Headcount and FTE Enrollment

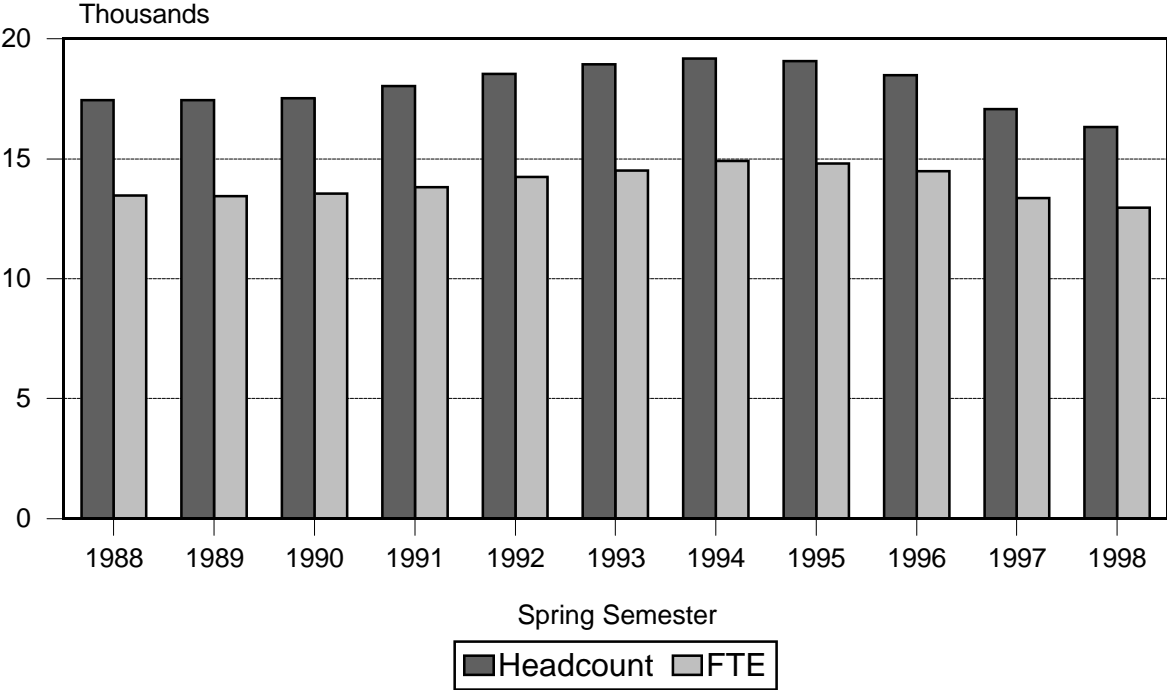
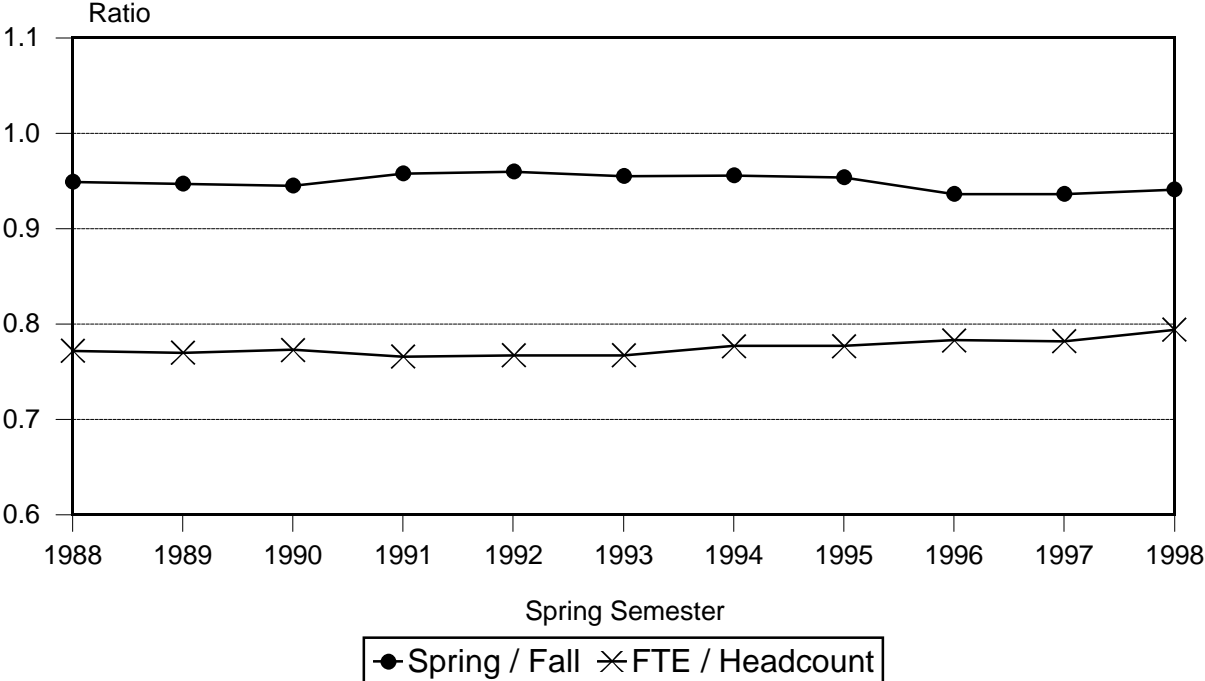

