Spring 03	60%	706 surveys returned; 1,175 estimated final enrollment*
Fall 02	63%	729 surveys returned; 1,153 estimated final enrollment*

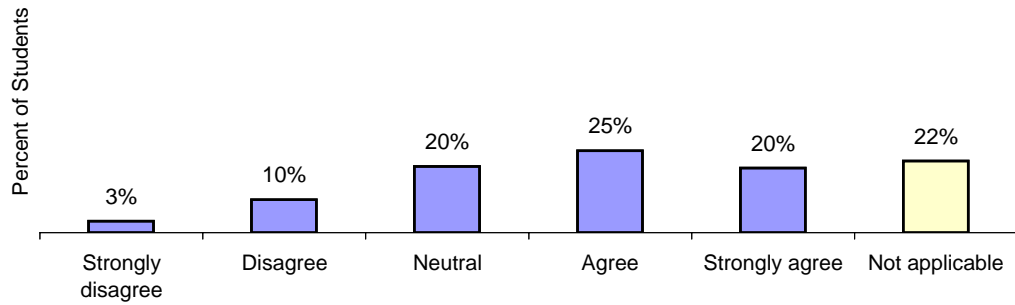

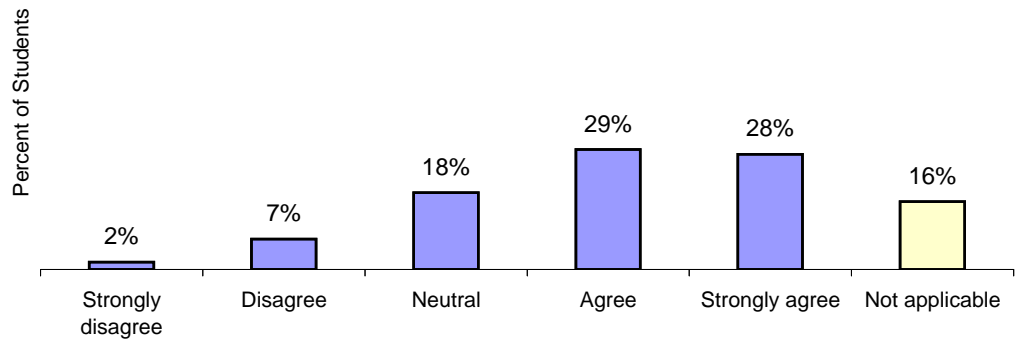

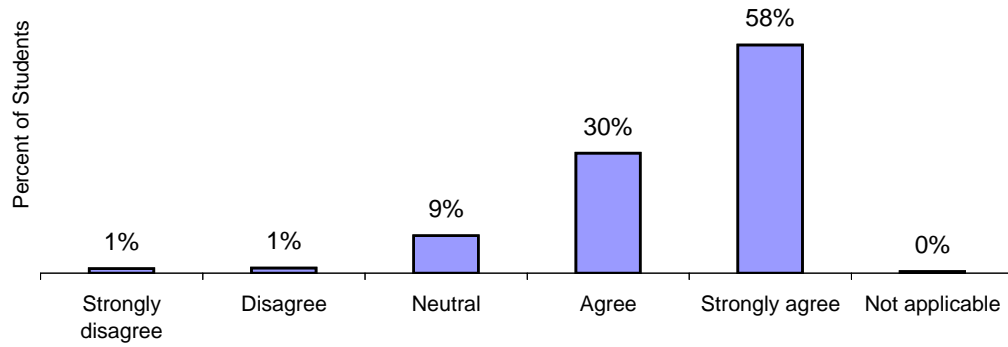
2. The course provided an in-depth understanding of significant relationships of the Pacific with Hawaiian culture.



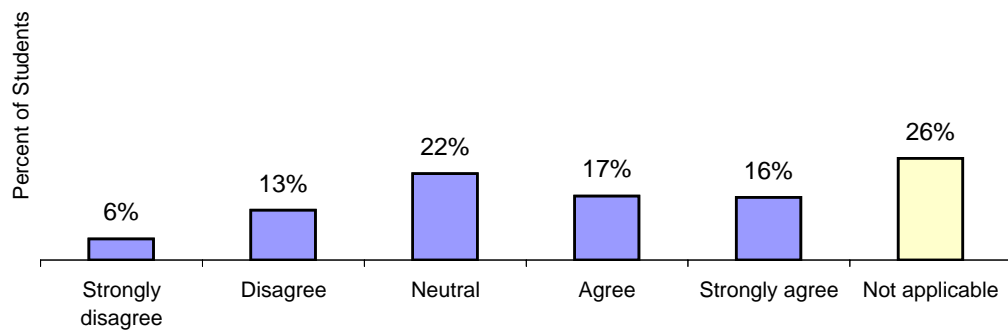
3. The course included indigenous perspectives from Asia and Native Hawai'i.



