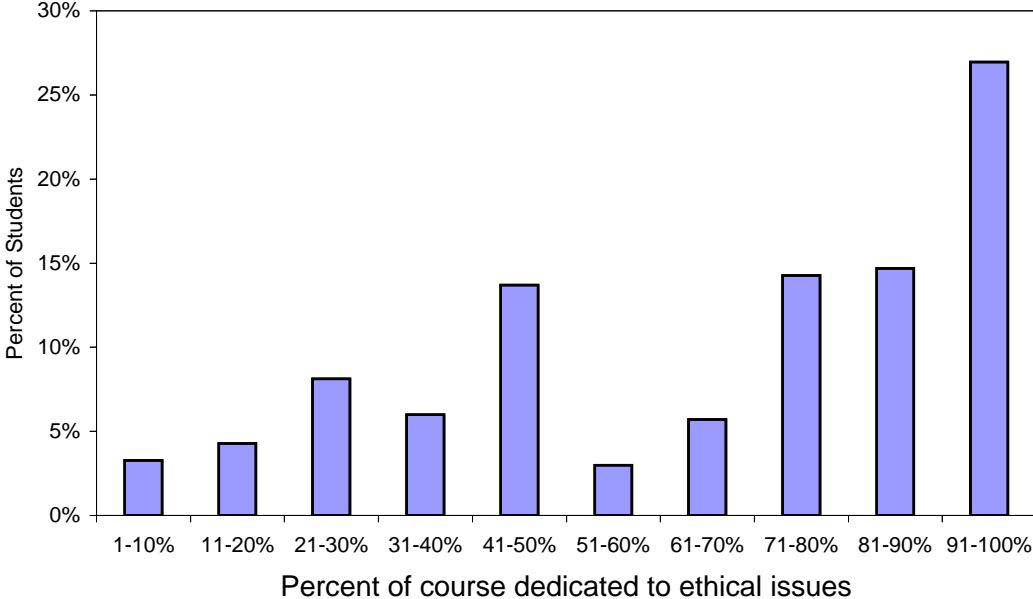