Enrollment by Education Level

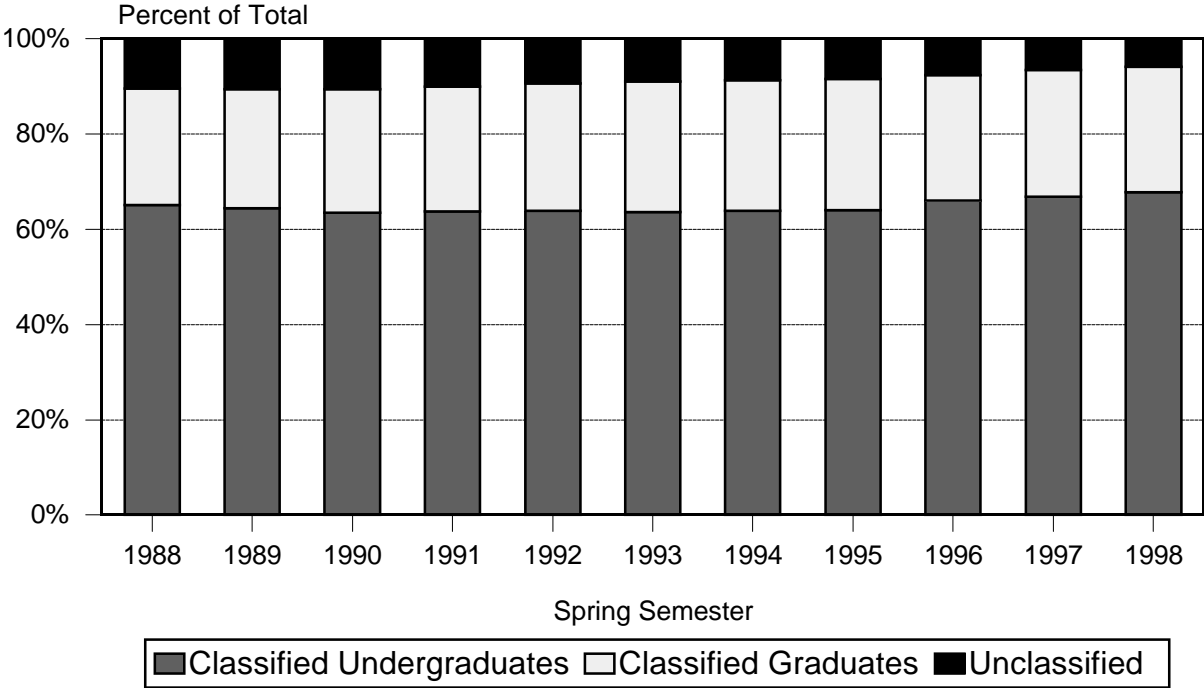
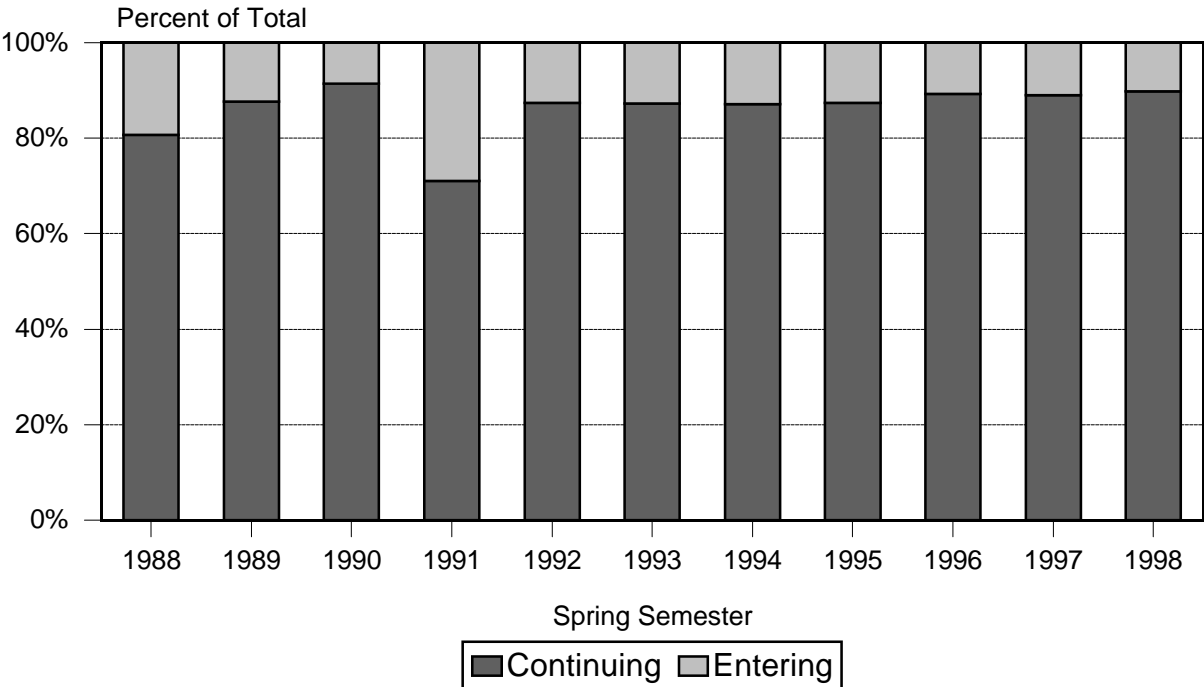

Enrollment by Gender

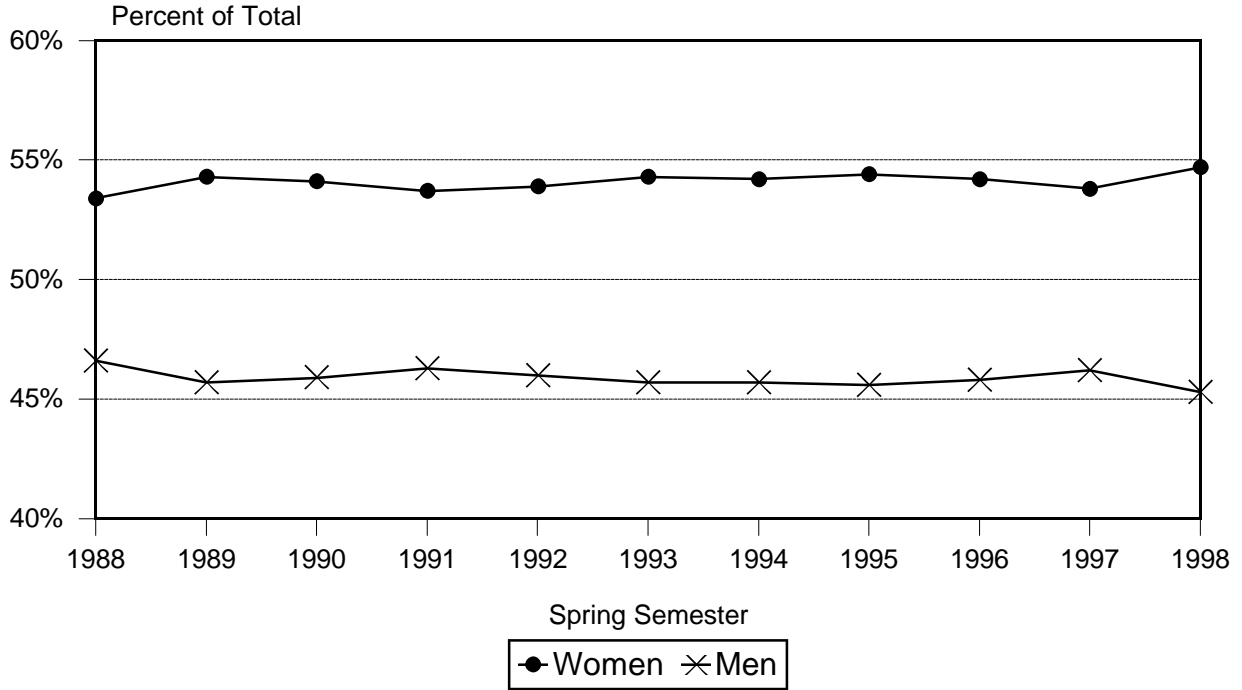
