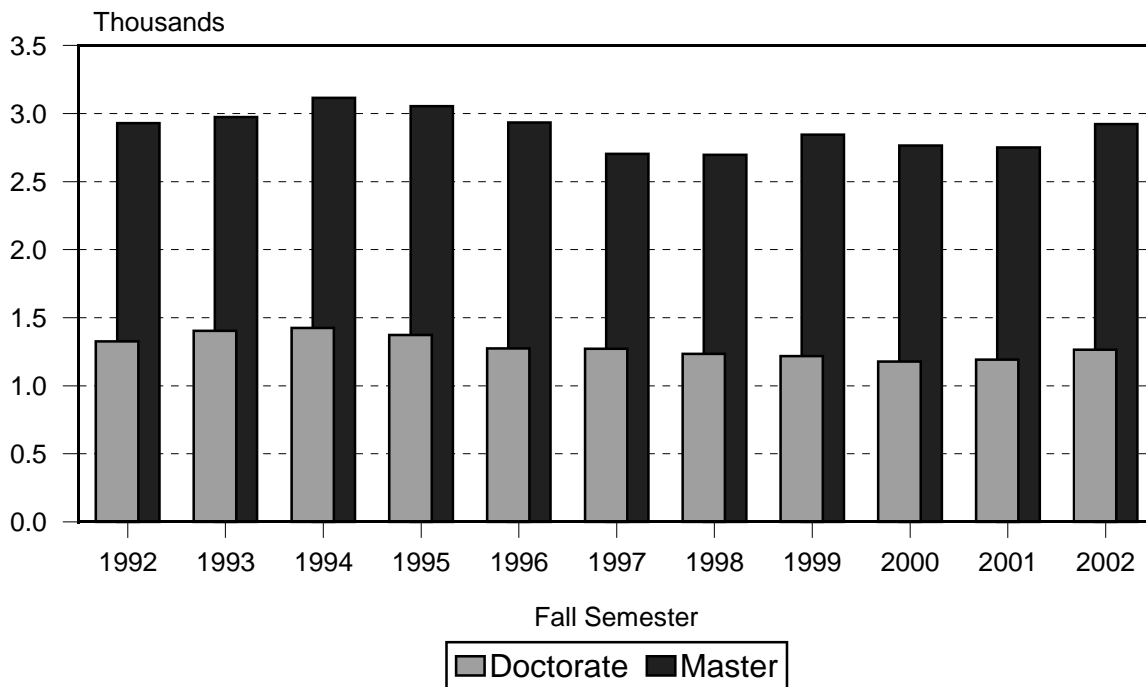
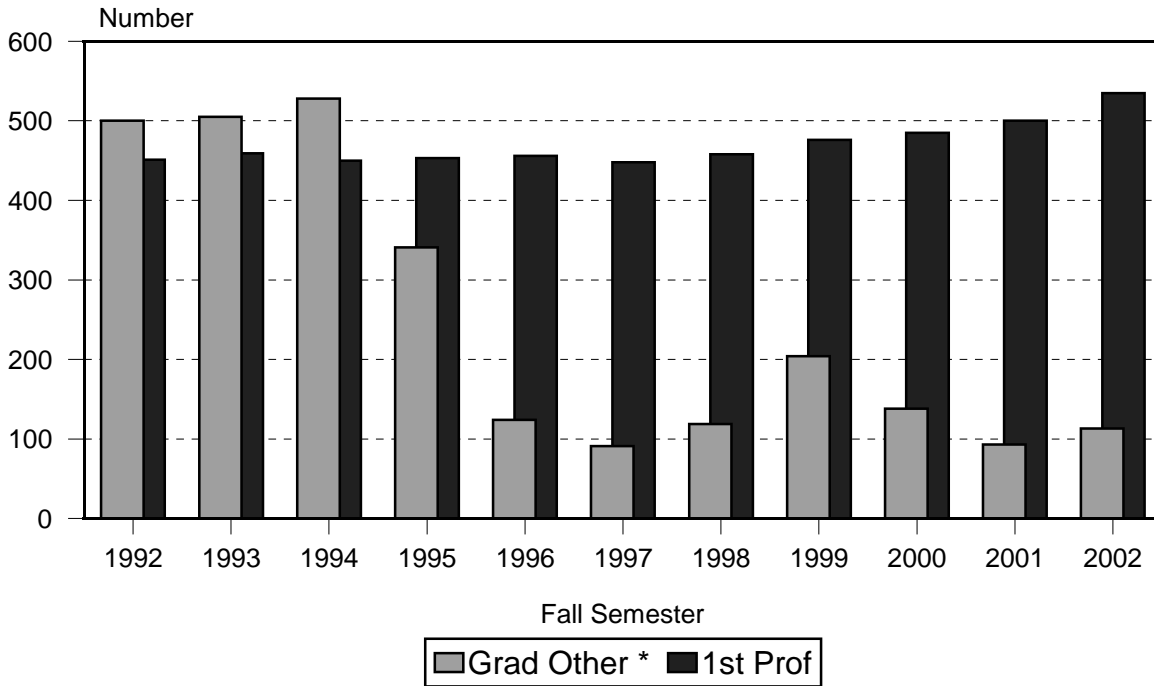

Headcount Enrollment by Degree Objective



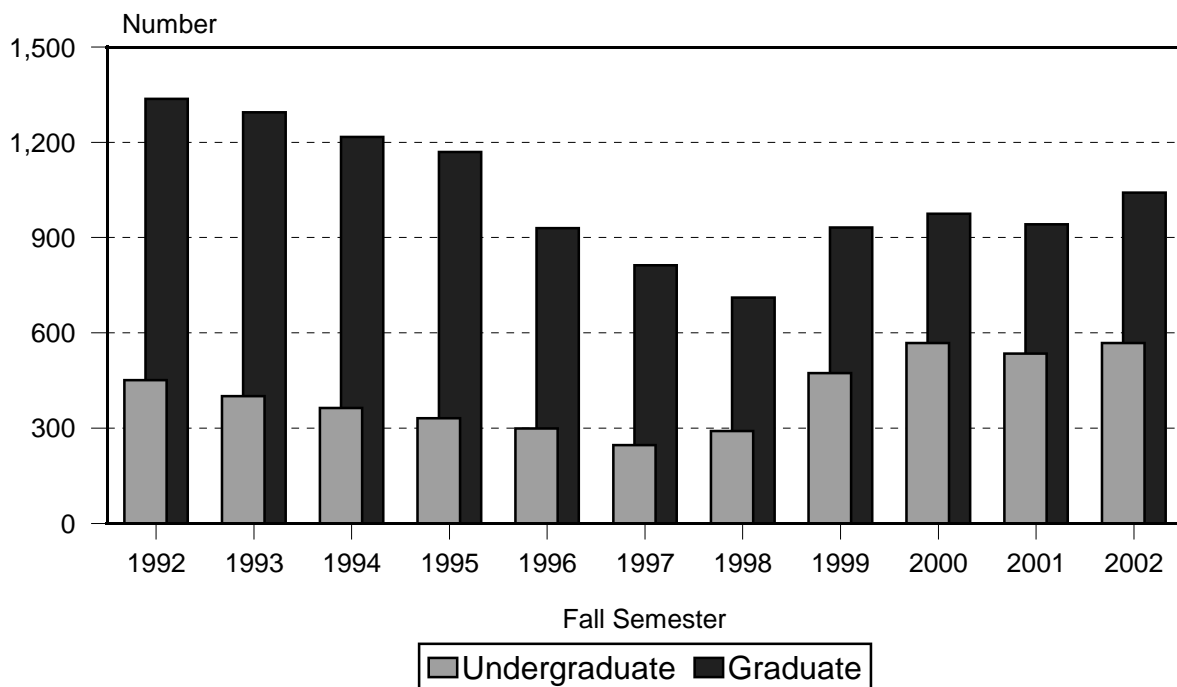

