The Center for Japanese Studies is offering a scholarship for a UHM student to participate in the Japan-America Student Conference (JASC), July 25 to Aug. 21, 2008.

The CJS Scholarship includes:

1. Roundtrip airfare to the conference site
2. \$3000 participation fee (which covers food, lodging and group travel for the duration of the conference)

Requirements for the Scholarship:

1. UHM classified undergraduate/graduate student status at the time of application and during the Conference
2. Demonstrate high academic achievement and promise
3. Proof of acceptance to participate in JASC

How to Apply for the Scholarship:

1. Submit a copy of the full JASC application to the Center for Japanese Studies by **February 15, 2008** (a week after the application is due to JASC).
2. Ask recommenders to send copies of their letters to the Center for Japanese Studies by **February 15, 2008**.

***Please note that students must submit their applications directly to JASC by **Feb. 8, 2008**, with a non-refundable application fee of \$15 to participate in the conference, and submit a copy of the full application to the Center for Japanese Studies at UHM by **Feb. 15, 2008**, to qualify for the scholarship.

This is an excellent leadership development opportunity for students who will have a chance to meet with other college students from across the U.S. and Japan for lively discussions on global issues.
