THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT, SPRING 2008

Headcount enrollment at the University of Hawai'i measured 48,093 in Spring 2008, a 3.6% increase from the previous spring semester. Eight campuses posted increases in enrollment: UH-West O'ahu (18.8%); Hawai'i CC (14%); Leeward CC (9%); Maui CC (8.6%); Windward CC (8.3%); Kapi'olani CC (6.1%); UH-Hilo (5.8%); Kaua'i CC (1.7%). The remaining two campuses had enrollment declines: UH Mānoa (-1.1%), Honolulu CC (-0.1%). Overall, enrollment for the UH Community College system increased 6.7% from Spring 2007.

In 2002-03, the University of Hawai'i campuses migrated to a new student registration system. During that process, aggregations for certain items in the report tables such as citizenship have changed. Data for certain other items may show discontinuities due to changes in data processing. The reader is advised to exercise caution when examining trends or percentage data over time.

Other Spring 2008 enrollment highlights:

- The Banner registration system requires students to designate one of the UH campuses as their "home" campus. However, business practice has changed so that once a student has been accepted into any UH campus he/she may register for classes at any UH Community College without submitting a new application. A new line item has been added to the tables to track this enrollment separately from other measures. Total enrollment at non-home based campuses measured 4,222 (17%) for the UH Community Colleges in Spring 2008 and 4,338 (9%) for the UH system.
- The Hawaiian Ancestry characteristic is a new item. The Hawaiian Ancestry enrollment is a combination of all those who indicated "Yes" to Hawaiian Ancestry on the application plus those who either did not answer the question or indicated "No" but who indicated Hawaiian / Part-Hawaiian ethnicity. The total for the UH system measured 9,033 or 18.8% of the enrollment in Spring 2008.
- The mean age of students has remained constant at 25.7 years for two consecutive years. The proportion of part-time students increased slightly to 48% while the proportion of full-time students decreased to 52% from the previous spring semester. After stabilizing at 78% over the last two years, the proportion of Hawai'i resident students increased slightly this year to 79%.
- With the migration to the Banner registration system, ethnic reporting has been expanded to include additional categories. However, only incoming students are included in these new categories; students already enrolled are shown under the ethnic category previously selected. The UH student body is ethnically diverse and continues to diversify. Of note, Hawaiian or Pacific Islanders continue to increase steadily, the increase coming mainly from the Hawaiian/Part-Hawaiian group. The proportion of students of Japanese ancestry continues its steady decline.

