THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII' HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT, SPRING 2004

Headcount enrollment at the University of Hawai'i measured 47,104 in Spring 2004, an increase of 3.5% over the previous spring semester and the largest spring total since Spring 1995 (Table 2 & Figure 1). UH Hilo posted the largest enrollment increase in percentage terms at 5.9%. UH Mānoa was next at 5.8%, followed by Hawai'i CC (5.4%), Kapi'olani CC (4.6%), Leeward CC (3.5%), Windward CC (2.2%), UH-West O'ahu (1.8%), Maui CC (-0.4%), Kaua'i CC (-2.7%), and Honolulu (-5.6%). Overall, enrollment for the UH Community College system was up 1.5% over Spring 2003.

Other highlights include:

- Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment for the UH system increased 3.2% in Spring 2004 to reach 32,017, also the highest spring semester total since Spring 1995 (Table 3 & Figure 1).
- Enrollment of full-time students declined slightly in Spring 2004, to 53.8% of total enrollment (Table 5 & Figure 3). The average credit load was 9.9 hours.
- The gender gap in enrollment continues to widen. In Spring 2004, female students made up 58.1% of total enrollment, a new all-time high (Table 5 & Figure 4).
- Western Undergraduate Exchange enrollment (tuition status) continues to grow rapidly (Table 5 & Figure 5). WUE enrollment for the UH system has grown from 90 students in Spring 1998 to 1,717 in Spring 2004, an annual average growth rate of over 63%. WUE enrollment is occurring at UH Mānoa and UH Hilo, and may be attributed to active recruiting efforts (Table 6).
- Enrollment of non-resident, non-exempted students (tuition status) has also increased in recent years (Table 5 & Figure 6). Since Spring 1997, non-resident, non-exempted enrollment has grown from 4.9% of total enrollment to 7.9%. Enrollment of exempted students has remained more or less constant over this period, while WUE enrollment has grown to 3.6% of total enrollment.
- The ethnic makeup of the student body continues to diversify (Table 5 & Figure 8). Hawaiian and Pacific Islanders made up 16.5% of the total enrollment in Spring 2004, as opposed to 13.5% in Spring 1994. Students of Mixed ethnicity have also increased, while the proportions of Caucasian, Japanese, Chinese and Filipino students have decreased.
- Since Summer 2002, the UH campuses have migrated to a new student registration system. A consequence of this change was a significant increase in invalid data for certain fields, including: citizenship, attendance status, education level and permanent home address. The reader is advised to exercise caution when examining trends or using percentage data. Efforts to improve data quality are ongoing.

Headcount and FTE Enrollment




Full-Time Student Enrollment





Figure 4

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Enrollment




Mean Age



Enrollment by Ethnicity


