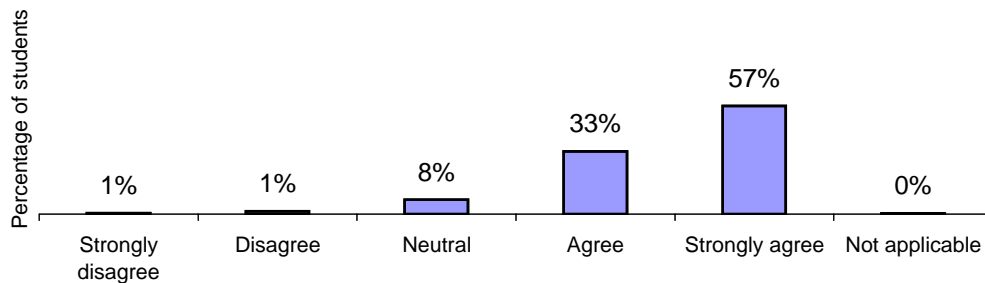
2. The course brought a greater understanding of Hawai'i and its indigenous culture.



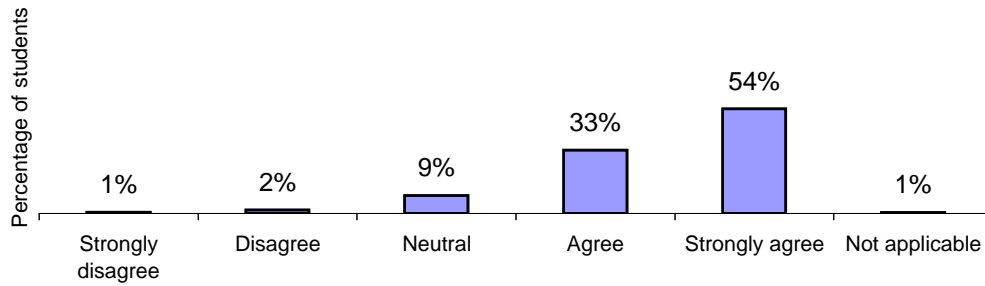
3. The course helped me to appreciate the perspective of Native Hawaiians.



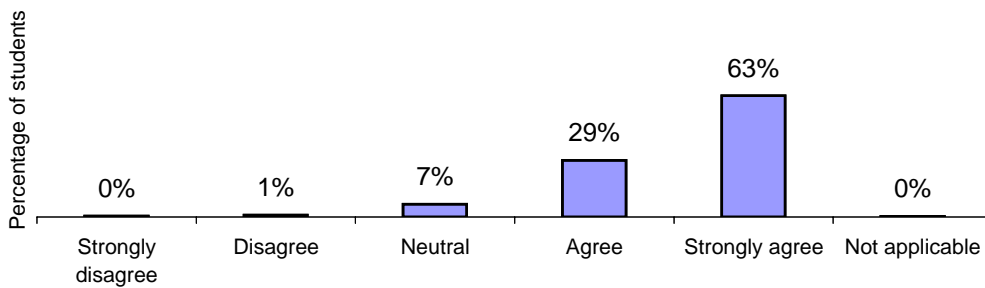
4. The course included activities or assignments which referred to a Pacific viewpoint.



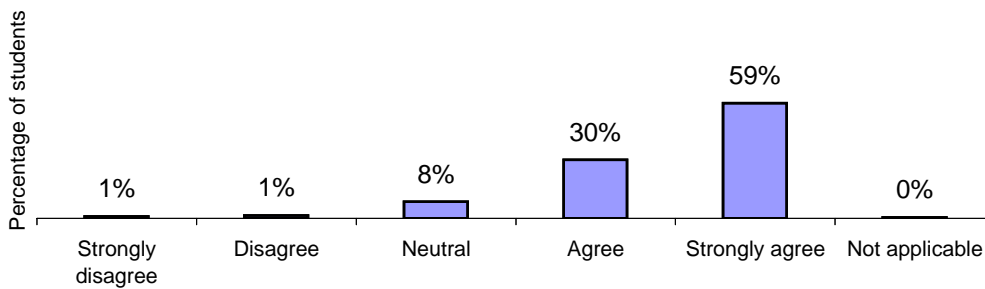

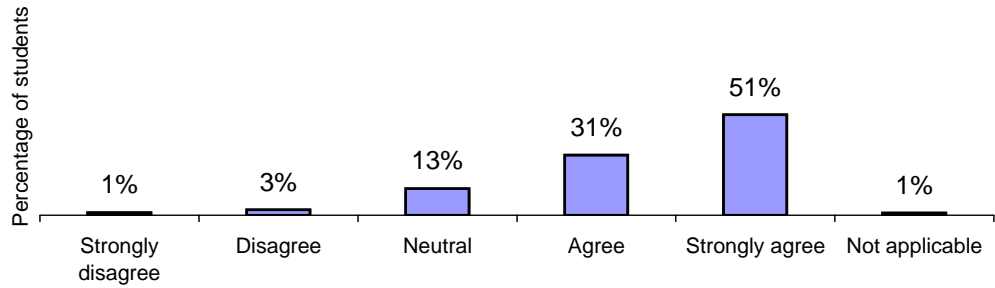