Headcount Enrollment by Degree Objective



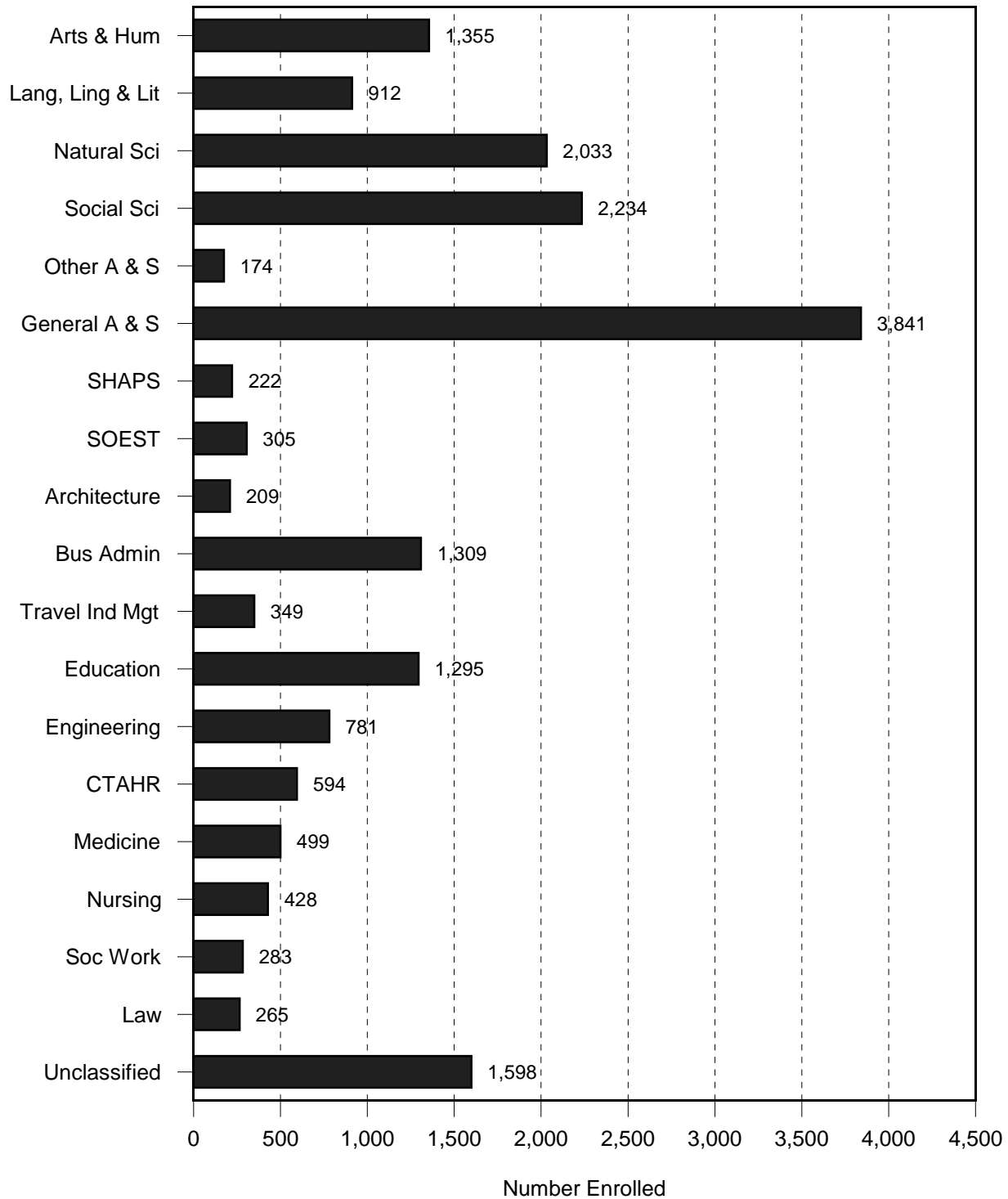