Headcount and FTE Enrollment

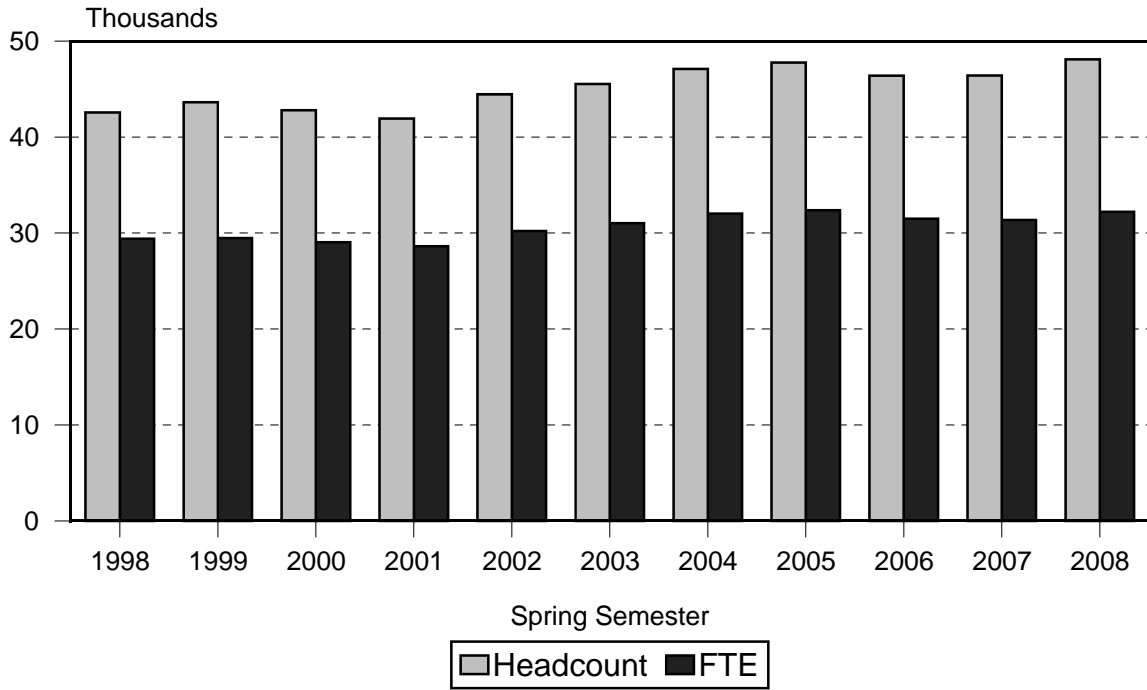
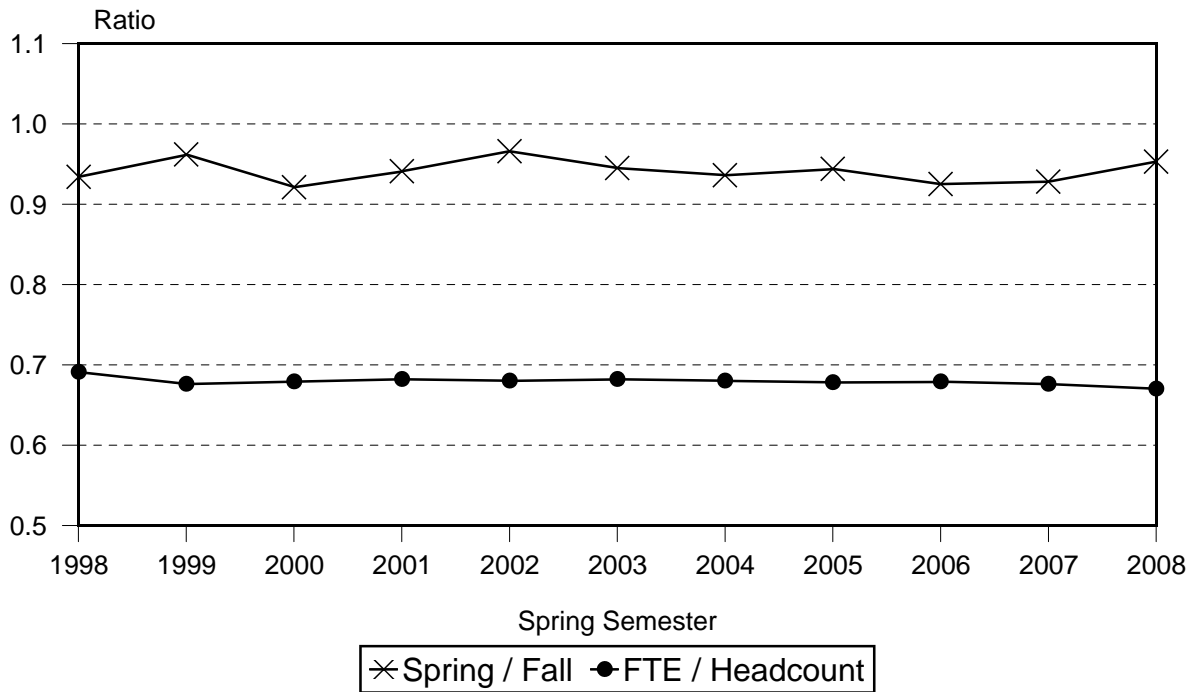

