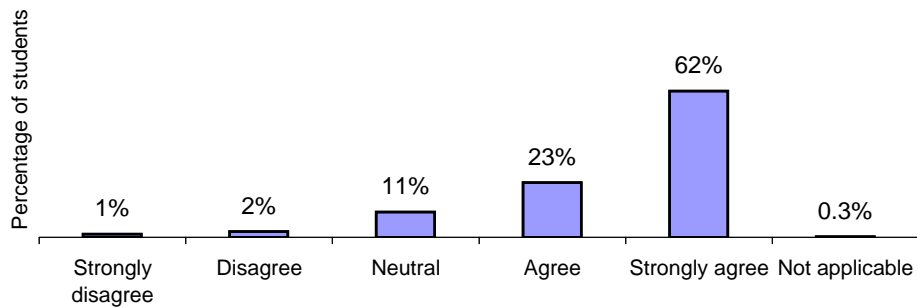

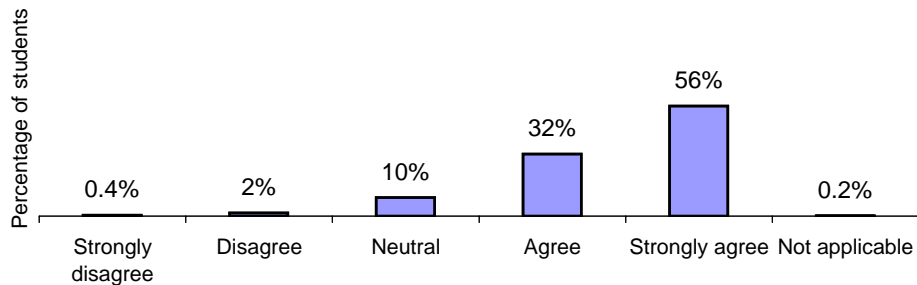
**2. The course brought a greater understanding of Hawai'i and its indigenous culture.**



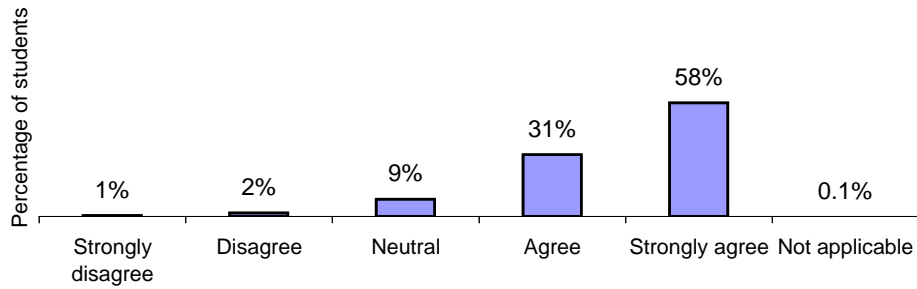
**3. The course helped me to appreciate the perspective of Native Hawaiians.**



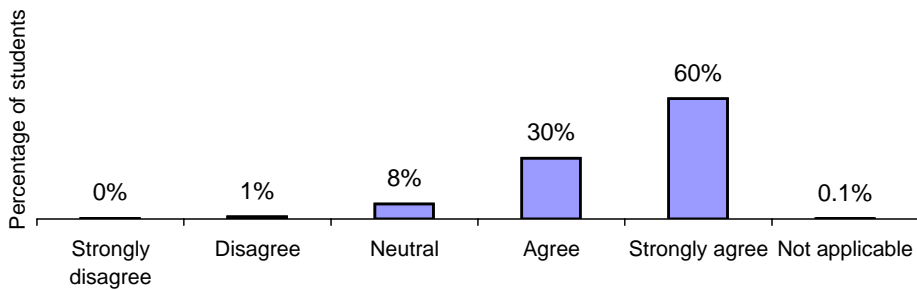
**4. The course included activities or assignments which referred to a Pacific viewpoint.**



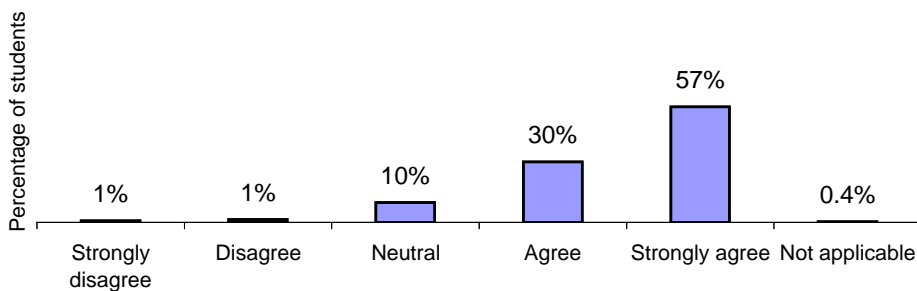
**5. The course brought a greater understanding of the Pacific region and culture.**



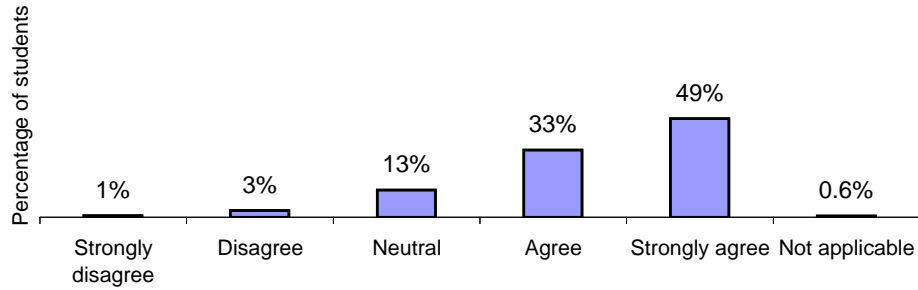
