

PLACEMENT TESTS FOR SPRING 2011 REGISTRATION

Students wishing to take a Chinese, Japanese or Korean language course for the first time at UH Manoa must receive clearance from the department before registering. Students with no previous experience in the language should go to the department office (Moore 382) for clearance; those who are unable to come to campus may call ((808)-956-8940) or e-mail (eall@hawaii.edu). Students with previous experience (i.e., formal classroom training, residence in the country of its use, or cohabitation with a native speaker) must take a placement test.
