Headcount and FTE Enrollment

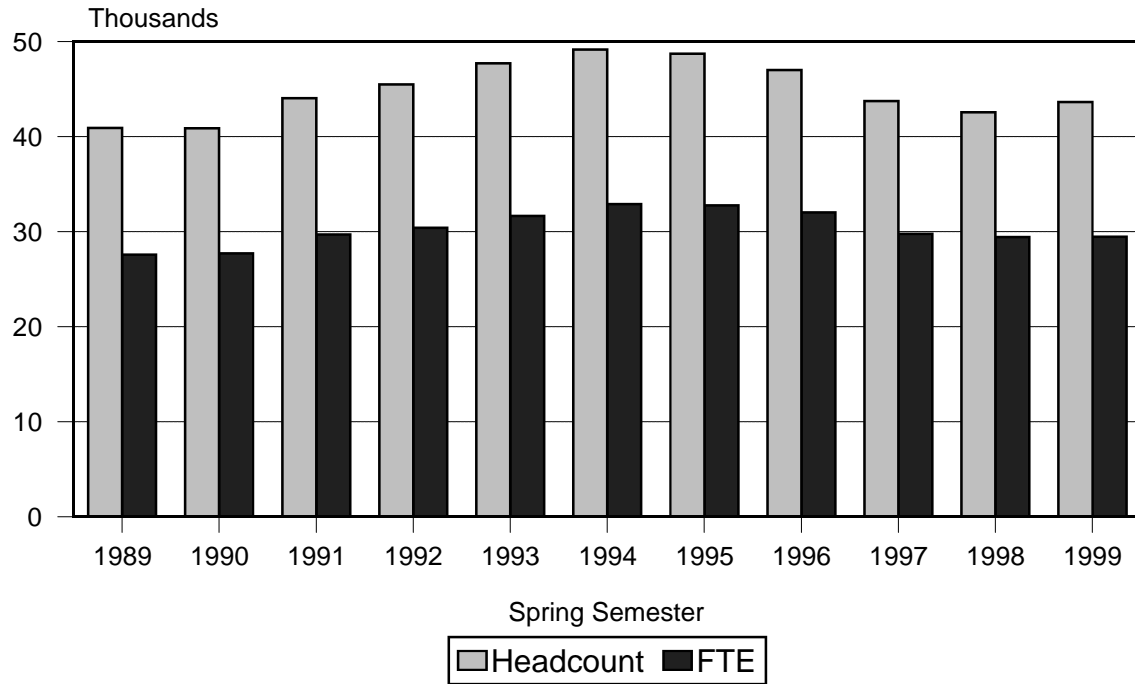
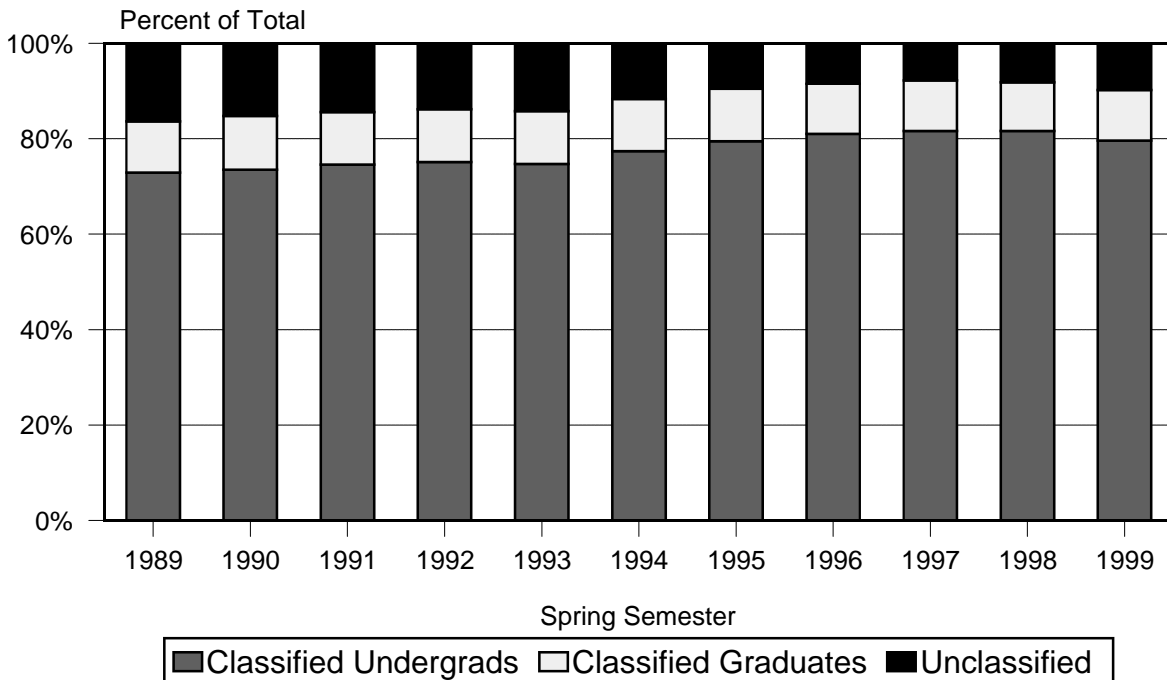

