



Training Requirements for JABSOM Kaka’ako/Leahi Researchers

- EHSO safety trainings are intended to be general awareness trainings.
- Principal Investigators and/or Lab Supervisors must provide all new lab personnel/students with task and site specific training.
- New lab personnel/students must complete the Lab Personnel Safety Checklist with their supervisor/PI prior to working in the lab.
- Lab personnel/students are responsible for keeping all training records and completing trainings when due. The Safety Training Log should be used to keep track of training dates.

UH System-wide General Lab Safety

- Initial/Classroom training provided by EHSO required once.
- Required for anyone working in a UH lab.
- May be completed at any UH campus/facility and will apply to any UH facility.
- A certificate for completion of the initial training is provided by EHSO.
- Annual refresher should be conducted by the individual PI or designated lab manager using the Lab Personnel Checklist as a guide.

Initial Hazardous Waste Generator Training and Annual Refresher HWG Training (specific to the Kaka’ako & Leahi facilities)

- Initial and annual refresher training is available online at Laulima. Click on link to join training: <https://laulima.hawaii.edu/autoenroll/?hazwastejabsom> (log in using your UH username and password).
- For all those who will submit chemical waste for disposal. Students & Volunteers are not required to complete this training if they will not be submitting waste for disposal.
- Upon completion, a certificate will be emailed by JABSOM EHSO

General Biosafety

Biological Agents & Bloodborne Pathogens

- Training required every 2 years.

Initial Bioshipping and Recertification of Bioshipping

- Required for anyone who ships, receives, transport biological commodities.

Initial Radiation Safety Training and Annual Refresher Radiation Safety Training

- Initial classroom training is required once; annual online refresher required thereafter.



- For anyone who works with radioactivity or may work in a lab that contains work with radioactive materials.
- Generally offered only at Manoa EHSO training classroom, please refer to the training schedule at <http://www.hawaii.edu/ehso/radiation/training.htm>.

Initial Fire Safety Training

- Required once for those requesting a JABSOM Kaka’ako Open Flame Permit.
- A certificate is NOT provided.

Respirator Safety Training

- Required annually for those who are *required* to use a respirator (disposable and non-disposable).
- Required annually for those who *voluntarily choose to use any non-disposable respirator*.*
- Medical clearance confirming that an employee is physically able to wear a respirator during work (required use and voluntary use of non-disposable respirators only).
- Fit testing to the specific respirator that will be used (required use and voluntary use of non-disposable respirators only).
- Fit testing is required at least annually and whenever the respirator type changes, when the risk to the employee changes, and when the employee’s physical changes could affect the seal/fit of the respirator.
- A certificate is provided by the EHSO instructor.
- *Appendix D: OSHA information for employees using disposable respirators when not required.

Vivarium Access/Lab Animal Services Training

- Required once if need to access the Vivarium.

Biosafety Level 3 Training

- Required annually for anyone working in a BSL3/ABSL3.

Select Agent (SA) Training

- Required annually for anyone with SA clearance to work with SA.