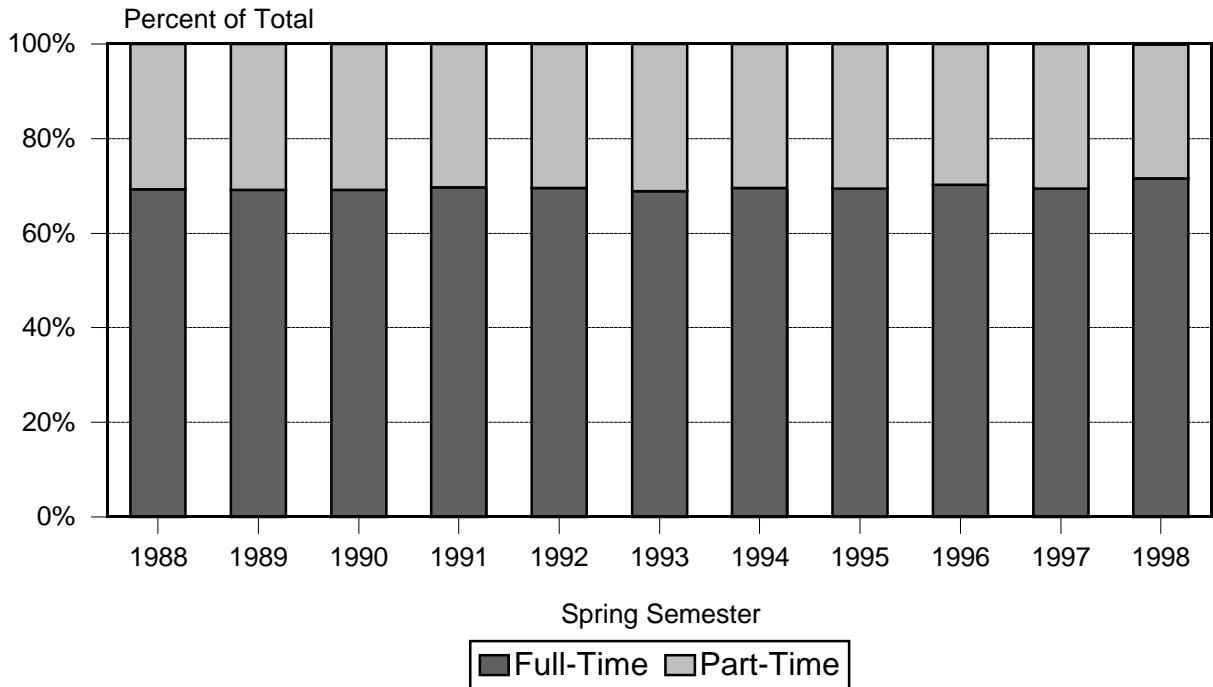

