1st Annual
Jarman Environmental Law Fellowship



The Environmental Law Program is delighted to announce the inaugural **Jarman Environmental Law Fellowship**, named after ELP founder and WSRSL faculty member Professor M. Casey Jarman in honor of her twenty-two years of service to the environmental community. The fellowship is made possible by generous ELP alumni and friends who started the UH Foundation Jarman Endowment in 2005. The endowment's goal is to support students who seek career development opportunities in the public interest or government sectors of environmental law.

The Fellowship award for a current 1L (full or part-time) student for Summer 2009 is \$3,000 for 6-week summer employment at a public interest organization or government agency. Applicants should have a strong record of, and commitment to, contributing to the environmental community through public service. Preference will be given to students seeking the Environmental Law Certificate.

The selected student must: (1) demonstrate exemplary performance during the Fellowship; (2) write a self-evaluation report at the end of the summer, (3) write a story for the ELP web site; and (4) be responsible for organizing one ELP Colloquium, community outreach meeting, or service trip next year related to the student's summer work.

How to apply: send a cover letter stating your qualifications for the fellowship (explaining how it furthers your career goals) and a current resume, by email, no later than April 15, 2009 to Prof. Denise Antolini (antolini@hawaii.edu). State in your application if you have already secured a summer position or if you need assistance with placement. ELP and the selection committee can assist students in finding the appropriate position. The selection committee consists of two ELP professors, a 3L Certificate candidate, and two ELP alumni.