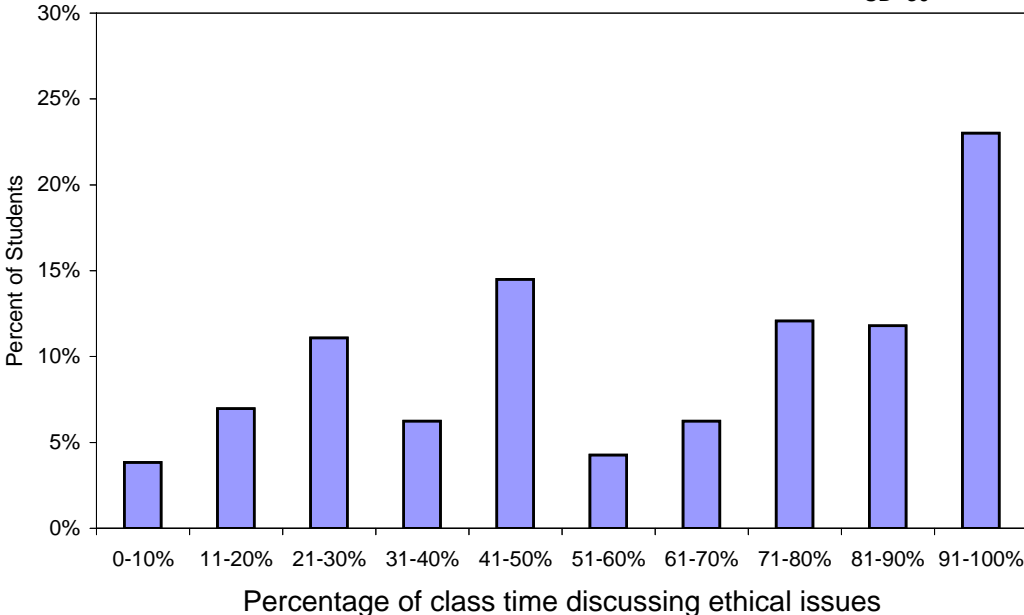
5. Approximately what percentage of this course was dedicated to contemporary ethical issues?

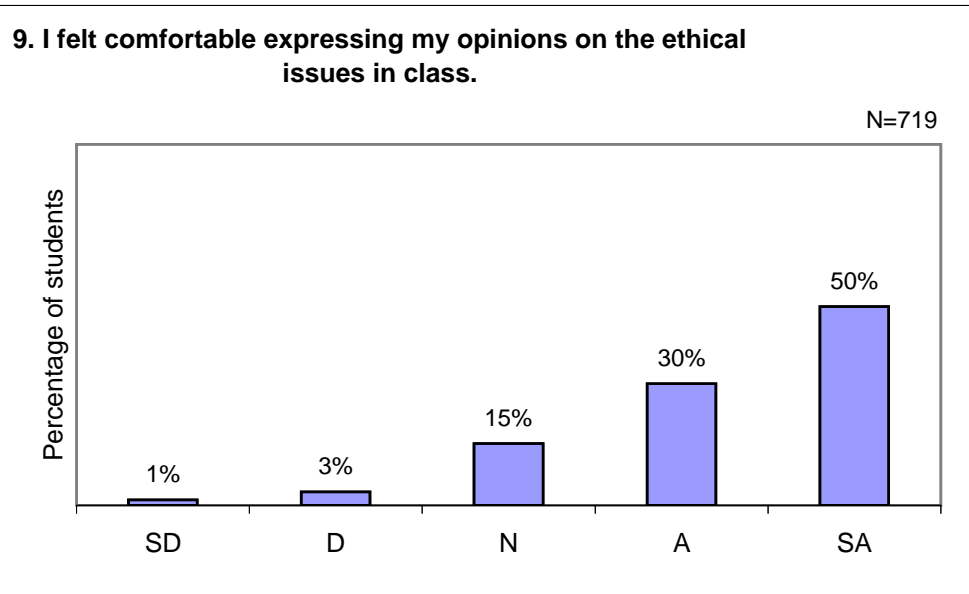
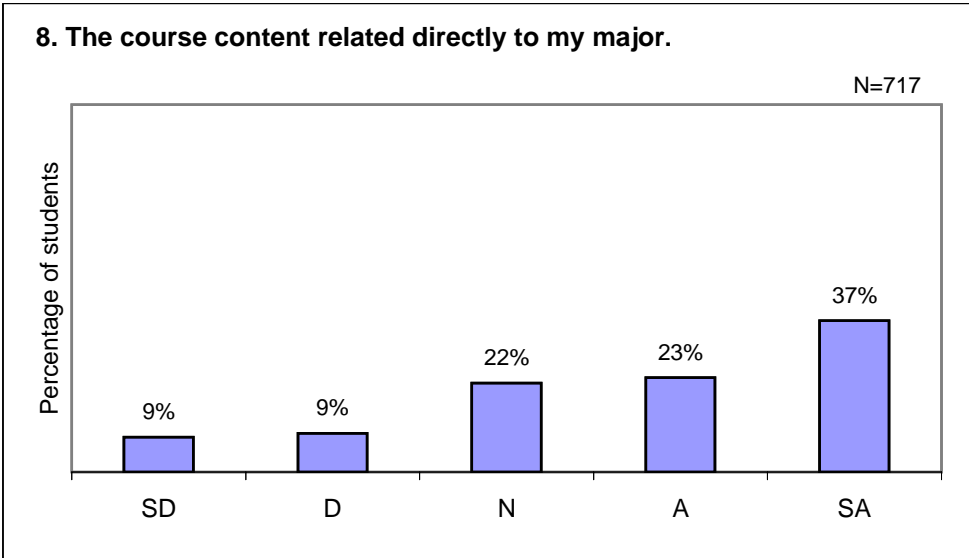