Full-Time Student Enrollment

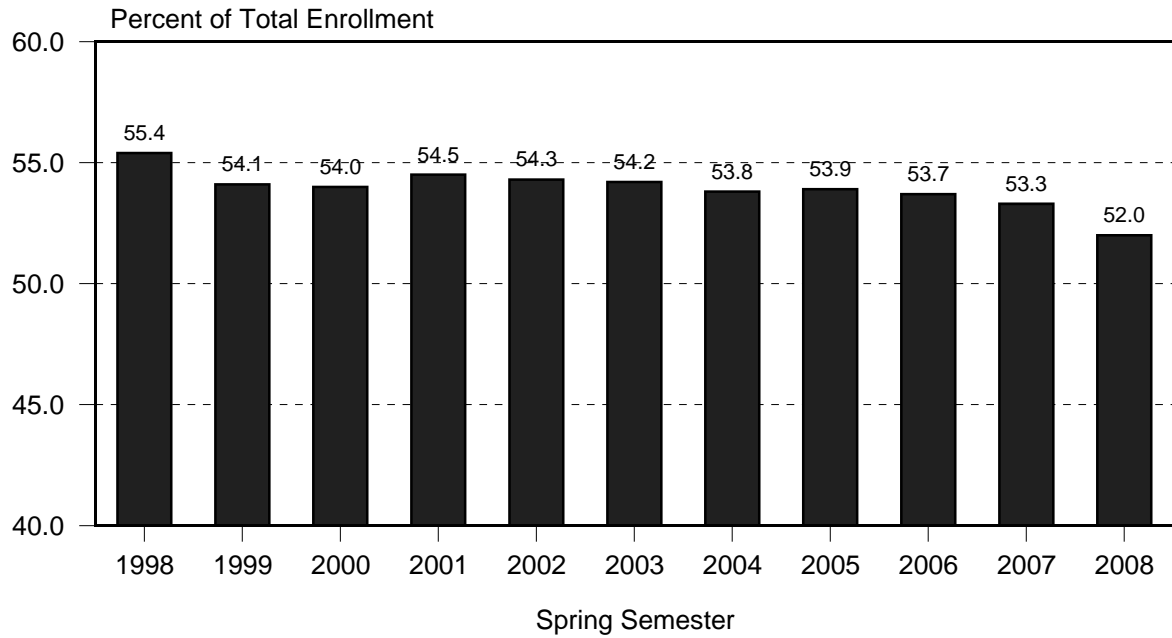
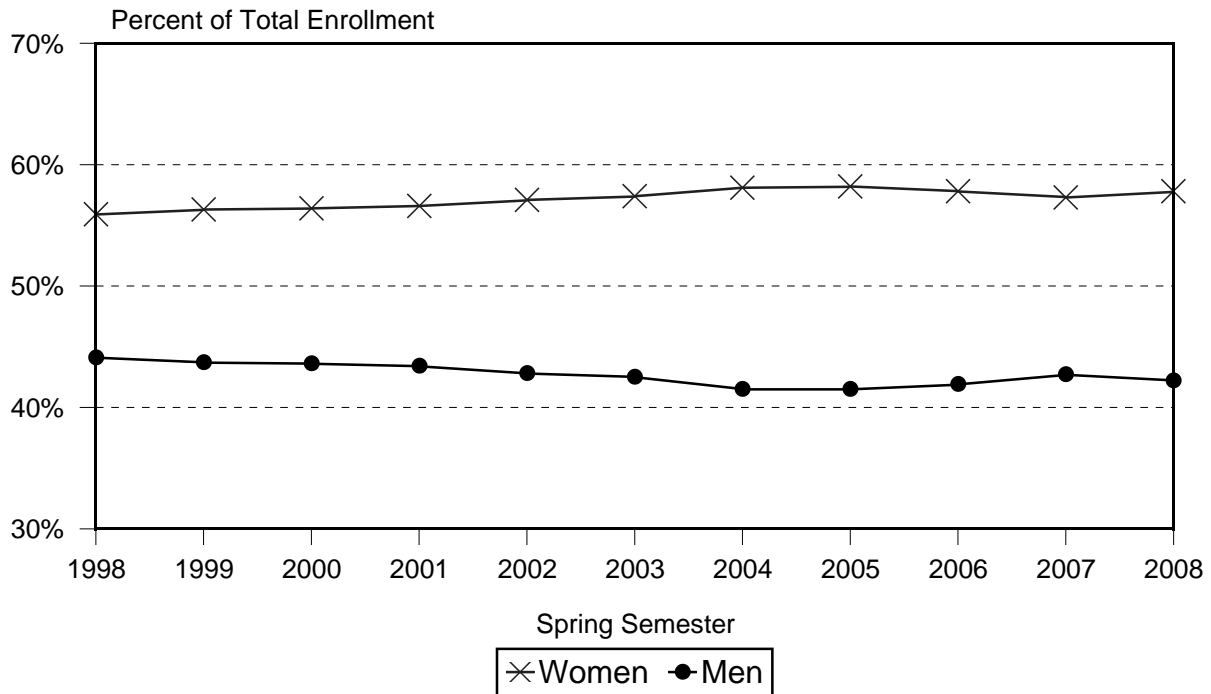