Enrollment by Gender

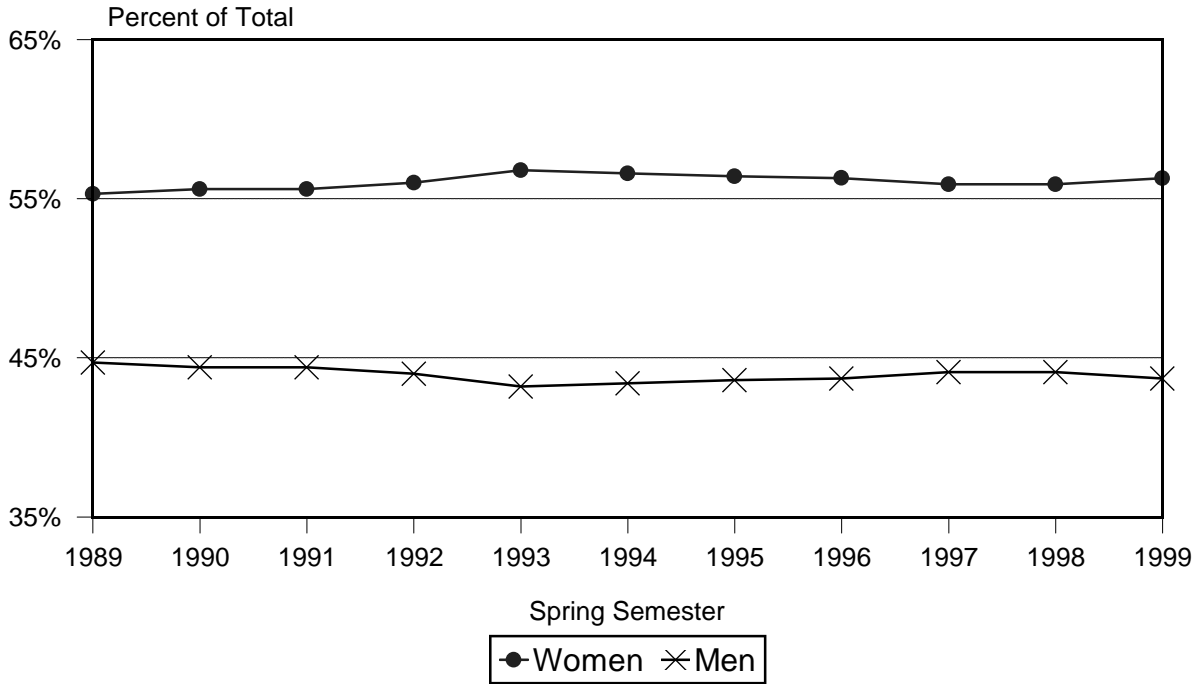