Mean Age

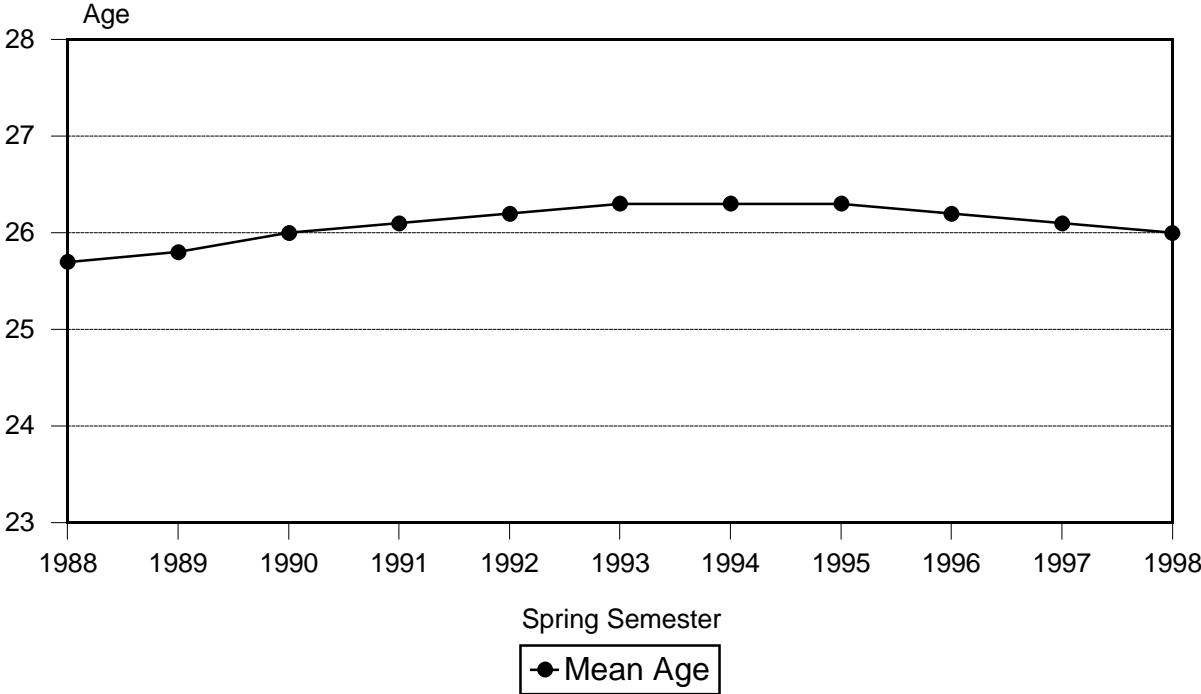

Enrollment by Ethnicity

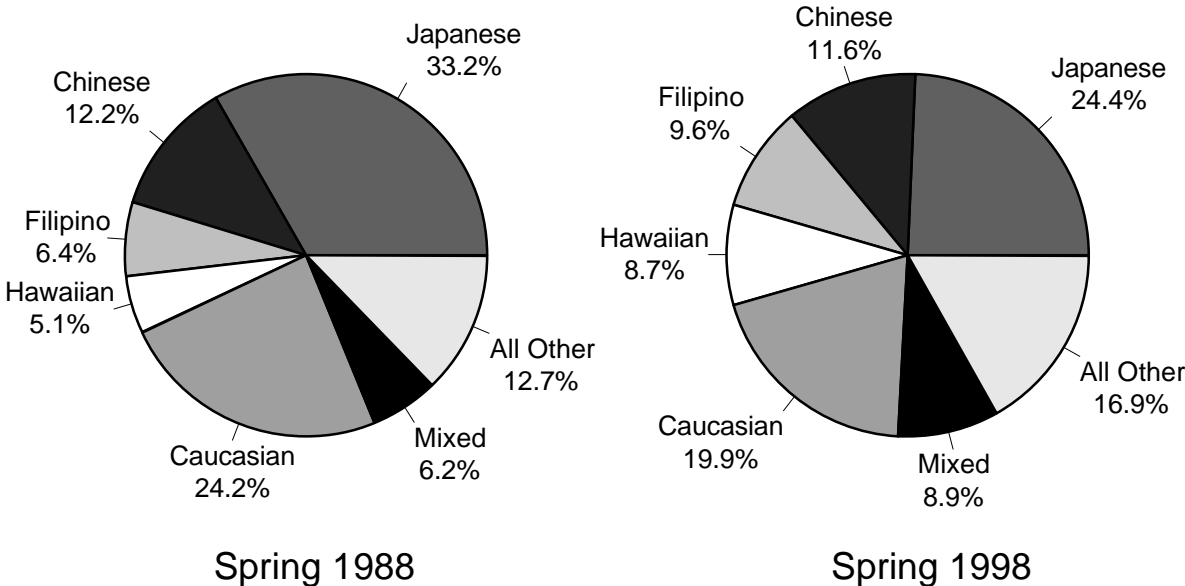