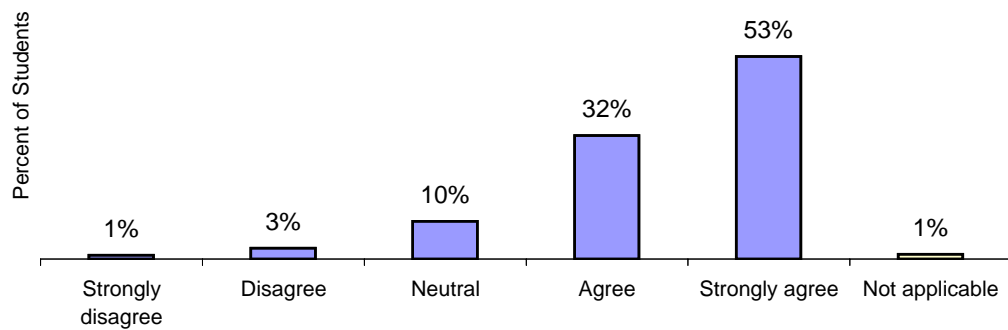
4. The course included indigenous perspectives from the Pacific and Native Hawai'i.



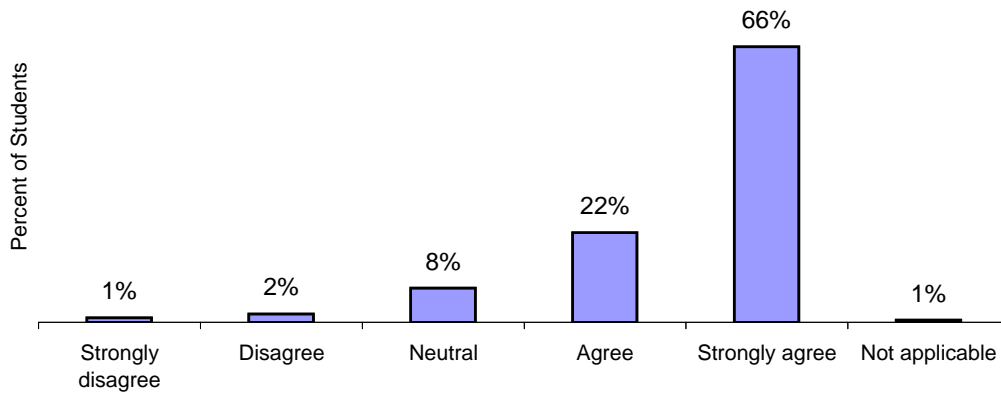
5. The course included activities or assignments which referred to an Asian viewpoint.



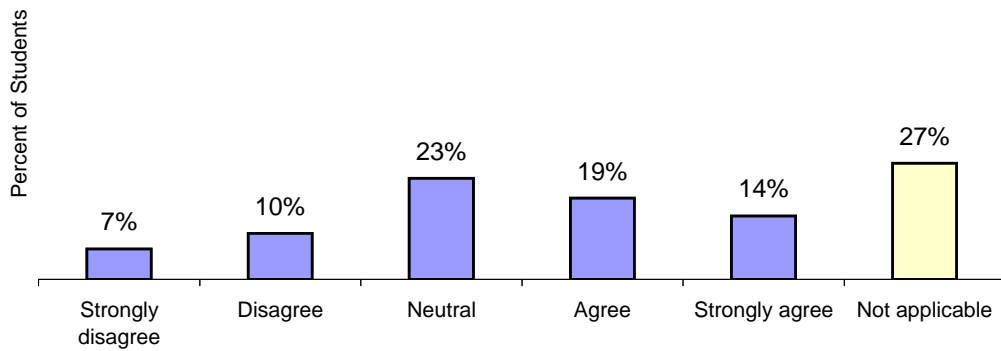
6. The course included activities or assignments which referred to a Pacific viewpoint.