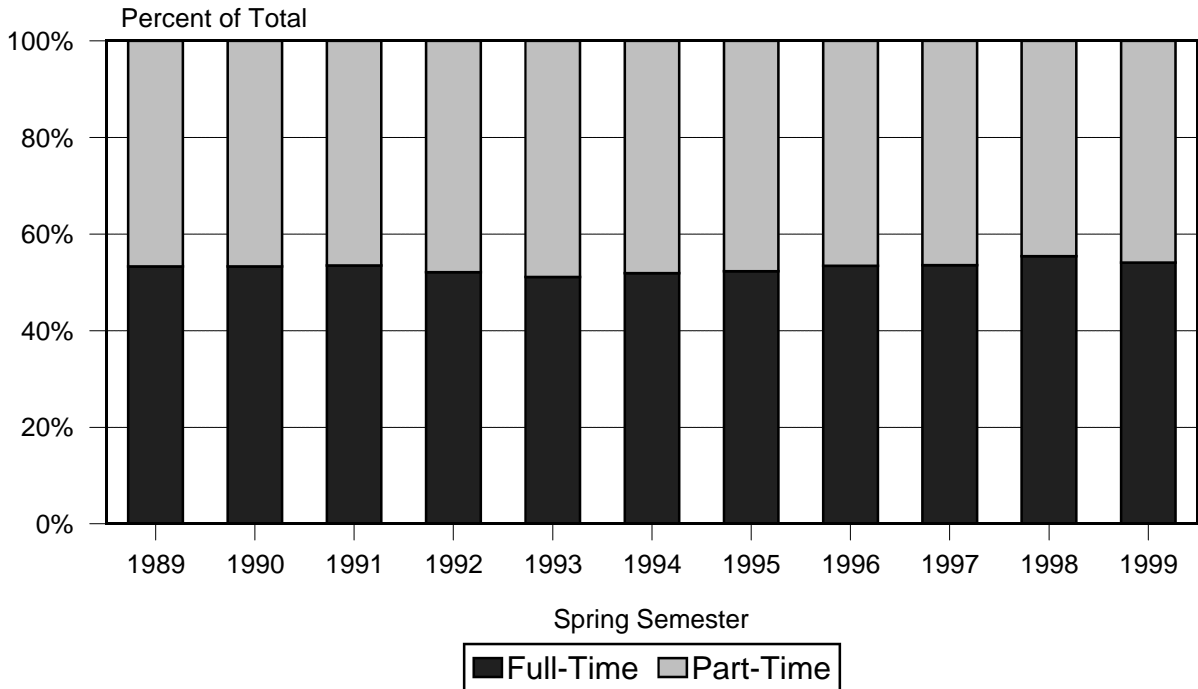

