### **Course Description:**

This is a continuing course in Chamorro. The course will focus on the fundamentals of the Chamorro language with emphasis on comprehension and language development. Listening, speaking, reading, and writing will be emphasized in that order.

### **Prerequisite:**

To enroll in Chamorro 201 you must have successfully completed Chamorro 102 with a grade of "C" or better.

### **Class Activities, Assignments, and Evaluations:**

1. Weekly drills and exercises to build vocabulary and comfort level of conversational speaking.
2. Dialogues, skits, and oral presentations will be interspersed with text activities to demonstrate ability to use Chamorro in conversations effectively.
3. Leksion 7-10 will be covered in Topping's Spoken Chamorro.
4. Pop quizzes, midterm and final exam.
