

PLACEMENT TESTS FOR SUMMER 2011 REGISTRATION

Students wishing to take a Chinese, Japanese or Korean language course for the first time at UH Mānoa must receive approval from the department before registering. Students with no previous experience in the language should go to the department office (Moore 382) for approval to register for 101 (or 111); those who are unable to come to campus may call ((808)-956-8940) or e-mail (eall@hawaii.edu). Students with some previous experience (i.e., formal classroom training, residence in the country of its use, or cohabitation with a native speaker) must take a placement test.