Mean Age of Regular Students

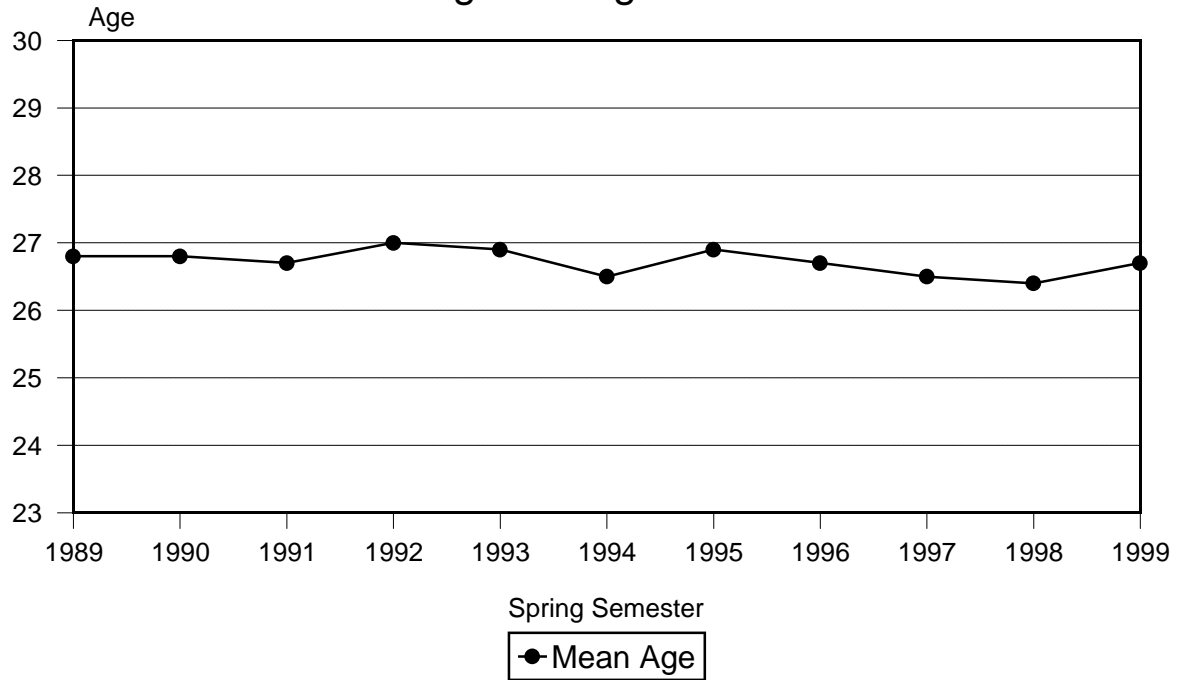

Enrollment by Ethnicity

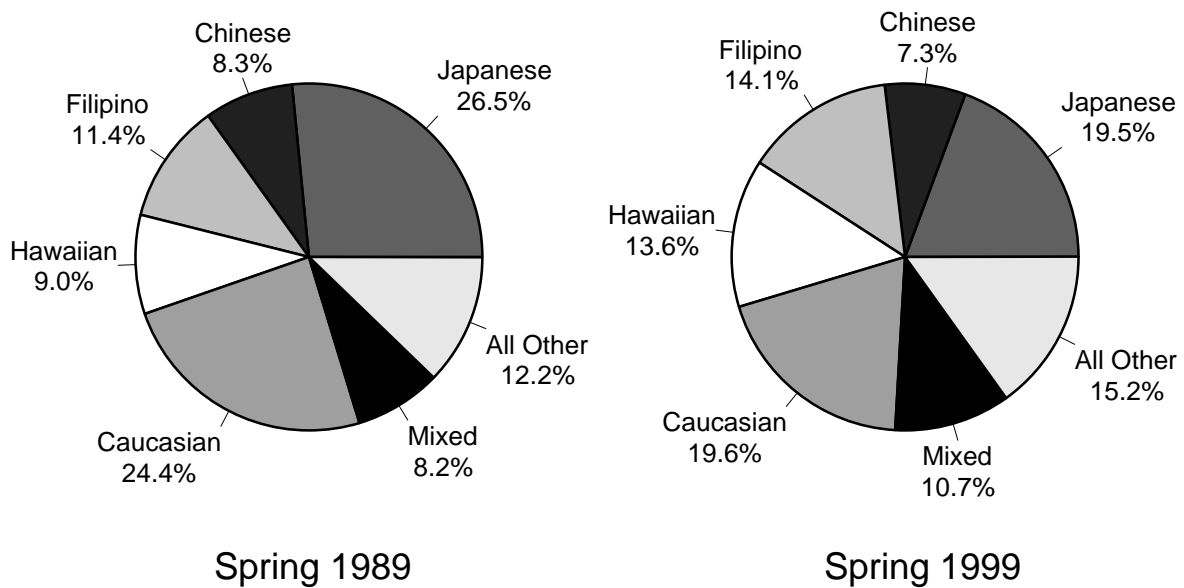