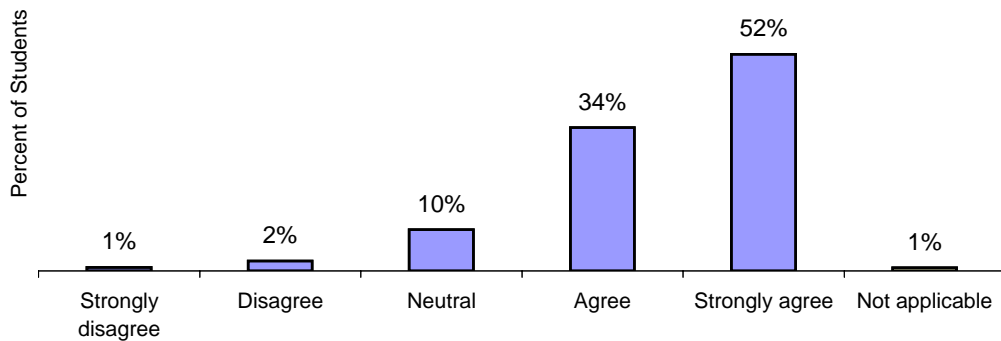

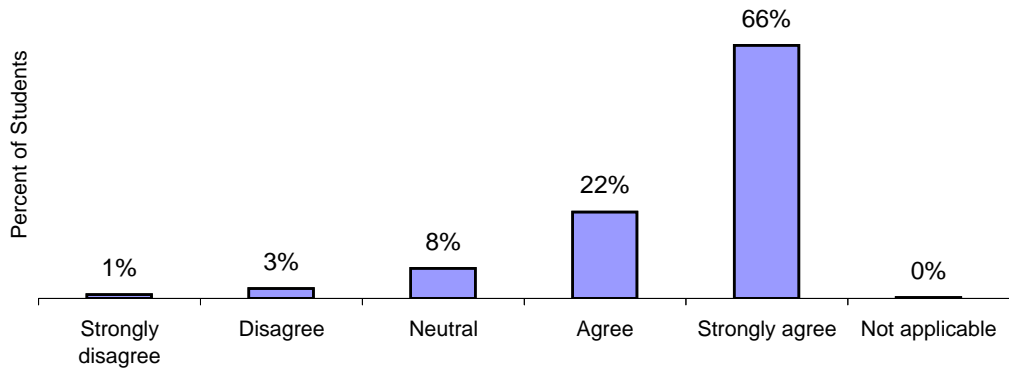

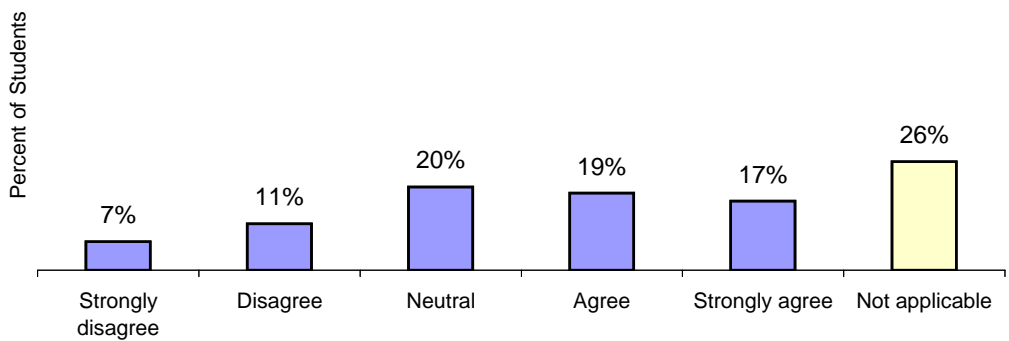

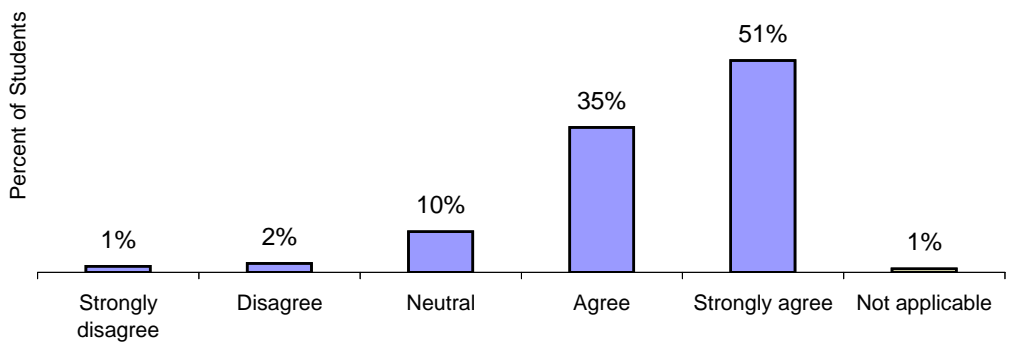