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Enrollment

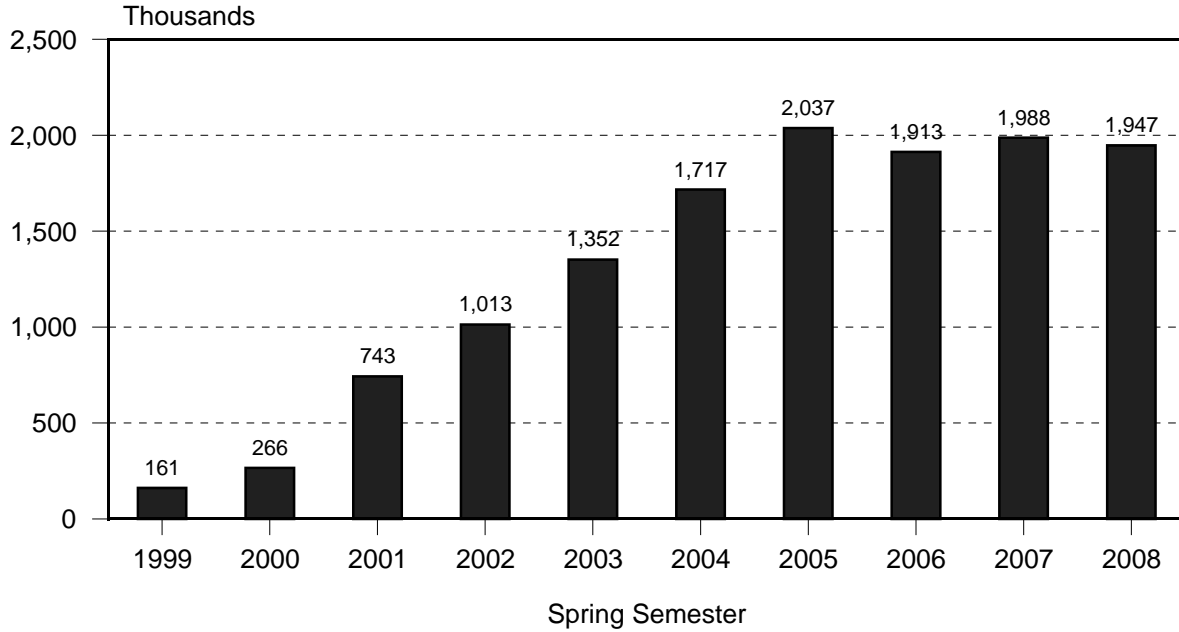
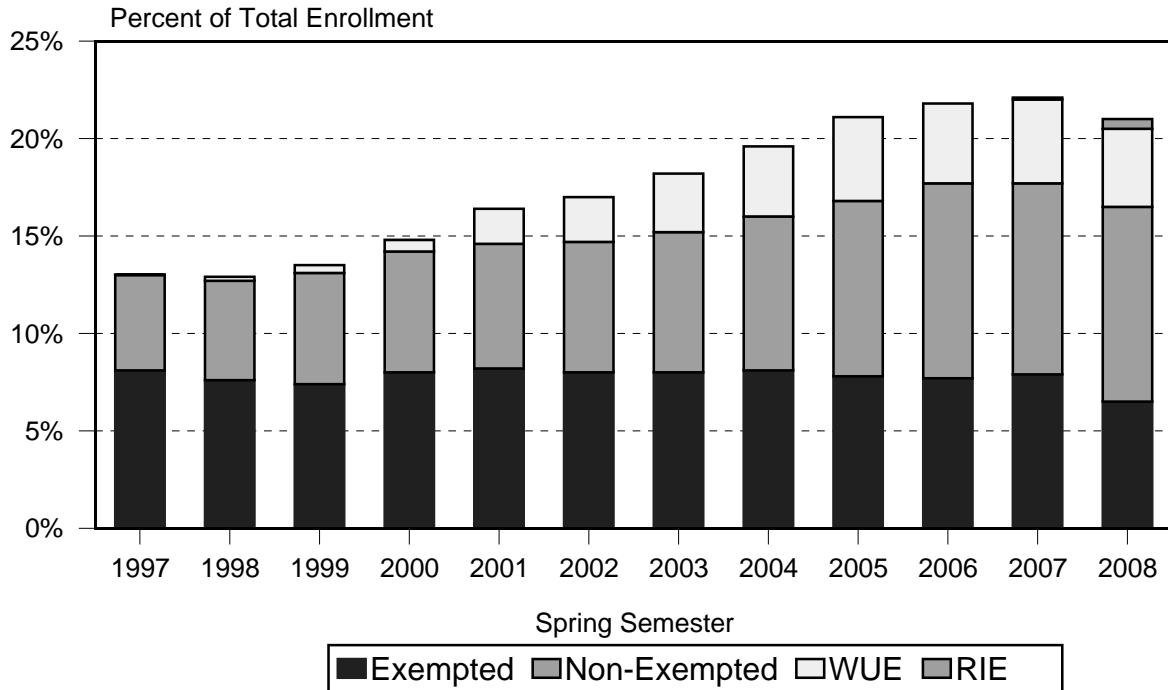