Headcount Enrollment of Unclassified Students



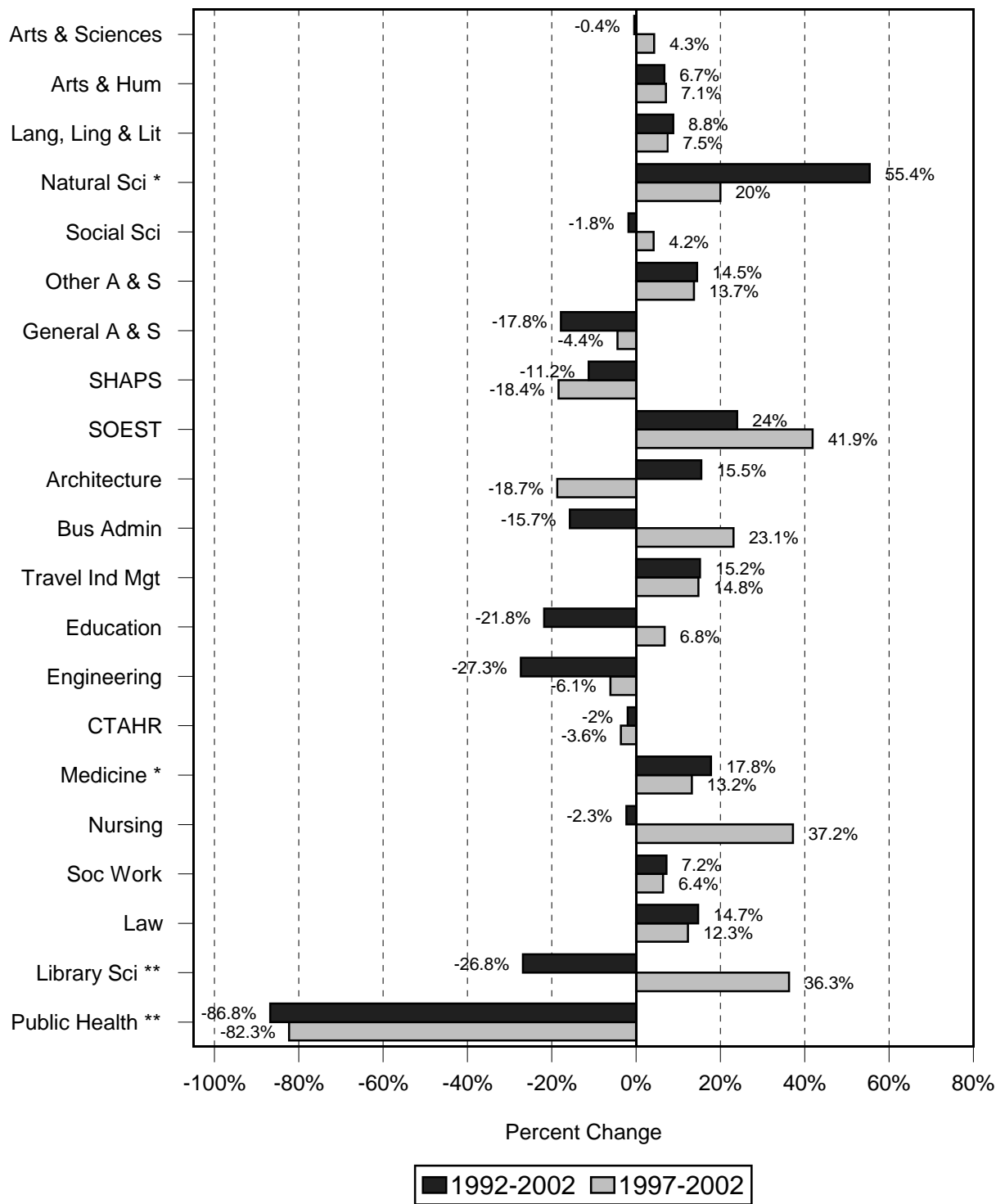
