These courses for grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 teachers are designed to address the Hawai'i Science Content and Performance Standards, HCPS III, and to follow the Benchmark Maps for each grade level. These courses will prepare teachers to successfully teach a series of inquiry-based science activities that will enable them to 1) use a variety of instructional and assessment strategies that are aligned to HCPS III, 2) have the knowledge and confidence to deliver the required science content for their grade level, and 3) develop an excitement and enthusiasm for teaching science at the elementary level. Course fees and materials for Hawai'i participants are covered by STEM grant funding. PDERI credit and follow-up support will be available.