Mean Age

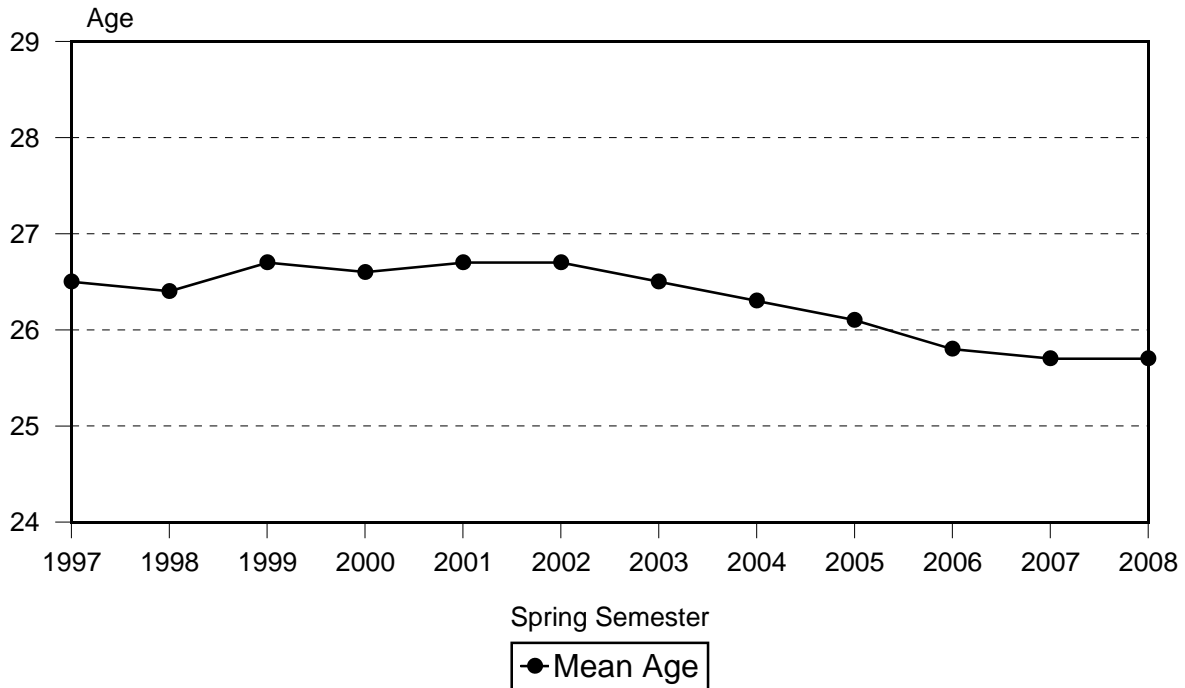

Enrollment by Ethnicity

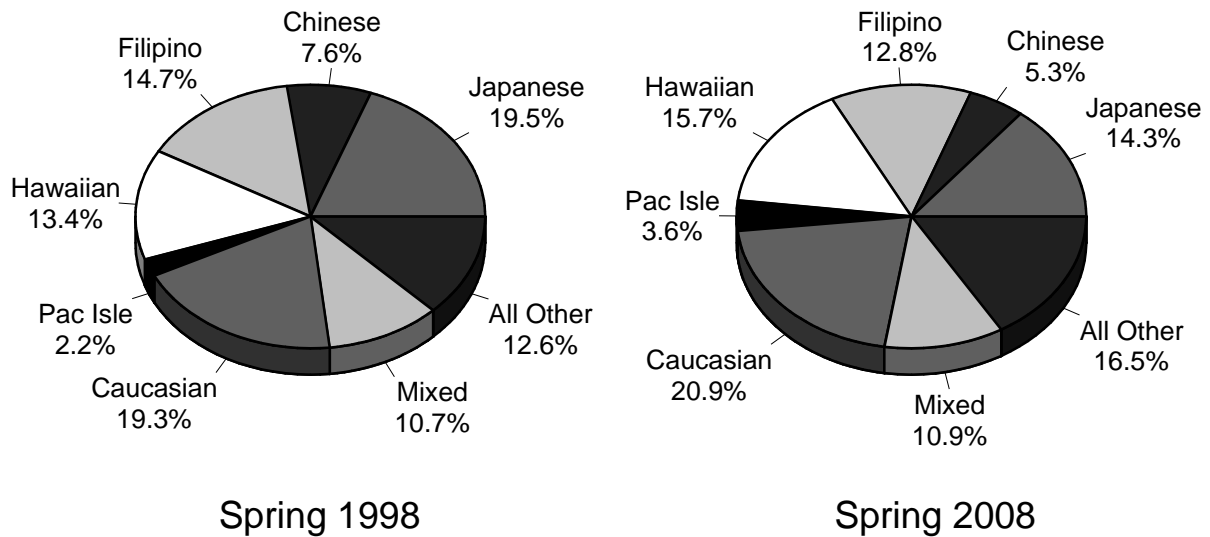