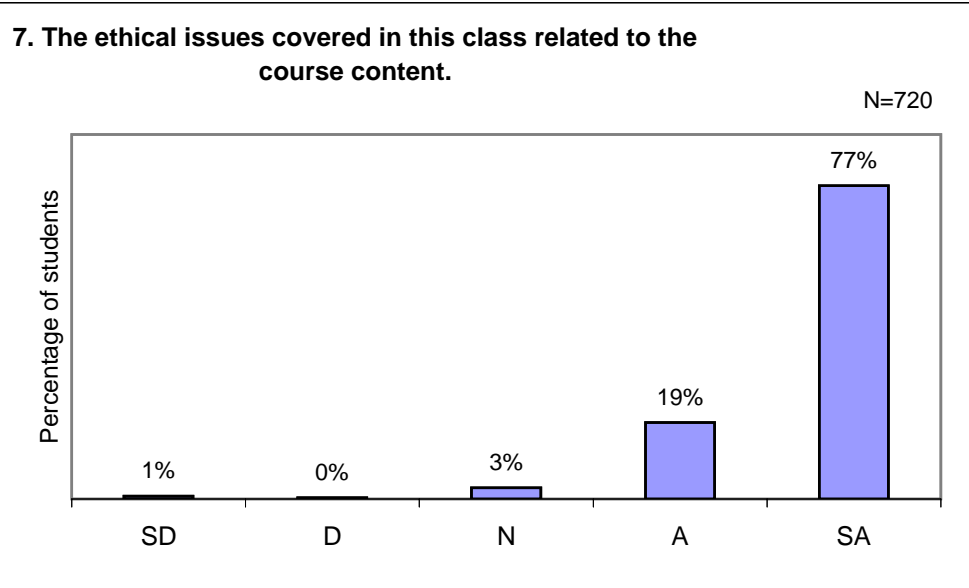

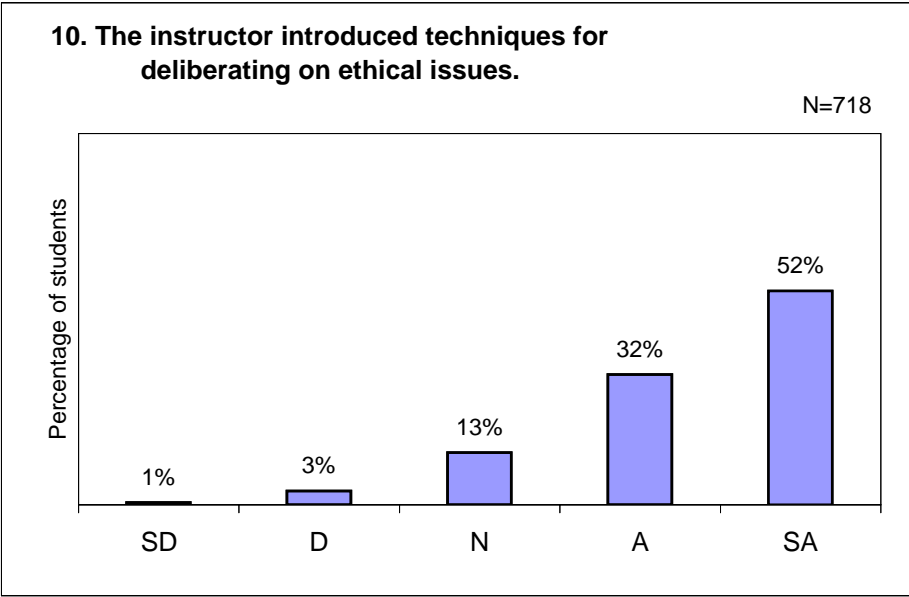


6. Approximately what percentage of time was spent in class discussions of contemporary ethical issues?
