

## Educational Psychology Doctoral Program Course Requirements Beginning Fall 2007

*Required core courses.* All doctoral students will be required to take the courses listed below. There will be a total of 33 credits required for these core courses. Students will need to receive a grade of no lower than B (B- will not be acceptable) in each of these courses. Most of the courses are divided into one of the three major areas of educational psychology:
